In the May 1967 issue of Trade of Canada, Imports by Commodities it was reported that delays in the receipt of customs documents from a major Customs Port required a revision to import trade statistics for the period back to April 1966. The last of the delayed documents was received in time to be included in statistics reported for the month of July.

The retention of the documents at the port for unusually long periods resulted in documents being credited as trade pertaining to subsequent months.

Had there been no delay in the submission of documents a detailed study indicates that the import totals for each of the affected months would have been as follows:
