

COMMENTARY

Overview

Estimates from Statistics Canada's Labour Force Survey indicate that employment grew by 73,000 in August 1989. After an unsettled period at the beginning of the year, three of the last four months have shown strong employment growth. There was little change in unemployment this month, reflecting an increase in the size of the labour force. The unemployment rate edged down to 7.4.

Employment

For the week ended August 19, 1989, the seasonally adjusted level of employment increased by 73,000 to 12,561,000. The employment/population ratio rose by 0.3 to 62.3.

- Employment increased by 31,000 among persons aged 15 to 24 and by 42,000 among those aged 25 and over. Overall, employment rose by 44,000 among men and by 29,000 among women.
- Full-time employment was estimated at 10,679,000, up 72,000 from July. This increase was concentrated among men (+58,000). There was little change in part-time employment, which stood at 1,850,000.
- The seasonally adjusted estimate of employment in agriculture increased by 14,000. Employment also grew slightly in most of the other sectors. On the other hand, employment in construction was down slightly.
- The estimated level of employment rose by 29,000 in Quebec, 21,000 in Ontario and 8,000 in Alberta. There was little or no change in employment in the other provinces.

COMMENTAIRE

Aperçu

Selon les estimations tirées de l'enquête sur la population active de Statistique Canada, l'emploi a connu une hausse de 73,000 en août 1989. Après les fluctuations notées au début de l'année, trois des quatre derniers mois affichent une forte croissance de l'emploi. Le niveau de chômage a peu varié ce mois-ci, ce qui traduit une augmentation de la taille de la population active. Le taux de chômage s'est abaissé à 7.4.

Emploi

Pour la semaine se terminant le 19 août 1989, le niveau désaisonnalisé de l'emploi a augmenté de 73,000, s'établissant à 12,561,000. Le rapport emploi-population a augmenté de 0.3 pour passer à 62.3.

- L'emploi a augmenté de 31,000 parmi les personnes de 15 à 24 ans et de 42,000 parmi celles de 25 ans et plus. Globalement, il a augmenté de 44,000 chez les hommes et de 29,000 chez les femmes.
- L'emploi à plein temps est estimé à 10,679,000, en hausse de 72,000 par rapport à juillet. Cette hausse se retrouve principalement chez les hommes (+58,000). L'emploi à temps partiel n'a pratiquement pas varié et s'établit à 1,850,000.
- L'estimation désaisonnalisée de l'emploi en agriculture a augmenté de 14,000. L'emploi a aussi avancé légèrement dans la plupart des grands secteurs de l'activité. Le secteur de la construction affiche par contre une légère baisse.
- Le niveau estimatif de l'emploi a avancé de 29,000 au Québec, 21,000 en Ontario et 8,000 en Alberta. L'emploi a peu ou pas varié dans les autres provinces.

Unemployment and Participation Rate

The seasonally adjusted level of unemployment was virtually unchanged at 1,001,000 (-6,000). The unemployment rate declined to 7.4 (-0.1), while the participation rate rose 0.2 to 67.2.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of unemployment fell by 17,000 among men, but rose by 11,000 among women.
- The unemployment rate declined to 7.0 (-0.3) for men, but edged up to 7.8 for women.
- The largest rise in the participation rate was for young people aged 15 to 24. The rate for this group rose by 0.9 to 70.8.
- Unemployment decreased by 13,000 in Quebec and by 7,000 in British Columbia. Unemployment rose by 8,000 in Ontario and showed little or no change in the other provinces.
- The unemployment rate fell by 0.5 in Quebec (8.8) and by 0.4 in Manitoba (6.8) and British Columbia (8.8). It also declined slightly in Nova Scotia (10.1), New Brunswick (12.5), Saskatchewan (7.2) and Alberta (7.1). The rate increased slightly in Newfoundland (15.8), Prince Edward Island (14.1) and Ontario (5.1).

Changes since August 1988 (Unadjusted estimates)

- Estimated employment grew by 299,000 (+2.4%) to 12,971,000.
- Full-time employment increased by 347,000 (+3.1%) while part-time employment declined by 48,000 (-3.1%).

Chômage et taux d'activité

Le niveau désaisonnalisé de chômage a peu varié pour s'établir à 1,001,000 (-6,000). Le taux de chômage s'est abaissé à 7.4 (-0.1) et le taux d'activité a avancé à 67.2, en hausse de 0.2.

- L'estimation désaisonnalisée du chômage s'est abaissée de 17,000 parmi les hommes alors qu'elle avançait de 11,000 parmi les femmes.
- Le taux de chômage a reculé à 7.0 (-0.3) parmi les hommes alors qu'il avançait légèrement chez les femmes pour s'établir à 7.8.
- L'avance du taux d'activité est la plus marquée parmi les jeunes de 15 à 24 ans pour lesquels le taux s'est établi 70.8 (+0.9).
- Le chômage a diminué de 13,000 au Québec et de 7,000 en Colombie-Britannique. Il a avancé de 8,000 en Ontario et a peu ou pas varié dans les autres provinces.
- Le taux de chômage a diminué de 0.5 au Québec (8.8), et de 0.4 au Manitoba (6.8) et en Colombie-Britannique (8.8). Il a aussi légèrement reculé en Nouvelle-Écosse (10.1), au Nouveau-Brunswick (12.5), en Saskatchewan (7.2) et en Alberta (7.1). Le taux a par ailleurs augmenté légèrement à Terre-Neuve (15.8), à l'Île-du-Prince-Édouard (14.1) et en Ontario (5.1).

Par rapport à août 1988 (données non désaisonnalisées)

- L'estimation de l'emploi a augmenté de 299,000 (+2.4%) pour s'établir à 12,971,000.
- L'emploi à plein temps s'est accru de 347,000 (+3.1%) et le temps partiel a reculé de 48,000 (-3.1%).

- Employment in the goods-producing industries grew by 2.1%, with the agriculture sector posting the largest increase (4.8%). The service industries experienced overall growth of 2.5%.
- The estimated number of unemployed fell by 54,000 (-5.3%) to 971,000.
- The unemployment rate declined by 0.5 to 7.0.
- The participation rate rose by 0.4 to 69.1 and the employment/population ratio increased by 0.7 to 64.3.

Student Data

From May to September inclusive, data on the participation of students in the labour market are collected through the Labour Force Survey. Persons aged 15 to 24 who were attending school full-time in March 1989 are asked additional questions. The information is compiled for two categories of students: (1) those who plan to return to school in the fall of 1989; and (2) those who do not plan to return to school at that time, or are uncertain of their intentions.

Returning students:

- The unemployment rate, unadjusted for seasonal variations, was estimated at 7.1, down 0.9 from the previous year. The rate declined by 0.4 for students aged 15 to 19 (8.5) and by 1.8 for those aged 20 to 24 (3.1).
- Employment among returning students was estimated at 1,197,000, an increase of 62,000 over the previous year. The employment/population ratio rose by 3.0 to 66.9.
- The participation rate increased by 2.5 to 72.0.

- L'emploi a progressé de 2.1% dans les industries productrices de biens, le secteur de l'agriculture affichant la plus forte hausse (4.8%). Les industries de services ont connu une progression globale de 2.5%.
- Le nombre estimatif de chômeurs a diminué de 54,000 (-5.3%) pour s'établir à 971,000.
- Le taux de chômage a reculé de 0.5, pour se fixer à 7.0.
- Le taux d'activité a avancé de 0.4 pour s'établir à 69.1 et le rapport emploi-population a atteint 64.3, en hausse de 0.7.

Données sur les étudiants

De mai à septembre inclusivement, l'enquête sur la population active recueille des données sur l'activité des étudiants sur le marché du travail. Des questions supplémentaires sont posées aux personnes âgées de 15 à 24 ans qui étudiaient à plein temps en mars 1989. Les réponses sont classées dans deux catégories d'étudiants: (1) ceux qui prévoient poursuivre leurs études à l'automne et (2) ceux qui ne croient pas retourner aux études ou n'en sont pas certains.

Étudiants qui prévoient poursuivre leurs études:

- Le taux de chômage non désaisonnalisé est estimé à 7.1, soit 0.9 de moins que l'an dernier. Il a diminué de 0.4 chez les étudiants de 15 à 19 ans (8.5) et de 1.8 parmi ceux de 20 à 24 ans (3.1).
- L'emploi parmi les étudiants qui prévoient poursuivre leurs études est estimé à 1,197,000, soit une hausse de 62,000 par rapport à l'année dernière. Le rapport emploi-population a progressé de 3.0 pour se fixer à 66.9.
- Le taux d'activité s'est accru de 2.5 pour s'établir à 72.0.

Other students:

- The unemployment rate was estimated at 13.6, an increase of 1.3 over the previous year.
- Employment was estimated at 232,000, 7,000 less than a year ago, lowering the employment/population ratio to 74.7 (-0.9).
- At 86.5, the participation rate was slightly higher (+0.3) than in August 1988.

- Le taux de chômage est estimé à 13.6, en hausse de 1.3 par rapport à l'an dernier.
- L'emploi est estimé à 232,000, soit 7,000 de moins qu'il y a un an, abaissant le rapport emploi-population à 74.7 (-0.9).
- Le taux d'activité est légèrement plus élevé qu'en août 1988. Il s'est établi à 86.5, une avance de 0.3.








Month-to-month changes in employment

(seasonally adjusted - désaisonnalisées)




Index of full-time/part-time employment

(seasonally adjusted - désaisonnalisés)


