

An almost identical number of births, marriages and deaths were registered in October as in the same month of 1947. During October there were increases in births registered in Ontario and Saskatchewan as compared with October 1947, but these were counter-balanced by general decreases in all other provinces. Total births registered to date in 1948 were about 4 per cent lower than in the first 10 months of 1947.
