NEW MOTOR VEHICLE SALES AND MOTOR VEHICLE FINANCING

SEPTEMBER, 1953

New Motor Vehicle Sales

For the first time in 1953, sales of new motor vehicles showed a downward trend. During September there were 30,029 new vehicles retailed for \$75,755,003, a drop of 6% in number and 4% in dollar value from the 31,936 vehicles sold for \$78,771,037 in September a year ago.

Although the overall sales were down, new passenger car sales maintained a slight upward trend. The 22,495 new passenger cars sold for \$55,762,426 in September 1953, represented an increase of less than 1% in number and 4% in value over sales in September 1952. Commercial vehicle sales decreased for the fifth consecutive month, their decline of 21% in number and value being responsible for the overall downward trend in sales of new motor vehicles.

Cumulative figures for the first 9 months of 1953 indicate that sales of new motor vehicles were 21 % higher both in number and retail value compared with the corresponding period in 1952. New passenger car sales were 30 % greater in number and 31 % higher in retail value during the period from January to September 1953 as compared with the same period in 1952. Commercial vehicles, on the other hand, declined 2% in number and 4% in value.

Note:

Retail values quoted in this report are based on the retail price to individual purchasers at the Canadian point of manufacture. In the case of imported vehicles, the values are the retail price delivered at the nearest Canadian distributing centre. Retail values include sales and excise taxes, charges for standard accessories, dealers' commissions, etc. Transportation charges from Canadian point of manufacture to point of delivery are not included.

Financing of Motor Vehicle Sales New Vehicles

Financing of new vehicles in September 1953 followed fairly closely the trend of sales. The 13,319 new vehicles financed to the extent of \$24,411,453 represented a decrease of 6% in number and 1% in financed value from the 14,190 vehicles financed for \$24,695,162 in September 1952.

Financing of new passenger cars decreased 2% in number but increased 5% in amount. Commercial vehicle financing, on the other hand, declined 15% in number and 14% in amount.

During the first nine months of 1953 financing of new vehicles was 16% greater in number and 255 higher in amount than in the same period a year ago.

Used Vehicles

The trend for several months in the financing of sales of used vehicles has been downward in number and upward in amount. This trend continued in September 1953 when there were 34,800 vehicles financed to the extent of \$28,894,464, representing a decrease of 3% in number and an increase of 2% in amount of financing compared with September 1952. Used passenger car financing followed the overall trend and was 3% lower in number and almost 4% higher in amount. Commercial vehicles financed were 5% fewer in number and 6% lower in amount.

The number of used vehicles financed during the first nine months of 1953 was 3% greater and the amount 15% above the January to September period of last year.

FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA 1952 (REVISED) - 1953


