### MUNICIPAL ASSESSMENT VALUATIONS, 1934.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics has for some years past compiled bulletins dealing with Assessment Valuations from reports made by municipalities to the several provincial governments. The report herewith presented gives information covering the year 1934.

There is no uniformity of system as between municipalities in the basis of assessment, nor is there any comparability as between provinces in the presentation of their several reports on assessments. The Bureau, however, has consulted with provincial authorities where discrepancies appeared to be somewhat abnormal, and the tables shown represent the latest and most reliable information which it is possible to obtain under existing conditions.

With regard to exempted valuations such property is comprised mainly of government property (Dominion, Provincial and Municipal) as well as that of educational, charitable and religious institutions.

In the province of Prince Edward Island there is no system of rural municipalities and the land valuations are estimated by provincial government authorities. The urban valuations represent the City of Charlottetown and seven incorporated towns. In the case of Charlottetown, land valuations only are shown under taxable real property.

Land and building valuations are only shown separately for the provinces of Ontario, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia. Personal property assessment is not recorded in the provinces of Quebec, Ontario, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia, while income valuation is only shown for Ontario, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island.

Table 3 gives an historical record of valuations from 1919 to 1934. The fluctuations of values in the case of New Brunswick are due to incomplete returns from certain municipalities in the earlier years.




