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

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## PREFACE

Hospital statistics have been collected on a continuing basis by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics since 1931. Throughout the years a number of changes have been made in both the reporting forms and the type of presentation—particularly for the years 1952, 1959 and 1961. The 1962 series of publications follows closely the pattern developed in 1961, with the Preliminary Annual Report and the analytic volumes dealing with particular aspects of hospitals as follows:

Volume III—Hospital Personnel	
Volume IV—Balance Sheet	
Volume V—Hospital Revenues	
Volume VI—Hospital Expenditures	
Volume VII—Hospital Indicators	
Preliminary Annual Report	

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Further refinements in Hospital Indicators have been made for the year 1962 based upon experience gained and comments received on the 1961 publication. The provision of quartiles, and minimum and maximum values should be of value to those who wish to further evaluate the distribution for each indicator by type of hospital.

The advice and assistance of a number of individuals and groups in the hospital field is gratefully acknowledged. The work of the individual hospital in preparing their data for inclusion in a national statistical program, and the cooperation of the provincial hospital plan authorities in the collection of this data deserves a special mention. Uniform accounting and recording has been promoted by various provincial hospital associations and the Canadian Hospital Association and consequently has been most beneficial to the hospital statistics program of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

This report was prepared in the Institutions Section of the Health and Welfare Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

## PRÉFACE

Le Bureau fédéral de la statistique n'a cessé, depuis 1931, de recueillir des statistiques hospitalières. Au cours des années, plusieurs changements ont été apportés aux formules de déclaration et au mode de présentation, particulièrement en 1952, 1959 et 1961. La série de publications de 1962 suit de près les traces de celle de 1961; aussi, le rapport annuel préliminaire et les volumes analytiques se répartissent-ils les divers aspects du domaine hospitalier de la façon suivante:

Grâce à l'expérience acquise et aux commentaires reçus lors de l'édition de 1961, nous avons procédé à de nouvelles précisions sur les indicateurs hospitaliers pour 1962. 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## GLOSSARY

### Hospital

An institution which is operated for the medical, surgical and/or obstetrical care of inpatients, and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by the federal and/or a provincial government, or by a municipality duly authorized under the laws of the province. Specifically excluded are institutions primarily for tuberculosis, mental disease, and mental defect.

### Public Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "public hospital" which is not operated for profit and accepts all patients regardless of ability to pay.

### General Hospital

A hospital which provides for the treatment and care of all types of diseases or at least a wide range of conditions.

### Chronic, Convalescent, Rehabilitation Hospitals

Hospitals which primarily provide for the treatment of conditions requiring long-term care, or for the treatment of patients who are considered to be in the recovery stage of an illness, especially where this is a long-term process and for those patients who are being rehabilitated.

### Maternity Hospital

A hospital which primarily provides for the treatment and care of obstetrical patients and newborn infants.

### Other Hospital

A hospital which primarily provides for the treatment of a particular type of disease, condition or case; example, rehabilitation, geriatric, communicable disease, orthopaedic, neurological, and cancer; or a hospital which provides a combination of various types of service which cannot be classified into chronic, convalescent or maternity.

### Allied Special Hospitals

Includes chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation, maternity and "other" hospitals.

### In-patient

A patient who is duly admitted to the hospital and to whom a bed or bassinet has been allocated. (This category excludes stillbirths as well as patients attending a day or night centre attached to the hospital.)

**Adults and Children.**—All in-patients except newborn.

## TERMINOLOGIE

### Hôpital

Établissement donnant des soins médicaux, chirurgicaux ou obstétriques aux hospitalisés et détenant un permis ou une approbation du gouvernement fédéral ou provincial ou d'une municipalité autorisée par la province à le faire. Sont exclues, les établissements destinés avant tout à la tuberculose, aux maladies mentales et à la déficience mentale.

### Hôpital public

Hôpital reconnu comme tel par la province et établi dans un but non lucratif; il accepte tous les malades sans égard à leur capacité de payer.

### Hôpital général

Hôpital qui traite toutes sortes de maladies ou, au moins, un grand nombre d'états pathologiques.

### Établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence et de réadaptation

Hôpitaux qui traitent, avant tout, des états requérant des soins de longue durée, ou les malades qui relèvent d'une maladie, surtout de longue durée, ou qui ont besoin de réadaptation.

### Maternité

Hôpital destiné avant tout aux soins obstétriques ainsi qu'à ceux des nouveau-nés.

### Hôpitaux divers

Hôpitaux destinés surtout au traitement d'états pathologiques particuliers ou de cas particuliers de maladie, comme gériatrie, maladie contagieuse, orthopédie, neurologie et cancer; c'est encore un hôpital qui a plusieurs affectations diverses ne pouvant être classées à "maladies chroniques", "convalescence" ou "maternité".

### Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Ces hôpitaux comprennent les établissements de maladies chroniques, de convalescence et de réadaptation, les maternités et les hôpitaux divers.

### Hospitalisé

Malade qui a été dûment admis à l'hôpital et auquel on a affecté un lit ou un berceau. (Sont exclus, les mort-nés aussi bien que les malades du centre diurne ou nocturne de l'hôpital.)

**Adultes et enfants.**—Tous les hospitalisés, sauf les nouveau-nés.

**Newborn.**—An infant in-patient born alive in the hospital and remaining as such during the period of his stay for which newborn rates are charged.

#### Patient-day

The period of service to an in-patient between the census-taking hours on two successive days; the day of admission is counted as a patient-day but the day of separation is not.

#### Revenue Fund

The Revenue Fund is set up to record monetary activities associated with the day-to-day operations of the hospital in providing services to patients. It is sometimes called the Operating Fund.

#### Revenue Fund Income

Revenue Fund income is all revenue (whether or not actually received) that accrues during the year for the purpose of operation and maintenance of the hospital.

#### Gross Earnings

Gross earnings are the amounts earned by the rendering of services to patients. These amounts are represented by the regular rates charged for such services, regardless of the terms of any contract, agreement, or understanding as to the basis of rates to be paid.

#### Net Earnings

Net earnings comprise the difference between gross earnings and deductions such as rebates, courtesy, and free service, and bad debts, less recoveries.

#### General Services

General services include the accommodation and meals, at the standard ward level, routine nursing care, and all of the special services provided to in-patients, such as the use of the operating and delivery rooms, laboratory and radiology services, etc., for which the hospital charges to the agency or category of persons responsible for payment of the basic inclusive daily rates.

#### Additional Services

Additional services include all services extended over and above standard ward care, mainly the differential to private and semi-private accommodation, non-benefit drugs and ambulance service.

**Nouveau-né.**—Bébé né vivant à l'hôpital et y demeurant au cours d'une période pour laquelle on débite le tarif affecté aux nouveau-nés.

#### Journée d'hospitalisation

La période de soins à un hospitalisé entre les heures de relevé de deux jours successifs; le jour d'admission compte pour une journée d'hospitalisation, mais non le jour de radiation.

#### Fonds d'administration générale

Le fonds d'administration générale sert à enregistrer les opérations financières quotidiennes de l'hôpital relativement aux soins fournis aux malades. Ce fonds s'appelait autrefois le fonds de revenu.

#### Revenus du fonds d'administration générale

Ce sont tous les revenus (perçus ou non), accumulés durant l'année et servant au fonctionnement et à l'entretien de l'hôpital.

#### Revenus bruts

Sommes acquises par suite de soins aux malades. Ces sommes sont calculées suivant le tarif ordinaire de tels soins, sans égard aux stipulations d'un contrat, d'une entente ou d'un accord quant au tarif à exiger.

#### Revenus nets

Les revenus nets sont la différence entre les déductions, telles que rabais, faveurs, soins gratuits et mauvaises créances, moins les recouvrements.

#### Soins généraux

Les soins généraux comprennent le logement et les repas, au prix de la salle commune, les soins infirmiers ordinaires et tous les soins spéciaux fournis aux hospitalisés,—comme l'usage des salles d'opération et d'accouchement, ainsi que du laboratoire et du service de radiologie, etc.—que l'hôpital débite au tarif de base à l'organisme ou aux personnes responsables du paiement.

#### Soins supplémentaires

Ces soins englobent tous ceux qui n'entrent pas dans la catégorie des soins ordinaires de salle, surtout les suppléments pour chambres privées ou semi-privées, les médicaments non assurés et le service d'ambulance.

**Grants**

These are monies received by the hospital from other than private sources, for revenue fund purposes only, such as maintenance services, covering operating deficit and carrying special research projects. These grants are in addition to and must be distinguished from any earnings derived from provincial plans or government departments to pay for the care of patients.

**Other Revenue Fund Income**

This includes investment income, contributed services of personnel, rentals, or discounts and purchases, recoveries and sales, provided from ancillary operations, and other unallocated income.

**Authorized Charges**

An authorized charge is a per diem amount designated by a province to be charged to an insured in-patient for insured services at the standard ward level. This amount is in addition to the regular payment made by the Provincial Plan. Authorized charges apply only in British Columbia, Alberta, and the Northwest Territories.

**Subventions**

Sommes que l'hôpital a reçues d'autres sources que privées pour les seules fins du fonds d'administration générale, — comme soins d'entretien, — en vue de parer au déficit de gestion et d'effectuer des recherches spéciales. Ces subventions sont en sus et doivent être distinguées de toute recette provenant de régimes ou ministères provinciaux et destinée à payer le soin des malades.

**Revenus divers du fonds d'administration générale**

Sont compris ici, les revenus de placements, services gratuits du personnel, loyers, escomptes au comptant sur achats, recouvrements et ventes, revenus des exploitations auxiliaires et autres revenus non répartis.

**Frais autorisés**

Montants quotidiens destinés, par une province, à être débités, au tarif de salle commune, à un hospitalisé assuré pour des soins assurés. Cette somme vient en sus du paiement régulier fait par le régime provincial. Les frais autorisés ne s'appliquent qu'en Colombie-Britannique, en Alberta et dans les Territoires du Nord-Ouest.

## INTRODUCTION

This publication contains Revenue Fund income data of public general and allied special hospitals in Canada. Limited Revenue Fund data for mental hospitals and tuberculosis sanatoria are found in Table 1. Other Bureau publications<sup>1</sup> provide more financial detail of these types of hospitals.

Revenue Fund income information for public general and allied special hospitals was taken from the Annual Return of Hospitals, Part II, which were submitted by the individual hospitals through the provincial hospital authorities to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

Of the 964 hospitals operating in 1962 and expected to submit financial returns to the Bureau, 904 (93.8 per cent) did so, representing 96.1 per cent of the rated beds and 97.6 per cent (\$743,224,000) of the estimated total revenue fund income.

The estimated total revenue fund income in 1962 was \$761,232,000 or 13.4 per cent more than the year before. All provinces experienced greater income than in the previous year—Quebec's increase was the largest (22.2 per cent) while Newfoundland's was lowest (7.2 per cent).

### Revenue Fund Income by Type


Net earnings from services to in-patients were 88.2 per cent of Revenue Fund income—a bit higher than in 1961 (87.9 per cent). Other income, net earnings from services to out-patients, and grants were 5.3 per cent, 4.8 per cent and 1.7 per cent respectively. Net earnings from services to in-patients ranged from 80.5 per cent of the total Revenue Fund income in Prince Edward Island (81.7 per cent in New Brunswick) to 92.2 per cent in Alberta.

### Revenu du fonds d'administration générale, suivant le poste

Les revenus nets venant de soins aux hospitalisés constituaient 88.2 p. 100 du revenu du fonds d'administration générale,—soit un peu plus qu'en 1961 (87.9),—alors que les revenus divers, les revenus nets venant de soins aux malades externes et les subventions figuraient respectivement pour 5.3, 4.8 et 1.7 p. 100. Quant aux soins originant de soins aux hospitalisés, leur pourcentage a varié de 80.5 p. 100 en île-du-Prince-Édouard (81.7 au Nouveau-Brunswick) à 92.2 en Alberta.

Gross earnings (amount earned before deductions for rebates, courtesy and full service, and bad debts) reported by the 904 hospitals amounted to \$613,819,000, and produced a ratio of 1.005:1 when compared with net earnings. The Provincial Plan (hospital insurance plan authorities) was the source of revenue for 92.5 per cent of the gross earnings (93.4 per cent in 1961). Authorized charges (that portion of the inclusive rate which is payable by the patient or the Plan) were 1.2 per cent (1.3 in 1961) and were found only in Alberta, British Columbia and the Northwest Territories. Revenue from uninsured residents was 0.8 per cent, with Ontario, one of three provinces where a premium system for insurance payments was in operation, having the largest proportion at 1.7 per cent.

Les revenus bruts (sommes acquises avant déduction des rabais, faveurs, soins gratuits et mauvaises créances) ont été déclarés par 904 hôpitaux et leur total s'est établi à \$613,819,000 pour un rapport de 1.005:1 aux revenus nets. Les régimes provinciaux d'assurance-hospitalisation ont été la source de 92.5 p. 100 des revenus bruts (93.4 en 1961). Les frais autorisés (cette partie du coût de base payable par le malade ou le régime) se sont chiffrés par 1.2 p. 100 (1.3 en 1961) et ne se sont rencontrés qu'en Alberta, en Colombie-Britannique et dans les Territoires du Nord-Ouest. Les revenus provenant de résidents non assurés ont été de 0.8 p. 100, et c'est l'Ontario (l'une des trois provinces où existe un système de primes d'assurance) qui en a récolté la majeure partie (1.7 p. 100).

Gross earnings from additional services to in-patients (that amount over and above the basic inclusive rate because the patient desires preferred accommodation, or incurs non-benefit drug expense, or employs ambulance service) amounted to \$45,612,000. Only 776 (85.8 per cent of reporting hospitals) reported any income from this source. Preferred accommodation charges were 97.7 per cent of this total.

"Other" income—over \$39,000,000 and representing 5.3 per cent of the total reported revenue fund income, was mainly concerned with recoveries and sales (dietary, housing, and other). This represented 78.3 per cent of "other" income. Donations (7.2 per cent of "other" income) and investment income (6.0 per cent) were the next most significant items and were much higher proportionately in Quebec than any other province.

Les revenus bruts venant de soins supplémentaires aux hospitalisés (suppléments au taux collectif pour chambre privée ou semi-privée, pour médicaments non assurés ou pour ambulance) ont totalisé \$45,612,000. Seulement 776 hôpitaux (85.8 p. 100 des répondants) ont déclaré de ces revenus supplémentaires. Les frais de chambre privée ou semi-privée ont atteint 97.7 p. 100 de ce total.

Les revenus divers (plus de 39 millions et 5.3 p. 100 du revenu du fonds d'administration générale) figuraient surtout aux recouvrements et ventes (alimentation, logement et divers) dans une proportion de 78.3 p. 100. Les dons (7.2 p. 100 des revenus divers) et les revenus de placement (6 p. 100) étaient les deux autres postes les plus importants, et cette importance était proportionnellement plus grande au Québec que dans toute autre province.


