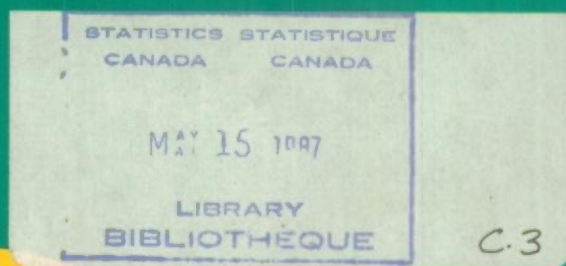

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## Highlights

The following highlights compare 1985-86 and 1984-85 figures for Canadian reporting public general and allied special hospitals. More detailed figures with breakdowns by province and hospital type and size are contained in Tables 1 to 13 of this publication. Definitions of the various terms may be found in the glossary (Appendix C).

## Faits saillants

Les faits saillants suivants comparent les statistiques de 1985-86 avec celles de 1984-85 sur les hôpitaux publics généraux et les hôpitaux spéciaux divers. Les tableaux 1 à 13 de la présente publication renferment des données détaillées ventilées selon la province ou le territoire et le genre et la taille de l'hôpital. Les définitions des différents termes figurent à la section de terminologie (appendice C).

Utilization of (reporting public) hospital inpatient services as measured by such variables as patient days and separations was up very slightly in 1985-86 as compared to 1984-85. However, relative to the population (patient days per 1,000, separations per 1,000) there was a slight decrease. Overall, 1985-86 figures appear to indicate a more intensive use of scarce hospital inpatient resources. Percentage occupancy is up slightly, average lengths of stay are shorter, and relative to the population, the supply of beds (beds per 1,000) has declined marginally. One explanation for the decline, relative to the population, of inpatient services is the increasing emphasis on less expensive outpatient care (e.g., surgical day care). While complete data are not yet available, trends suggest that hospital based outpatient services are continuing to expand.

Hospital expenditures (reporting public hospitals) for 1985-86 rose to 15.2 billion dollars from 14.2 billion dollars in 1984-85, an increase of 6.67%. Expense per patient day, expense per approved bed and expense per capita increased about 6% in 1985-86 as compared to 1984-85. Paid hours (for all hospital employees except physicians) increased about 3% to more than 744 million in 1985-86. Assuming an average work week of 37.5 hours, these paid hours represent the equivalent of 381,668 full time positions in 1985-86, an increase of 11,191 positions over the previous year. As these paid hours include both full and part time employees the actual number of positions will be greater than full time equivalents quoted here.

L'utilisation des services d'hospitalisation dans les hôpitaux publics répondants, mesurée à l'aide de variables telles que les journées d'hospitalisation et les radiations, était quelque peu à la hausse en 1985-86 par rapport à 1984-85. Cependant, si l'on exprime cette mesure en jours d'hospitalisation pour 1,000 habitants et en radiations pour 1,000 habitants, on constate une légère baisse. Dans l'ensemble, les données de 1985-86 semblent révéler une utilisation plus intensive des maigres ressources des hôpitaux en ce qui a trait à l'hospitalisation. Le pourcentage d'occupation s'est quelque peu accru, la durée moyenne des séjours a diminué et le nombre de lits pour 1,000 habitants a baissé légèrement. La régression du taux d'utilisation pour 1,000 habitants des services d'hospitalisation peut s'expliquer par le recours grandissant aux services, moins coûteux, de consultation externe (p. ex., les soins chirurgicaux de jour). Bien que les données complètes ne soient pas encore disponibles, les tendances semblent indiquer que les services de consultation externe dans les hôpitaux prennent constamment de l'expansion.

Les dépenses des hôpitaux publics répondants se chiffraient à \$15.2 milliards en 1985-86 contre \$14.2 milliards en 1984-85, ce qui représente une hausse de 6.67%. Les dépenses par jour d'hospitalisation, par lit approuvé et par habitant ont grimpé d'environ 6% en 1985-86 par rapport à 1984-85. Pour ce qui est des heures rémunérées (pour tout le personnel hospitalier à l'exception des médecins), elles ont subi une augmentation d'environ 3%, ce qui porte leur nombre à plus de 744 millions en 1985-86. Si l'on suppose qu'une semaine moyenne de travail est de 37.5 heures, ces heures équivalaient, en 1985-86, à 381,668 postes à temps plein, soit une hausse de 11,191 postes par rapport à l'année précédente. Comme ces heures rémunérées ont été travaillées par des employés à temps plein et à temps partiel, le nombre réel de postes occupés est supérieur au nombre de postes susmentionnés.



## Introduction

The preliminary annual report contains tabulations of selected elements of hospital data. The objective of the report is to provide, in a timely manner, useful statistics in key areas of hospital utilization and costs. Although the figures presented are preliminary they nevertheless provide a reasonably accurate portrayal of costs and utilization of Canadian general and allied special hospitals.

The 1985-86 edition of the preliminary report is based on the data of some 1,161 hospitals containing some 176,010 approved beds. This represents 94.47% of operating hospitals and 99.17% of approved beds in operating hospitals.

Le rapport annuel préliminaire comprend un certain nombre d'éléments des données hospitalières. Le but de ce rapport est de fournir, dans les plus brefs délais, des statistiques utiles sur l'utilisation et les coûts des services hospitaliers. Bien que les chiffres soient préliminaires, ils présentent néanmoins une description suffisamment précise de l'utilisation et des coûts des hôpitaux canadiens, généraux et spéciaux divers.

Le rapport préliminaire 1985-86 a été préparé à partir des données de quelque 1,161 hôpitaux, comprenant 176,010 lits approuvés. Ces chiffres représentent 94.47% de tous les hôpitaux en activité et 99.17% de tous les lits approuvés dans ces mêmes hôpitaux.

## Appendix C

### Glossary

#### Hospital

Is defined as an institution where patients are accommodated on the basis of medical need and are provided with continuing medical care and supporting diagnostic and therapeutic services, and which is licensed or approved as a hospital by a provincial government, or is operated by the Government of Canada. This definition includes mental institutions.

#### Type of Hospital

##### Public Hospital

**Public (including voluntary, provincial and municipal).** Applies to a hospital recognized by the province as a "public hospital". Such a hospital generally is not operated for profit.

**Proprietary.** Applies to a hospital owned by an individual or by a private organization, operated for a profit and recognized by the province as a "proprietary hospital".

**Federal.** Applies to a hospital owned by a department or agency of the Government of Canada and operated on a non-profit basis.

#### Type of Service

##### General

**No long-term units.** Refers to a hospital which provides primarily for the diagnoses and short-term treatment of patients for a wide range of diseases or injuries. The services of a general hospital are not restricted to a specific age group or sex.

**With long-term units.** Refers to a hospital with a group of beds or rooms or a separate wing or building which is recognized as a distinct and separate treatment unit of the hospital. Admission normally requires formal admission procedures even when transferred from another part of the hospital.

## Appendice C

### Terminologie

#### Hôpital

Par définition, un hôpital est un établissement qui reçoit des personnes requérant des soins médicaux et leur dispense de façon continue ces soins ainsi que les services diagnostiques et thérapeutiques d'appoint, et qui est enregistré ou reconnu comme hôpital par une province ou administré par le gouvernement du Canada. Cette définition englobe les établissements psychiatriques.

#### Genre d'hôpital

##### Hôpital public

**Public (s'applique aux hôpitaux sans but lucratif, aux hôpitaux provinciaux et aux hôpitaux municipaux).** Hôpital reconnu par la province comme "public". Un tel hôpital ne vise ordinairement pas à réaliser des bénéfices.

**Privé à but lucratif.** S'applique aux hôpitaux reconnus par la province comme "privés à but lucratif"; il s'agit d'un hôpital qu'un particulier ou un organisme privé possède et exploite en vue de réaliser des bénéfices.

**Hôpital fédéral.** Hôpital appartenant à un ministère ou à un organisme du gouvernement du Canada et ne visant pas à réaliser des bénéfices.

#### Genre de service

##### Hôpital général

**Sans unités de soins à long terme.** Hôpital qui assure principalement des soins de courte durée (diagnostic et traitement) d'une grande variété d'affections et de traumatismes, sans distinction d'âge et de sexe.

**Avec unités de soins à long terme.** S'applique à un hôpital comprenant un groupe de lits ou de chambres ou une aile ou un bâtiment séparé qui est considéré comme quartier de traitement distinct. Pour y être admis, il faut en général remplir les formalités de demande d'admission, même s'il s'agit d'un transfert d'un autre quartier de l'hôpital.

**Teaching hospital.** Applies to a hospital which provides medical education programs, approved by the appropriate authorities, for the major (not only elective) clinical instruction in at least the medical disciplines of internal medicine and general surgery to undergraduate medical students in their final two years.

### Allied Special Hospitals

Includes specialty, rehabilitation, extended care and other hospitals.

**Specialty.** Applies to a hospital which provides for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of pediatric patients, generally 14 years of age and under.

**Pediatric.** Applies to a hospital which provides for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of pediatric patients, generally 14 year of age and under.

**Psychiatric.** Applies to a hospital which provides for the diagnosis and short-term treatment of patients with psychiatric conditions.

**Other.** Applies to a cancer hospital, cardiology hospital or institute institute of psychiatry, maternity hospital, neurological institute, orthopedic hospital, etc.

**Rehabilitation (including convalescent).** Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing assessment and treatment of patients whose condition is expected to improve significantly through the provision of physical medicine and other rehabilitative services.

**Extended care (including chronic).** Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing treatment of patients with long-term illness or with a low potential for recovery and who require regular medical assessment and continuing nursing care.

**Psychiatric (long term).** Applies to a hospital which provides primarily for the continuing assessment and treatment of patients with psychiatric conditions.

**Other.** Applies to Nursing Stations and Outpost Hospitals.

**Hôpital d'enseignement.** Hôpital qui offre des programmes d'enseignement médical, dûment approuvés par les autorités compétentes, pour la formation clinique des étudiants effectuant leurs deux dernières années d'études dans les disciplines majeures (non pas seulement facultatives), dont la médecine interne et la chirurgie générale.

### Hôpitaux spéciaux divers

Comprend les hôpitaux spécialisés, ceux de réadaptation, de soins prolongés, et les "autres" hôpitaux.

**Hôpital spécialisé.** Hôpital qui assure principalement des soins de courte durée (diagnostic et traitement) pour un nombre restreint de maladies ou de blessures, ou qui fournit une gamme étendue de services à des personnes d'un groupe particulier.

**Hôpital pédiatrique.** Hôpital qui se spécialise dans la diagnostic et le traitement à court terme des maladies chez les enfants, âgés généralement de 14 ans ou moins.

**Hôpital psychiatrique.** Hôpital qui assure des soins de courte durée (diagnostic et traitement) à des malades souffrant de troubles psychiatriques.

**Autres.** S'applique à un hôpital anticancéreux, à un hôpital ou institut de cardiologie, à un institut psychiatrique, à un hôpital obstétrique, à un institut de neurologie, à un hôpital orthopédique, etc.

**Hôpital de réadaptation (convalescence comprise).** Hôpital qui assure principalement la surveillance constante et le traitement des personnes dont l'état est censé s'améliorer à la suite de soins de médecine physique et de réadaptation.

**Hôpital de soins prolongés (Maladies chroniques comprises).** Hôpital qui dispense principalement des traitements à des personnes qui sont affectées de maladies de longue durée, à celles dont les chances de guérison sont restreintes, et qui requièrent des soins médicaux et infirmiers constants.

**Hôpital psychiatrique (soins prolongés).** Hôpital qui assure principalement l'évaluation et le traitement suivi à des malades souffrant de troubles psychiatriques.

**Autres.** S'applique aux postes infirmiers et aux hôpitaux éloignés.



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
