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PREFACE

Hospital statistics have been collected on a continuing basis by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics since 1931. Throughout the years a number of changes have been made in both the reporting forms and the type of presentation—particularly for the years 1952, 1959 and 1961. The 1962 series of publications follows closely the pattern developed in 1961, with the Preliminary Annual Report and the analytic volumes dealing with particular aspects of hospitals as follows:

Volume III	— Hospital Personnel
Volume IV	— Balance Sheet
Volume V	— Hospital Revenues
Volume VI	— Hospital Expenditures
Volume VII	— Hospital Indicators
Preliminary Annual Report	

Further refinements in Hospital Indicators have been made for the year 1962 based upon experience gained and comments received on the 1961 publication. The provision of quartiles, and minimum and maximum values should be of value to those who wish to further evaluate the distribution for each indicator by type of hospital.

The advice and assistance of a number of individuals and groups in the hospital field is gratefully acknowledged. The work of the individual hospital in preparing their data for inclusion in a national statistical program, and the cooperation of the provincial hospital plan authorities in the collection of this data deserves a special mention. Uniform accounting and recording has been promoted by various provincial hospital associations and the Canadian Hospital Association and consequently has been most beneficial to the hospital statistics program of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

This report was prepared in the Institutions Section of the Health and Welfare Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

PRÉFACE

Le Bureau fédéral de la statistique n'a cessé, depuis 1931, de recueillir des statistiques hospitalières. Au cours des années, plusieurs changements ont été apportés aux formules de déclaration et au mode de présentation, particulièrement en 1952, 1959 et 1961. La série de publications de 1962 suit de près les traces de celle de 1961; aussi, le rapport annuel préliminaire et les volumes analytiques se répartissent-ils les divers aspects du domaine hospitalier de la façon suivante:

BALANCE SHEETS

Introduction

The data found in this report were obtained from the Annual Return of Hospitals, Part II, received from public general and allied special hospitals in Canada. Mental institutions and tuberculosis sanatoria are excluded as are private and federal hospitals.

Canadian hospitals generally follow the system of fund accounting as suggested by the accounting manual of the Canadian Hospital Association. This system provides for the segregation of accounts into revenue fund, plant fund and endowment fund. Data for each of these funds are found in the tables of this report.

The revenue fund is used to record activities associated with the day-to-day operations of the hospital in providing services to patients, while the plant fund is used primarily to record transactions relating to property which is long lasting (land, buildings and equipment) as well as long-term liabilities relating thereto. The endowment fund is used to record transactions related to special gifts and bequests to the hospital.

Of the 964 public general and allied special hospitals operating in Canada in 1962, some 868 (90.0 per cent) submitted revenue fund balance sheets. Control or ownership of plant fund assets was specified by 861 (89.3 per cent), while only 191 (19.8 per cent) indicated control or ownership of endowment fund assets.

Reported assets of revenue fund, plant fund and endowment fund balance sheets for the 868 reporting hospitals in 1962 were \$1,621 million. The total comprised \$137 million for revenue fund, \$1,423 million for plant fund and \$61 million for endowment fund. Current and long-term liabilities were \$557 million, exclusive of balance of fund (capital) of \$1,065 million.

It should be noted that in some cases final year-end adjustments from provincial plans had not been recorded by the hospitals since they occurred too late to be included in the hospitals' annual returns.

Revenue Fund

The aggregate of accounts and notes receivable represented 36.5 per cent of total revenue fund assets in 1962, compared with 44.6 per cent in 1961. Included in this category are accounts and notes receivable from provincial plans amounting to 18.7 per cent (24.2 per cent), from patients 14.6 per cent (18.0 per cent) and sundry 3.2 per cent (2.4 per cent). Accounts and notes receivable have represented the major portion of revenue fund assets over the past 4 years, although ex-

BILANS HOSPITALIERS

Introduction

Les données de la présente publication sont tirées des rapports annuels des hôpitaux (2e partie) que nous ont envoyés les hôpitaux publics (généraux et spéciaux divers) du Canada. Ne sont concernés, ni les établissements psychiatriques, ni les sanatoriums de tuberculose, ni les hôpitaux privés ou fédéraux.

Les hôpitaux du Canada suivent généralement, pour leur comptabilité, le système proposé par l'Association des hôpitaux du Canada dans son manuel de comptabilité. Suivant ce système, les comptes sont répartis en trois fonds: administration générale, immobilisations et dotation. Les tableaux du présent rapport fournissent les données relatives à chacun de ces fonds.

Le fonds d'administration générale sert à enregistrer les opérations quotidiennes de l'hôpital qui fournit des services aux malades, alors que le fonds d'immobilisations sert avant tout à enregistrer les transactions qui touchent à la propriété de longue durée (terres, bâtiments et équipement), ainsi qu'au passif qui s'y rapporte. Quant au fonds de dotation, il sert à enregistrer les dons spéciaux ou legs faits à l'hôpital.

Des 964 hôpitaux publics (généraux et spéciaux divers) en activité au Canada en 1962, environ 868 (90 p. 100) ont présenté un bilan du fonds d'administration générale, 861 (89.3) un bilan du fonds d'immobilisations et seulement 191 (19.8) un bilan du fonds de dotation.

L'actif des fonds d'administration générale, d'immobilisations et de dotation déclaré par les 868 hôpitaux répondants de 1962 a totalisé 1,621 millions de dollars, dont 137 millions pour le fonds d'administration générale, 1,423 millions pour le fonds d'immobilisations et 61 millions pour le fonds de dotation. Le passif en cours et à long terme a été de 557 millions, sans les 1,065 millions au solde du fonds (capital).

A noter que, dans certains cas, les hôpitaux n'ont pas inscrit les ajustements de fin d'année pour tenir compte des régimes provinciaux, vu que ces ajustements ont eu lieu trop tard pour paraître au rapport annuel de l'hôpital.

Fonds d'administration générale

L'ensemble des comptes et billets à recevoir a, en 1962, répondu pour 36.5 p. 100 de l'actif total du fonds d'administration générale, comparativement à 44.6 en 1961. Ces comptes et billets étaient à recevoir des régimes provinciaux (18.7 p. 100 en 1962 et 24.2 en 1961), des malades (14.6 et 18) et de diverses sources (3.2 et 2.4). L'ensemble de ces postes a compté pour la plus grande partie de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale au cours des 4 dernières années, bien qu'il ait accusé des baisses depuis 1960,

periencing declines since 1960: 1959 (50.5 per cent); 1960 (52.7 per cent); 1961 (44.6 per cent). On the other hand, inventory of supplies have shown the opposite trend, rising from 15.9 per cent of the assets in 1959 to 17.8 per cent in 1960, 19.9 per cent in 1961 and 20.7 per cent in 1962 (Chart 1). Two other items accounting for a sizeable portion of revenue fund assets were cash on hand and in bank 13.5 per cent (10.7 per cent in 1959) and due from other funds 13.2 per cent (12.6 per cent in 1959).

Accounts and notes receivable from provincial plans varied considerably among the provinces, accounting for a minimum (4.6 per cent) of revenue fund assets in New Brunswick and a maximum (27.4 per cent) in Ontario (Chart 2). Accounts and notes receivable from paying patients ranged between 8.9 per cent of assets in Nova Scotia to 22.1 per cent in Alberta. Sundry accounts and notes receivable were proportionately greatest in New Brunswick (6.0 per cent) and lowest in Prince Edward Island (0.2 per cent).

The percentage of revenue fund assets for inventories of supplies in 1962 reached 49.7 per cent in Newfoundland and was also high in Yukon (39.8 per cent) and Northwest Territories (36.1 per cent). However, the remoteness of these areas from supply depots probably influences the amount of inventory. Public hospitals in Quebec operated with the lowest percentage of assets for inventories of supplies (16.5 per cent). Quebec has consistently shown the lowest proportion in this regard over the past 4 years (Statement 1).

Par contre, les stocks ont dessiné une courbe ascendante; figurant pour 15.9 p. 100 de l'actif en 1959, ils ont atteint 17.8 en 1960, 19.9 en 1961 et 20.7 en 1962 (graphique 1). Les deux autres éléments qui ont accusé une forte proportion de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale sont l'encaisse et les créances sur d'autres fonds qui se sont chiffrés respectivement par 13.5 p. 100 (10.7 en 1959) et 13.2 (12.6).

Les comptes et billets à recevoir des régimes provinciaux ont considérablement varié d'une province à l'autre, le Nouveau-Brunswick enregistrant le plus bas pourcentage (4.6) de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale et l'Ontario, le plus haut (27.4) (graphique 2). Les comptes et billets à recevoir des malades payants ont oscillé entre 8.9 p. 100 en Nouvelle-Écosse et 22.1 en Alberta. Les comptes et billets à recevoir de diverses sources ont été, proportionnellement, les plus élevés au Nouveau-Brunswick (6) et les moins élevés en Île-du-Prince-Édouard (0.2).

Le pourcentage des stocks dans l'actif du fonds d'administration générale s'est établi à 49.7 à Terre-Neuve en 1962; il a aussi été élevé au Yukon (39.8) et dans les Territoires du Nord-Ouest (36.1). Toutefois, l'éloignement de ces régions des dépôts de fournitures affecte probablement la quantité des stocks. Les hôpitaux publics du Québec ont enregistré le plus bas pourcentage à cet égard (16.5). Au cours des quatre dernières années, cette province a toujours accusé le plus bas pourcentage (état statistique 1).






The value of inventory of supplies per rated bed amounted to \$284 in 1962, an increase of 2.8 per cent over the 1961 ratio (\$277). In general hospitals, the rate was \$303 per bed (\$293), ranging from \$460 in 1-9 bed hospitals to \$279 in 1,000 or more bed institutions (Chart 3). On the whole, the value of inventory of supplies tended to decline with an increase in the size of the hospital. In the provinces, the range of values was great, being lowest in Prince Edward Island (\$218 per rated bed). By comparison, Newfoundland, Yukon and the Northwest Territories maintained the highest ratios, amounting to \$452 and \$582, respectively.

La valeur des stocks par lit (capacité théorique) a totalisé \$284 en 1962, hausse de 2.8 p. 100 sur 1961 (\$277). Dans les hôpitaux généraux, ce taux s'est établi à \$303 (\$293) et s'est échelonné de \$460 dans les hôpitaux de 1-9 lits à \$279 dans ceux de 1,000 lits ou plus (graphique 3). Dans l'ensemble, la valeur des stocks a eu tendance à baisser avec l'accroissement de la taille de l'hôpital. Au niveau provincial, l'écart des valeurs a été considérable; le plus bas rapport a été enregistré en Île-du-Prince-Édouard (\$218 par lit). En comparaison, Terre-Neuve et les Territoires du Yukon et du Nord-Ouest ont accusé les rapports les plus élevés (\$452 et \$582, respectivement).

Of total revenue fund liabilities, some 44.9 per cent were classified as due to other funds (plant fund and endowment fund). The next largest liability was accounts payable (18.0 per cent) followed by bank loans and overdrafts (10.2 per cent), accrued liabilities (7.4 per cent) and notes payable (5.2 per cent) (Chart 4).

In 1962, revenue fund liabilities were 18.6 per cent higher than revenue fund assets, compared with 17.8 per cent in 1961 and 5.2 per cent in 1960. General hospitals' liabilities exceeded assets by 19.5 per cent. However, within the category of general hospitals, those with less than 100 beds showed a credit balance (Chart 5), the largest occurring in the 1-9 bed group (71.9 per cent). The highest debit balance was attributed

Environ 44.9 p. 100 du passif total du fonds d'administration générale a été assigné aux créances sur d'autres fonds (fonds d'immobilisations et de dotation). Les comptes à recevoir se sont placés au second rang d'importance (18), suivis des emprunts et découverts à la banque (10.2), des dettes courues (7.4) et des billets à payer (5.2) (graphique 4).

En 1962, le passif du fonds d'administration générale a surpassé l'actif de 18.6 p. 100, comparativement à 17.8 en 1961 et à 5.2 en 1960. Dans les hôpitaux généraux, le passif s'est élevé à 19.5 p. 100 au-dessus de l'actif. Toutefois, dans cette classe d'hôpitaux, ceux de moins de 100 lits ont accusé un solde créditeur (graphique 5), ce dernier ayant atteint un sommet (71.9 p. 100) dans les hôpitaux de 1-9 lits.  RÉPARTITION PROCENTUELLE DU PASSIF DU FONDS D'ADMINISTRATION GÉNÉRALE, 1962




to hospitals with 1,000 or more beds (63.2 per cent). As in 1961, the Atlantic Provinces and Quebec showed debit balances, which in 1962 ranged between 56.5 per cent in Nova Scotia and 134.9 per cent in Prince Edward Island. Again, Ontario and the western provinces maintained credit balances, from 8.4 per cent in Ontario to 51.9 per cent in Alberta.

Plant Fund

Plant fund assets at December 31, 1962 were valued at \$1,423 million, covering 861 reporting public general and allied special hospitals. Most significant item among assets was the value of buildings and building service equipment, representing 65.2 per cent of the total. This proportion has been steadily decreasing over the past four years, however, as shown in Statement 2. Generally, this has been the case in each of the provinces as well. In 1962, buildings and building service equipment varied between 62.8 per cent of the plant fund assets in Saskatchewan to 75.3 per cent in Prince Edward Island (Yukon and Northwest Territories excluded from the comparison).

Fonds d'immobilisations

Le 31 décembre 1962, l'actif du fonds d'immobilisations s'évaluait à 1,423 millions de dollars dans les 861 hôpitaux publics répondants, généraux et spéciaux divers. L'élément le plus important de l'actif a été la valeur des bâtiments, agencements et installations qui a répondu pour 65.2 p. 100 du total. Comme l'indique l'état statistique 2, ce pourcentage a baissé régulièrement au cours des quatre dernières années, ainsi que, en général, dans toutes les provinces. En 1962, la part procentuelle des bâtiments, agencements et installations dans l'actif du fonds d'immobilisations a oscillé entre 62.8 en Saskatchewan et 75.3 en Île-du-Prince-Édouard (on n'a pas fait de comparaison avec le Yukon et les Territoires du Nord-Ouest).

Major equipment (with an estimated useful life of 5 years or more) ranked second in value among components of plant fund assets, representing 10.6 per cent, the same as in 1961. In general hospitals, 10.7 per cent of the assets were attributed to this item, ranging between 17.7 per cent in 1-9 bed hospitals and 9.7 per cent in 1,000 or more bed institutions (Chart 6). On the whole, the proportion of major equipment decreased as the size of the hospital became larger.


Parmi les éléments qui composent l'actif du fonds d'immobilisations, le gros matériel (dont la durée utile est évaluée à 5 ans ou plus) s'est classé au second rang d'importance avec 10.6 p. 100 comme en 1961. DES HÔPITAUX GÉNÉRAUX, 1962





Construction in progress, formerly included as part of other plant fund assets, is shown separately in 1962 as representing 8.2 per cent of the total. In general hospitals, the percentage of construction in progress was a little higher (8.6 per cent), and fluctuated widely according to size. Hospitals with 1,000 or more beds showed the maximum value in this respect (18.4 per cent), while 1-9 bed hospitals revealed the minimum (2.2 per cent) (Chart 7). The province having the highest proportion of construction in progress was Alberta, amounting to 10.2 per cent of plant fund assets (general hospitals), compared with only 0.1 per cent in Prince Edward Island and 0.2 per cent in Newfoundland (Chart 8).

Undepreciated value of buildings and building service equipment amounted to \$11,548 per rated bed in public hospitals in 1962, an increase of 2.7 per cent over 1961 (\$11,242). The 1962 ratio ranged in value from \$6,464 in 1-9 bed hospitals to \$15,685 in the 500-999 bed group (Chart 9), the average for all general hospitals being \$12,062 (\$11,681). Among the provinces, Saskatchewan had the lowest value of buildings and building service equipment per rated bed (\$9,262) and Quebec was highest (\$13,889).

Major equipment value (undepreciated) per rated bed in public hospitals was \$2,732, a rise of 6.1 per cent over the 1961 figure (\$2,574). In general hospitals, the ratio was \$2,869 (\$2,681), with 25-49 bed hospitals recording the lowest value (\$2,350) and 500-999 bed hospitals the highest (\$3,384) (Chart 10). On a provincial basis, the rate ranged between \$2,092 in Prince Edward Island to \$3,263 in New Brunswick. The ratio of buildings and building service equipment added to those retired was 39.1:1 (37.4:1 in 1961), while the similar ratio for major equipment was 14.4:1 (14.5:1) and for other depreciable equipment 21.8:1 (14.7:1).

Funds provided for buildings and equipment and for debt retirement come mainly from grants of federal, provincial and municipal governments (70.7 per cent). There was considerable variation in this proportion among the provinces (Chart 11), with Ontario showing the lowest percentage (62.0 per cent) and Alberta the highest (97.2 per cent). Appropriations from other funds represented 11.3 per cent of the total funds provided in 1962.

Endowment Fund

In 1962, hospitals reporting endowment fund had assets of \$61.0 million, of which 65.5 per cent were bonds and debentures and 12.7 per cent were stocks. Comparable 1961 percentages were 63.1 and 16.5, respectively. Other forms of investments accounted for 8.8 per cent (6.0 per cent in 1961), due from other funds was 4.0 per cent (4.9 per cent), cash and bank accounts were 3.6 per cent (4.3 per cent) and real estate holdings represented 3.4 per cent (4.3 per cent). The endowment fund balance in 1962 was 96.6 per cent of the endowment fund liabilities and balance (97.7 per cent in 1961).

La construction en cours,—qui paraissait auparavant au poste de l'actif divers du fonds d'immobilisations,—constitue un poste distinct en 1962 et répond pour 8.2 p. 100 du total. Dans les hôpitaux généraux, ce pourcentage est un peu plus élevé (8.6) et varie considérablement suivant la taille de l'établissement. Les hôpitaux de plus de 1,000 lits enregistrent le pourcentage le plus élevé à cet égard (18.4), tandis que ceux de 1-9 lits accusent le plus bas (2.2) (graphique 7). C'est en Alberta que la construction en cours marque son plus fort pourcentage (10.2) dans l'actif du fonds d'immobilisations (dans les hôpitaux généraux), comparativement à seulement 0.1 en île-du-Prince-Édouard et à 0.2 à Terre-Neuve (graphique 8).

La valeur non amortie des bâtiments, agencements et installations s'est arrêtée, en 1962, à \$11,548 par lit (capacité théorique) dans les hôpitaux publics, hausse de 2.7 p. 100 sur 1961 (\$11,242). La valeur de ce rapport s'est échelonnée de \$6,464 dans les hôpitaux de 1-9 lits à \$15,685 dans ceux de 500-999 lits (graphique 9), et la moyenne pour tous les hôpitaux généraux s'est établie à \$12,062 (\$11,681). Parmi les provinces, la Saskatchewan a enregistré la plus basse valeur à cet égard (\$9,262) et le Québec, la plus haute (\$13,889).

La valeur non amortie du gros matériel, par lit (capacité théorique), a atteint \$2,732 dans les hôpitaux publics, augmentation de 6.1 p. 100 sur les \$2,574 de 1961. Dans les hôpitaux généraux, ce rapport a été de \$2,869 (\$2,681), les hôpitaux de 25-49 lits accusant le plus bas (\$2,350) et ceux de 500-999 lits le plus élevé (\$3,384) (graphique 10). Au niveau provincial, ce taux a varié entre \$2,092 en île-du-Prince-Édouard et \$3,263 au Nouveau-Brunswick. Le rapport des nouveaux bâtiments, agencements et installations à ceux que l'on a fait disparaître a été de 39.1 (37.4 en 1961) à 1, tandis que le même rapport a été de 14.4 (14.5) pour le gros matériel et de 21.8 (14.7) pour l'autre matériel dépréciable.

Les fonds pour bâtiments, agencements et installations et pour amortissement de la dette viennent surtout des subventions fédérales, provinciales et municipales (70.7 p. 100). Ce pourcentage, qui a considérablement varié parmi les provinces (graphique 11), a marqué son plus haut degré en Alberta (97.2) et son plus bas en Ontario (62). En 1962, les affectations sur d'autres fonds ont accusé 11.3 p. 100 de tous les fonds.

Fonds de dotation

En 1962, les hôpitaux qui ont déclaré un fonds de dotation possédaient un actif de 61 millions de dollars, dont 65.5 p. 100 étaient constitués d'obligations et 12.7 p. 100 d'actions. Les pourcentages correspondants de 1961 s'établissaient respectivement à 63.1 et 16.5. Les placements divers ont figuré pour 8.8 p. 100 (6 en 1961), les créances sur d'autres fonds pour 4 (4.9), l'encaisse et le compte de banque pour 3.6 (4.3) et les immobilisations pour 3.4 (4.3). Le solde du fonds de dotation a été de 96.6 p. 100 (97.7 en 1961) de l'actif et du solde du même fonds.

DES HÔPITAUX GÉNÉRAUX, SUIVANT LA PROVINCE, 1962



PAR LIT (CAP. THÉOR.), 1962



 VALEUR NON AMORTIE DU MATÉRIEL FIXE, PAR LIT (CAP. THÉOR.), 1962



