

The totals of columns 2, 3 and 7 should read \$686,614,000; \$3,963,-640,000; and \$4,028,984,000 respectively.



This report provides analyses of funded debt, based upon interim figures provided by government sources and supplemented in some instances by other published information. These statistics appear several months earlier than those available in our report "Direct and Indirect Debt-Actual". The figures, being interim, may be found in some instances to vary from those which will appear in the provincial Public Accounts, when released, and in our "Actual" report. However, it is not expected that such variations will be of any great significance.

During the fiscal year ended March 31, 1964 all of the provinces except Alberta and British Columbia floated new bond issues totalling \$554,963,000. This figure includes \$177,289,200 10-year, 5, 51/4, 5½ per cent savings bonds dated April 1, 1963, issued by the Province of Quebec; \$13,063,000 10-year 4% per cent savings bonds dated June 1. 1963, issued by the Province of Manitoba; and \$13,861,200 10-year 5-51/2 per cent savings bonds dated March 15, 1964 issued by the Province of Saskatchewan. Of the total new borrowings, over 96 per cent was payable only in Canada. In this period all provinces made retirement of bonded debt totalling \$245,107,000; this includes \$3,910,000. called or cancelled by three provinces prior to maturity and \$28,202,850 savings bonds cashed at the owners' option. Of this latter figure \$20,581,850 pertained to savings bonds issued by the Province of Quebec.

Since the first issue of provincial government savings bonds by the Province of Saskatchewan on March 15, 1961, sales of this type of non-marketable bonds by Quebec, Manitoba and Saskatchewan have amounted to over \$301 million. These bonds are non-callable, but are redeemable, with accrued interest, at the owner's demand. Up to March 31, 1964 savings bonds totalling \$40.6 million had been redeemed, leaving a balance of \$260.6 million outstanding. This represents 5.6 per cent of the total gross provincial bonded debt as at March 31, 1964.

All provinces except Alberta and British Columbia showed increases in gross bonded debt outstanding over the previous fiscal year; the total for all provinces of \$4,650.3 million increasing by 7.1 per cent over the \$4,340.4 million at March 31, 1963. The proportion of the total debt payable in Canada increased from 76.4 per cent to 78.9 per cent. Based on par values, the average interest rate continued to rise amounting to 4.47 per cent at March 31, 1964.

Information on other direct liabilities (consisting of short-term treasury bills; temporary loans and overdrafts; trust funds, savings and other deposits; accounts and other payables; and accrued expenditure) as at March 31, 1964 is not yet available. However at March 31, 1963 they totalled \$775 million for all provinces.

Bonds guaranteed by provincial governments amounted to \$5,296.8 million at March 31, 1964 an increase of 13.97 per cent over the \$4,647.5 million at the end of the previous year; all provinces except Nova Scotia which showed a decrease, shared in this increase. These guarantees consist mainly of bonds issued by government enterprises, such as power and telephone corporations, and also include certain bonds issued by provincial universities, municipalities and school corporations, and various private authorities,

This report does not include statistics of provincial guarantees of bank loans, guarantee of loans by the Government of Canada to municipalities under the Municipal Improvement Assistance Act, nor of other guarantees, as these data for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1964, are not yet available. At March 31, 1963 they amounted to \$170.1 million.

The co-operation of provincial officials in supplying information is gratefully acknowledged.
