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## PREFACE

Hospital statistics in Canada are published in a series of eight annual reports, each of which is concerned with a specific topic. These statistics are provided so that the reader may assess the facilities and services available, the labour force involved and the financial situation in the Canadian hospitals.

Statistics on hospitals have been collected by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics since 1931 and have been published since then in varying degrees of detail. Until 1951, one volume contained the entire hospital statistical data. From 1952 to 1958 there were two, 1959-1960 there were six, and since 1961, eight volumes have been required to portray data of the hospital scene. These volumes are as follows:

La statistique des hôpitaux du Canada est publiée dans une série de huit rapports annuels dont chacun traite d'un sujet déterminé. Ces publications permettront au lecteur d'apprécier les installations et services disponibles, la main-d'oeuvre employée et la situation financière des hôpitaux canadiens.

Depuis 1931, le Bureau fédéral de la statistique recueille la statistique sur les hôpitaux et la présente en publications plus ou moins détaillées. 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
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HOSPITAL CLASSIFICATION CHART, 1965

## GLOSSARY

### Hospital

An institution which is operated for the medical, surgical and/or obstetrical care of in-patients, and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by the federal and/or a provincial government, or by a municipality duly authorized under the laws of the province. Specifically excluded are institutions primarily for tuberculosis, mental diseases and mental defect.

### Public Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "public hospital" which is not operated for profit and accepts all patients regardless of ability to pay.

### General Hospital

A hospital which provides for the treatment and care of all types of diseases or at least a wide range of conditions.

### Chronic - Convalescent - Rehabilitation Hospitals

Hospitals which primarily provide for the treatment of conditions requiring long-term care, or for the treatment of patients who are considered to be in the recovery stage of an illness, especially where this is a long-term process and for those patients who are being rehabilitated.

### Other Hospital

A hospital which primarily provides for the treatment of a particular type of disease, condition or case such as maternity, communicable disease, orthopaedic, neurological and cancer; or a hospital which provides a combination of various types of service which cannot be classified into chronic, convalescent or rehabilitation.

### Allied Special Hospitals

Includes chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation, maternity and "other" hospitals.

### Plant Fund

The Plant Fund is used primarily to record transactions relating to property which is long-lasting as well as long-term liabilities relating thereto.

### Revenue Fund

The Revenue Fund is used to record activities associated with the day-to-day operations of the hospital in providing services to patients.

## TERMINOLOGIE

### Hôpital

Établissement donnant des soins médicaux, chirurgicaux ou obstétriques aux hospitalisés et détenant un permis ou une approbation du gouvernement fédéral ou provincial ou d'une municipalité autorisée par la province à le faire. Sont exclues, les établissements destinés avant tout à la tuberculose, aux maladies mentales et à la déficience mentale.

### Hôpital public

Hôpital reconnu comme tel par la province et établi dans un but non lucratif; il accepte tous les malades sans égard à leur capacité de payer.

### Hôpital général

Hôpital qui traite toutes sortes de maladies ou, au moins, un grand nombre d'états pathologiques.

### Établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence et de réadaptation

Hôpitaux qui traitent, avant tout, des états requérant des soins de longue durée, ou les malades qui relèvent d'une maladie, surtout de longue durée, ou qui ont besoin de réadaptation.

### Autres hôpitaux

Hôpitaux qui se spécialisent dans le traitement de maladies, d'états pathologiques ou de cas d'un genre particulier, notamment maternité, maladies contagieuses, orthopédie, neurologie, cancer; ce sont encore les hôpitaux à affectations diverses qui ne peuvent être classés parmi les hôpitaux généraux, les hôpitaux de maladies chroniques, les maisons de convalescence ou de réadaptation.

### Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Ces hôpitaux comprennent les établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence, de réadaptation, les maternités et les hôpitaux divers.

### Fonds d'administration générale

Le Fonds d'exploitation générale énumère les activités journalières de l'établissement hospitalier exigées par les soins à donner aux malades.

### Fonds des installations

Le Fonds des installations énumère en particulier les transactions immobilières à longue échéance et les exigences à long terme qui en résultent.

**Endowment Fund**

The Endowment Fund is used to record transactions relating to special gifts and bequests to the hospital.

**Buildings and Building Service Equipment**

Includes all structures owned by the hospital and used in carrying out normal functions, as well as equipment added, to heat, light, ventilate or otherwise make serviceable.

**Major Equipment**

Includes hospital equipment, other than building service equipment, which has an estimated useful life of 5 years or more and is usually moveable rather than affixed.

**Minor Equipment**

Includes hospital equipment with an estimated life of not more than 5 years, usually small in size, numerous in quantity, relatively low unit cost and no fixed location.

**Depreciation Expense**

Includes depreciation on land improvements, buildings and building service equipment and major equipment.

**Sinking Fund**

Cash or investments, including bonds, debentures and stocks, held for the purpose of retiring a bond issue at some future date.

**Improvement and Replacement Fund**

Cash or investments set aside for extensions, improvements, or replacement of building, equipment and other plant assets.

**Estimated Year-end Adjustment**

The amount due to or from the Provincial Plan of the province and other agencies with respect to the adjustment of a surplus or deficit incurred during the year.

**Fonds de dotation**

Le Fonds de dotation note en particulier les opérations relatives aux dons et legs reçus par l'hôpital.

**Bâtiments et matériel fixe**

Comprend l'ensemble des bâtiments que possède l'hôpital et qui servent aux fonctions régulières de celui-ci, de même que le matériel ajouté au chauffage, à l'éclairage et à la ventilation, ou mis en service de quelque manière.

**Gros matériel**

Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital autre que le matériel fixe, dont la durée estimative de service est de cinq ans ou plus et qui est habituellement amovible plutôt que fixe.

**Petit matériel**

Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital dont la durée estimative de service ne dépasse pas cinq ans, dont la taille est ordinairement petite, la quantité grande, le prix unitaire modique et qui n'a pas d'emplacement fixe.

**Frais d'amortissement**

Comprend l'amortissement des aménagements de terrain, des bâtiments, du matériel fixe et du gros matériel.

**Fonds de remboursement de la dette**

Comprend tout solde en argent et la valeur des placements du fonds de remboursement de la dette, y compris les obligations et (ou) actions conservées en vue de racheter plus tard une émission d'obligations.

**Fonds d'amélioration et de renouvellement**

Comprend tout solde en argent et la valeur des placements (obligations et (ou) actions) mis en réserve pour les rajouts, les améliorations et le remplacement de bâtiments, de matériel ou autre actif du fonds d'immobilisations.

**Estimation de l'ajustement de fin d'année**

Le montant dû à ou au régime d'assurance-hospitalisation de la province et des autres organismes ou à en recevoir, en ce qui trait à l'ajustement du surplus ou du déficit au cours de l'année.

## INTRODUCTION

Information covered by this Volume pertains to the balance sheet data as reported by Canadian public general and allied special hospitals for the year 1965. Some 918 public general and allied special hospitals, representing 90.8 per cent of the total number operating, reported information on Revenue Fund balance sheets, 912 or 90.2 per cent submitted data on Plant Fund and 198 or 19.6 per cent specified control or ownership of Endowment Fund assets. Excluded from the tabulations are private and federal hospitals, mental and tuberculosis hospitals and a number of public hospitals providing a "composite" form of service combining hospital and non-hospital functions, which cannot be divided into separate accounts as required for purposes of this publication.

Source of the material contained in this report is the Annual Return of Hospitals, Part II (Finances), which are received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics through the hospitals' respective Provincial Hospital authorities. The majority of Canadian hospitals use the system of fund accounting as recommended by the Canadian Hospital Association, dividing the balance sheets into Revenue Fund, Plant Fund and Endowment Fund. Total reported assets of the three funds combined stood at \$2,032 million in 1965, comprising Plant Fund assets of \$1,790 million, Revenue Fund \$161 million and Endowment Fund \$81 million. Current and long-term liabilities amounted to \$710 million, exclusive of balance of Fund (capital) of \$1,322 million.

### Revenue Fund

#### Accounts and Notes Receivable

In 1965, accounts and notes receivable reported by 823 public general hospitals amounted to \$56,538,900, representing 38.0 per cent of the Revenue Fund assets of this group of hospitals (Chart 1). The comparable percentage in 1964 was 37.6 per cent. Of this amount (38.0 per cent), 18.0 per cent was due from Provincial Plans, ranging from 2.5 per cent in Prince Edward Island to 29.8 per cent in Ontario (Table 4). The proportion of Revenue Fund assets held in the form of accounts and notes receivable also varied according to hospital size, being generally higher in the larger hospitals, rising from 10.1 per cent in the 1-9 bed group to 48.8 per cent in the 500-999 bed range (Chart 2).

#### Inventory of Supplies

Inventory of supplies constituted the second largest component of Revenue Fund assets, amounting to \$30,353,700, as reported by 804 public general hospitals. This was equivalent to 22.4 per cent of the total assets in this Fund, a slight increase over the previous year's proportion (21.3 per cent). Inventory of supplies varied considerably among the provinces, being 18.7 per

Les renseignements statistiques qui figurent dans le présent rapport portent sur le bilan d'exploitation de l'année 1965 des hôpitaux publics généraux et spéciaux divers. Quelque 918 hôpitaux généraux publics et spéciaux divers, soit 90.8 p. 100 du total des hôpitaux en exploitation, ont fourni des données sur le bilan du fonds d'administration générale, 912 ou 90.2 p. 100 sur le fonds des installations et 198 ou 19.6 p. 100 ont fourni des précisions sur le droit de regard ou l'appartenance du fonds de dotation. Les tableaux ne comprennent pas les hôpitaux fédéraux et privés, les établissements pour malades mentaux et pour tuberculeux et certains hôpitaux publics dont l'activité est "générale" c'est-à-dire à la fois hospitalière et non hospitalière, et dont les comptes ne peuvent être distincts pour les fins de la présente publication.

La matière du rapport provient de la partie II du rapport annuel des hôpitaux (Finances) que le Bureau fédéral de la statistique reçoit des autorités hospitalières provinciales. La plupart des hôpitaux canadiens utilisent la comptabilité de fonds que leur propose la *Canadian Hospital Association*, et qui consiste à diviser le bilan en fonds de l'administration générale, fonds des installations matérielles et fonds de dotation. L'actif global des trois fonds réunis s'établit à 2,032 millions de dollars en 1965 et se répartit ainsi qu'il suit: des installations matérielles, 1,790 millions, fonds d'administration générale, 161 millions et fonds de dotation 81 millions. Les exigibilités à court et à long termes s'élevaient à 710 millions de dollars, sans le solde de 1,322 millions du fonds (capital).

### Fonds d'administration générale

#### Comptes et billets à recevoir

En 1965, les comptes et billets à recevoir déclarés par 823 hôpitaux publics généraux s'élevaient à \$56,538,900 constituant 38 p. 100 du fonds d'administration générale de ce groupe d'hôpitaux (graphique 1). En 1964, ce même pourcentage était de 37.6 p. 100. Sur ces 38 p. 100, 18 p. 100 devaient être reçus des régimes provinciaux et s'échelonnaient de 2.5 p. 100 en Île-du-Prince-Édouard à 29.8 p. 100 en Ontario (tableau 4). La proportion du fonds d'administration générale détenue sous formes de comptes et de billets à recevoir variait également selon la taille de l'hôpital; elle était généralement plus élevée dans les grands hôpitaux, haussant de 10.1 p. 100 dans le groupe de 1 à 9 lits à 48.8 p. 100 dans celui de 500-999 lits (graphique 2).

#### Stocks de fournitures

Les stocks de fournitures constituaient, suivant les déclarations de 804 hôpitaux généraux publics, l'élément suivant du fonds d'administration générale; ils s'élevaient à \$30,353,700. Cette somme équivalait à 22.4 p. 100 de l'actif total inscrit dans ce fonds, soit une légère augmentation (21.3 p. 100) sur l'année précédente. Les stocks de fournitures variaient considérablement d'une province à l'autre, la proportion




cent of the assets (\$11,751,700) in Ontario and 46.7 per cent (\$1,096,900) in Newfoundland. The geographical location of some hospitals in relation to the availability of supplies no doubt has an impact on the degree of inventory that is carried. Inventory of supplies was, on the whole, greater proportionally among smaller hospitals of under 100 beds, varying between a high of 29.4 per cent in the 25-49 bed group and a low of 18.6 per cent in hospitals with 1,000 or more beds. Since 1961, the amount of inventory per rated bed has climbed from \$268 to \$346, an increase of just over 29 per cent. The advance of the ratio value in 1965 over 1964 amounted to 6.1 per cent. Hospitals with between 1 and 9 beds maintained a higher relationship of inventory to rated beds (\$499) than any other size group, while hospitals of 300-499 beds were lowest in the comparison (\$321) (Chart 3).

#### Other Revenue Fund Assets

The value of cash on hand and in bank accounted for 12.6 per cent of the Revenue Fund assets in general hospitals (11.2 per cent in 1964), due from other Funds was 11.5 per cent (13.8), temporary investments reached 8.2 per cent (6.9) and all other assets totalled 7.3 per cent. Cash on hand and in bank was highest proportionally in 1-9 bed hospitals, representing 34.9 per cent of Revenue Fund assets, and decreased as size of hospital increased until a minimum value of 6.4 per cent was noted in the 500-999 bed hospitals.

Il est certain que la situation géographique de certains hôpitaux ne leur permet pas de s'approvisionner facilement et cet état de chose influe sûrement sur la quantité des stocks qu'ils doivent conserver. Dans l'ensemble, les stocks des hôpitaux de moins de 100 lits étaient plus considérables, proportionnellement, et variaient d'un sommet de 29.4 p. 100 dans les hôpitaux de 25-49 lits à un creux de 18.6 p. 100 dans ceux de 1,000 lits ou plus. Depuis 1961, les stocks par lit théorique se sont accrus de \$268 à \$346, soit d'un peu plus de 29 p. 100. De 1964 à 1965, la valeur du rapport a augmenté de 6.1 p. 100. Le rapport entre les stocks et les lits théoriques (\$499) était plus élevé dans les hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits que dans toute autre tranche de taille, tandis que les hôpitaux de 300-499 lits accusaient le rapport le plus faible (\$321) (graphique 3).

#### Autre actif du fonds d'administration générale

L'encaisse et l'argent en banque constituaient 12.6 p. 100 du fonds d'administration générale dans les hôpitaux généraux (11.2 p. 100 en 1964), le montant à percevoir d'autres fonds s'élevait à 11.5 p. 100 (13.8) les placements provisoires atteignaient 8.2 p. 100 (6.9) et tous les autres apports se chiffraient par 7.3 p. 100. L'encaisse et l'argent en banque étaient proportionnellement plus élevés dans les hôpitaux de 1-9 lits et représentaient 34.9 p. 100 du fonds d'administration générale; ils étaient inversement proportionnels à la taille de l'hôpital, et atteignaient une valeur minimale de 6.4 p. 100 dans les hôpitaux de 500-999 lits.




### Revenue Fund Liabilities

Revenue Fund liabilities of public general hospitals in 1965 consisted for the most part of due to other Funds, which accounted for \$99,898,300 or 47.6 per cent, a slight increase of 0.6 per cent over the proportion in 1964 (Chart 4). Other liabilities comprised accounts payable of 19.9 per cent (17.8), bank loans and overdrafts of 8.3 per cent (10.2), accrued liabilities 6.1 per cent (7.1), notes payable 4.8 per cent (4.7) and other remaining liabilities totalling 13.3 per cent (13.2).

In general hospitals in 1965, the value of Revenue Fund liabilities exceeded that of assets by some 41.5 per cent, marking an increase in the imbalance of 10.7 per cent compared with the 1964 situation (Chart 5). On the whole, hospitals with under 100 beds showed the opposite trend, experiencing credit balances (assets greater than liabilities), ranging from 11.2 per cent in the 25-49 bed group to 62.8 per cent in the 1-9 bed group. Debit balances (liabilities greater than assets) were noted in hospitals over 100 beds, being lowest in the 300-499 bed range at 38.6 per cent and highest in the 200-299 bed hospitals at 68.5 per cent.

### Plant Fund

#### Buildings and Building Service Equipment

Plant Fund assets in the form of buildings and building service equipment (less depreciation) accounted for \$1,094,173,700 or almost two-thirds (65.8 per cent) of the total as reported by 820 public general hospitals in 1965 (Chart 6). In 1964, some 802 general hospitals reported assets of this type amounting to \$1,005,031,700 or 66.6 per cent of the total. The value of buildings and building service equipment per rated bed advanced by \$800 or 6 per cent to \$14,184, with an average rate of increase since 1961 of 5.4 per cent (Chart 7). Hospitals of 1-9 beds had the lowest ratio in this regard, being \$6,850, from which the value rose to \$17,486 in the 500-999 bed group, and dropped finally to \$14,522 in the largest hospitals of 1,000 beds or more.

Assets added to buildings and building service equipment during the year were \$93,669,000 or 7.0 per cent of the value of balance at year-end in this area of Plant Fund (6.0 per cent in 1964). General hospitals of between 50 and 99 beds and also 200 and 299 beds both added assets valued at 11.8 per cent of the balance at year-end, the maximum value recorded for this particular ratio, while the lowest percentage noted was attributable to the 1-9 bed group of hospitals, with 1.5 per cent.

#### Major Equipment

Major equipment (less reserve for depreciation), as in 1964, represented 11.2 per cent of Plant Fund assets of general hospitals, amounting to a reported \$186,671,900. The proportion of

### Passif du fonds d'administration générale

Le passif du fonds d'administration générale des hôpitaux généraux publics en 1965 consiste surtout en sommes dues à d'autres fonds, lesquelles s'établissent à \$99,898,300 ou 47.6 p. 100, soit une légère avance de 0.6 p. 100 par rapport au chiffre de 1964 (graphique 4). Les autres valeurs passives comprennent les comptes à payer, 19.9 p. 100 (17.8), les prêts et découverts bancaires, 8.3 p. 100 (10.2), le passif couru, 6.1 p. 100 (7.1), les billets à payer, 4.8 p. 100 (4.7), et les autres valeurs passives totalisant 13.3 p. 100 (13.2).

Dans les hôpitaux généraux, en 1965, la valeur du passif du fonds d'administration générale dépasse l'actif de quelque 41.5 p. 100, accusant une hausse de 10.7 p. 100 du déséquilibre par rapport à 1964 (graphique 5). Dans l'ensemble, les hôpitaux de moins de 100 lits indiquaient une tendance contraire lorsque le solde créditeur (quand l'actif est plus grand que le passif) variait de 11.2 p. 100 dans le groupe de 25-49 lits à 62.8 p. 100 dans celui de 1-9 lits. On constate un solde débiteur (quand le passif est plus grand que l'actif) dans les hôpitaux de plus de 100 lits, dont le moins élevé (38.6 p. 100) est celui des hôpitaux de 300-499 lits, et le plus élevé (68.5 p. 100), celui des hôpitaux de 200-299 lits.

### Fonds des installations

#### Bâtiments et matériel fixe

Les bâtiments et matériel fixe (moins l'amortissement) constituaient \$1,094,173,700 du fonds des installations, soit presque les deux tiers (65.8 p. 100) du total déclaré par 820 hôpitaux généraux publics en 1965 (graphique 6). En 1964, quelque 802 hôpitaux généraux ont déclaré pour \$1,005,031,700 de capitaux de cette nature, ou 66.6 p. 100 du total. La valeur des bâtiments et du matériel fixe par lit théorique s'est accrue de \$800 ou 6 p. 100 et s'établit à \$14,184, le taux moyen d'accroissement depuis 1961 étant de 5.4 p. 100 (graphique 7). Les hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits accusaient la plus faible proportion à cet égard, soit \$6,850; cette valeur atteignait \$17,486 dans les hôpitaux de 500-999 lits et baissait finalement à \$14,522 dans les plus grands hôpitaux de 1,000 lits et plus.

La valeur des installations ajoutées aux bâtiments et au matériel fixe durant l'année s'élevait à \$93,669,000 ou 7 p. 100 de la valeur du solde pour ce poste à la fin de l'année (6 p. 100 en 1964). Les hôpitaux généraux de 50-99 lits et ceux de 200-299 lits ajoutèrent des installations représentant 11.8 p. 100 du solde à la fin de l'année, atteignant ainsi la proportion maximale, tandis que la proportion minimale (1.5 p. 100) était celle des hôpitaux de 1-9 lits.

#### Gros matériel

De même qu'en 1964, le gros matériel (moins la réserve pour amortissement), constituait 11.2 p. 100 du fonds des installations des hôpitaux généraux et le montant s'élevait à \$186,671,900. La proportion







assets in this form ranged from 10.4 per cent in 300-499 bed hospitals to 15.8 per cent in the 1-9 bed group (Chart 8). Undepreciated value of major equipment per rated bed advanced to \$3,623, marking a gain of \$282 or 8.4 per cent higher than in 1964, and fluctuated according to hospital size, from a low of \$2,911 in the 10-24 bed group to \$4,154 in the 500-999 bed group (Chart 9). Since 1961, the value of major equipment as related to rated bed capacity has increased some 35.1 per cent. Assets added during the year to major equipment represented 10.0 per cent of the balance at year-end compared with 10.4 per cent in the previous year. This particular ratio varied from 4.0 per cent in the case of 1-9 bed hospitals to 12.4 per cent in 25-49 bed hospitals.

**Construction in Progress**

The proportion of Plant Fund assets of general hospitals in the form of construction in progress was reported as \$102,836,100 or 6.2 per cent, a moderate decline from 6.4 per cent in 1964. In 1962 and 1963, the percentage of construction in progress amounted to 8.6 per cent and 6.9 per cent, respectively (Chart 10). General hospitals with 1,000 or more beds experienced the most significant level of construction in progress, amounting to 17.1 per cent of Plant Fund assets, while hospitals of 50-99 beds reflected the lowest proportion of 2.6 per cent.




**Other Plant Fund Assets**

Amounts due from Revenue Fund increased to 6.0 per cent of the Plant Fund assets of general hospitals in 1965, compared with 5.9 per cent in 1964. 

land improvements were \$593,700, as reported by 243 public general hospitals, equivalent to 16.0 per cent of the balance at year-end in this category. Hospitals of 500-999 beds recorded the highest ratio of assets added to year-end balance, amounting to 36.4 per cent, while hospitals of 300-499 beds experienced the lowest at 6.4 per cent (Chart 11).

**Increase in Plant Capital**

Government grants (federal, provincial and municipal) accounted for three-quarters of the \$111,191,500 in funds provided for increase in plant capital in 1965, as reported by 776 public general hospitals. The total of government grants comprised 55.8 per cent for land, buildings and equipment (61.3 per cent in 1964) and 19.2 per cent for debt retirement (12.1 per cent) (Chart 12). Appropriations from other Funds amounted to 11.5 per cent of the increase in plant capital, including 4.4 per cent for debt retirement (1.2 per cent). All other sources of funds together contributed 13.5 per cent of the amount provided (14.8).

**Plant Fund Liabilities**

Liabilities of Plant Fund of general hospitals comprised bonded debt not due issued by hospitals



**Endowment Fund**

The proportion of Endowment Fund assets attributed to investments accounted for 86.0 per cent of the total as reported by 179 public general hospitals in 1965. In 1964, the comparable figure was 80.3 per cent. Due from other Funds declined to 5.4 per cent from 9.8 per cent (Chart 14), and cash and bank accounts were down to 3.1 per cent from 4.4 per cent a year earlier. Real estate holdings increased to 4.1 per cent of the assets from 3.8 per cent. Due to other Funds represented 51.9 per cent of Endowment Fund liabilities and due to Revenue Fund accounted for 12.7 per cent.

**Fonds de dotation**



