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PREFACE

A wide range of hospital statistics relating to facilities available, services provided, personnel employed, training facilities and finances of general and allied special hospitals, mental institutions and tuberculosis sanatoria in Canada are produced by the Institutions Section of the Health and Welfare Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. A series of eleven annual reports are published to convey to the user the statistics collected.

Statistics on hospitals have been compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics since 1931 and since then have been published in varying degrees of detail. The current list of annual publications is as follows:

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
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HOSPITAL CLASSIFICATION CHART, 1967

GLOSSARY

Hospital

An institution which is operated for the medical, surgical and/or obstetrical care of inpatients, and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by the federal and/or a provincial government, or by a municipality duly authorized under the laws of the province. Specifically excluded are institutions primarily for tuberculosis, mental diseases and mental defect.

Public Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "public hospital" which is not operated for profit and accepts all patients regardless of ability to pay.

General Hospital

A hospital which provides for the treatment and care of all types of diseases or at least a wide range of conditions.

Chronic – Convalescent – Rehabilitation Hospitals

Hospitals which primarily provide for the treatment of conditions requiring long-term care, or for the treatment of patients who are considered to be in the recovery stage of an illness, especially where this is a long-term process and for those patients who are being rehabilitated.

Other Hospital

A hospital which primarily provides for the treatment of a particular type of disease, condition or case such as maternity, communicable disease, orthopaedic, neurological and cancer; or a hospital which provides a combination of various types of service which cannot be classified into chronic, convalescent or rehabilitation.

Allied Special Hospitals

Includes chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation and "other" hospitals.

Revenue Fund

The Revenue Fund is used to record activities associated with the day-to-day operations of the hospital in providing services to patients.

Estimated Year-end Adjustment

The amount due to or from the Provincial Plan of the province and other agencies with respect to the adjustment of a surplus or deficit incurred during the year.

Plant Fund

The Plant Fund is used primarily to record transactions relating to property which is long-lasting as well as long-term liabilities relating thereto.

TERMINOLOGIE

Hôpital

Établissement donnant des soins médicaux, chirurgicaux ou obstétriques aux hospitalisés et détenant un permis ou une approbation du gouvernement fédéral ou provincial ou d'une municipalité autorisée par la province à le faire. Sont exclues, les établissements destinés avant tout à la tuberculose, aux maladies mentales et à la déficience mentale.

Hôpital public

Hôpital reconnu comme tel par la province et établi dans un but non lucratif; il accepte tous les malades sans égard à leur capacité de payer.

Hôpital général

Hôpital qui traite toutes sortes de maladies ou, au moins, un grand nombre d'états pathologiques.

Établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence et de réadaptation

Hôpitaux qui traitent, avant tout, des états requérant des soins de longue durée, ou les malades qui relèvent d'une maladie, surtout de longue durée, ou qui ont besoin de réadaptation.

Autres hôpitaux

Hôpitaux qui se spécialisent dans le traitement de maladies, d'états pathologiques ou de cas d'un genre particulier, notamment maternité, maladies contagieuses, orthopédie, neurologie, cancer; ce sont encore les hôpitaux à affectations diverses qui ne peuvent être classés parmi les hôpitaux généraux, les hôpitaux de maladies chroniques, les maisons de convalescence ou de réadaptation.

Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Ces hôpitaux comprennent les établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence, de réadaptation et les hôpitaux divers.

Fonds des installations

Le Fonds des installations énumère en particulier les transactions immobilières à longue échéance et les exigibilités à long terme qui en résultent.

Estimation de l'ajustement de fin d'année

Le montant dû à ou au régime d'assurance-hospitalisation de la province et des autres organismes ou à en recevoir, en ce qui trait à l'ajustement du surplus ou du déficit au cours de l'année.

Fonds d'administration générale

Le Fonds d'exploitation générale énumère les activités journalières de l'établissement hospitalier exigées par les soins à donner aux malades.

Buildings and building service equipment.—Includes all structures owned by the hospital and used in carrying out normal functions, as well as equipment added, to heat, light, ventilate or otherwise make serviceable.

Major equipment.—Includes hospital equipment, other than building service equipment, which has an estimated useful life of 5 years or more and is usually moveable rather than affixed.

Minor equipment.—Includes hospital equipment, with an estimated life of not more than 5 years, usually small in size, numerous in quantity, relatively low unit cost and no fixed location.

Depreciation Fund.—Cash and investments held in the Plant Fund as the result of the funding of the Reserve for Depreciation.

Sinking Fund.—Cash or investments, including bonds, debentures and stocks, held for the purpose of retiring a bond issue at some future date.

Improvement and replacement Fund.—Cash or investments set aside for extensions, improvements, or replacement of building, equipment and other plant assets.

Endowment Fund

The Endowment Fund is used to record transactions relating to special gifts and bequests to the hospital.

Bâtiments et matériel fixe.—Comprend l'ensemble des bâtiments que possède l'hôpital et qui servent aux fonctions régulières de celui-ci, de même que le matériel ajouté au chauffage, à l'éclairage et à la ventilation, ou mis en service de quelque manière.

Gros matériel.—Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital autre que le matériel fixe, dont la durée estimative de service est de cinq ans ou plus et qui est habituellement amovible plutôt que fixe.

Petit matériel.—Comprend le matériel de l'hôpital dont la durée estimative de service ne dépasse pas cinq ans, dont la taille est ordinairement petite, la quantité grande, le prix unitaire modique et qui n'a pas d'emplacement fixe.

**Fond d'amortissement de l'installation matériel-
le.**—Encaises et placements conservées dans le fonds d'immobilisation comme résultat de la consolidation de la réserve pour dépréciation.

Fonds de remboursement de la dette.—Comprend tout solde en argent et la valeur des placements du fonds de remboursement de la dette, y compris les obligations et (ou) actions conservées en vue de racheter plus tard une émission d'obligations.

Fonds d'amélioration et de renouvellement.—Comprend tout solde en argent et la valeur des placements (obligations et (ou) actions) mis en réserve pour les rajouts, les améliorations et le remplacement de bâtiments, de matériel ou autre actif du fonds d'immobilisations.

Fonds de dotation

Le Fonds de dotation note en particulier les opérations relatives aux dons et legs reçus par l'hôpital.

INTRODUCTION

This report is concerned with balance sheet data pertaining to public general and allied special hospitals for the reporting year 1967. Certain of these hospitals which provide "composite" services combining hospital and non-hospital functions which cannot be represented by separate accounts are excluded from the report along with all private and federal hospitals, mental institutions and tuberculosis sanatoria.

Most hospitals use the Canadian Hospital Association system of fund accounting, separating the balance sheets into the Revenue Fund, the Plant Fund and the Endowment Fund. Hospitals record their balance sheet data on the reporting form Annual Return of Hospitals - Part II (Finances). These documents, which come to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics via the hospital insurance authorities in each province, are the principal source of the data presented herein.

This report contains Revenue Fund balance sheet data for 946 (91.3 per cent), of the 1,036 public general and allied special hospitals which were in operation in 1967, Plant Fund data for 939 of the hospitals (90.6 per cent) and Endowment Fund data for 211 hospitals (20.4 per cent). Total reported assets of these three Funds combined stood at \$2,477 million in 1967 with the Plant Fund accounting for \$2,174 million followed by the Revenue Fund with \$204 million and the Endowment Fund \$99 million. Current and long-term liabilities amounted to \$878 million exclusive of balance of Fund (capital) of \$1,599 million (Table 1).

Revenue Fund

Accounts and Notes Receivable

Accounts and notes receivable reported by public general hospitals in 1967 amounted to \$78.6 million or 41.3 per cent of the Revenue Fund assets of these hospitals (39.0 per cent in 1966), comprising amounts due from Provincial Plan (20.7 per cent), from patients (17.4 per cent) and from sundry sources (3.2 per cent) (Table 2). Table 4 records the broad regional variations in these proportions as illustrated in Chart 1, showing that the amount due from Provincial Plans ranged from 0.1 per cent of total assets in Saskatchewan to 36.0 per cent in Ontario, while the amount due from patients went from 8.3 per cent of total assets in Saskatchewan to 24.3 per cent in British Columbia. Chart 2 demonstrates the extent to which accounts and notes receivable varied directly with hospital size in 1967, increasing from 9.8 per cent of total Revenue Fund assets in the 1-9 bed hospitals to 64.0 per cent of total assets in the 1,000 and over bed hospitals.

Le présent bulletin traite des données présentées dans les bilans de l'année de déclaration 1967 préparés par les hôpitaux généraux ou spéciaux divers à caractère public. Le bulletin ne tient pas compte des hôpitaux dont l'activité est "général", c'est-à-dire qui remplissent des fonctions hospitalières et non hospitalières qui ne peuvent figurer séparément dans les comptes. Sont également exclus les hôpitaux privés et fédéraux, ainsi que les établissements psychiatriques et les sanatoriums pour tuberculeux.

La plupart des hôpitaux emploient la méthode de comptabilisation des fonds de l'Association des hôpitaux du Canada, méthode suivant laquelle les bilans sont répartis en fonds d'administration générale, fonds des installations et fonds de dotation. Les hôpitaux déclarent les données tirées de leurs bilans sur la formule Rapport annuel des hôpitaux, Partie II (Finances). Ces documents, qui parviennent au B.F.S. par l'entremise des autorités de l'assurance-hospitalisation de chaque province, constituent la principale source des données du présent bulletin.

Le présent bulletin renferme les données des bilans sur le fonds d'administration générale de 946 (91.3 p. 100) hôpitaux généraux ou spéciaux divers sur les 1,036 ouverts au public en 1967, ainsi que des chiffres sur le fonds des installations de 939 (90.6 p. 100) et sur le fonds de dotation de 211 (20.4 p. 100) de ces hôpitaux. La totalité de l'actif déclaré des trois fonds réunis s'élevait à 2,477 millions de dollars en 1967 et se répartissait comme il suit: fonds des installations, 2,174 millions; fonds d'administration générale, 204 millions; fonds de dotation 99 millions. Le passif à court et à long terme a formé un total de 878 millions de dollars sans tenir compte du solde des fonds (capital) de 1,599 millions (Tableau 1).

Fonds d'administration générale

Sommes et effets à recevoir

En 1967, les comptes et effets à recevoir déclarés par les hôpitaux généraux publics ont atteint le total de 78.6 millions de dollars, soit 41.3 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale de ces établissements, contre 39 p. 100 en 1966. Ils comprenaient les sommes dues dans le cadre des régimes provinciaux d'assurance-hospitalisation (20.7 p. 100), les créances dues par les malades (17.4 p. 100) et les montants à venir de sources diverses (3.2 p. 100) (Tableau 2). Le Tableau 4 montre que ces proportions variaient beaucoup d'une région à l'autre (voir le Graphique 1), que les sommes dues dans le cadre des régimes provinciaux d'assurance-hospitalisation variaient entre 0.1 p. 100 de l'actif global (Saskatchewan) et 36 p. 100 (Ontario) et que les créances dues par les malades allaient de 8.3 p. 100 de l'actif global (Saskatchewan) à 24.3 p. 100 (Colombie-Britannique). Le Graphique 2 montre l'ampleur de la variation des sommes et effets à recevoir en fonction de la taille des hôpitaux en 1967, ce poste allant en augmentant depuis 9.8 p. 100 de l'actif global du fonds d'administration générale pour les hôpitaux de 1 à 9 lits jusqu'à 64 p. 100 de l'actif global pour les hôpitaux de 1,000 lits et plus.




Inventory of Supplies

Inventory of supplies totalled \$40.5 million in reporting public general hospitals in 1967, representing 21.3 per cent of total Revenue Fund assets. Approximately 28.0 per cent of Revenue Fund assets in the 10-99 bed range were allotted to inventories. This ratio then decreased with bed size to about 19.0 per cent of total assets for hospitals of over 300 beds (Table 4, Chart 2). In the provinces, inventory of supplies varied from 18.0 per cent of total assets in Ontario to 46.2 per cent in Newfoundland (Chart 3). Inventory of supplies per rated bed rose by 4.6 per cent in public general hospitals from \$373 in 1966 to \$391 in 1967 and varied inversely with bed size from \$508 in the 1-9 bed hospitals to \$356 in the 300-499 bed group (Chart 4). In the provinces, inventory of supplies per rated bed in public general hospitals was lowest in Prince Edward Island (\$298) and highest in Newfoundland (\$537) (Table 7).

Other Revenue Fund Assets

Cash on hand and in the bank amounted to 9.5 per cent of Revenue Fund assets in public general hospitals in 1967 and was inversely related to hospital size, declining steadily with the exception of the 200-299 bed group, from 26.3 per cent of assets in the 1-9 bed hospitals to 5.5 per cent in hospitals of 1,000 beds or more (Chart 2). Other assets included temporary investments (6.8 per cent) and due from other Funds (11.9 per cent) (Chart 5).

Revenue Fund Liabilities

Amounts due to other Funds constituted \$117.1 million or 43.3 per cent of the Revenue Fund liabilities of public general hospitals in 1967 (Chart 6). Accounts payable represented an additional 23.7 per cent of liabilities followed by bank loans and overdrafts (9.4 per cent), accrued liabilities (6.5 per cent), notes payable (3.4 per cent) and Provincial Plan (1.7 per cent). Accrued liabilities and accounts payable as a proportion of Revenue Fund liabilities tend to rise with hospital size whereas the other liabilities do not appear to be overly affected by size of hospital (Table 4).

Revenue Fund liabilities of public general hospitals exceeded assets by 42.3 per cent in 1967 (47.6 per cent in 1966). On the whole, hospitals of under 25 beds and hospitals in the 50-99 bed group had credit balances, ranging from 1.9 per cent in the 50-99 bed group to 61.3 per cent in the 1-9 bed hospitals, while debit balances ranged from 3.9 per cent in the 25-49 bed group to 70.7 per cent in the 200-299 bed group (Chart 7). Provincially, credit balances ranged from 23.1 per cent in British Columbia to 41.3 per cent in Manitoba and debit balances ranged from 2.2 per cent in Ontario to 227.5 per cent in Newfoundland.

Stocks de fournitures

L'inventaire de fournitures des hôpitaux généraux publics s'est élevé à 40.5 millions de dollars en 1967, soit 21.3 p. 100 de l'actif global du fonds d'administration générale. Environ 28 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale des hôpitaux de 10 à 99 lits ont été affectés aux stocks. Cette proportion diminue à mesure que la taille de l'hôpital augmente pour s'établir à 19 p. 100 de l'actif global pour les hôpitaux de plus de 300 lits (Tableau 4, Graphique 2). Pour ce qui est des provinces, la valeur des stocks a varié entre 18 p. 100 de l'actif global en Ontario et 46.2 p. 100 à Terre-Neuve (Graphique 3). La valeur des stocks par lit (capacité théorique) s'est accrue de 4.6 p. 100 dans les hôpitaux généraux publics (\$391 en 1967 contre \$373 en 1966) et a été inversement proportionnelle à la taille de l'hôpital, tombant de \$508 pour les établissements de 1 à 9 lits à \$356 pour ceux de 300 à 499 lits (Graphique 4). L'inventaire de fournitures par lit (capacité théorique) d'hôpital général public le moins élevé (\$298) a été enregistré dans l'Île-du-Prince-Édouard et le plus élevé (537) à Terre-Neuve (Tableau 7).

Autres éléments d'actif du fonds d'administration générale

En 1967, l'argent en caisse et en banque représentaient 9.5 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds d'administration générale des hôpitaux généraux publics et ce montant était inversement proportionnel à la taille de l'hôpital. En effet, on note que le montant suit une courbe décroissante régulière, (les hôpitaux de 200 à 299 lits mis à part) depuis 26.3 p. 100 de l'actif pour les établissements de 1 à 9 lits jusqu'à 5.5 p. 100 pour ceux de 1,000 lits ou plus (Graphique 2). Parmi les autres éléments d'actif, il y avait les placements provisoires (6.8 p. 100) et les sommes à recevoir d'autres fonds (11.9 p. 100) (Graphique 5).

Passif du fonds d'administration générale

En 1967, les sommes à virer sur d'autres fonds formaient un total de 117.1 millions de dollars, soit 43.3 p. 100 du passif du fonds d'administration générale des hôpitaux généraux publics (Graphique 6). Les comptes à payer représentaient 23.7 p. 100 du passif, suivis des emprunts bancaires et les découverts (9.4 p. 100), des charges à payer (6.5 p. 100), des effets à payer (3.4 p. 100) et des sommes dues aux caisses d'assurance-hospitalisation (1.7 p. 100). Les charges à payer et les comptes à payer considérés comme une proportion du passif du fonds d'administration générale tendent à augmenter à mesure que la taille de l'hôpital augmente alors que les autres éléments de passif ne semblent pas trop dépendre de l'importance de l'établissement (Tableau 4).

En 1967, le passif du fonds d'administration générale des hôpitaux généraux publics était de 42.3 p. 100 supérieur à l'actif, contre 47.6 p. 100 en 1966. Dans l'ensemble, les hôpitaux de moins de 25 lits et ceux de 50 à 99 lits avaient un solde créditeur variant de 1.9 p. 100 pour les établissements de 50 à 99 lits à 61.3 p. 100 pour ceux de 1 à 9 lits, alors que le solde débiteur allait de 3.9 p. 100 pour les hôpitaux de 25 à 49 lits à 70.7 p. 100 pour ceux de 200 à 299 lits (Graphique 7). Sur le plan provincial, le solde créditeur variait entre 23.1 p. 100 (Colombie-Britannique) et 41.3 p. 100 (Manitoba) et le solde débiteur, entre 2.2 p. 100 (Ontario) et 227.5 p. 100 (Terre-Neuve).










Plant Fund**Buildings and Building Service Equipment**

In public general hospitals, buildings and building service equipment (less depreciation) totalled \$1,308.2 million or 64.8 per cent of Plant Fund assets in 1967 as compared to 65.4 per cent in 1966 (Statement 1, Chart 8). There were \$121 million of assets in the form of buildings and building service equipment added to public general hospitals in 1967 (Table 6). These assets added amounted to 7.6 per cent of the balance at year end in this section of the Plant Fund, ranging from 1.9 per cent in the 500-999 bed group to 12.1 per cent in the 200-299 bed group (Chart 10).

Major Equipment

Major equipment (less reserve for depreciation) came to \$238.7 million or 11.8 per cent of the Plant Fund assets of public general hospitals in 1967, ranging from 10.8 per cent of assets in the 500-999 bed group to 15.4 per cent in the 1,000 and over bed group (Chart 9). In 1967, some \$48.6 million of assets in the form of major equipment were added to public general hospitals, amounting to 10.9 per cent of the balance at year end and ranging from 7.8 per cent of the balance in the 10-24 and 1,000 and over bed groups to 14.4 per cent in the 200-299 bed group (Chart 10).

Construction in Progress

Construction in progress as reported by 162 public general hospital in 1967 totalled \$110.2 million or 5.5 per cent of Plant Fund assets and varied from 0.7 per cent of total assets in the 1,000 and over bed group to 9.1 per cent in the 300-499 bed group. Chart 11 shows that construction in progress as a proportion of Plant Fund assets has declined from 8.6 per cent of total assets in 1962. While hospital construction is a random occurrence, the bed group comparisons of Chart 11 nevertheless are useful in that they provide some insight as to the make up of the Plant Fund balance sheet at a given point in time.

Other Plant Fund Assets

In public general hospitals the amount of Plant Fund assets due from the Revenue Fund declined from 6.1 per cent of Plant Fund assets in 1966 to 5.8 per cent in 1967 (Table 5). Land was valued at 2.2 per cent of total assets (2.0 per cent in 1966). Some \$1.5 million of assets in the form of land improvements were added to public general hospitals in 1967. The assets added amounted to 22.4 per cent of the balance at year end and ranged from 10.5 per cent of the balance in the 500-999 bed group to 42.6 per cent in the 200-299 bed group (Chart 10).

Fonds des installations**Bâtiments et matériel fixe**

Les bâtiments et matériel fixe (nets d'amortissements) des hôpitaux généraux publics avaient, en 1967, une valeur globale de 1,308.2 millions de dollars, soit 64.8 p. 100 du fonds des installations, contre 65.4 p. 100 en 1966 (État 1, Graphique 8). L'augmentation de l'actif sous forme de bâtiments et matériel fixe a été de 121 millions de dollars en 1967 (Tableau 6). Cette augmentation de l'actif équivalait à 7.6 p. 100 du solde de fin d'année de cet élément du fonds des installations; elle allait de 1.9 p. 100 dans le cas des hôpitaux de 500 à 999 lits à 12.1 p. 100 dans le cas de ceux de 200 à 299 lits (Graphique 10).

Gros matériel

La valeur du gros matériel (nette d'amortissements) s'élevait, en 1967, à 238.7 millions de dollars soit 11.8 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds des installations des hôpitaux généraux publics, ce qui représentait de 10.8 p. 100 de l'actif (établissements de 500 à 999 lits) à 15.4 p. 100 de l'actif (établissements de 1,000 lits ou plus) (Graphique 9). En 1967, les hôpitaux généraux publics ont ajouté quelque 48.6 millions de dollars à leur actif sous forme de gros matériel, soit 10.9 p. 100 du solde de fin d'année, ce qui représente de 7.8 p. 100 du solde (hôpitaux de 10 à 24 lits et de 1,000 lits ou plus) à 14.4 p. 100 du solde (établissements de 200 à 299 lits) (Graphique 10).

Construction en cours

D'après les déclarations de 162 hôpitaux généraux publics la valeur de la construction en cours en 1967 était de 110.2 millions de dollars, soit 5.5 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds des installations, le pourcentage variant de 0.7 p. 100 de l'actif global pour les établissements de 1,000 lits et plus à 9.1 p. 100 pour ceux de 300 à 499 lits. Le Graphique 11 indique que la construction en cours, exprimée en pourcentage de l'actif des installations, a diminué par rapport à 1962, année où elle représentait 8.6 p. 100 de l'actif global. Si la construction d'hôpitaux est une activité sporadique, il reste que la comparaison des divers groupes de taille d'hôpitaux présentée dans le Graphique 11 est utile puisqu'elle permet de mieux comprendre ce qui constitue, à une date déterminée, le bilan du fonds des installations.

Autres éléments d'actif du fonds des installations

Dans les hôpitaux généraux, le montant de l'actif du fonds des installations à recevoir du fonds d'administration générale est tombé de 6.1 p. 100 de l'actif du fonds des installations en 1966 à 5.8 p. 100 en 1967 (Tableau 5). Les terrains constituaient 2.2 p. 100 de l'actif global contre 2.0 p. 100 en 1966. En 1967, les hôpitaux généraux publics ont ajouté à leur actif environ 1.5 million de dollars sous forme d'améliorations de terrains. L'augmentation de l'actif équivalait à 22.4 p. 100 du solde de fin d'année, allant de 10.5 p. 100 du solde pour les hôpitaux de 500 à 999 lits et 42.6 p. 100 pour les établissements de 200 à 299 lits (Graphique 10).

HÔPITAUX PUBLICS GÉNÉRAUX, 1967




HÔPITAUX GÉNÉRAUX PUBLICS, 1962-1967





Increase in Plant Capital

Federal, provincial and municipal government grants were the source of 72.5 per cent of the \$143 million of funds provided for increase in plant capital of public general hospitals in 1967, comprising grants for land buildings and equipment (57.2 per cent) and for debt retirement (15.3 per cent) (Table 9, Chart 12). Appropriations from other Funds accounted for an additional 13.8 per cent of total funds and other income made up the remaining 13.7 per cent.

Plant Fund Liabilities

In 1967, bonded debt not due issued by hospitals made up 50.0 per cent of Plant Fund liabilities in public general hospitals and bonded debt not due issued by municipalities accounted for an additional 7.2 per cent, followed by other long-term debt (20.3 per cent), accounts and notes payable (9.0 per cent) and due to other Funds (4.4 per cent) (Chart 13).

Endowment Fund

Endowment Fund assets as reported by 190 public general hospitals in 1967 totalled \$92.3 million, 87.7 per cent of which were investments comprised of bonds and debentures (69.4 per cent), stocks (8.3 per cent), real estate mortgages (2.2 per cent) and other investments (7.8 per cent). Other assets included cash and bank accounts (3.8 per cent), due from other Funds (3.6 per cent), and real estate holdings (3.3 per cent) (Table 10, Chart 14). Endowment Fund liabilities of public general hospitals amounted to almost \$5 million in 1967 and were mainly constituted of amounts due to other Funds (85.6 per cent) and due to Revenue Fund (7.4 per cent).

Augmentation du capital du fonds des installations

Les subventions fédérales, provinciales et municipales ont constitué la source de 72.5 p. 100 des fonds d'une valeur de 143 millions de dollars affectés à l'augmentation du capital du fonds des installations des hôpitaux généraux publics en 1967. Ce montant comprenait des subventions pour les terrains, bâtiments et matériel (57.2 p. 100) et pour le remboursement de la dette (15.3 p. 100) (Tableau 9, Graphique 12), des sommes affectées provenant d'autres fonds (13.8 p. 100) et d'autres revenus (13.7 p. 100).

Passif du fonds des installations

En 1967, la dette d'obligations non échues émises par les hôpitaux formait 50 p. 100 du passif du fonds des installations des hôpitaux généraux publics, la dette d'obligations non échues émises par les municipalités, 7.2 p. 100, d'autres dettes à long terme, 20.3 p. 100, comptes et effets à payer, 9.0 p. 100 et sommes à virer sur d'autres fonds, 4.4 p. 100 (Graphique 13).

Fonds de dotation

En 1967, 190 hôpitaux généraux publics ont déclaré un actif global de 92.3 millions de dollars sous forme de fonds de dotation, dont 87.7 p. 100 étaient des placements dans des obligations (69.4 p. 100), des actions (8.3 p. 100), des hypothèques (2.2 p. 100) et d'autres valeurs (7.8 p. 100). Parmi les autres éléments d'actif, il y avait l'argent en caisse et en banque (3.8 p. 100), les sommes à recevoir d'autres fonds (3.6 p. 100) et les propriétés (3.3 p. 100) (Tableau 10, Graphique 14). En 1967, le passif du fonds de dotation des hôpitaux généraux publics s'élevait à près de 5 millions de dollars et comprenait surtout les sommes à virer sur d'autres fonds (85.6 p. 100) et sur le fonds d'administration générale (7.4 p. 100).







