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

HOTELS, 1950

INTRODUCTION

The survey of hotels, conducted for the year 1949, was continued for 1950. Certain changes in both reporting firms and tabulation of results were made in the 1950 survey. Public houses in Ontario were shown in the 1949 final report but have been deleted from the 1950 survey. The 1949 figures shown in this bulletin have been revised to exclude these public houses.

The 1949 survey was the first taken since the 1941 Census and in some instances businesses were included as hotels due to improper descriptions, i.e. a large tourist home described as a lodge or seasonal resort. The decrease in number

of hotels in 1950 from 1949 in some provinces may be attributed, in part, to certain refinement of classification. This survey does not include tourist homes, cabins or camps, boarding houses, residential hotels, Y.M.C.A.'s or Y.W.C.A.'s.

New Features - Room occupancy as a percentage of total room potential is shown for the first time in this report in Table 4.

Receipts from leased concessions and a three way breakdown of taxes are also new features of this publication.

SUMMARY OF OPERATIONS

There were 5,169 hotels in operation in Canada during 1950 with 146,353 rooms compared with 5,425 in 1949 with 150,098 rooms. Receipts from all sources in 1950 amounted to \$322,390,000 slightly lower than the 1949 level of \$324,452,000.

The sale of beer, wine and liquor accounted for

50.5% of total receipts in 1950, a very slight increase over the 1949 proportion of 50.2%, while receipts from rooms and meals showed fractional declines from 1949. Hotels in the Prairie Provinces reported the highest percentage of receipts from the sale of alcoholic beverages (over 60%).

There were 3167 full year hotels (open 300 days or more) licensed to sell beer, wine and/or liquor with receipts of \$279,735,000, 61% of the total number and 87% of total receipts of all hotels. The majority of seasonal hotels were not licensed and these 769 hotels had receipts of \$9,588,000 in 1950 compared with 863 hotels in 1949 with receipts of \$10,178,000.

Principal 1950 statistics of hotels - number of rooms, bed capacity, percentage of room occupancy, employment, receipts and expenses - are given in Table 4, by nature of operations.

Receipts by source and a breakdown of operating expenses are shown in dollar volume separately for incorporated and unincorporated hotels and by nature of operations in Tables 5 and 6. Tables 7 and 8 show operating expenses as percentages of total receipts for the same groups as presented in Tables 5 and 6.

City data on hotel operations in Table 9 show Toronto first in volume of receipts, followed by Montreal, Vancouver and Winnipeg. Toronto and

Halifax hotels obtained the highest percentage of room occupancy during 1950 at 84% of total room capacity.

Hotels are classified by amount of annual receipts in Table 10 and number of hotels and receipts of full year hotels are also shown by provinces for each size class in Table 11.

Hotels with receipts of \$100,000 or more numbered 711 or 14% of all hotels but accounted for 55% of total receipts. The large hotels were more concentrated in the full year licensed class than in the other "nature of operations" categories.

In Table 12, hotels are classified according to number of rooms and results are shown by provinces and nature of operations.

The percentage of room occupancy was higher in the larger hotels than in the smaller. Hotels with over 500 rooms registered 81% occupancy utilization while the group of hotels with less than 10 rooms reported 32% occupancy. Table 13 shows percentage of room occupancy of hotels classified by number of rooms.
