

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## PREFACE

Hospital statistics in Canada are published in a series of eight annual reports, each of which is concerned with a specific topic. These statistics are provided so that the reader may assess the facilities and services available, the labour force involved and the financial situation in the Canadian hospitals.

Statistics on hospitals have been collected by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics since 1931 and have been published since then in varying degrees of detail. Until 1951, one volume contained the entire hospital statistical data. From 1952 to 1958 there were two, 1959-1960 there were six, and since 1961, eight volumes have been required to portray data of the hospital scene. These volumes are as follows:

## PRÉFACE

La statistique des hôpitaux du Canada est publiée dans une série de huit rapports annuels dont chacun traite d'un sujet déterminé. Ces publications permettront au lecteur d'apprécier les installations et services disponibles, la main-d'œuvre employée et la situation financière des hôpitaux canadiens.

Depuis 1931, le Bureau fédéral de la statistique recueille la statistique sur les hôpitaux et la présente en publications plus ou moins détaillées. Jusqu'en 1951, toutes les données statistiques afférentes aux hôpitaux tenaient en un seul volume. De 1952 à 1958, il est paru deux volumes, en 1959-1960 six, et depuis 1961, huit volumes sont nécessaires pour tracer un tableau complet de l'activité hospitalière.

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
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HOSPITAL CLASSIFICATION CHART<sup>(i)</sup>

## GLOSSARY

### Hospital

An institution which is operated for the medical, surgical and/or obstetrical care of inpatients, and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by the federal and/or a provincial government, or by a municipality duly authorized under the laws of the province. Specifically excluded are institutions primarily for tuberculosis, mental diseases and mental defect.

### Public Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "public hospital" which is not operated for profit and accepts all patients regardless of ability to pay.

### General Hospital

A hospital which provides for the treatment and care of all types of diseases or at least a wide range of conditions.

### Chronic – Convalescent – Rehabilitation Hospitals

Hospitals which primarily provide for the treatment of conditions requiring long-term care, or for the treatment of patients who are considered to be in the recovery stage of an illness, especially where this is a long-term process and for those patients who are being rehabilitated.

### Maternity Hospital

A hospital which primarily provides for the treatment and care of obstetrical patients and newborn infants.

### Other Hospital

A hospital which primarily provides for the treatment of a particular type of disease, condition or case; example, rehabilitation, geriatric, communicable disease, orthopaedic, neurological and cancer; or a hospital which provides a combination of various types of service which cannot be classified into chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation or maternity.

### Allied Special Hospitals

Includes chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation, maternity and "other" hospitals.

### Buildings and Building Service Equipment

Includes all structures owned by the hospital and used in carrying out normal functions, as well as equipment added, to heat, light, ventilate or otherwise make serviceable.

## TERMINOLOGIE

### Hôpital

Établissement donnant des soins médicaux, chirurgicaux ou obstétriques aux hospitalisés et détenant un permis ou une approbation du gouvernement fédéral ou provincial ou d'une municipalité autorisée par la province à le faire. Sont exclues, les établissements destinés avant tout à la tuberculose, aux maladies mentales et à la déficience mentale.

### Hôpital public

Hôpital reconnu comme tel par la province et établi dans un but non lucratif; il accepte tous les malades sans égard à leur capacité de payer.

### Hôpital général

Hôpital qui traite toutes sortes de maladies ou, au moins, un grand nombre d'états pathologiques.

### Établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence et de réadaptation

Hôpitaux qui traitent, avant tout, des états requérant des soins de longue durée, ou les malades qui relèvent d'une maladie, surtout de longue durée, ou qui ont besoin de réadaptation.

### Maternité

Hôpital destiné avant tout aux soins obstétriques ainsi qu'à ceux des nouveau-nés.

### Hôpitaux divers

Hôpitaux destinés surtout au traitement d'états pathologiques particuliers ou de cas particuliers de maladie, comme gériatrie, maladie contagieuse, orthopédie, neurologie et cancer; c'est encore un hôpital qui a plusieurs affectations diverses ne pouvant être classées à maladies chroniques, convalescence, réadaptation ou maternité.

### Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Ces hôpitaux comprennent les établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence, de réadaptation, les maternités et les hôpitaux divers.

### Bâtiments et matériel fixe

Comprend l'ensemble des bâtiments que possède l'hôpital et qui servent aux fonctions régulières de celui-ci, de même que le matériel ajouté au chauffage, à l'éclairage et à la ventilation, ou mis en service de quelque manière.

**Major Equipment**

Includes hospital equipment, other than building service equipment, which has an estimated useful life of 5 years or more and is usually moveable rather than affixed.

**Minor Equipment**

Includes hospital equipment with an estimated life of not more than 5 years, usually small in size, numerous in quantity, relatively low unit cost and no fixed location.

**Depreciation Expense**

Includes depreciation on land improvements, buildings and building service equipment and major equipment.

**Gros matériel**

Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital autre que le matériel fixe, dont la durée estimative de service est de cinq ans ou plus et qui est habituellement amovible plutôt que fixe.

**Petit matériel**

Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital dont la durée estimative de service ne dépasse pas cinq ans, dont la taille est ordinairement petite, la quantité grande, le prix unitaire modique et qui n'a pas d'emplacement fixe.

**Frais d'amortissement**

Comprend l'amortissement des aménagements de terrain, des bâtiments, du matériel fixe et du gros matériel.

## INTRODUCTION

The data found in this report were obtained from the Annual Return of Hospitals, Part II, received from public general and allied special hospitals in Canada. Mental institutions and tuberculosis sanatoria are excluded as are private and federal hospitals.

Canadian hospitals generally follow the system of fund accounting as suggested by the accounting manual of the Canadian Hospital Association. This system provides for the segregation of accounts into revenue fund, plant fund and endowment fund. Data for each of these funds are found in the tables of this report.

The revenue fund is used to record activities associated with the day-to-day operations of the hospital in providing services to patients, while the plant fund is used primarily to record transactions relating to property which is long lasting (land, buildings and equipment) as well as long-term liabilities relating thereto. The endowment fund is used to record transactions related to special gifts and bequests to the hospital.

Of the 978 public general and allied special hospitals operating in Canada in 1963, some 904 (92.4 per cent) submitted revenue fund balance sheets. Control or ownership of plant fund assets was specified by 894 (91.4 per cent), while only 202 (20.7 per cent) indicated control or ownership of endowment fund assets.

Reported assets of revenue fund, plant fund and endowment fund balance sheets for the 904 reporting hospitals in 1963 were \$1,771 million. The total comprised \$145 million for revenue fund, \$1,559 million for plant fund and \$67 million for endowment fund. Current and long-term liabilities were \$622 million, exclusive of balance of fund (capital) of \$1,149 million.

It should be noted that in some cases final year-end adjustments from provincial plans had not been recorded by the hospitals since these occurred too late to be included in the hospitals' annual returns.

### Revenue Fund

The aggregate of accounts and notes receivable represented 37.1 per cent of total revenue fund assets in 1963, compared with 36.5 per cent in 1962. Included in this category are accounts and notes receivable from provincial plans amounting to 17.6 per cent (18.7 per cent in 1962), from patients 15.3 per cent (14.6 per cent) and sundry 4.2 per cent (3.2 per cent). Accounts and notes receivable have represented the major portion of revenue fund assets over the past 5 years, al-

Les données de la présente publication sont tirées des rapports annuels des hôpitaux (Partie II) que nous ont envoyés les hôpitaux publics (généraux et spéciaux divers) du Canada. Les établissements psychiatriques, les sanatoriums pour tuberculeux et les hôpitaux privés ou fédéraux sont exclus.

En général, le régime comptable des hôpitaux du Canada est conforme au système que propose l'Association des hôpitaux canadiens dans son manuel de comptabilité. Ce système répartit les comptes suivant trois fonds: administration générale, installation matérielle et dotation. Les tableaux du présent rapport fournissent les données relatives à chacun de ces fonds.

Au chapitre du fonds d'administration générale s'inscrivent les données comptables qui concernent l'activité quotidienne à laquelle l'hôpital se livre pour dispenser des soins aux malades, alors que le fonds de l'installation matérielle sert avant tout à comptabiliser les transactions relatives aux biens immeubles (terrains, bâtiments et matériel), ainsi que les éléments de passif à long terme qui s'y rapportent. Quant au fonds de dotation, il sert à consigner les transactions relatives aux dons spéciaux et aux legs faits à l'hôpital.

Des 978 hôpitaux publics (généraux et spéciaux divers) en activité au Canada en 1963, environ 904 (92.4 p. 100) ont présenté un bilan du fonds d'administration générale, 894 (91.4) ont fourni des données relatives à l'assujettissement ou à l'appartenance de l'actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle, et seulement 202 (20.7) des données relatives à l'assujettissement ou à l'appartenance de l'actif du fonds de dotation.

L'actif des fonds d'administration générale, de l'installation matérielle et de dotation déclaré par les 904 hôpitaux répondants en 1963 a totalisé 1,771 millions de dollars, dont 145 millions pour le fonds d'administration générale, 1,559 millions pour le fonds de l'installation matérielle et 67 millions pour le fonds de dotation. Le passif en cours et à long terme a été de 622 millions, sans les 1,149 millions au solde du fonds (capital).

A noter que, dans certains cas, les hôpitaux n'ont pas inscrit les rajustements de fin d'année reçus des régimes provinciaux, vu que ces rajustements ont eu lieu trop tard pour paraître au rapport annuel de l'hôpital.

### Fonds d'administration générale

L'ensemble des comptes et billets à recevoir a répondu, en 1963, pour 37.1 p. 100 de l'actif total du fonds d'administration générale, comparativement à 36.5 p. 100 en 1962. Ces comptes et billets étaient à recevoir des régimes provinciaux (17.6 p. 100 en 1963 et 18.7 en 1962), des malades (15.3 et 14.6) et de diverses sources (4.2 et 3.2). L'ensemble de ces comptes a formé la plus grande partie de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale au cours des 5 dernières années, bien qu'à un taux décroissant depuis

though at a declining rate since 1960: 1959 (50.5 per cent); 1960 (52.7 per cent); 1961 (44.6 per cent); 1962 (36.5 per cent). At the same time, inventory of supplies has shown the opposite trend, rising from 15.9 per cent of the assets in 1959 to 17.8 per cent in 1960, 19.9 per cent in 1961, 20.7 per cent in 1962 and 21.2 per cent in 1963 (Chart 1). Two other items accounting for a sizeable portion of revenue fund assets were cash on hand and in bank 12.7 per cent (10.7 per cent in 1959) and due from other funds 11.7 per cent (12.6 per cent in 1959).

Accounts and notes receivable from provincial plans varied considerably among the provinces, accounting for a minimum (5.3 per cent) of revenue fund assets in Alberta and a maximum (28.4 per cent) in Ontario (Chart 2). Accounts and notes receivable from paying patients ranged between 9.0 per cent of assets in Prince Edward Island to 20.7 per cent in Alberta.

The percentage of revenue fund assets for inventories of supplies in 1963 reached 48.3 per cent in Newfoundland, compared with 18.6 per cent in Ontario and 18.8 per cent in Quebec. However, in certain provinces, the remoteness of hospitals from supply depots no doubt increases the amount of inventory. In 1963, public hospitals in Ontario operated with the lowest percentage of assets for inventories of supplies, displacing Quebec which had consistently shown the lowest proportion in this regard over the years 1958-1962 (Statement 1).

Les comptes et billets à recevoir des régimes provinciaux ont considérablement varié d'une province à l'autre, l'Alberta enregistrant le plus bas pourcentage (5.3) de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale et l'Ontario, le plus haut (28.4) (graphique 2). Les comptes et billets à recevoir des malades payants ont oscillé entre 9 p. 100 de l'actif en Ile-du-Prince-Édouard à 20.7 p. 100 en Alberta.

Le pourcentage de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale consacré aux stocks de fournitures s'est établi à 48.3 à Terre-Neuve comparativement à 18.6 en Ontario et 18.8 au Québec. Toutefois, la grande distance qui sépare certaines provinces des dépôts de fournitures affecte sans doute la quantité des stocks. En 1963, les hôpitaux publics de l'Ontario ont enregistré le plus bas pourcentage de l'actif consacré aux stocks de fournitures, remplaçant le Québec qui a toujours accusé la plus faible proportion à cet égard au cours des années 1958-1962 (état statistique 1).

The value of inventory of supplies per rated bed amounted to \$294 in 1963, an increase of 3.2 per cent over the 1962 ratio (\$284). In general hospitals, the rate was \$314 per bed (\$303), rang-




ing from \$295 in 500-999 bed hospitals to \$500 in 1-9 bed institutions (Chart 3). On the whole, the value of inventory of supplies tended to decline with an increase in the size of the hospital. In the provinces the range of values was great, being lowest in Prince Edward Island (\$216 per rated bed). By comparison, Yukon, the Northwest Territories and Newfoundland maintained the highest ratios, amounting to \$877, \$453 and \$449, respectively.

Of total revenue fund liabilities, some 45.0 per cent were classified as due to other funds (plant fund and endowment fund). The next largest liability was accounts payable (17.6 per cent) followed by bank loans and overdrafts (10.1 per cent), accrued liabilities (7.0 per cent) and notes payable (5.6 per cent) (Chart 4).

In 1963, revenue fund liabilities were 30.3 per cent higher than revenue fund assets, compared with 18.6 per cent in 1962 and 17.8 per cent in 1961. General hospitals' liabilities exceeded assets by 29.9 per cent. However, within the category of general hospitals, those with less than 50 beds showed a credit balance (Chart 5), the largest occurring in the 1-9 bed group (72.4 per cent). The highest debit balance was attributed to hospitals with 1,000 or more beds (62.1 per cent). As in 1962, the Atlantic Provinces and Quebec showed

RÉPARTITION PROCENTUELLE DU PASSIF DU FONDS D'ADMINISTRATION GÉNÉRALE, 1963




debit balances, which in 1963 ranged between 74.8 per cent in Nova Scotia and 143.7 per cent in Prince Edward Island. Again, Ontario and the Western Provinces maintained credit balances, being lowest at 10.5 per cent in Ontario and highest at 45.9 per cent in Manitoba.

#### Plant Fund

Plant fund assets at December 31, 1963 were valued at \$1,559 million, covering 894 reporting public general and allied special hospitals. Most significant item among assets was the value of buildings and building service equipment, representing 66.4 per cent of the total, an increase over the 1962 proportion (65.2 per cent). From 1958 to 1962, the general trend for this item showed decreases (Statement 2). In 1963, buildings and building service equipment varied between 60.0 per cent of the plant fund assets in Saskatchewan to 78.1 per cent in Alberta (Yukon, and Northwest Territories excluded from the comparison).

#### Fonds de l'installation matérielle

Le 31 décembre 1963, l'actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle s'évaluait à 1,559 millions de dollars dans les 894 hôpitaux répondants, généraux et spéciaux divers. L'élément le plus important de l'actif a été la valeur des bâtiments et du matériel fixe qui a répondu pour 66.4 p. 100 du total, soit une hausse sur la proportion de 1962 (65.2 p. 100). De 1958 à 1962, ce poste a suivi une courbe descendante (état statistique 2). En 1963, la part procentuelle des bâtiments et du matériel fixe dans l'actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle a oscillé entre 60 en Saskatchewan et 78.1 en Alberta (on n'a pas fait de comparaison avec le Yukon et les Territoires du Nord-Ouest).

Major equipment (with an estimated useful life of 5 years or more) ranked second in value among components of plant fund assets, representing 10.8 per cent (10.6 per cent in 1962). In general hospitals, 11.0 per cent of the assets were attributed to this item, ranging between 18.4 per cent in 1-9 bed hospitals and 9.8 per cent in 1,000 or more bed institutions (Chart 6). On the whole, the proportion of major equipment decreased as the size of the hospital became larger.

Construction in progress, since 1962 included as part of the plant fund assets is shown in 1963 as representing 6.8 per cent of the total (8.6 per cent in 1962). In general hospitals, the percentage of




construction in progress was a little higher (6.9 per cent), and fluctuated widely according to size. Hospitals with 1,000 or more beds showed the maximum value in this respect (18.5 per cent), while 200-299 bed hospitals experienced the minimum (0.9 per cent) (Chart 7). The province having the highest proportion of construction in progress was Saskatchewan, amounting to 13.0 per cent of plant fund assets (general hospitals), compared with only 0.6 per cent in Prince Edward Island and Alberta (Chart 8).

Undepreciated value of buildings and building service equipment amounted to \$12,333 per rated bed in public hospitals in 1963, an increase of 6.8 per cent over 1962 (\$11,548).

The 1963 ratio ranged in value from \$6,675 in 1-9 bed hospitals to \$16,454 in the 500-999 bed group (Chart 9), the average for all general hospitals being \$12,904 (\$12,062). Among the provinces, public hospitals in Saskatchewan had the lowest value of buildings and building service equipment per rated bed (\$9,259) and Quebec was highest (\$14,794).

Major equipment value (undepreciated) per rated bed in public hospitals was \$2,960, a rise of 8.3 per cent over the 1962 figure (\$2,732). In general hospitals, the ratio was \$3,121 (\$2,869), with 50-99 bed hospitals recording the lowest value (\$2,529) and 500-999 bed hospitals the highest (\$3,572) (Chart 10). On a provincial basis, the rate in public hospitals ranged between \$2,288 in Prince Edward Island to \$3,560 in New Brunswick. The ratio of buildings and building service equipment added, to those retired was 30.8:1 (39.1:1 in 1962), while the similar ratio for major equipment was 13.3:1 (14.4:1).

Plant funds provided for land, buildings and equipment, and debt retirement come mainly from grants of federal, provincial and municipal governments (71.1 per cent). There was considerable variation in this proportion among the provinces (Chart 11), with Prince Edward Island showing the lowest percentage (52.4 per cent) and Newfoundland the highest (94.3 per cent). Appropriations from other funds represented 10.4 per cent of the total funds provided in 1963.

#### Endowment Fund

In 1963, hospitals reporting endowment fund had assets of \$67.3 million, of which 65.0 per cent were bonds and debentures and 12.2 per cent were stocks. Comparable 1962 percentages were 65.5 and 12.7, respectively. Other forms of investments accounted for 8.1 per cent (8.8 per cent in 1962), due from other funds was 4.0 per cent (4.0 per cent), cash and bank accounts were 3.6 per cent (3.6 per cent) and real estate holdings represented 3.2 per cent (3.4 per cent). The endowment fund balance in 1963 was 96.0 per cent of the endowment fund liabilities and balance (96.6 per cent in 1962).

La valeur non amortie des bâtiments et du matériel fixe s'est établie, en 1963, à \$12,333 par lit (capacité théorique), dans les hôpitaux publics, hausse de 6.8 p. 100 sur 1962 (\$11,548).

La valeur de ce rapport s'est échelonnée de \$6,675 dans les hôpitaux de 1-9 lits à \$16,454 dans ceux de 500-999 (graphique 9), et la moyenne de tous les hôpitaux généraux s'est établie à \$12,904 (\$12,062). Parmi les provinces, les hôpitaux publics de la Saskatchewan ont enregistré la plus basse valeur à cet égard (\$9,259) et ceux du Québec, la plus haute (\$14,794).

Les placements divers ont figuré pour 8.1 p. 100 (8.8 en 1962), les créances sur d'autres fonds pour 4 p. 100 (4), l'encaisse et le compte de banque pour 3.6 p. 100 (3.6) et les immobilisations pour 3.2 p. 100 (3.4). Le solde du fonds de dotation a été de 96 p. 100 (96.6 en 1962) de l'actif et du solde du même fonds.





VALEUR NON AMORTIE DU MATÉRIEL FIXE, PAR LIT (CAP. THÉOR.), 1963





