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GLOSSARY

Public Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "public hospital", generally not operated for profit and accepting all patients regardless of their ability to pay.

Private Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "private hospital", generally restricting its admissions to patients paying for care provided at rates determined by the management.

Federal Hospital

Owned and operated by the Government of Canada; usually operated by the Department of National Health and Welfare, Department of National Defence or Veterans Affairs.

General Hospital

Provides treatment and care for all types of diseases or at least a wide range of conditions.

Allied Special

Includes chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation and other (maternity, communicable disease, orthopaedic, cancer) hospitals.

Patient-day

The period of service to an in-patient between the census-taking hours on two successive days; the day of admission is counted as a patient-day but the day of separation is not.

Separation

The discharge or death of an in-patient.

Revenue Fund Income

All revenue (whether or not actually received) that accrues during the year for the purpose of operation and maintenance of the hospital.

Revenue Fund Expense

The cost, on an accrual basis, of operation and maintenance of the hospital during the year, regardless of the amounts of disbursements made.

Other Supplies and Expense

Departmental expenditure other than gross salaries and wages, medical and surgical supplies and drugs.

Other Revenue Fund Expense

Non-departmental expenditure such as interest on loans, depreciation, rentals and other miscellaneous expenses.

TERMINOLOGIE

Hôpital public

Reconnu comme tel par la province, généralement établi dans un but non lucratif et recevant tous les malades sans égard à leur capacité de payer.

Hôpital privé

Reconnu comme tel par la province et réservant d'ordinaire l'admission des malades à ceux qui paient pour les soins fournis suivant les taux déterminés par la direction.

Hôpital fédéral

Hôpital que possède et dirige le gouvernement fédéral, d'ordinaire géré par le ministère de la Santé nationale et du Bien-être social, ou le ministère de la Défense nationale, ou le ministère des Anciens combattants.

Hôpital général

Qui traite et soigne toutes sortes de maladies ou, au moins, un grand nombre d'états pathologiques.

Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Qui comprennent les hôpitaux de maladies chroniques, les maisons de convalescence, les hôpitaux de réadaptation et les autres hôpitaux (les maternités, maladies contagieuses, orthopédie, cancer).

Journée d'hospitalisation

Période de soins à un hospitalisé entre les heures de vérification de deux jours successifs; le jour d'admission compte comme une journée d'hospitalisation, mais non le jour de départ.

Départ

Sortie ou décès d'un hospitalisé.

Revenus du fonds d'administration générale

Tous les revenus (perçus ou non) accumulés durant l'année en vue du fonctionnement et de l'entretien de l'hôpital.

Dépenses du fonds d'administration générale

Le coût, sur une base d'exercice, du fonctionnement et de l'entretien de l'hôpital durant l'année, quel que soit le montant des déboursés effectués.

Autres fournitures et dépenses

Dépenses des services, autres que frais de rémunération, de fournitures chirurgicales et médicales et de médicaments.

Autres dépenses du fonds d'administration générale

Les dépenses non afférentes aux services, comme intérêts sur emprunts, amortissement, loyers et autres dépenses.

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INTRODUCTION

This preliminary report is the first to be published in the Institutions Section's Hospital Statistics series of publications for the reporting year 1967. The report contains an historical compendium of basic hospital data for the period 1962-1967 and, in summary form, preliminary data on the services, facilities and finances of Canadian general and allied special hospitals for 1967 as reported to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics by the individual hospitals on the reporting forms "Annual Return of Hospitals - Part I (Facilities and Services) and Part II (Finances)". Data pertaining to mental institutions and tuberculosis sanatoria are excluded from this publication.

Published data represent all operating general and allied special hospitals in regard to facilities and services and all public general and allied special hospitals in regard to finances. Estimates for non-coverage have been incorporated with the reported data, however, due to the preliminary nature of the report, there may be minor discrepancies in the final data which will appear in more detail in Volumes I to VII to be published later in the year. The complete series of Institutions Section annual publications is listed on the back cover of this Report.

Facilities and Services

There were 1,277 general and allied special hospitals in operation in Canada in 1967, an increase of 4 from 1966. Public hospitals numbered 1,035, private 166 and federal 76. Total rated bed capacity rose by 3.0 per cent from 136,900 in 1966 to 141,000 in 1967, amounting to 6.9 rated beds per 1,000 population as against 6.8 in 1966. Public hospitals accounted for 126,600 of these rated beds or 89.8 per cent of the total. Beds set up in operating hospitals numbered 140,976, a ratio of 1:1 with rated beds.

Percentage occupancy in public hospitals continued to decline in the sixties, dropping from 81.4 in 1966 to 79.7 in 1967 while total adult and child patient-days during the year rose by 2.5 per cent to 36,790,300 for an average daily patient load of 100,900. Provincial hospital insurance plans paid for 95.4 per cent of these patient-days in 1967 as against 94.9 per cent in 1966.

Le présent rapport préliminaire est le premier rapport de 1967 dans la série sur la statistique hospitalière de la Section des institutions. Il contient un recueil récapitulatif de données de base sur les hôpitaux pour la période de 1962 à 1967, ainsi qu'un résumé des statistiques préliminaires concernant les services, les installations et les finances des hôpitaux généraux et spéciaux divers du Canada en 1967, d'après les déclarations soumises au Bureau fédéral de la statistique par tous les hôpitaux dans le "Rapport annuel des hôpitaux - Partie I (Installations et services) et Partie II (Finances)". Les données relatives aux établissements pour malades mentaux et pour tuberculeux ne figurent pas ici.


Les renseignements publiés font état des installations et des services de tous les hôpitaux généraux et spéciaux divers en activité, de même que des finances de tous les hôpitaux publics généraux et spéciaux divers. Dans le cas des hôpitaux qui n'ont pas soumis de déclaration, des estimations complètent les données fournies; toutefois, vue la nature préliminaire du rapport, il pourra y avoir de légères divergences dans les données définitives que l'on publiera plus en détail dans les volumes I à VII qui doivent paraître plus tard cette année. La série complète des publications annuelles de la Section des institutions figure sur la couverture verso du présent rapport.

Installations et services

Il y avait au Canada, 1,277 hôpitaux généraux et spéciaux divers en activité en 1967, soit 4 de plus qu'en 1966. Les hôpitaux publics étaient au nombre de 1,035, les hôpitaux privés, de 166 et les hôpitaux fédéraux, de 76. La capacité théorique totale s'est accrue de 30 p. 100 en 1967, passant de 136,900 à 141,000 et elle représentait 6.9 lits pour 1,000 habitants, contre 6.8 l'année précédente. Les hôpitaux publics réunissaient 126,600 lits, soit 89.8 p. 100 du total. Le nombre de lits dressés dans les hôpitaux en activité atteignait 140,976, constituant un rapport de 1 à 1 avec le nombre théorique de lits.

Le taux d'occupation des hôpitaux publics a continué sa régression dans les années 1960, 79.7 p. 100 en 1967 à comparer à 81.4 p. 100 en 1966; par contre, le nombre total de journées d'hospitalisation d'adultes et d'enfants a augmenté de 2.5 p. 100, atteignant 36,790,300, ce qui donne une moyenne quotidienne de 100,900 malades. Les régimes provinciaux d'assurance-hospitalisation ont payé 95.4 p. 100 des journées d'hospitalisation en 1967 contre 94.9 p. 100 en 1966.

The average length of stay for adults and children in public hospitals dropped from 11.7 days in 1966 to 11.5 days in 1967 and for newborn remained constant from 1966 to 1967 at 6.8 days. Over the same period, separations for adults and children rose by 1.4 per cent to 3,085,700 while newborn separations fell by 3.6 per cent to 363,144.

In 1967, total employment in Canadian public hospitals rose by 7.4 per cent to an excess of 274,400 persons, of whom 87.3 per cent were employed on a full-time basis. Proportionately, part-time personnel increased at a greater rate (up 15.1 per cent from 1966) than full-time personnel (up 6.4 per cent). Nursing staff made up more than 55.0 per cent of both full and part-time personnel.

The average number of paid hours of work per patient-day of care in public hospitals rose from 13.4 in 1966 to 13.9 in 1967 with total nursing staff accounting for 7.7 paid hours of this total (7.4 in 1966).

Finances

Financial data are limited to public hospitals as only these institutions are required to submit this type of information to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. In 1967, Revenue Fund income in public general and allied special hospitals reached \$1,415,523,000 which amounted to \$38.48 per patient-day (\$34.34 in 1966). Net earnings from services to in-patients made up 89.2 per cent of this income followed by net earnings from services to out-patients (5.5 per cent), grants (1.4 per cent) and all other income (3.9 per cent).

Revenue Fund expenditures by public hospitals for 1967 totalled \$1,480,489,000 or \$40.24 per patient-day as against \$36.06 in 1966. Gross salaries and wages accounted for more than two-thirds (67.0 per cent) of these expenditures followed by drugs (3.5 per cent), medical and surgical supplies (3.0 per cent) other (departmental) supplies and expense (21.3 per cent) and non-departmental expense (5.2 per cent).

La durée moyenne du séjour des adultes et des enfants dans les hôpitaux publics n'était plus que de 11.5 jours en 1967, par rapport à 11.7 en 1966, mais elle est demeurée inchangée dans le cas des nouveau-nés (6.8 jours). Pour la même période, le nombre de départs d'adultes et d'enfants (3,085,700) a augmenté de 1.4 p. 100, tandis que le nombre de départs de nouveau-nés (363,144) a fléchi de 3.6 p. 100.

Les effectifs globaux des hôpitaux publics du Canada en 1967 se sont accrus de 7.4 p. 100, dépassant 274,400 personnes, dont 87.3 p. 100 à temps plein. Proportionnellement, le personnel à temps partiel s'est accru à un rythme plus rapide que le personnel à plein temps (15.1 p. 100 contre 6.4 p. 100). Le personnel du nursing représentait plus de 55 p. 100 des employés à temps plein et à temps partiel.

Le nombre moyen d'heures de rémunération par journée de soins dans les hôpitaux publics est passé de 13.4 en 1966 à 13.9 en 1967, le personnel du nursing intervenant pour 7.7 heures de ce total (7.4 en 1966).

Finances

Les données financières sont limitées aux hôpitaux publics, vu qu'ils sont les seuls tenus de soumettre ces renseignements au Bureau fédéral de la statistique. En 1967, le revenu passé au fonds d'administration générale dans les hôpitaux publics généraux et spéciaux divers a atteint \$1,415,523,000, soit \$38.48 par journée d'hospitalisation (\$34.34 en 1966). Les gains nets provenant des soins aux hospitalisés équivalaient à 89.2 p. 100 de ce total; les autres sources de revenu étaient, dans l'ordre, les soins aux malades externes (5.5 p. 100), les subventions (1.4 p. 100) et les autres revenus (3.9 p. 100).

Les dépenses du fonds d'administration générale des hôpitaux publics en 1967 se sont élevées à \$1,480,489,000, c'est-à-dire à \$40.24 par journée d'hospitalisation au regard de \$36.06 en 1966. La rémunération brute a retenu plus des deux tiers (67.0 p. 100) de ce total; les autres dépenses se répartissaient ainsi: médicaments, 3.5 p. 100; fournitures médicales et chirurgicales, 3.0 p. 100; autres fournitures et dépenses des services, 21.3 p. 100 et dépenses autres que celles des services, 5.2 p. 100.
