

### MUNICIPAL TAX LEVIES AND RECEIPTS

Lack of uniformity as between provinces in the methods of collection and presentation of municipal statistics makes it difficult to obtain comparable data for the four thousand three hundred municipalities that exist in Canada. For earlier years certain provinces have no available information.

A Dominion-Provincial Conference was held in Ottawa last year for the purpose of organizing a uniform scheme of collecting municipal statistics. While such an undertaking presents many difficulties, the several committees appointed by the Conference have since held a series of meetings at which a uniform classification of accounts and draft schedules were prepared for consideration by officials having charge of municipal affairs in the various provinces before their final adoption.

The public interest concerning taxation has greatly increased within the last three years and the Bureau has received numerous requests for statistics on the subject. The series of tables presented in this bulletin show, as completely as it is now possible to give, the taxation levies and receipts of municipalities by provinces from 1913 to 1936, inclusive. The figures represent general purpose, school, and other taxation. In the case of Quebec however, as noted on page four school tax receipts cannot be shown separately for cities, towns and rural municipalities.

The following notes will help to explain the tables for each province:

In the case of Prince Edward Island, the municipal system comprises only the City of Charlottetown and seven small incorporated towns. Statistics for towns are not available, while for the City of Charlottetown tax receipts only for the more recent years are procurable.

In Nova Scotia, no statistics have been collected showing municipal tax levies. With regard to tax receipts, information is not available for cities prior to 1918, while the receipts for villages are included with "Rural" tax receipts.

With regard to New Brunswick, the provincial government has never collected information showing taxation levies. The tax receipts for the cities of Saint John, Moncton and Fredericton alone, are shown for the years 1932 and 1933 and for Saint John and Moncton only in 1934 and 1935. Statistics of taxation receipts covering all municipalities were published for the first time in 1936.

Statistics showing tax levies in Quebec were not collected. While tax receipts for general purposes are available for cities, towns and rural municipalities which include villages, school tax receipts are not so separated, and can be given only for "all municipalities" from 1915.

Statistics of levies and receipts for villages in Ontario are included with towns until 1934 and from then on are shown separately. Tax receipts are not available prior to the year 1924.

Tax receipts for Manitoba are not available prior to 1931, while receipts for cities are shown for the first time in 1932.

In Saskatchewan tax receipts for cities are not available prior to 1921.

In Alberta tax levies for cities in 1922 and towns in 1926 are not available, while statistics showing tax receipts were not collected prior to 1923. City tax receipts for 1923 are not shown.

British Columbia has no municipal organization of towns, while villages were first erected in 1922. Tax levies for cities prior to 1918 are not available, nor are those for villages earlier than 1923. Statistics of tax receipts for cities and rural districts are shown beginning with 1917, and those for villages beginning with 1922.

While the tables generally cover the period 1913-1936 the following Table I gives a comparative statement as between provinces for the five latest available years.


