

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PREFACE

Hospital statistics in Canada are published in a series of eight annual reports, each of which is concerned with a specific topic. These statistics are provided so that the reader may assess the facilities and services available, the labour force involved and the financial situation in the Canadian hospitals.

Statistics on hospitals have been collected by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics since 1931 and have been published since then in varying degrees of detail. Until 1951, one volume contained the entire hospital statistical data. From 1952 to 1958 there were two, 1959-1960 there were six, and since 1961, eight volumes have been required to portray data of the hospital scene. These volumes are as follows:

La statistique des hôpitaux du Canada est publiée dans une série de huit rapports annuels dont chacun traite d'un sujet déterminé. Ces publications permettront au lecteur d'apprécier les installations et services disponibles, la main-d'œuvre employée et la situation financière des hôpitaux canadiens.

Depuis 1931, le Bureau fédéral de la statistique recueille la statistique sur les hôpitaux et la présente en publications plus ou moins détaillées. Jusqu'en 1951, toutes les données statistiques afférentes aux hôpitaux tenaient en un seul volume. De 1952 à 1958, il est paru deux volumes, en 1959-1960 six, et depuis 1961, huit volumes sont nécessaires pour tracer un tableau complet de l'activité hospitalière.

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
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HOSPITAL CLASSIFICATION CHART, 1966

GLOSSARY

Hospital

An institution which is operated for the medical, surgical and/or obstetrical care of inpatients, and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by the federal and/or a provincial government, or by a municipality duly authorized under the laws of the province. Specifically excluded are institutions primarily for tuberculosis, mental diseases and mental defect.

Public Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "public hospital" which is not operated for profit and accepts all patients regardless of ability to pay.

General Hospital

A hospital which provides for the treatment and care of all types of diseases or at least a wide range of conditions.

Chronic – Convalescent – Rehabilitation Hospitals

Hospitals which primarily provide for the treatment of conditions requiring long-term care, or for the treatment of patients who are considered to be in the recovery stage of an illness, especially where this is a long-term process and for those patients who are being rehabilitated.

Other Hospital

A hospital which primarily provides for the treatment of a particular type of disease, condition or case such as maternity, communicable disease, orthopaedic, neurological and cancer; or a hospital which provides a combination of various types of service which cannot be classified into chronic, convalescent or rehabilitation.

Allied Special Hospitals

Includes chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation and "other" hospitals.

Revenue Fund

The Revenue Fund is used to record activities associated with the day-to-day operations of the hospital in providing services to patients.

Estimated Year-end Adjustment

The amount due to or from the Provincial Plan of the province and other agencies with respect to the adjustment of a surplus or deficit incurred during the year.

Plant Fund

The Plant Fund is used primarily to record transactions relating to property which is long-lasting as well as long-term liabilities relating thereto.

TERMINOLOGIE

Hôpital

Établissement donnant des soins médicaux, chirurgicaux ou obstétriques aux hospitalisés et détenant un permis ou une approbation du gouvernement fédéral ou provincial ou d'une municipalité autorisée par la province à le faire. Sont exclues, les établissements destinés avant tout à la tuberculose, aux maladies mentales et à la déficience mentale.

Hôpital public

Hôpital reconnu comme tel par la province et établi dans un but non lucratif; il accepte tous les malades sans égard à leur capacité de payer.

Hôpital général

Hôpital qui traite toutes sortes de maladies ou, au moins, un grand nombre d'états pathologiques.

Établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence et de réadaptation

Hôpitaux qui traitent, avant tout, des états requérant des soins de longue durée, ou les malades qui relèvent d'une maladie, surtout de longue durée, ou qui ont besoin de réadaptation.

Autres hôpitaux

Hôpitaux qui se spécialisent dans le traitement de maladies, d'états pathologiques ou de cas d'un genre particulier, notamment maternité, maladies contagieuses, orthopédie, neurologie, cancer; ce sont encore les hôpitaux à affectations diverses qui ne peuvent être classés parmi les hôpitaux généraux, les hôpitaux de maladies chroniques, les maisons de convalescence ou de réadaptation.

Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Ces hôpitaux comprennent les établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence, de réadaptation et les hôpitaux divers.

Fonds des installations

Le Fonds des installations énumère en particulier les transactions immobilières à longue échéance et les exigibilités à long terme qui en résultent.

Estimation de l'ajustement de fin d'année

Le montant dû à ou au régime d'assurance-hospitalisation de la province et des autres organismes ou à en recevoir, en ce qui trait à l'ajustement du surplus ou du déficit au cours de l'année.

Fonds d'administration générale

Le Fonds d'exploitation générale énumère les activités journalières de l'établissement hospitalier exigées par les soins à donner aux malades.

Buildings and building service equipment.— Includes all structures owned by the hospital and used in carrying out normal functions, as well as equipment added, to heat, light, ventilate or otherwise make serviceable.

Major equipment.— Includes hospital equipment, other than building service equipment, which has an estimated useful life of 5 years or more and is usually moveable rather than affixed.

Minor equipment.— Includes hospital equipment, with an estimated life of not more than 5 years, usually small in size, numerous in quantity, relatively low unit cost and no fixed location.

Depreciation Fund.— Cash and investments held in the Plant Fund as the result of the funding of the Reserve for Depreciation.

Sinking Fund.— Cash or investments, including bonds, debentures and stocks, held for the purpose of retiring a bond issue at some future date.

Improvement and replacement Fund.— Cash or investments set aside for extensions, improvements, or replacement of building, equipment and other plant assets.

Endowment Fund

The Endowment Fund is used to record transactions relating to special gifts and bequests to the hospital.

Bâtiments et matériel fixe.— Comprend l'ensemble des bâtiments que possède l'hôpital et qui servent aux fonctions régulières de celui-ci, de même que le matériel ajouté au chauffage, à l'éclairage et à la ventilation, ou mis en service de quelque manière.

Gros matériel.— Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital autre que le matériel fixe, dont la durée estimative de service est de cinq ans ou plus et qui est habituellement amovible plutôt que fixe.

Petit matériel.— Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital dont la durée estimative de service ne dépasse pas cinq ans, dont la taille est ordinairement petite, la quantité grande, le prix unitaire modique et qui n'a pas d'emplacement fixe.

**Fond d'amortissement de l'installation matériel-
le.**— Encaisses et placements conservées dans le fonds d'immobilisation comme résultat de la consolidation de la réserve pour dépréciation.

Fonds de remboursement de la dette.— Comprend tout solde en argent et la valeur des placements du fonds de remboursement de la dette, y compris les obligations et (ou) actions conservées en vue de racheter plus tard une émission d'obligations.

Fonds d'amélioration et de renouvellement.— Comprend tout solde en argent et la valeur des placements (obligations et (ou) actions) mis en réserve pour les rajouts, les améliorations et le remplacement de bâtiments, de matériel ou autre actif du fonds d'immobilisations.

Fonds de dotation

Le Fonds de dotation note en particulier les opérations relatives aux dons et legs reçus par l'hôpital.

INTRODUCTION

This report contains in summary form the balance sheet data as reported by more than 91 per cent of all operating public general and allied special hospitals in Canada for the year 1966. Private and federal hospitals as well as mental institutions and tuberculosis sanatoria are excluded along with those public hospitals providing "composite" services, i.e., hospitals for which the financial data represent hospital and non-hospital functions which cannot be separated.

The source document for the data of this report is the "Annual Return of Hospitals - Part 2 (Finances)" as completed by each individual hospital and forwarded to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics through arrangements made with the respective provincial hospital authorities. The majority of Canadian hospitals use the Canadian Hospital Association system of fund accounting, utilizing the Revenue Fund, the Plant Fund and the Endowment Fund as defined in the glossary. Total reported assets of these three funds amounted to \$2,261 million in 1966. The Plant Fund accounted for \$1,990 million of this total followed by the Revenue Fund \$183 million and the Endowment Fund \$88 million. Current and long term liabilities were \$806 million, exclusive of balance of Fund (capital) of \$1,455 million (Table 1).

Le présent rapport est un résumé des bilans de plus de 91 p. 100 des hôpitaux publics généraux et spéciaux divers en activité au Canada en 1966. Il ne comprend pas les hôpitaux fédéraux et privés, les établissements pour malades mentaux et pour tuberculeux, ni certains hôpitaux publics dont l'activité est "générale", c'est-à-dire à la fois hospitalière et non hospitalière, et dont les comptes ne peuvent être séparés.

La matière du rapport provient de la "Partie 2 du Rapport annuel des hôpitaux (Finances)" que le Bureau fédéral de la statistique reçoit de chacun des hôpitaux en vertu d'ententes conclues avec les autorités hospitalières provinciales. La plupart des hôpitaux canadiens utilisent le système de comptabilité de l'Association des hôpitaux du Canada et divisent leurs bilans en fonds d'administration générale, fonds de l'installation matérielle et fonds de dotation (voir les définitions dans la terminologie). L'actif global des trois fonds réunis atteignait 2,261 millions de dollars en 1966 et se répartissait comme il suit: fonds de l'installation matérielle, 1,990 millions, fonds d'administration générale, 183 millions, fonds de dotation, 88 millions. Les exigibilités à court et à long terme s'élevaient à 806 millions de dollars, sans le solde de 1,455 millions du fonds (capital) (tableau 1).

Revenue Fund

Accounts and Notes Receivable

In public general hospitals in 1966, accounts and notes receivable amounted to \$65,877,573 or 39.0 per cent of Revenue Fund assets (38.0 per cent in 1965), 19.3 per cent being due from Provincial Plans, 17.3 per cent from patients and 2.4 per cent from sundry sources (Table 2). Inspection of Table 4 and Chart 3 shows that there was wide provincial variation in these proportions. The amount due from Provincial Plans went from 0.1 per cent of total assets in Prince Edward Island and Saskatchewan to 33.0 per cent in Ontario. Provincial variations in the amount due from patients fluctuated to a lesser extent from 8.6 per cent of total assets in Nova Scotia to 24.2 per cent in British Columbia. Generally speaking, accounts and notes receivable as a proportion of Total Revenue Fund assets varied directly with hospital size as illustrated by Chart 2.

Inventory of Supplies

The second largest component of Revenue Fund assets, inventory of supplies amounted to \$36,822,858 or 21.8 per cent of the Revenue Fund assets of public general hospitals in 1966. Prov-

Fonds d'administration générale

Comptes et billets à recevoir

Dans les hôpitaux généraux publics en 1966, les comptes et billets à recevoir se sont élevés à \$65,877,573, soit 39 p. 100 du fonds d'administration générale (38 p. 100 en 1965); sur ces 39 p. 100, 19.3 p. 100 devaient être reçus des régimes provinciaux, 17.3 p. 100 des malades et 2.4 p. 100 de sources diverses (tableau 2). L'étude du tableau 4 et du graphique 3 fait apparaître une grande variation provinciale de ces proportions. Le montant devant provenir des régimes provinciaux variait de 0.1 p. 100 de l'actif global (Île-du-Prince-Édouard et Saskatchewan) à 33 p. 100 (Ontario). Les sommes dues par les malades variaient moins d'une province à l'autre, allant de 8.6 p. 100 de l'actif global (Nouvelle-Écosse) à 24.2 p. 100 (Colombie-Britannique). Comme l'indique le graphique 2, la proportion des comptes et billets à recevoir par rapport au fonds d'administration générale total varie presque toujours suivant la taille de l'hôpital.

Stocks de fournitures

Les stocks de fournitures constituaient le deuxième élément du fonds d'administration générale: ils s'élevaient en 1966 à \$36,822,858, soit 21.8 p. 100 du fonds d'administration générale des hôpitaux




incipally, inventory of supplies varied as a proportion of total assets from 18.6 per cent in Ontario to 44.7 per cent in Newfoundland (Chart 4). Inventory of supplies tends to involve a higher proportion of Revenue Fund assets (between 27 and 30 per cent in 1966) in the smaller hospitals (from 10-99 beds) than in the larger hospitals (300 beds and over) where the variation was between 18 and 19 per cent in 1966. The economics of transport no doubt have an effect on the character of inventories which cannot be fully appreciated by an analysis of this type. For example, a hospital whatever its size requires inventories commensurate with its remoteness from suppliers. The ratio of inventory of supplies per rated bed advanced by 7.9 per cent in public general hospitals from \$346 in 1965 to \$373 in 1966, varying from \$286 in Prince Edward Island to \$498 in Newfoundland (Table 7). Inventory of supplies per rated bed varies inversely with bed size, ranging from \$485 in the 1-9 bed hospitals to \$345 in the 300-499 bed hospitals in 1966 (Chart 5).

Other Revenue Fund Assets

Public general hospitals reported cash on hand amounting to 11.0 per cent of Revenue Fund assets in 1966. Cash on hand bore an inverse relationship to bed size, declining from 38.5 per cent of total assets in the 1-9 bed hospitals to 7.9 per cent in hospitals of 500 beds or more. Other substantial assets reported included temporary investments (8.3 per cent) and due from other Funds (12.0 per cent).

Revenue Fund Liabilities

In public general hospitals, \$112,962,187 or 45.4 per cent of Revenue Fund liabilities in 1966 were amounts due to other Funds (47.6 per cent in 1965). Accounts payable made up an additional 21.4 per cent followed by bank loans and overdrafts (8.5 per cent), accrued liabilities (6.7 per cent), notes payable (3.5 per cent), Provincial Plan (3.2 per cent) and all other liabilities of 11.3 per cent (Chart 6). Inspection of Table 4 shows that accounts payable and accrued liabilities as a proportion of Revenue Fund liabilities tend to rise with hospital size while the other components do not seem to be unduly influenced by hospital size.

In 1966, Revenue Fund liabilities were 47.6 per cent higher than Revenue Fund assets (41.5 per cent in 1965). As a group, hospitals of less than 100 beds showed a credit balance ranging from 66.1 per cent in the 1-9 bed hospitals to 3.6 per cent in the 50-99 bed group (Chart 7). The highest debit balances occurred in the 100-199 bed group (71.0 per cent) and the 200-299 bed group (79.8 per cent) as on the whole, debit balances were considerably greater than credit balances.

généraux publics. D'une province à l'autre, la proportion de l'actif global constituée par les stocks variait entre 18.6 p. 100 (Ontario) à 44.7 p. 100 (Terre-Neuve) (graphique 4). On semble consacrer aux stocks dans les plus petits hôpitaux (10 à 99 lits) une plus forte proportion (entre 27 et 30 p. 100 en 1966) du fonds d'administration générale que dans les plus grands hôpitaux (300 lits et plus) où cette proportion a varié entre 18 et 19 p. 100. Le transport influe sans aucun doute sur le caractère des stocks, mais la présente analyse ne peut en tenir pleinement compte. Par exemple, quelle que soit sa taille, un hôpital se doit de garder des stocks qui varient en fonction de l'éloignement des fournisseurs. La valeur des stocks par lit théorique a augmenté de 7.9 p. 100 en 1966 dans les hôpitaux généraux publics, passant de \$346 en 1965 à \$373 en 1966; elle variait de \$286 (Île-du-Prince-Édouard) à \$498 (Terre-Neuve) (tableau 7). La valeur des stocks par lit théorique variait en proportion inverse de la taille de l'hôpital, étant de \$485 dans les hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits, et de \$345 dans ceux de 300 à 499 lits (graphique 5).

Autre actif du fonds d'administration générale

Les hôpitaux généraux publics signalaient que leur encaisse équivalait en 1966 à 11 p. 100 du fonds d'administration générale. L'encaisse était inversement proportionnelle à la taille de l'hôpital, passant de 38.5 p. 100 de l'actif total dans les hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits à 7.9 p. 100 dans ceux de 500 lits ou plus. Les autres éléments d'actif importants comprenaient les placements provisoires (8.3 p. 100) et le montant à percevoir d'autres fonds (12 p. 100).

Passif du fonds d'administration générale

En 1966, le montant à verser à d'autres fonds atteignait \$112,962,187, soit 45.4 p. 100 des exigibilités du fonds d'administration générale (47.6 p. 100 en 1965). Les autres valeurs passives comprenaient les comptes à payer (21.4 p. 100), les prêts et découverts bancaires (8.5 p. 100), le passif couru (6.7 p. 100), les billets à payer (3.5 p. 100), les sommes dues aux régimes provinciaux (3.2 p. 100) et les autres exigibilités (11.3 p. 100) (graphique 6). Le tableau 4 montre que la proportion des comptes à payer et du passif couru par rapport aux exigibilités du fonds d'administration générale s'accroît ordinairement avec la taille de l'hôpital, tandis que les autres éléments ne semblent pas dans une large mesure influencés par la taille de l'hôpital.

En 1966, la valeur du passif du fonds d'administration générale dépasse l'actif de 47.6 p. 100 (41.5 p. 100 en 1965). Les hôpitaux de moins de 100 lits avaient un solde créiteur variant de 66.1 p. 100 dans les hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits à 3.6 p. 100 dans les hôpitaux de 50 à 99 lits (graphique 7). On a relevé les plus forts soldes débiteurs dans les hôpitaux de 100 à 199 lits (71 p. 100) et de 200 à 299 lits (79.8 p. 100); dans l'ensemble, les soldes débiteurs étaient beaucoup plus élevés que les soldes créateurs.











Plant Fund

Buildings and Building Service Equipment

Buildings and building service equipment (less depreciation) amounted to more than (\$1,205.2 million or 65.4 per cent of Plant Fund assets in public general hospitals in 1966 as against 65.8 per cent in 1965 (Table 5, Chart 8). Almost \$104.2 million of assets were added to public general hospitals in 1966 in the form of buildings and building service equipment (Table 6). These additions were equal to 7.1 per cent of the balance at year-end of this segment of the Plant Fund. This ratio remained relatively stable (between 5.0 and 7.6 per cent) for all bed groups except 25-49 (14.1), 300-499 (10.9) and 1,000 and over (2.3) as illustrated by Chart 10.

Major Equipment

Major equipment (less reserve for depreciation), the second largest Plant Fund asset, amounted to \$209.5 million or 11.4 per cent of Plant Fund assets in public general hospitals in 1966, ranging from 10.8 per cent of total assets in the 100-199 bed hospitals to 14.9 per cent in the 1-9 bed group (Chart 9). Assets added during the year in the form of major equipment amounted to \$38.9 million or 9.9 per cent of the balance at year-end (Table 6). This ratio ranged from 3.9 in the 1-9 bed group to 13.2 in the 200-299 bed group (Chart 10).

Construction in Progress

Construction in progress in public general hospitals in 1966 amounted to \$111.4 million or 6.0 per cent of Plant Fund assets (6.2 per cent in 1965), ranging from 1.3 per cent of Plant Fund assets in the 1,000 bed hospitals to 9.9 per cent in the 300-499 bed group. Chart 11 summarizes this ratio for the period 1962-1966. The bed group comparison for 1965 and 1966 illustrates the point that construction in relation to hospital size is a random occurrence for which trends are unfeasable. However, the overall picture does provide some insight as to the character of the Plant Fund balance sheet for any particular year.

Other Plant Fund Assets

The amount due to the Plant Fund from the Revenue Fund stood at 6.1 per cent of Plant Fund assets in public general hospitals in 1966 (6.0 per cent in 1965). As in 1965, land was valued at 2.0 per cent of assets. More than \$1 million of assets were added to public general hospitals in the form of land improvements (Table 6), an amount equivalent to 19.3 per cent of the balance at year-end. Assets added in the form of land improvements ranged from 5.2 per cent of total balance at year-end in the 300-499 bed hospitals to 32 per cent in the 50-99 (32.5) and 200-299 (32.4) bed groups (Chart 10).

Fonds de l'installation matérielle

Bâtiments et matériel fixe

Les bâtiments et le matériel fixe (moins l'amortissement) étaient évalués à 1,205.2 millions de dollars, soit 65.4 p. 100 du fonds de l'installation matérielle des hôpitaux généraux publics en 1966, contre 65.8 p. 100 en 1965 (tableau 5, graphique 8). L'augmentation de l'actif (bâtiments et matériel fixe) des hôpitaux généraux publics en 1966 a été de presque 104.2 millions de dollars (tableau 6). Cette augmentation équivalait à 7.1 p. 100 du solde de fin d'année de cet élément du fonds de l'installation matérielle. Ce pourcentage est relativement le même (variant entre 5 et 7.6) pour toutes les tailles d'hôpitaux sauf celles de 25 à 49 lits (14.1), de 300 à 499 lits (10.9) et de 1,000 lits ou plus (2.3), comme l'indique le graphique 10.

Gros matériel

En 1966, le gros matériel (moins la réserve pour amortissement) des hôpitaux généraux publics constituait le deuxième élément en importance de l'actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle et atteignait 209.5 millions de dollars, soit 11.4 p. 100 du fonds; dans les hôpitaux de 100 à 199 lits, cette proportion était de 10.8 p. 100, et elle était de 14.9 p. 100 dans les hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits (graphique 9). La valeur du matériel acquis au cours de l'année s'élevait à 38.9 millions de dollars, soit 9.9 p. 100 du solde de fin d'année (tableau 6). Cette proportion variait de 3.9 p. 100 (hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits) à 13.2 p. 100 (hôpitaux de 200 à 299 lits) (graphique 10).

Construction en cours


La construction en cours dans les hôpitaux généraux publics en 1966 s'élevait à 111.4 millions de dollars, soit 6 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle (contre 6.2 p. 100 en 1965); ce pourcentage variait de 1.3 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle (hôpitaux de 1,000 lits et plus) à 9.9 p. 100 (hôpitaux de 300 à 499 lits). Le graphique 11 donne l'évolution de ce pourcentage de 1962 à 1966. En 1965 et en 1966, il n'existe aucun rapport entre la taille de l'hôpital et l'importance des constructions en cours; il est donc impossible de dégager des tendances à cet égard. Toutefois, la vue d'ensemble permet de mieux comprendre le bilan du fonds de l'installation matérielle pour toute l'année.

Autre actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle

Dans les hôpitaux généraux, en 1966, les sommes dues par le fonds d'administration générale équivalaient à 6.1 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds de l'installation matérielle, comparativement à 6 p. 100 en 1965. Comme en 1965, les terrains constituaient 2 p. 100 de l'actif. La valeur ajoutée par l'amélioration des terrains a été de plus d'un million de dollars (tableau 6), ce qui équivaut à 19.3 p. 100 du solde de fin d'année. Cette valeur ajoutée variait de 5.2 p. 100 du solde de fin d'année dans les hôpitaux de 300 à 499 lits à plus de 32 p. 100 dans les hôpitaux de 50 à 99 lits (32.5) et de 200 à 299 lits (32.4) (graphique 10).











Increase in Plant Capital

The source of more than three-quarters (78.3 per cent) of the \$144.3 million of funds provided for increase in plant capital reported by public general hospitals in 1966 was made up of government (federal, provincial and municipal) grants, 69.4 per cent for land, buildings and equipment and 8.9 per cent for debt retirement (Table 9, Chart 12). The comparable 1965 proportions were 55.8 per cent and 19.2 per cent. Apportions from other funds came to 4.1 per cent of the total funds for increase in plant capital and other income accounted for the remaining 17.6 per cent.

Plant Fund Liabilities

The largest component of Plant Fund liabilities in public general hospitals in 1966 was bonded debt not due issued by hospitals (42.5 per cent) and by municipalities (14.3 per cent) followed by other long term debt (19.2 per cent), accounts and notes payable (10.4 per cent) and due to other funds (4.5 per cent) as illustrated by Chart 13 which covers the period 1961 to 1966.

Endowment Fund

In 1966, public general hospitals reported Endowment Fund assets of \$87.6 million, mostly (86.4 per cent) in the form of investments made up of bonds and debentures (67.8 per cent), stocks (9.2 per cent), real estate mortgages (2.0 per cent) and other investments (7.4 per cent). Real estate holdings and due from other funds made up an additional 4.1 per cent each, followed by cash and bank accounts 3.9 per cent (Table 10, Chart 14). On the other side of the balance sheet, liabilities of \$3.9 million were reported, the largest component of which was due to other funds (62.3 per cent) with due to Revenue Fund accounting for an additional 8.1 per cent.

Augmentation du capital du fonds de l'installation matérielle

Plus des trois quarts (78.3 p. 100) des 144.3 millions de dollars affectés à l'augmentation du capital du fonds de l'installation matérielle des hôpitaux généraux publics en 1966 provenaient de subventions fédérales, provinciales et municipales: 69.4 p. 100 pour les terrains, bâtiments et matériel et 8.9 p. 100 pour le remboursement de la dette (tableau 9, graphique 12). Ces proportions étaient 55.8 p. 100 et 19.2 p. 100 en 1965. Les affectations sur d'autres fonds constituaient 4.1 p. 100 de l'accroissement et les autres revenus, 17.6 p. 100.

Passif du fonds de l'installation matérielle

L'élément le plus important du passif du fonds de l'installation matérielle des hôpitaux généraux en 1966 était la dette obligataire non échue émise par les hôpitaux (42.5 p. 100) et par les municipalités (14.3 p. 100); le passif comprenait aussi les autres dettes à longue échéance (19.2 p. 100), les comptes et les billets dus (10.4 p. 100) et les sommes dues à d'autres fonds (4.5 p. 100); voir le Graphique 13 qui couvre la période de 1961 à 1966.

Fonds de dotation

En 1966, le fonds de dotation des hôpitaux généraux publics atteignait 87.6 millions de dollars, dont la plus grande partie (86.4 p. 100) était des obligations garanties et non garanties (67.8 p. 100), des actions (9.2 p. 100), des hypothèques (2 p. 100) et d'autres placements (7.4 p. 100). Les avoirs en propriétés immobilières et les montants à percevoir d'autres fonds formaient chacun 4.1 p. 100 du fonds, et l'encaisse et les comptes en banque, 3.9 p. 100 (tableau 10, graphique 14). Le passif atteignait 3.9 millions de dollars dont la plus grande partie était constituée par le montant à verser à d'autres fonds (62.3 p. 100); la somme à verser au fonds d'administration générale s'élevait à 8.1 p. 100 du passif.
