

GROSS BUNDED INDEBTEDNESS OF URBAN AND RURAL MUNICIPALITIES - 1933.

Introduction

The Bureau has for some years published a bulletin dealing with the gross bonded indebtedness of urban and rural municipalities by provinces, the information being compiled from the reports made to the provincial governments by the various municipalities throughout Canada. The tables herewith presented cover the year 1933 and represent the latest available information.

There were 4,296 municipalities in Canada in 1933 divided into urban and rural classes. The first class consists of cities, towns, villages and five suburban municipalities, while the second class consists of counties, rural municipalities and districts.

The provincial governments continue to exercise certain restrictions and control of borrowings by the municipalities situated within their respective provincial areas, but the yearly increase of bonded indebtedness since 1925 indicates the more or less free use of borrowing powers by municipalities to meet their expensitures and debt requirements. While there are decreases in the provinces of British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Ontario and New Brunswick in 1933 as compared with the previous year, the increases in the other provinces more than offset the reduction.

Municipal governments, in general, have endeavoured to curtail expenditures during the depression period, but the unemployment situation and relief problems fall heavily upon them and no doubt explain to a large extent the increase in this branch of governmental indebtedness in the later years

A special table is included in the report showing the sinking funds held to offset the gross bonded debt.




