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
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NEW MOTOR VEHICLE SALES AND MOTOR VEHICLE FINANCING

JULY 1956

New Motor Vehicle Sales

Sales of new passenger cars in Canada during July 1956 numbered 42,076 and retailed for \$114,446,000, a record in number and value for any month of July. The number of passenger cars sold was 5.2 per cent above July 1955 while the retail value of sales increased 10.4 per cent over the same period. Cumulative sales for January to July increased 6.3 per cent in number and 13.3 per cent in value over the same period a year ago.

Commercial vehicle sales rose 25.0 per cent in number, to 9,296 from 7,434 and 44.9 per cent in value, to \$32,900,000 from \$22,698,000 over July 1955. Sales of buses included in these figures, totalled 113 units which were valued at \$2,299,000. In the first seven months of this year 55,502 commercial vehicles were sold for \$160,108,000.

Values:

Retail values quoted in this report are based on the retail price to individual purchasers at the Canadian point of manufacture. In the case of imported vehicles, the values are the retail price delivered at the nearest Canadian distributing centre. Retail values include sales and excise taxes, charges for standard accessories, dealers' commissions, etc. Transportation charges from Canadian point of manufacture to point of delivery are not included.

The financing shown herein represents only that business done by sales finance and acceptance companies engaged in the purchase or discounting of notes receivable arising from retail installment sales of new and used motor vehicles.

Financing of Motor Vehicle SalesNew Vehicles

The financing of sales of new passenger cars and commercial vehicles amounted to \$58,475,000 and covered 25,486 units. These totals showed gains of 42.1 per cent and 25.8 per cent respectively over July of last year. Passenger cars alone accounted for 22,067 units financed and \$47,216,000 in amount of financing, a level never before reached in a month of July for both the number and the value. With \$11,259,000 in amount of financing, commercial vehicles established a record for July while the 3,419 units financed came fifth in line after July 1952, 1951, 1953 and 1950.

Used Vehicles

Used passenger vehicle sales financed totalled 41,404 units and \$36,524,000 in amount of financing. These totals were respectively 10.8 per cent and 18.1 per cent greater than the 37,379 units financed for \$30,914,000 in July 1955. Commercial vehicles financed numbered 5,422 or 2.1 per cent above the 5,309 units reported for July 1955 while the amount of financing at \$4,936,000 was 12.0 per cent greater than the \$4,406,000 registered last year.


