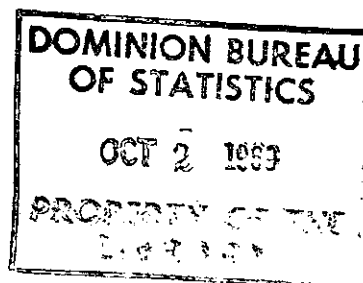

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## GLOSSARY

### Public Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "public hospital", generally not operated for profit and accepting all patients regardless of their ability to pay.

### Private Hospital

Recognized by the province as a "private hospital", generally restricting its admissions to patients paying for care provided at rates determined by the management.

### Federal Hospital

Owned and operated by the Government of Canada; usually operated by the Department of National Health and Welfare, Department of National Defence or Veterans Affairs.

### General Hospital

Provides treatment and care for all types of diseases or at least a wide range of conditions.

### Allied Special

Includes chronic, convalescent, rehabilitation and other (maternity, communicable disease, orthopaedic, cancer) hospitals.

### Patient-day

The period of service to an in-patient between the census-taking hours on two successive days; the day of admission is counted as a patient-day but the day of separation is not.

### Separation

The discharge or death of an in-patient.

### Revenue Fund Income

All revenue (whether or not actually received) that accrues during the year for the purpose of operation and maintenance of the hospital.

### Revenue Fund Expense

The cost, on an accrual basis, of operation and maintenance of the hospital during the year, regardless of the amounts of disbursements made.

### Other Supplies and Expense

Departmental expenditure other than gross salaries and wages, medical and surgical supplies and drugs.

### Other Revenue Fund Expense

Non-departmental expenditure such as interest on loans, depreciation, rentals and other miscellaneous expenses.

## TERMINOLOGIE

### Hôpital public

Reconnu comme tel par la province, généralement établi dans un but non lucratif et recevant tous les malades sans égard à leur capacité de payer.

### Hôpital privé

Reconnu comme tel par la province et réservant d'ordinaire l'admission des malades à ceux qui paient pour les soins fournis suivant les taux déterminés par la direction.

### Hôpital fédéral

Hôpital que possède et dirige le gouvernement fédéral, d'ordinaire géré par le ministère de la Santé nationale et du Bien-être social, ou le ministère de la Défense nationale, ou le ministère des Anciens combattants.

### Hôpital général

Qui traite et soigne toutes sortes de maladies ou, au moins, un grand nombre d'états pathologiques.

### Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Qui comprennent les hôpitaux de maladies chroniques, les maisons de convalescence, les hôpitaux de réadaptation et les autres hôpitaux (les maternités, maladies contagieuses, orthopédie, cancer).

### Journée d'hospitalisation

Période de soins à un hospitalisé entre les heures de vérification de deux jours successifs; le jour d'admission compte comme une journée d'hospitalisation, mais non le jour de départ.

### Départ

Sortie ou décès d'un hospitalisé.

### Revenus du fonds d'administration générale

Tous les revenus (perçus ou non) accumulés durant l'année en vue du fonctionnement et de l'entretien de l'hôpital.

### Dépenses du fonds d'administration générale

Le coût, sur une base d'exercice, du fonctionnement et de l'entretien de l'hôpital durant l'année, quel que soit le montant des déboursés effectués.

### Autres fournitures et dépenses

Dépenses des services, autres que frais de rémunération, de fournitures chirurgicales et médicales et de médicaments.

### Autres dépenses du fonds d'administration générale

Les dépenses non afférentes aux services, comme intérêts sur emprunts, amortissement, loyers et autres dépenses.

### INTRODUCTION

This publication presents basic hospital data historically for the period 1963-1968 as well as more detailed preliminary data relating to the facilities, services and finances of operating general and allied special hospitals in Canada for 1968. The sources of these data are the Annual Returns of Hospitals (HS-1, Facilities and Services, and HS-2, Finances), which are submitted to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics through the various provincial hospital authorities. Information concerned with the mental institutions and tuberculosis sanatoria is not included in this report.

Facilities and services data in this report are descriptive for all operating general and allied special hospitals, while financial data are representative of public general and allied special hospitals exclusively, since only they are required to submit such information. In order that the data would portray a complete representation of hospital activity and maintain historical comparability, estimates were made to account for hospitals which did not report in time for tabulation purposes. Since this is a preliminary report, there may be minor discrepancies with the final data which will appear in the Hospital Statistics series of publications, Volumes I to VII (see the back cover of this report for titles), to be published later in the year.

#### Facilities and Services

General and allied special hospitals in operation in Canada numbered 1,269 in 1968, compared with 1,277 in 1967. Comprising this total were 1,042 public (1,036), 154 private (165) and 73 federal hospitals (76). Rated bed capacity in all operating hospitals amounted to 143,600, an increase of 2.2 per cent from 140,500 rated beds in the previous year, in 1968, as in 1967, the ratio of rated beds per 1,000 population in operating hospitals was 6.9. Public hospitals, with 129,900 rated beds, accounted for 90.5 per cent of the total. Beds set up and ready for use in operating hospitals numbered 143,627, or roughly a ratio of 1:1 to rated beds.

La présente publication renferme les statistiques chronologiques de base sur les hôpitaux pour la période de 1963 à 1968 ainsi que des données préliminaires plus détaillées concernant les installations, les services et les finances des hôpitaux généraux et spéciaux divers en activité au Canada en 1968. Les sources de ces renseignements sont les déclarations annuelles des hôpitaux (HS-1, Installations et services, et HS-2, Finances), qui sont envoyées au Bureau fédéral de la statistique par l'entremise des autorités chargées de l'administration des hôpitaux dans les diverses provinces. Les renseignements sur les établissements pour malades mentaux et sur les sanatoriums pour tuberculeux ne sont pas compris dans ce bulletin.

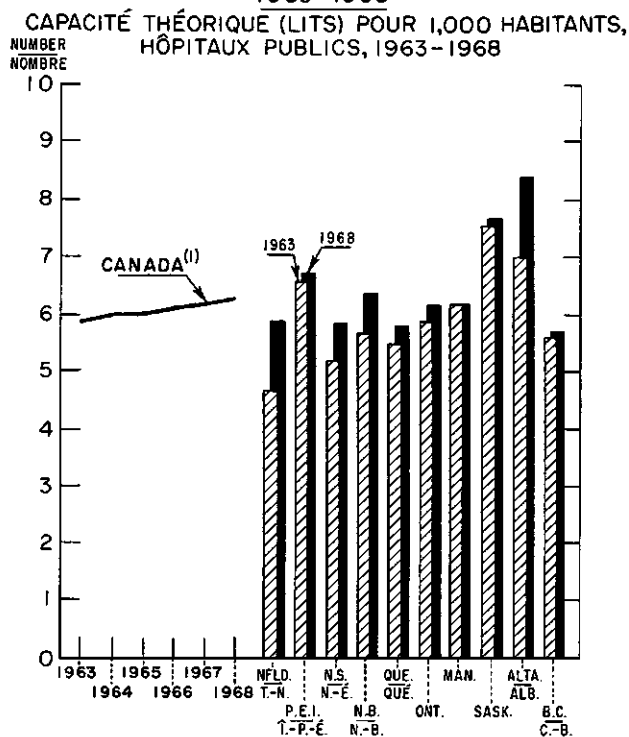
Les statistiques publiées ici sur les installations et les services couvrent la totalité des hôpitaux généraux et spéciaux divers en activité, alors que les données financières sont représentatives des hôpitaux publics généraux et spéciaux divers exclusivement, ces derniers étant les seuls à qui l'on demande de tels renseignements. Pour pouvoir présenter un tableau statistique complet de l'activité hospitalière et maintenir la comparabilité chronologique, on a fait des estimations pour suppléer aux données des hôpitaux qui n'ont pas envoyé leur déclaration à temps. Comme il s'agit d'un bulletin préliminaire, il pourra y avoir de légères divergences lorsqu'on comparera avec les données définitives qui paraîtront dans la série de publications sur la statistique hospitalière, Volumes I à VII (voir les titres à la couverture-verso du présent bulletin), que l'on doit publier plus tard dans l'année.

#### Installations et services

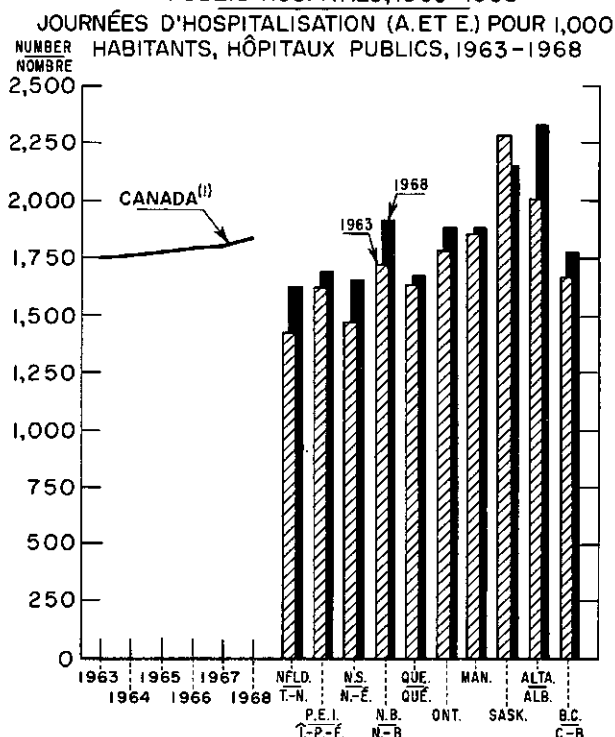
En 1968, il y avait au Canada 1,269 hôpitaux généraux et spéciaux divers en activité contre 1,277 en 1967. Ce total comprenait 1,042 hôpitaux publics (1,036), 154 hôpitaux privés (165) et 73 hôpitaux fédéraux (76). La capacité théorique de tous les hôpitaux en activité était de 143,600 lits, soit une augmentation de 2.2 p. 100 par rapport à la capacité théorique de l'année précédente (140,500 lits). En 1968, comme en 1967, le nombre de lits (capacité théorique) pour 1,000 habitants des hôpitaux en activité était de 6.9. Les hôpitaux publics, d'une capacité théorique de 129,900 lits, représentaient 90.5 p. 100 du total. Les lits dressés et prêts à être occupés dans les hôpitaux en activité étaient au nombre de 143,627 c'est-à-dire que le rapport lits dressés et occupés/capacité théorique était pratiquement égal à 1.

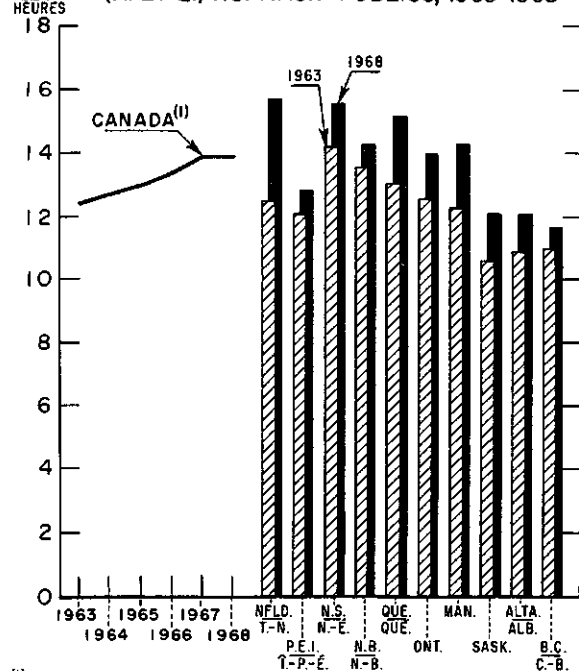
RATED BEDS PER 1,000 POPULATION, PUBLIC HOSPITALS, 1963-1968



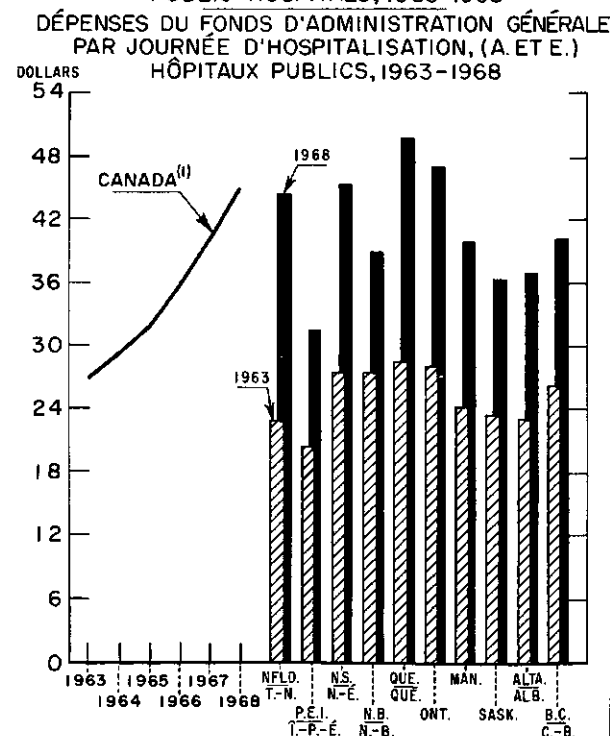
PATIENT-DAYS (A AND C) PER 1,000 POPULATION, PUBLIC HOSPITALS, 1963-1968

Total adult and child patient-days during 1968 in public hospitals increased 4.1 per cent to 38,302,700, 95.5 per cent of which were paid for by provincial hospital insurance plans (95.5 per cent in 1967). Percentage occupancy in public hospitals climbed slightly from 80.2 per cent in 1967 to 81.0 per cent in 1968.

Average length of stay (adults and children) in public hospitals in 1968 was 11.7 days, an increase of 1.7 per cent from 11.5 days in 1967, while for newborn in public hospitals average length of stay in 1968 remained unchanged at 6.8 days. Generally, in public general hospitals, length of stay increased in direct relationship with the size of the hospital, going from 7.2 days in hospitals with 10-24 beds to 13.7 days in the largest hospitals. Adult and child separations from public hospitals increased by 4.0 per cent to 3,208,700, while the number of newborn separated from public hospitals decreased 1.2 per cent to 358,954.

In 1968, public hospitals in Canada employed over 285,400 personnel, representing an increase of 4.5 per cent from the 1967 total. Of this total, 86.9 per cent were classified as full-time employees, of whom 55.7 per cent were nursing staff. The proportion of full-time staff advanced by 3.9 per cent from 1967, while the rate of increase for part-time personnel was almost two and one-half times that for full-time staff (up 8.4 per cent).

Paid hours of work per adult and child patient-day of care in public hospitals averaged 13.9 hours in 1968, unchanged from the 1967 average. Of this total ratio, nursing staff accounted for 7.7 hours (7.7 in 1967).

### Finances

Financial data in this publication pertain only to public general and allied special hospitals. Revenue Fund Income in these public hospitals in 1968 was estimated as \$1,653,838,000 or \$43.18 per patient-day (\$38.61 in 1967). Of total estimated revenue, net earnings from services to in-patients accounted for 88.8 per cent, followed by net earnings from services to out-patients (6.3 per cent), grants (1.4 per cent) and other income (3.5 per cent).

Total Revenue Fund Expenditure amounted to \$1,719,064,000 or \$44.88 per patient-day, compared with \$40.38 in 1967. Provincially, Revenue Fund Expenditure per patient-day ranged from \$31.62 in Prince Edward Island to \$49.88 in Quebec. In 1968, gross salaries and wages accounted for over two thirds (67.4 per cent) of total expenditure (66.7 per cent in 1967), followed by other supplies and expense 21.6 per cent (21.7), drugs 3.3 per cent (3.5), medical and surgical supplies 3.1 per cent (3.0) and other non-departmental expense 4.6 per cent (5.1).

En 1968, le nombre de journées d'hospitalisation des adultes et des enfants dans les hôpitaux publics a augmenté de 4.1 p. 100 atteignant 38,302,700, dont 95.5 p. 100 ont été payées par les régimes provinciaux d'assurance-hospitalisation (95.5 p. 100 en 1967). Le pourcentage d'occupation dans les hôpitaux publics a augmenté légèrement, passant de 80.2 p. 100 en 1967 à 81.0 p. 100 en 1968.

En 1968, la durée moyenne de séjour des adultes et des enfants dans les hôpitaux publics était de 11.7 jours, soit 1.7 p. 100 de plus qu'en 1967 (11.5 jours), tandis que la durée de séjour des nouveau-nés dans ces mêmes hôpitaux est demeurée la même qu'en 1968, soit 6.8 jours. En général dans les hôpitaux publics généraux la durée de séjour a augmenté en fonction directe de la taille de l'hôpital, variant de 7.2 jours dans les hôpitaux de 10 à 24 lits à 13.7 jours dans les hôpitaux les plus grands. Le nombre de radiations d'adultes et d'enfants dans les hôpitaux publics a augmenté de 4.0 p. 100 atteignant 3,208,700, tandis que le nombre de nouveau-nés radiés de ces hôpitaux a diminué de 1.2 p. 100, tombant à 358,954.

En 1968, les hôpitaux publics du Canada employaient plus de 285,400 personnes, soit 4.5 p. 100 de plus qu'en 1967. Sur ce nombre total d'employés, 86.9 p. 100 étaient classés comme employés à plein temps, dont 55.7 p. 100 appartenaient au personnel infirmier. La proportion du personnel à plein temps a augmenté de 3.9 p. 100 par rapport à 1967, tandis que dans le cas du personnel à temps partiel le taux d'augmentation a été presque deux fois et demie plus élevé que pour le personnel à plein temps, soit 8.4 p. 100.

En 1968, le nombre moyen d'heures de travail rémunérées par journée d'hospitalisation des adultes et des enfants dans les hôpitaux était de 13.9 heures, soit le même nombre qu'en 1967. Sur ce total, le personnel infirmier travaillait 7.7 heures (7.7 en 1967).

### Finances

Les statistiques financières de la présente publication n'intéressent que les hôpitaux publics généraux et spéciaux divers. En 1968, le revenu du fonds d'administration de ces hôpitaux publics était estimé à \$1,653,838,000, soit \$43.18 par journée d'hospitalisation (\$38.61 en 1967). Sur le revenu estimatif total, les gains nets provenant des services aux malades hospitalisés représentaient 88.8 p. 100; venaient ensuite les gains nets provenant des services aux malades externes (6.3 p. 100), les subventions (1.4 p. 100) et les autres revenus (3.5 p. 100).

Les dépenses totales du fonds d'administration générale s'élevaient à \$1,719,064,000, soit \$44.88 par journée d'hospitalisation contre \$40.38 en 1967. Au niveau provincial, les dépenses du fonds d'administration générale par journée d'hospitalisation variaient de \$31.62 dans l'Île du Prince-Édouard à \$49.88 au Québec. En 1968, la rémunération brute représentait plus des deux tiers (67.4 p. 100) de toutes les dépenses (66.7 p. 100 en 1967), suivie par les autres fournitures et dépenses, 21.6 p. 100 (21.7), les médicaments, 3.3 p. 100 (3.5 p. 100), les fournitures médicales et chirurgicales, 3.1 p. 100 (3.0) et les autres dépenses non afférentes au service, 4.6 p. 100 (5.1).
