

# MUNICIPAL ASSESSMENT VALUATIONS, 1938.

Variations in the basis of assessment as between provinces and frequently as between municipalities make it impossible to compile a strictly comparable report on Municipal Assessment Valuations throughout Canada. In preparing the present bulletin the Bureau has, where discrepancies appeared abnormal, consulted with Provincial authorities, and the information submitted is as complete and accurate as it is possible to obtain under existing circumstances.

Exempted valuations represent largely Dominion, Provincial and Municipal government properties, plus educational, religious and charitable institutions.

Land valuations as shown for Prince Edward Island where there are no rural municipalities have been estimated by provincial government authorities. Urban valuations in that province cover the City of Charlottetown and seven incorporated towns.

An historical record of assessment and exempted valuations covering the years 1919 to 1938 inclusive, will be found in Table 3. Fluctuations of values in the earlier years in New Brunswick are due to incomplete returns from certain municipalities.

The Dominion-Provincial Conference on uniform methods of reporting Municipal Statistics has been engaged through a standing Committee for some time past in the study of assessment problems, and hope is entertained that eventually more comparable data may be obtained.
