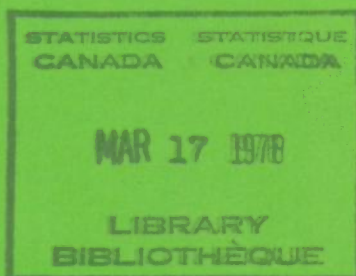

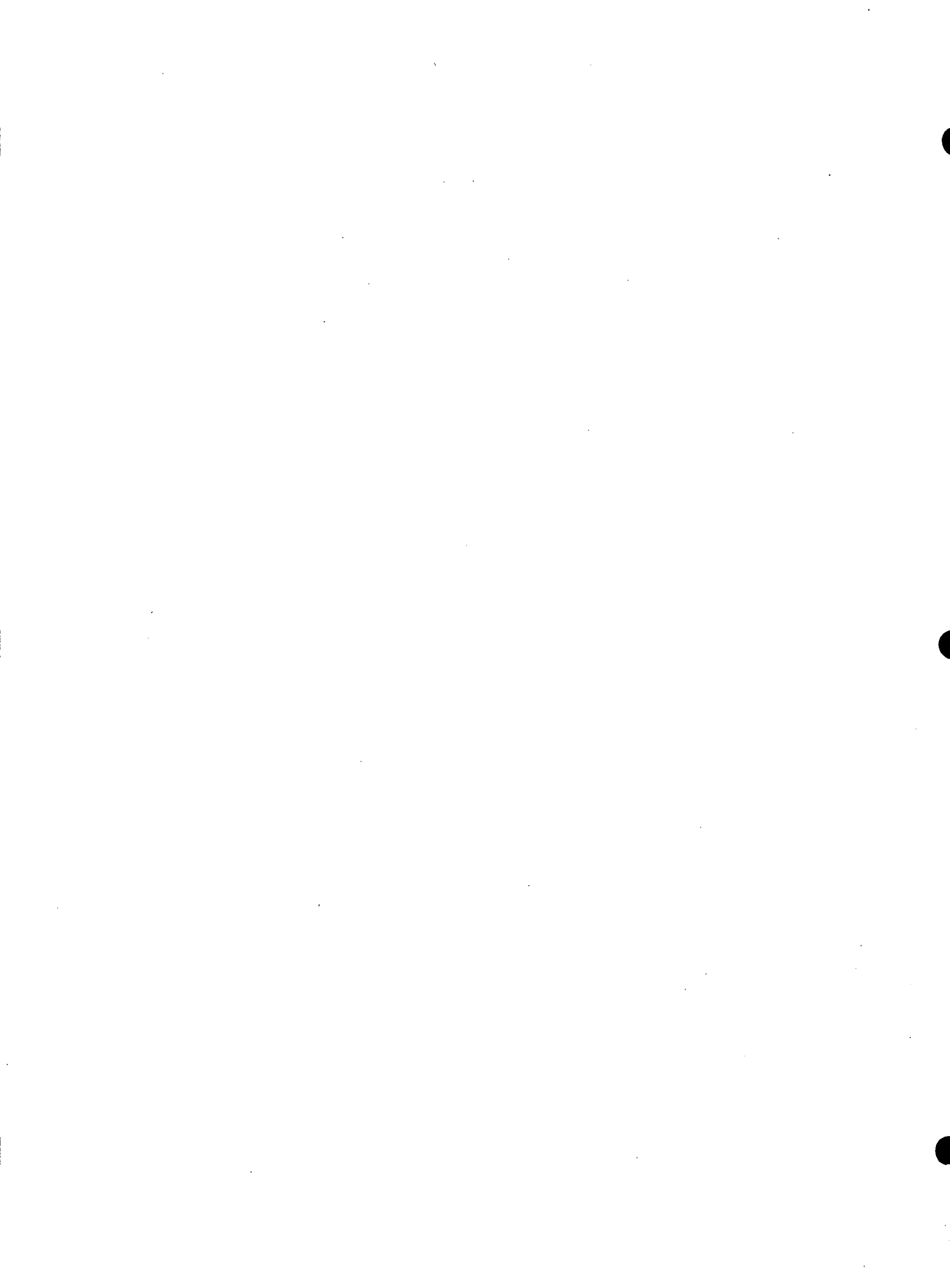

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## PREFACE

An extensive array of hospital statistics relating to facilities available, services provided, personnel employed, educational facilities and finances of general and allied special hospitals and mental institutions operating in Canada is prepared by the Hospitals Section of the Health Division of Statistics Canada. A series of one quarterly and six annual reports are published, to provide users with a comprehensive presentation of these statistics.

Statistics Canada wishes to express its indebtedness to the individual hospitals across the nation which have prepared and submitted data for inclusion in this national statistical program; to the provincial hospital plan authorities for the collection of the data and; to the provincial hospital associations and the Canadian Hospital Association in their promotion of uniform accounting and recording practises.

Statistics on hospitals have been compiled by Statistics Canada since 1931 and have since been published in varying degrees of detail. The reader's attention is drawn to the fact that, beginning with the reporting year 1973, Volumes I, II and III have been condensed and combined into one volume – *Volume I – Hospital Statistics: Beds, Services and Personnel*, Catalogue 83-227. In a similar manner, Volumes IV, V and VI have become *Volume II – Hospital Statistics: Expenditures, Revenues and Balance Sheets*, Catalogue 83-228 and Volume VII has become *Volume III – Hospital Statistics: Indicators*, Catalogue 83-229. Data no longer published in these reports are still available on request, along with other non-published, but collected and tabulated data.

## PRÉFACE

La Section des hôpitaux de la Division de la santé de Statistique Canada prépare un grand nombre de statistiques sur les installations disponibles, les services fournis, le personnel employé, l'équipement didactique et la situation financière des hôpitaux généraux et spéciaux divers et des hôpitaux pour malades mentaux du Canada. Statistique Canada publie six bulletins annuels et une série de bulletins trimestriels afin d'offrir aux utilisateurs des statistiques complètes dans ce domaine.

Statistique Canada remercie les hôpitaux canadiens qui ont préparé et présenté les données pour qu'on puisse les intégrer dans le cadre du programme national de statistique; les administrateurs provinciaux de l'assurance-hospitalisation pour la collecte des données; les associations hospitalières provinciales et l'Association canadienne des hôpitaux pour leur effort d'uniformisation de la comptabilité et de la tenue des registres.

Depuis 1931, Statistique Canada recueille les statistiques sur les hôpitaux et les présente dans des publications plus ou moins détaillées. Nous attirons l'attention du lecteur sur le fait qu'à partir de 1973, les volumes I, II et III ont été condensés et fusionnés en un volume: *Volume I – Statistique hospitalière: lits, services et personnel*, n° 83-227 au catalogue. De même les volumes IV, V et VI deviennent: *Volume II – Statistique hospitalière: dépenses, revenus et bilan*, n° 83-228 au catalogue. 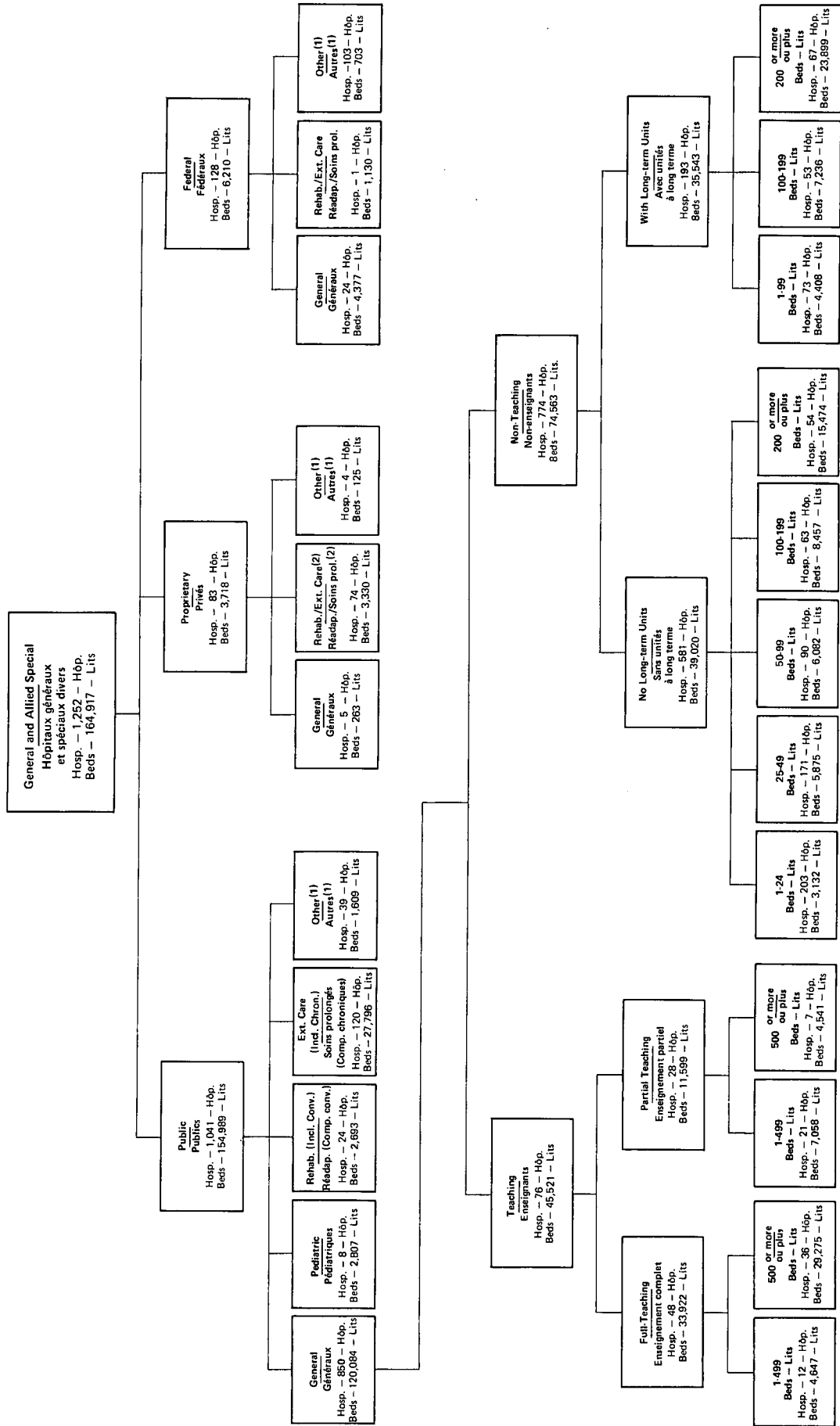

# INTRODUCTION

This preliminary annual report of hospital statistics provides a summary presentation of data relating to the facilities, utilization, personnel and finances of general and allied special hospitals that reported as at December 31, 1976.

Published data relating to facilities and personnel embody all reporting general and allied special hospitals; data pertaining to finances apply to public hospitals only.

Further, in an effort to show historical trends on selected statistics from reporting hospitals, tabulations, indicators and graphic illustrations have also been included with data dating back to 1967.

Additional information relating to mental hospitals and tuberculosis sanatoria may be found exclusively in Tables 1, 1 A and 1 B which cover the period ranging from 1967 to 1975.

## Source

This publication is based on data submitted to Statistics Canada by individual hospitals in one of the following forms:

- (1) Report for the quarter ending December 1976 submitted under the Quarterly Hospitals Information System of Statistics Canada and the Canadian Hospital Association.
- (2) Annual Return of Health Care Facilities – Hospitals – Part One.
- (3) Preliminary Annual Report of Hospitals.

Of the hospitals that were operating at year end, 1976, the total number of hospitals which reported data for this report was 1,168. Thus, this report covers 93.2% of all operating hospitals. These differences may be acknowledged upon comparing Tables 2 and 3.

## Public General Hospitals

In 1976, a total of 834 public general hospitals reported 32,993,944 patient-days. Total operating expenditures for these hospitals amounted to about \$4.5 billion, a cost of about \$140.00 per patient-day. Analysis of the data provided in Table 12 will reveal among other things that gross salaries and wages accounted for 71.8% of the total operating expenditure.

By virtue of the preliminary nature of this report, it must be emphasized that data are subject to revision as may be dictated by the final data reported in our annual publication series to be released at a later date.

Le présent rapport annuel provisoire de la statistique hospitalière présente des données sommaires sur les installations, l'utilisation, le personnel et les finances des hôpitaux généraux et spécialisés du Canada qui avaient répondu à l'enquête au 31 décembre 1976.

Les statistiques relatives aux installations et au personnel couvrent l'ensemble des hôpitaux généraux et spécialisés; les statistiques sur les finances s'appliquent aux hôpitaux publics seulement.

Pour montrer les tendances historiques de certaines données fournies par les hôpitaux répondants, on a ajouté à ces statistiques des tableaux, des indicateurs et des graphiques remontant à 1967.

Des renseignements supplémentaires sur les établissements pour malades mentaux et les sanatoriums pour tuberculeux sont présentés exclusivement aux tableaux 1, 1 A et 1 B qui portent sur la période 1967 à 1975.

## Source

Cette publication comprend les données reçues des hôpitaux par Statistique Canada sur les formules suivantes:

- (1) Les rapports du quatrième trimestre de 1976 pour les hôpitaux faisant partie du Programme de renseignements hospitaliers trimestriels de Statistique Canada et de l'Association des hôpitaux du Canada.
- (2) Rapport annuel des établissements de santé – Hôpitaux – Première partie.
- (3) Les rapports annuels provisoires des hôpitaux.

Du nombre d'hôpitaux en activité à la fin de 1976, le nombre total d'hôpitaux ayant répondu à l'enquête aux fins du présent rapport est de 1,168. Par conséquent, ce rapport couvre 93.2 % de tous les hôpitaux en activité. Ces différences peuvent être relevées en comparant les tableaux 2 et 3.

## Hôpitaux généraux publics

En 1976, 834 hôpitaux généraux publics ont déclaré 32,993,944 journées d'hospitalisation. Les dépenses d'exploitation de ces hôpitaux se sont chiffrées à environ \$4.5 milliards, un coût approximatif de \$140.00 par journée d'hospitalisation. L'analyse des données du tableau 12 montre, entre autres, que la rémunération brute représente 71.8 % des dépenses d'exploitation totales.

En raison de la nature préliminaire de ce bulletin, nous devons insister sur le fait que ces données pourront être remplacées par les données finales présentées dans notre série de publications annuelles qui paraîtront à une date ultérieure.

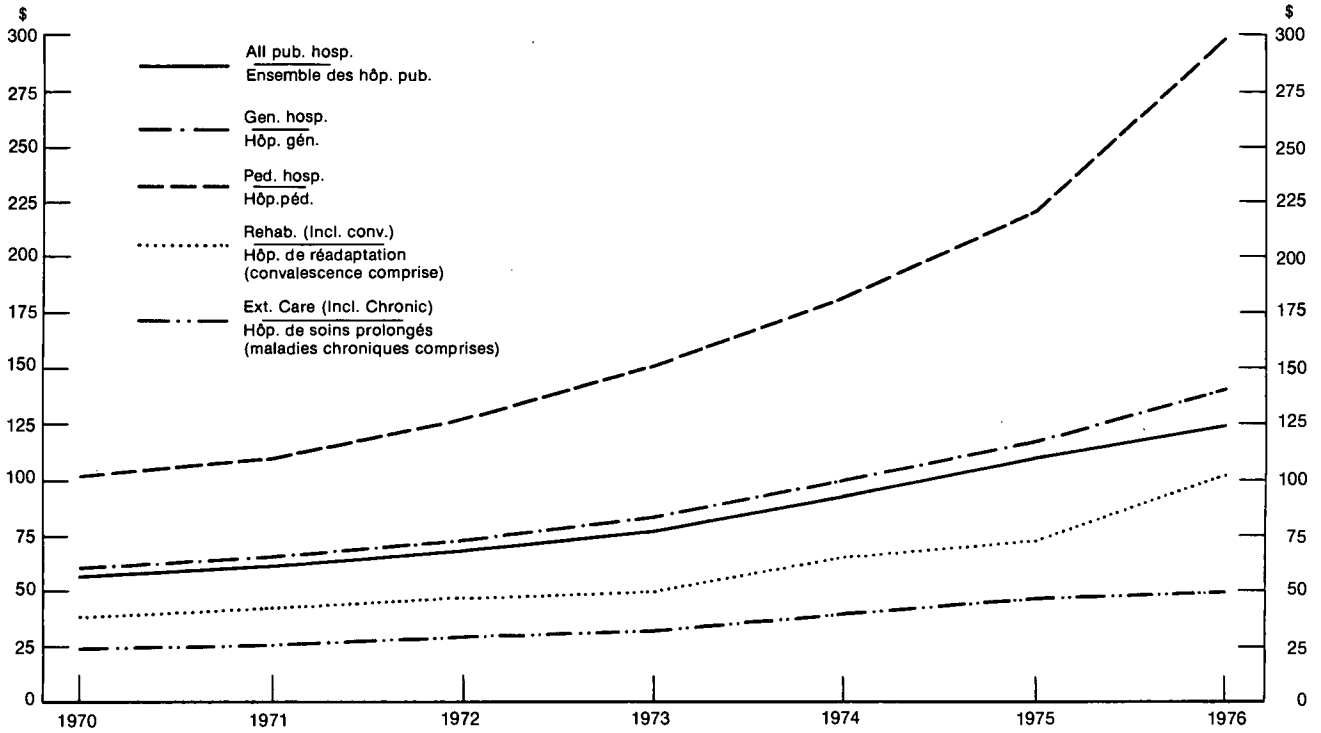

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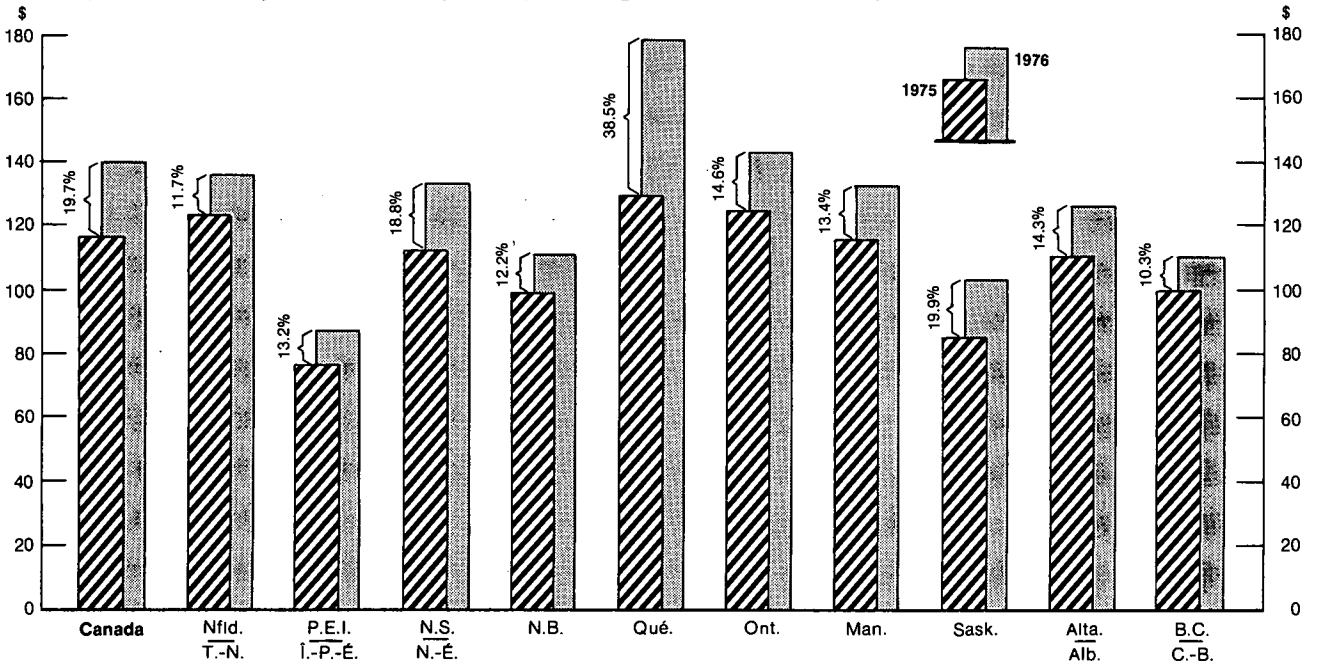
**Cost per Patient-day (Adults and Children) Canada, 1970-1976**

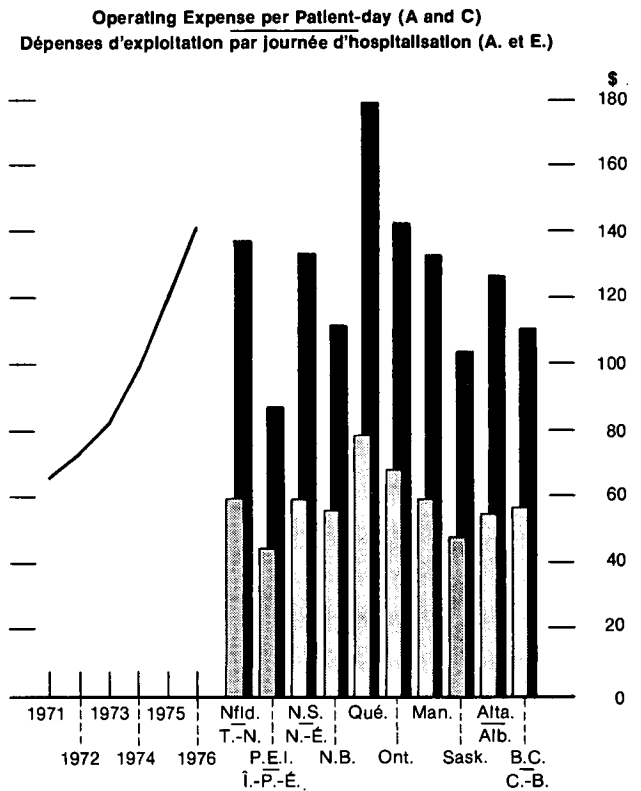
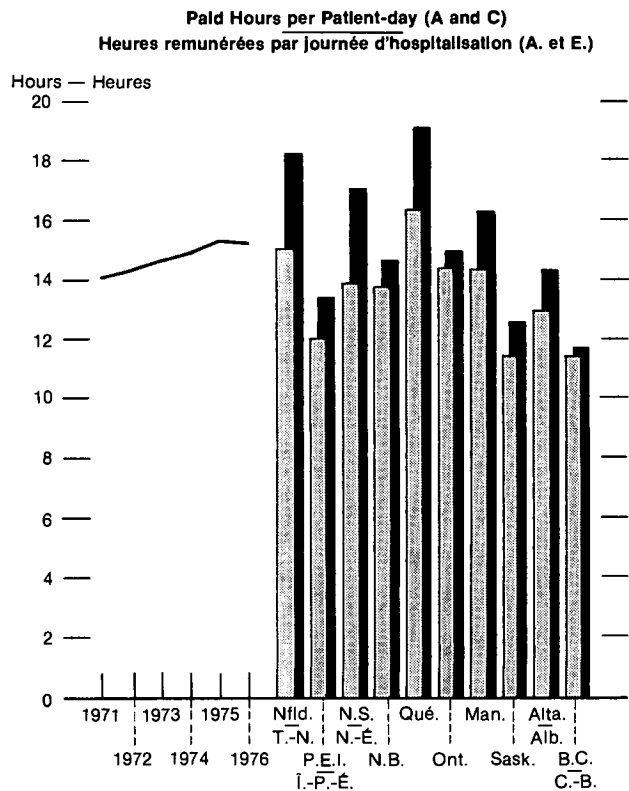
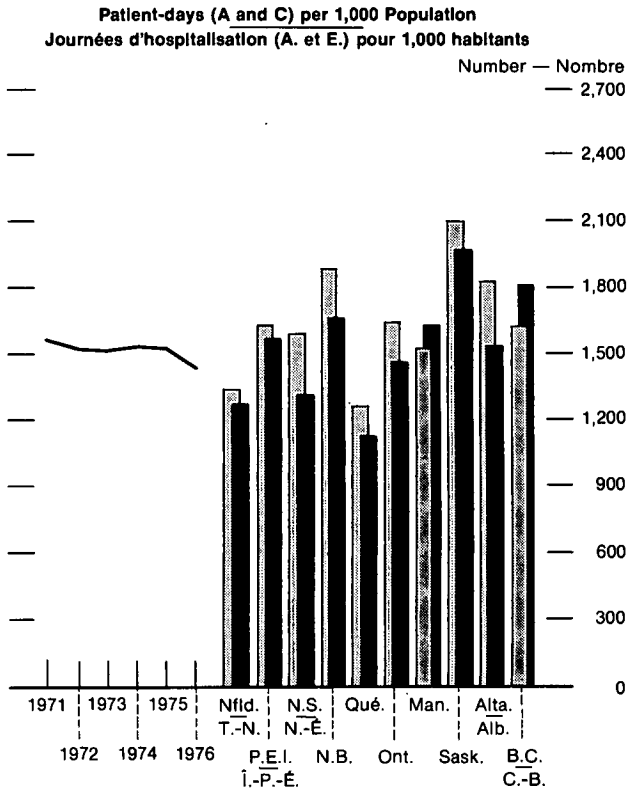
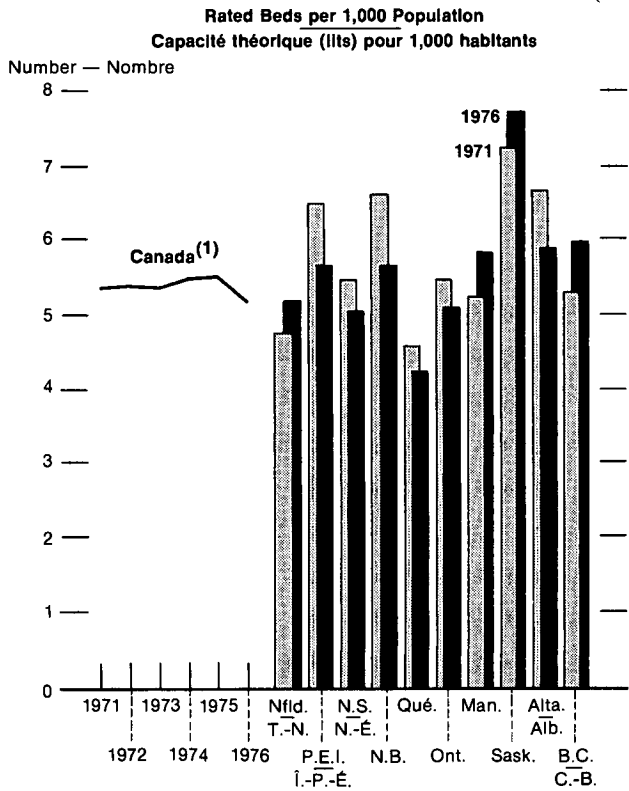

**Partial medical teaching hospital** – Applies to a hospital which provides post-graduate medical education programs, approved by the appropriate authorities, in at least one residency program in a medical specialty.

#### Allied Special Hospitals

Includes pediatric, rehabilitation, extended care and other hospitals.

**Pediatric hospital** – A hospital which provides primarily for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of pediatric patients, generally 14 years of age and under.

**Rehabilitation (including convalescent)** – Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing assessment and treatment of patients whose condition is expected to improve significantly through the provision of physical medicine and other rehabilitative services.

**Extended care (including chronic)** – Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing treatment of patients with long-term illness or with a low potential for recovery and who require regular medical assessment and continuing nursing care.

**Other** – A hospital which provides primarily for the treatment of a limited range of diseases or injuries, or which restricts admissions to a particular age group or sex. Examples of such specified categories may include orthopaedic, maternity, neurological, cancer hospitals. A hospital which provides a combination of various types of service and cannot be classified in any one of the foregoing categories is included in this group. "Other" also includes nursing stations and outpost hospitals.

#### Subject Matter Terminology

##### Rated Bed (Bassinets) Capacity

The number of beds and cribs (bassinets) which the hospital is designed to accommodate on the basis of established standards of floor area per bed (bassinets) as at December 31 of the reporting year.

##### Approved Bed (Bassinets) Complement

The number of beds and cribs, or bassinets for newborn, that have been approved for the hospital (or unit of the hospital), as at year-end of the reporting year, by the Provincial authorities.

##### Patient-day

The period of service to an inpatient between the census-taking hours on two successive days; the day of admission is counted as a patient-day but the day of separation is not.

**Hôpital d'enseignement médical partiel** – S'applique à un hôpital qui offre des programmes réguliers d'enseignement, dûment approuvés par les autorités compétentes, aux diplômés en médecine dans au moins un programme de résidence d'une spécialité médicale.

#### Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Ce groupe comprend les hôpitaux pédiatriques, de réadaptation, de soins prolongés et les "autres" hôpitaux.

**Hôpital pédiatrique** – Hôpital qui se spécialise dans le diagnostic et le traitement à court terme des maladies chez les enfants âgés généralement de 14 ans ou moins.

**Hôpital de réadaptation (convalescence comprise)** – Hôpital qui assure principalement la surveillance et le traitement suivis des personnes dont l'état est censé s'améliorer à la suite de soins de médecine physique et de réadaptation.

**Hôpital de soins prolongés (maladies chroniques comprises)** – Hôpital qui dispense principalement des traitements suivis à des personnes affectées de maladies de longue durée ou de guérison lente et requérant des soins médicaux et infirmiers de façon continue.

**Autres** – Hôpital qui assure principalement le traitement d'un nombre restreint de maladies ou de traumatismes, ou qui n'admet que les malades d'un groupe d'âge ou d'un sexe particulier (par ex., orthopédie, maternité, neurologie, cancer). L'hôpital qui offre divers genres de services et qui ne peut être classés dans aucune des catégories susmentionnées est compris dans ce groupe. "Autres" comprend en outre les postes de soins infirmiers et les hôpitaux éloignés.

#### Glossaire des termes techniques

##### Capacité théorique en lits (ou berceaux)

Le nombre de lits d'adultes et d'enfants et de berceaux de nouveau-nés que l'hôpital peut abriter au 31 décembre de l'année du rapport suivant les normes de superficie établies par lit ou berceau.

##### Lits (ou berceaux) approuvés

Le nombre de lits (adultes et enfants) et de berceaux (nouveau-nés) qui, à la fin de l'année visée par le rapport, étaient approuvés par les autorités provinciales dans le cas de l'hôpital (ou l'unité de l'hôpital).

##### Journée d'hospitalisation

Période de soins fournis à un hospitalisé entre les heures du recensement quotidien de deux jours consécutifs; le jour de l'admission compte comme journée d'hospitalisation, mais non le jour de la sortie.

## GLOSSARY

### Hospital

Is defined as an institution where patients are accommodated on the basis of medical need and are provided with continuing medical care and supporting diagnostic and therapeutic services and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by a provincial government, or is operated by the Government of Canada. Specifically excluded are institutions primarily for tuberculosis, or psychiatric disorders.

### Type of Hospital

#### Public Hospital

**Public (including voluntary, provincial and municipal)** — Applies to hospitals recognized by the province as "public hospitals". Such hospitals generally are not operated for profit.

#### Proprietary Hospital

Applies to hospitals owned by an individual or by a private organization, operated for a profit and recognized by the province as "proprietary hospitals".

#### Federal Hospital

Applies to hospitals owned by a department or agency of the Government of Canada and operated on a non-profit basis.

### Type of Service

#### General

**No long-term units** — Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of patients for a wide range of diseases or injuries. The services of a general hospital are not restricted to a specific age group or sex.

**With long-term units** — Applies to a hospital with a group of beds or rooms or a separate wing or building which is recognized as a distinct and separate treatment unit of the hospital. Admission normally requires formal admission procedures even when transferred from another part of the hospital.

**Full medical teaching hospital** — Applies to a hospital which provides medical education programs, approved by the appropriate authorities, for the major (not only elective) clinical instruction in at least the medical disciplines of internal medicine and general surgery to undergraduate medical students in their final two years.

## GLOSSAIRE

### Hôpital

Par définition, un hôpital est un établissement qui reçoit des personnes requérant des soins médicaux et leur dispense de façon continue ces soins ainsi que les services diagnostiques et thérapeutiques d'appoint et qui est enregistré ou reconnu comme hôpital par une province ou administré par le gouvernement du Canada. Ne comprend pas les établissements destinés avant tout au traitement de la tuberculose ou des troubles psychiatriques.

### Genre d'hôpital

#### Hôpital public

**Public (s'applique aux hôpitaux sans but lucratif, aux hôpitaux provinciaux et aux hôpitaux municipaux)** — Hôpital reconnu par la province comme "public". Un tel hôpital ne vise ordinairement pas à réaliser des bénéfices.

#### Hôpital privé à but lucratif

S'applique aux hôpitaux reconnus par la province comme "privés à but lucratif"; il s'agit d'un hôpital qu'un particulier ou un organisme privé possède et exploite en vue de réaliser des bénéfices.

#### Hôpital fédéral

Hôpital appartenant à un ministère ou à un organisme du gouvernement du Canada et ne visant pas à réaliser des bénéfices.

### Genre de service

#### Hôpital général

**Sans unités de soins à long terme** — Hôpital qui assure principalement des soins de courte durée (diagnostique et traitement) d'une grande variété d'affections et de traumatismes, sans distinction d'âge et de sexe.

**Avec unités de soins à long terme** — S'applique à un hôpital comprenant un groupe de lits ou de chambres ou une aile ou un bâtiment séparé qui est considéré comme quartier de traitement distinct. Pour y être admis, il faut en général remplir les formalités de demande d'admission, même s'il s'agit d'un transfert d'un autre quartier de l'hôpital.

**Hôpital d'enseignement médical complet** — S'applique à un hôpital qui offre des programmes d'enseignement médical, dûment approuvés par les autorités compétentes, pour la formation clinique des étudiants effectuant leurs deux dernières années d'études dans les disciplines majeures (non pas seulement facultatives), dont la médecine interne et la chirurgie générale.

**Partial medical teaching hospital** – Applies to a hospital which provides post-graduate medical education programs, approved by the appropriate authorities, in at least one residency program in a medical specialty.

#### **Allied Special Hospitals**

Includes pediatric, rehabilitation, extended care and other hospitals.

**Pediatric hospital** – A hospital which provides primarily for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of pediatric patients, generally 14 years of age and under.

**Rehabilitation (including convalescent)** – Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing assessment and treatment of patients whose condition is expected to improve significantly through the provision of physical medicine and other rehabilitative services.

**Extended care (including chronic)** – Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing treatment of patients with long-term illness or with a low potential for recovery and who require regular medical assessment and continuing nursing care.

**Other** – A hospital which provides primarily for the treatment of a limited range of diseases or injuries, or which restricts admissions to a particular age group or sex. Examples of such specified categories may include orthopaedic, maternity, neurological, cancer hospitals. A hospital which provides a combination of various types of service and cannot be classified in any one of the foregoing categories is included in this group. "Other" also includes nursing stations and outpost hospitals.

### **Subject Matter Terminology**

#### **Rated Bed (Bassinets) Capacity**

The number of beds and cribs (bassinets) which the hospital is designed to accommodate on the basis of established standards of floor area per bed (bassinets) as at December 31 of the reporting year.

#### **Approved Bed (Bassinets) Complement**

The number of beds and cribs, or bassinets for newborn, that have been approved for the hospital (or unit of the hospital), as at year-end of the reporting year, by the Provincial authorities.

#### **Patient-day**

The period of service to an inpatient between the census-taking hours on two successive days; the day of admission is counted as a patient-day but the day of separation is not.

**Hôpital d'enseignement médical partiel** – S'applique à un hôpital qui offre des programmes réguliers d'enseignement, dûment approuvés par les autorités compétentes, aux diplômés en médecine dans au moins un programme de résidence d'une spécialité médicale.

#### **Hôpitaux spéciaux divers**

Ce groupe comprend les hôpitaux pédiatriques, de réadaptation, de soins prolongés et les "autres" hôpitaux.

**Hôpital pédiatrique** – Hôpital qui se spécialise dans le diagnostic et le traitement à court terme des maladies chez les enfants âgés généralement de 14 ans ou moins.

**Hôpital de réadaptation (convalescence comprise)** – Hôpital qui assure principalement la surveillance et le traitement suivis des personnes dont l'état est censé s'améliorer à la suite de soins de médecine physique et de réadaptation.

**Hôpital de soins prolongés (maladies chroniques comprises)** – Hôpital qui dispense principalement des traitements suivis à des personnes affectées de maladies de longue durée ou de guérison lente et requérant des soins médicaux et infirmiers de façon continue.

**Autres** – Hôpital qui assure principalement le traitement d'un nombre restreint de maladies ou de traumatismes, ou qui n'admet que les malades d'un groupe d'âge ou d'un sexe particulier (par ex., orthopédie, maternité, neurologie, cancer). L'hôpital qui offre divers genres de services et qui ne peut être classés dans aucune des catégories susmentionnées est compris dans ce groupe. "Autres" comprend en outre les postes de soins infirmiers et les hôpitaux éloignés.

### **Glossaire des termes techniques**

#### **Capacité théorique en lits (ou berceaux)**

Le nombre de lits d'adultes et d'enfants et de berceaux de nouveau-nés que l'hôpital peut abriter au 31 décembre de l'année du rapport suivant les normes de superficie établies par lit ou berceau.

#### **Lits (ou berceaux) approuvés**

Le nombre de lits (adultes et enfants) et de berceaux (nouveau-nés) qui, à la fin de l'année visée par le rapport, étaient approuvés par les autorités provinciales dans le cas de l'hôpital (ou l'unité de l'hôpital).

#### **Journée d'hospitalisation**

Période de soins fournis à un hospitalisé entre les heures du recensement quotidien de deux jours consécutifs; le jour de l'admission compte comme journée d'hospitalisation, mais non le jour de la sortie.

### Separation

The discharge or death of an inpatient.

### Percentage Occupancy

The number of actual patient-days recorded during the year expressed as a percentage of the potential patient-days in that year based either on rated bed capacity or approved bed complement.

### Average Length of Stay

The mean number of days' stay in hospital from the date of admission of patients separated during the reporting year.

## Personnel

### Full-time Staff

Persons employed on a full-time basis, i.e., regularly employed throughout the hospital's full work week.

### Part-time Staff

Persons employed on a part-time basis, i.e., regularly employed on selected days or partial days in the hospital's work week.

### Nursing Staff (Exclusive of Nursing Education)

All staff engaged in nursing including directors, associate or assistant directors, supervisors 2, supervisors 1, assistant head nurses, other graduate nurses, qualified nursing assistants, orderlies and other staff (nurse interns, child-care nurses, ward clerks and receptionists and others).

### Nursing Education

Includes a senior nurse responsible for the direction of the school of nursing, her assistant(s) clinical and classroom instructors, clerical or stenographic staff assigned to nursing education, house mothers, students and other trainee nursing personnel whose courses lead to provincial certification, licensing or registration.

## Financial

### Operating Expense

The cost, on an accrual basis, of operating and maintaining the hospital during the year.

### Départ

Sortie ou décès d'un hospitalisé.

### Pourcentage d'occupation

Nombre de journées d'hospitalisation enregistrées au cours de l'année en pourcentage du potentiel d'hospitalisation durant cette même année, basé sur la capacité théorique en lits ou sur les lits approuvés.

### Durée moyenne du séjour

Le nombre moyen de jours passés à l'hôpital depuis la date d'admission des hospitalisés sortis durant l'année du rapport.

## Personnel

### Personnel à plein temps

Personnes employées à plein temps, c.-à-d., régulièrement employées pendant toute la semaine de travail de l'hôpital.

### Personnel à temps partiel

Personnes employées à temps partiel, c.-à-d., régulièrement employées certains jours ou parties de journées au cours de la semaine de travail de l'hôpital.

### Personnel des soins infirmiers (à l'exclusion de l'enseignement infirmier)

Ensemble du personnel affecté aux soins infirmiers, y compris les directrices et directrices adjointes, les surveillantes 2, les surveillantes 1, surveillantes adjointes, les autres infirmières diplômées, les auxiliaires qualifiés(es), les infirmiers non diplômés et autre personnel tel que les infirmières internes, les puéricultrices ou aides-puéricultrices, les réceptionnistes-secrétaires et autres.

### Enseignement infirmier

Comprend l'infirmière chargée de la direction de l'école des infirmières, ses adjointes, les monitrices en clinique et en classe, le personnel de bureau et les sténodactylos affectés au service d'enseignement infirmier, les infirmières chefs, les élèves de l'école et les autres membres du personnel infirmier dont les cours de formation conduisent à la délivrance, par la province, d'un certificat, permis ou autorisation.

## Finances

### Dépenses d'exploitation

Les frais d'exploitation et d'entretien de l'hôpital au cours de l'année, établis d'après la comptabilité d'exercice.

### Salaries and Wages

This includes gross salaries and wages earned during the year by all hospital personnel. Gross salaries and wages include the following: (1) all types of hospital remuneration earned during the year by paid medical staff, i.e., salaries, wages, fees, contract rates, honorariums, etc.; gross salaries and wages earned by interns, residents or students enrolled in organized educational programs; and, gross salaries and wages earned by all other staff including non-medical teaching staff and regular employees involved in extramural or on-the-job training; (2) the value of donated services of regular staff members working without pay; and of perquisites supplied to such personnel, calculated on the basis of salary scales for similar services in the community and supported by regular payroll records.

The distribution of the gross salary or wages of an employee working in more than one department of a hospital normally is made proportionately to the number of paid hours of work performed by the employee in each of the several departments. However, if the employee received separate remuneration in each department, these amounts are charged to the departments concerned.

### Other

Constitutes the remainder of expenses under "supplies and other expenses" e.g., laboratory, radiology and radioisotope services; and other supplies and expenses such as office equipment, travel, the costs of utilities (telephone, electricity); laundry and linen supplies, patients' wearing apparel; rent, insurance, taxes; etc.

### Rémunération

La rémunération correspond au montant brut des traitements et des salaires gagnés durant l'année par tout le personnel des hôpitaux. Elle comprend: (1) tout type de rémunération hospitalière gagnée pendant l'année par les membres rémunérés du personnel médical, c.-à-d., les traitements, les salaires, les honoraires, les tarifs conventionnels, etc.; la rémunération brute des internes, des résidents ou des élèves inscrits aux programmes d'enseignement et la rémunération brute du reste des effectifs, y compris le personnel enseignant non médical et les employés réguliers s'occupant de formation hors cadre ou en cours d'emploi; (2) la valeur des services donnés gratuitement par les membres du personnel régulier travaillant sans rémunération, et des compensations qui leur sont accordées, valeur établie d'après l'échelle de la rémunération pour des semblables dans la localité et appuyée par des entrées ordinaires aux bordereaux de paie.

La répartition de la rémunération brute d'un employé d'hôpital travaillant dans plus d'un service est ordinairement exprimée en proportion du nombre d'heures de travail rémunérées, réalisées par l'employé dans chacun des services. Toutefois, si l'employé a reçu une rémunération distincte dans chaque service, les montants sont attribués aux services intéressés.

### Autres

Constitue le reste des dépenses sous la rubrique "fournitures et autres dépenses" e.g., les services de laboratoire, de radiologie et des radioisotopes, et les autres fournitures et dépenses telles que; les fournitures de bureau, les déplacements; les coûts pour services de téléphone et d'électricité; les fournitures de blanchissage et de lingerie, les vêtements de malades; la location, les assurances, les taxes, etc.
