



Total number of births registered in Canada in July were about 7 per cent less than in July 1947. There were 198,304 births registered up to the end of July as compared with 211,662 in the corresponding months of 1947, a decline of 6.3 per cent.


Despite a 6 per cent increase in marriages in July as compared with July, 1947, the total number of marriages registered to date is 5 per cent below that of 1947.


Deaths from January to July were almost 3 per cent higher than in the same months of the previous year, with British Columbia showing the greatest increase.
