


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

INTRODUCTION

This report is the thirteenth of an annual series presenting estimated revenues, expenditures and debt of local governments in provincial and territorial aggregates. Over the years the series has developed thereby enabling a more comprehensive presentation of results. Two years ago territorial aggregates and selected Census Metropolitan Area statistics were introduced. Last year the series was extended and gross expenditures were presented on a new format to show "revenue from own sources" and "cost of services provided"; the functional classification of conditional grants were introduced and the Census Metropolitan Area presentation extended and Census Major Urban Area aggregates introduced. This year the financial statistics of school boards are included in their entirety whereas in prior years they were included only to the extent of their financing by municipalities. Waterworks are included for the first time as an integral part of the general services provided by municipal government following a review of the definition of government general, as opposed to government enterprise, thereby conforming with the concept of government employed in the recent historically revised series of the System of National Accounts. Also the presentation of Census Metropolitan Area and Major Urban Area statistics is now complete with the inclusion of all CMAs and CMUs within the Province of Quebec. To increase the usefulness of the statistics, detail of "Other revenue" as shown in total in Table 1 is now presented in Table 5.

Over the past few years this report has been extended substantially both in scope and depth of detail, and now conforms with the gross revenue and expenditure as presented for the other levels of government.

An analysis of debenture debt charges and estimated gross debenture debt outstanding at the year end, has again been included in provincial aggregate form; this information, however, was not available for Quebec, Yukon and the Northwest Territories.

Local Government Organization and Structure

Government in Canada is comprised of three tiers—federal, provincial or territorial, and local. Whereas, for statistical purposes, distinction between the federal and provincial levels is clear-cut, that between the provincial and local is less well defined. "Local government" is defined by DBS as all government entities below the provincial level. The number of these entities is large, and their relationships with one another and with their respective provincial governments are extremely complex. An understanding of these relationships is essential for the interpretation of local government statistics.

Local government exists to provide services which constitutionally are the responsibility of the provinces but which, in the latter's opinion, are best administered by organizations whose jurisdictions are confined to localities within the province. Because the constitution is permissive insofar as the establishment of "municipal institutions" by provincial governments is concerned, and because of the wide variations in tradition, history, development, and other determinants in each province, the roles assigned to local government and the way it discharges these roles vary considerably, not only from province to province, but also between similar entities within a single province.

Similarly, while all provinces provide financial assistance to their local government entities, such assistance can vary widely. In fact, because of the differing financial arrangements existing among the three levels of government in each province and especially because of the divergences in allocation of responsibilities between provincial and local levels from province to province, true interprovincial comparability can only be achieved after a process of integration of government and government enterprise operations at each level followed by a consolidation of operations at both levels. Consolidated statements of provincial and local government statistics for each province may be obtained by adding together the gross revenue and expenditure data for the two levels of government, subject to adjustments for conditional and unconditional grants. Specifically, the amounts of conditional and unconditional grants to

local government shown as expenditures of provincial governments must be offset against the amounts of provincial conditional and unconditional grants shown as revenue of local governments. Because of differences in fiscal year-ends and accounting practices, amounts shown as having been paid by one level of government to another will differ from those shown as having been received.

Consolidations of provincial-local as well as federal-provincial-local revenues and expenditures are compiled in the DBS publication "Consolidated Government Finance, 1967", Catalogue No. 68-202. Provincial government financial data for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1968 is available in the publication "Provincial Government Finance, Revenue and Expenditure, 1967", Catalogue No. 68-207. The Federal Government financial data for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1968 is available in the publication "Federal Government Finance, Revenue and Expenditure, 1967", Catalogue No. 68-211.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics assigns local government entities to three principal categories (as illustrated in the diagram below)—municipalities, special purpose boards and local school boards. Municipalities, whether regional or unitary may delegate authority to a joint board or create boards or commissions which DBS classifies as enterprise, institutional or other. Quasi-municipalities, administered by provincially-appointed boards or commissions, are regarded as municipalities because they provide limited municipal services to areas that would otherwise be considered unorganized territory. Special purpose boards are also created by the provincial government to provide services of a local nature to areas which usually embrace more than one municipality; examples are regional library boards, conservation authorities, etc. School boards are closely allied to municipalities in that, in many instances, a large part of the financing is provided through the municipality and, in some cases, the school board is formed from a committee of council. Although the quality and quantity of service provided by school boards is controlled by the provincial government, there is a strong local element of administration; DBS therefore considers school boards as a major component of local government.


The financial statistics presented herein are for municipalities (including waterworks), school boards and joint boards in their entirety; the remaining municipal boards, and special purpose boards are included to the extent to which they are financed by municipalities. Also to maintain uniformity, as near as possible, between provinces and to adhere to the concept of "gross revenue" and "gross expenditure (cost of services provided)", capital expenditures and relative provincial grants are included for municipalities, school boards and for special purpose boards that could be identified.

Estimating Procedures

The estimates presented as "Preliminary" for 1968 and "Estimates" for 1969 in this publication were obtained by projection of 1967 information as published in "Local Government Finance—Actual" Catalogue No. 68-204 on the trends established by survey.

Municipalities included in the survey were selected on the basis of two criteria.

- (1) Municipalities considered unique and therefore not representative were selected to be surveyed on a full coverage basis. This group included all municipalities in Census Metropolitan and Major Urban Areas, most remaining cities, and other municipalities which constituted extremes during the process of forming homogeneous groups prior to sample selection.
- (2) The remaining municipalities were grouped essentially by type of corporation (cities, towns, villages etc.) within each province with some groups subdivided into size strata where required. From these homogeneous groups sample municipalities were selected on a random basis with representation weighted by the proportion of the group to the respective provincial aggregate of total expenditures.



Basically, the method of projection was to apply the percentage change in sample data from base to current year to the total data for the base year. This link or index of change was computed and applied for each item of revenue, expenditure etc. within each sample group.

The estimates derived from data provided by those selected as sample municipalities were added to the estimates provided by the self-representing municipalities to arrive at projected revenue and expenditure comparable in scope to the Department of Municipal Affairs base data. These estimates on a provincial aggregate basis were then adjusted to compensate for portions of local government not represented by the survey and also to make the estimates comparable in concept with the "actual" series as published for 1967.

Capital expenditures were derived from the same survey, but a different estimating technique was employed. Although the same sample composition was observed, the estimates derived from sample municipalities were tempered by supporting information respecting capital expenditure programmes and works contract data — that is, due to the high degree of variability of capital expenditures, the sample element of the survey was subject to errors, especially between functions.

Limitations

Although the specific items of revenue and expenditure are common to nearly all municipalities, their relative significance within the financial structure of each municipality differs to varying degrees. As an example, towns of a comparable size in a given area might all have "real property tax" and "licences and permits" revenue. The proportion of these items of revenue to their respective total revenue could vary from one town to another within the group — indeed, it might be expected that the proportion of "licences and permits" would vary significantly. Therefore, the sample representation varies between items of revenue and expenditure and the quality of the estimates varies accordingly. Items which form a stable proportion of revenue or expenditure for a sample group of municipalities have a higher degree of accuracy or reliability than others. This inadequacy

of the sample to be totally representative was recognized and special attention was given during the compilation to minimize errors resulting from under-representation of this nature. Such errors of sampling vary from item to item; however, the sample element forms only a part of the provincial total and hence the error in the provincial total of a particular item is relatively insignificant.

Gross Revenue and Expenditure

The "Gross" concept is employed in the presentation of statistics in this publication to conform with the publications for the other levels of government and the "Local Government Finance — Actual" Catalogue No. 68-204. Gross revenue includes all revenue regardless of source; gross expenditure (or cost of services provided) includes all current and capital expenditures without duplication. To avoid duplication in the calculation of gross expenditure, outlays for the acquisition of fixed assets are reflected at the point in time at which the fixed asset is acquired rather than when any loan in this respect is repaid (municipal accounting conventions treat the repayment of long-term loans as an expenditure in the year in which revenue is provided for this purpose). Also, as the "gross" presentation constitutes a consolidation of the "current" and "capital" funds, the current expenditure item "contributions to the capital and loan fund" is eliminated as an inter-fund transfer.

Gross revenue in this publication includes all current revenue of all municipalities (including waterworks) school boards and the net contributions from municipal boards, together with capital grants from other levels of government respecting all capital expenditures of municipalities and their boards (except enterprises), special purpose boards and school boards. Gross expenditure was compiled to include current and capital expenditures without duplication including the same coverage of the local government universe as the revenue. Because municipal boards are included only to the extent of their financing by municipalities, the revenues are understated by the amount of relevant transfers to these entities from other levels of government and to a lesser extent by other incidental forms of revenue.

Most provinces provide some form of tax relief to the homeowner and, as in Ontario, the tenant. In this statistical presentation such payments are considered as payments to the homeowner or tenant by the provincial government and administered through the municipal offices, and therefore not a reduction of municipal tax revenue nor a municipal revenue grant from the province.

Continuity with the actual series for both scope in coverage and consistency of classification was maintained wherever possible, to reflect the true trend in the estimates for 1968 and 1969.

Improved reporting and estimating techniques enabled the identification and presentation of "Business tax" for Ontario and Saskatchewan municipalities for all three years covered in this publication. This tax is more dominant in the larger urban municipalities, and improved survey coverage plus improved reporting by respondents resulted in the need to estimate for only a minor portion of each respective provincial aggregate.

Capital expenditures for the acquisition of land were classified in "Other expenditures - Other", as they were not identifiable by function in the source material, and because they could be applicable to "Recreation and community service" as well as "Public works" or various forms of urban redevelopment programmes.

Debenture Debt Charges

The analysis of debenture debt charges shown in Table 3 is a presentation of the charges relative to the gross debenture debt of local government. The interest portion, relative to debentures issued for municipal and school purposes only, agrees with the expenditure item "Debt charges - Debenture interest" in Table 2. Resumption of the responsibility for education at the local level by the government of the Province of New Brunswick is reflected in this table with the elimination of debenture debt charges for this purpose for all three years as the change was effective January 1, 1967.

Gross Debenture Debt

Table 6 shows the estimated debt outstanding at December 31 for all debentures issued by local government with the exception of Quebec and the Yukon and Northwest Territories for which information was not available.

Conditional Transfers from Federal and Provincial Governments

Conditional transfers from other levels of government, comprising grants-in-aid and shared-cost contributions of both a current and capital nature, are presented in provincial aggregate form by function. The presentation conforms both in scope and detail with that shown for prior years in the publication "Local Government Finance - Actual" Catalogue No. 68-204. Some difficulty was experienced in the allocation of grants identifiable by programme rather than by function. Provincial grants for "Winter works" are included in "Public works", but other grants which could not be identified as being predominantly for only one function but were nevertheless conditional are

included in "Conditional Transfers - Other". Examples of such multi-function grants are those made under "The Municipal Aid Act" of British Columbia, as well as those under "The Municipal Services Act" of Nova Scotia. Improved data for conditional grants in Ontario enabled the presentation of additional data for 1968 and 1969 which accounts for the substantial increase in the total for these years. An additional break in continuity occurs where capital expenditures for hospitals were included for 1968 and 1969, but information on the relative capital grants was not available.

Census Metropolitan and Major Urban Areas

Where only a portion of a municipality was included for Census of Canada Population Statistics, the entire municipality was included in this presentation. An exception was made to present the Ontario and Quebec portions of the CMA of Ottawa in their respective provinces for purposes of comparison with provincial aggregates, otherwise both parts are combined in the Ontario CMA presentations.

Similarly the decision respecting the inclusion of school boards in the CMA and CMUA compilations where boundaries were not coterminous was based on the determination of those boards, the area of which most closely conformed to the CMA and CMUA boundaries. Provincial grants to these school boards and their current expenditures were allocated provincially on a per capita basis. Similar treatment was accorded the estimated capital expenditures in Quebec.

So far as possible CMA and CMUA gross revenue and expenditure is presented on a basis consistent with the provincial aggregates. Exceptions to this consistency occur where inter-municipal transfers can be almost entirely eliminated on consolidation for the provincial aggregate but only partially eliminated in the CMA or CMUA aggregate - e.g., county rates in Ontario. As contributions from other municipalities are included in "Other revenue" it is possible for the CMA and CMUA aggregates to exceed the provincial aggregate with a contra situation in the expenditure item "Other expenditures - Special projects" where joint expenditures are presented.

Where adjustments were required to provincial aggregate data to offset known bias in the estimates, a comparable adjustment was made to the CMA and CMUA data on a judgment basis.

In some instances conditional grants were available only in provincial aggregate form (such as Municipal Development and Loan Funds contributions) and are therefore omitted from the CMA and CMUA compilations resulting in an understatement of the ratio to provincial aggregate. This situation is accentuated in Ontario where provincial grants to conservation authorities are shown in the provincial aggregate only, in the item "Provincial grants - Other".

The CMAs and CMUAs and their constituent municipalities, showing the 1966 Census population figures for each and the proportions to their respective provincial totals follow. Municipalities included in this compilation are denoted by an "x" in the last column.






MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE AND CONDITIONAL TRANSFERS
RECEIVED 1968, BY FUNCTION





LOCAL GOVERNMENT—GENERAL EXPENDITURE, 1968 PRELIMINARY—

AS A PERCENTAGE OF RESPECTIVE FUNCTIONS, BY PROVINCE




