CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

SECTION I

Classification of Manufacturing Industries according to the Chief
Component Material of the Principal Products.

1. VEGETABLE PRODUCTS.

11. Fruit & Vegetable Preparations.

- 110 Fruit & Vegetable Preparations -
Includes canned fruits and vegetables; dehydrated and evaporated fruits and vegetables; jams, jellies and marmalades; fountain and glacé fruits; frozen and processed fruits; pickles, vinegar and cider, sauces and mincemeat.

12. Flour & Cereals.

- 120 Malt & Malt Products -
Includes barley malt, malt extracts, malt syrup and malt flour
- 121 Rice Mills -
Includes cleaned and polished rice, rice meal, etc.
- 122 Flour & Feed Mills -
This industry is divided into two sections, (a) flour mills, which include establishments manufacturing wheat flour and other cereals, and (b) feed mills, which include establishments engaged in custom and merchant grinding of grains other than wheat. The principal products of this industry are, wheat flour, chopped grain feed, shorts and middlings, bran, oatmeal and rolled oats.

13. Prepared Grain Foods & Confectionery.

- 130 Bread and other Bakery Products -
Includes bread, buns, pies, cakes, cookies and puddings.
- 131 Biscuits, Confectionery, Cocoa & Chocolate -
Includes plain, fancy and soda biscuits, pretzels, cocoa and chocolate, sugar and chocolate confectionery; chewing gum, and other confections such as salted nuts and popcorn. Ice Cream is also included as a subsidiary product.
- 133 Ice Cream Cones.
- 134 Macaroni, Vermicelli, etc. -
Includes macaroni, spaghetti, vermicelli, noodles, alphabets, etc.
- 135 Foods, Breakfast -
Includes breakfast foods ready to serve, such as corn, wheat and bran flakes, and other prepared cereals.
- 136 Feeds, Stock & Poultry -
Includes feeds, meals and tonics prepared for stock and poultry, fox and dog biscuits, etc.

2. ANIMAL PRODUCTS (except Textiles.)

20. Fish Processing.

- 200 Clam Canners
- 201 Lobster Canners
- 202 Salmon Canners
- 203 Sardine and other fish Canners
- 204 Fish Curing
- 205 Reduction Plants
- 206 Freezing Plants

21. Fur & Fur Products.

- 210 Fur Dressing & Dyeing -
Includes dressing, dyeing and other preparation of skins.
- 211 Fur Goods -
Includes fur coats, muffs, stoles, robes, gauntlets and gloves; but excludes fur hats and caps as principal products.

22. Leather & Leather Products.

- 220 Leather Tanneries -
Includes tanned, split and flexible, colored or other, specially finished leather.
- 221 Miscellaneous Leather Goods -
Includes harness and saddlery, trunks and valises, leather washers, laces, belts (part of apparel), straps, purses, handbags, tobacco pouches and bank book covers.
- 222 Belting, Leather
- 223 Boots and Shoes, Leather
- 224 Boot and Shoe Findings, Leather -
Includes boot and shoe findings and parts, such as counters, toe caps, heels and soles, insoles, but excludes felt goods and insoles.
- 225 Gloves and Mittens, Leather

23. Meat Products.

- 230 Meat Extracts -
Includes beef extracts, such as Oxo and Bovril.
- 231 Slaughtering and Meat Packing.
- 232 Sausages and Sausage Casings -
Includes sausage of various kinds, sausage casings and hog bungs.

24. Dairy Products.

- 240 Butter and Cheese
- 241 Dairy Products, Miscellaneous
Includes plants whose principal product is Ice Cream.

- 243 Concentrated Milk Products
Includes Condensed and Evaporated Milk, Milk Powder, etc.
- 244 Cheese, Processed
25. Animal Oils & Fats.
- 250 Animal Oils & Fats -
Includes tallow refining, lard, stearine, neatsfoot oils, and other extracts.
29. Miscellaneous.
- 290 Hair Goods, Animal and Human -
Includes products of human and animal hair, such as wigs and switches, curled and brushed hair, etc.

3. TEXTILES.

30. Cotton Textiles.
- 304 Cotton Yarn & Cloth -
Includes grey, bleached, printed or colored piece goods and yarns, blankets, curtains, etc., but excludes knitted goods.
- 305 Cotton Thread.
- 306 Batting & Wadding -
Includes absorbent cotton, batting and wadding.
- 307 Cotton & Wool Waste -
Includes waste of cotton and wool and wiping rags.
- 308 Cotton Textiles, Miscellaneous -
Includes: Comforters, curtains, bedspreads, tailors' supplies, etc.
31. Woollen Textiles.
- 310 Woollen Cloth -
Includes suitings, dress goods, overcoatings and cloakings, velours, plushes and mohairs, and other cut pile fabrics, blankets and other woollen fabrics and goods, but excludes knitted goods as chief products.
- 311 Woollen Yarns -
Includes yarn spun for sale or transfer, only.
- 312 Carpets, Mats & Rugs -
Includes Axminster, Wilton, Brussels, Tapestry and Oriental carpets and rugs made of cotton or wool; jute and cocoa fibre mats and matting; rag carpets and rugs, as well as new carpets and rugs made from old carpets.
- 313 Woollen Goods, Miscellaneous -
Includes felt of all kinds, such as boot and shoe felts; pulp and paper makers' felts; shoddy, mungo and wool extract; wool pulling and miscellaneous woollen textiles; but excludes felt hats.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

32. Silk, Artificial and real, and Silk Goods.

- 320 Silk and Silk Goods, Artificial and Real -
Includes fabrics, yarns and thread of natural and artificial silk and their mixtures with other fibres such as cotton and wool, but does not include knitted goods as principal product.

33. Linen Goods

- 330 Linen Goods -
Includes towels, napery and linen fire hose.

34. Hosiery, Knitted Goods and Fabric Gloves.

- 340 Hosiery & Knitted Goods -
Includes establishments whose chief product is knitted goods whether of cotton, wool, silk or other yarns.
- 341 Gloves & Mittens, Fabric -
Includes cotton, woollen, silk and other fabric gloves when produced as a principal product.

35. Dyeing & Finishing of Textiles.

- 350 Dyeing & Finishing of Textiles -
Includes the dyeing and finishing of cotton, wool, silk and other fabrics and yarns, when it is the principal operation of the plant reporting, or when it is carried on as a separate department of plants producing cottons, woollens and silks. When the dyeing and finishing is not carried on as a distinct department, it is included with its respective industry.

36. Garments & Personal Furnishings.

- 360 Clothing, men's factory, including furnishings -
Includes suits, overcoats and odd garments for men and boys, furnishings and work clothing.
- 364 Clothing, women's factory -
Includes suits and dresses, coats and cloaks, waists, skirts and blouses for women and children. Ladies' and children's wear, including underwear, lingerie and neckwear, such as scarves and mufflers for women and children, embroideries, pleating, hemstitching, etc.
- 367 Oiled & Waterproofed Clothing -
Includes rubberized clothing.
- 368 Corsets -
Includes corsets, girdles, brassieres and combination garments.
- 369 Clothing Contractors, men's
- 363 Clothing Contractors, women's.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

37. Hats & Caps.

370 Hats & Caps -

Includes straw hats and shapes, hats and caps of fur, felt and cloth. Millinery, factory made.

38. Cordage, Rope & Twine.

380 Cordage, rope and twine.

39. Miscellaneous.

390 Awnings, Tents & Sails -

Includes tarpaulins, flags and sleeping bags.

391 Bags, Cotton and Jute.

392 Miscellaneous Textiles -

Includes oilcloth and linoleum, window blinds, leatherette and other coated fabrics, parachutes, etc.

393 Flax Fibre

394 Narrow Fabrics -

Includes: laces, tapes, bindings, braids, ribbons, fringes, cords, etc.

4. WOOD AND PAPER PRODUCTS

40. Pulp & Paper Mills.

400-402 Pulp & Paper Mills -

400 - Pulp Mills -

Includes chemical and mechanical wood-pulp.

401 - Combined Pulp & Paper Mills -

Includes chemical and mechanical wood-pulp and paper and paperboards of all kinds (except coated and treated, see "Paper Products, Miscellaneous").

402 - Paper Mills -

Includes paper and paperboard of all kinds (except coated and treated, see "Paper Products, Miscellaneous").

41. Paper Goods.

410 Roofing Paper -

Includes asphalt saturated shingles and sidings, smooth surfaced and mineral surfaced roll roofings, and tar and asphalt saturated felts and sheatings.

411 Boxes & Bags, Paper -

Includes set-up, folding, corrugated and fibreboard boxes, corrugated paper and wrappers, paper bags of all kinds, fibre cans, mailing tubes, etc.

413 Wall Paper.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

- 414 Paper Products, Miscellaneous -
Includes the coating, treating, cutting and otherwise converting of paper and board (for example, clay coated and enamelled board and paper, gummed paper, waxed paper, creped paper, envelopes, paper napkins, packaged towel and toilet paper, cigarette papers and tubes, soda straws, etc.)
42. Printing Trades.
- 420 Printing and Bookbinding -
Includes general commercial or job printing from type, blank bound books (binders, counter check books, etc.), binding, ruling, etc.
- 421 Printing and Publishing -
Includes publishers of newspapers and periodicals who do their own printing.
- 422 Lithographing -
Includes products of establishments using the lithographic process of reproduction (chiefly posters, calendars, maps, playing cards, letter-heads, envelopes, etc.)
- 423 Engraving, Stereotyping and Electrotyping -
Includes photo-engraving, embossed or engraved plates, electrotyping, stereotyping, (Production of stock and bond certificates, banknotes, postage and revenue stamps, is chiefly reported in this industry.)
- 424 Blueprinting -
Includes blue prints and photostats.
- 425 Trade composition -
Includes monotype, linotype or hand typesetting for the Printing Trades.
43. Saw & Planing Mills
- 430 Sawmills -
Includes products of sawmills, shingle mills, lath mills, tie mills, veneer mills, shook mills, stave, heading and hoop mills, and mills for cutting-up, rossing or barking pulpwood.
- 431 Planing Mills, Sash and Door Factories -
Includes sash, doors and other mill-work, molding, matched and planed lumber.
- 432 Hardwood Flooring.
44. Furniture.
- 440 Furniture, Upholstering and Cabinetmaking -
Includes household furniture of all kinds, office and store furniture and fixtures, furniture for churches, schools and other public buildings, and cabinetmaking.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

- 441 Refrigerators, (Other than Gas & Electric).
Includes household and commercial refrigerators and cold storage counters.
45. Vehicles, chiefly of Wood.
- 450 Carriages, Wagons and Sleighs and Vehicle Supplies -
Includes complete wheeled vehicles and sleighs (horse-drawn), bodies and boxes for horse-drawn vehicles, wheels, hubs, spokes, bent goods and other parts for horse-drawn vehicles.
46. Containers.
- 460 Cooperage -
Includes barrels, casks, kegs, and other slack and tight cooperage.
- 461 Wooden Boxes -
Includes Berry boxes, fruit and vegetable baskets and crates, butter, cheese, fish, cigar and other boxes and containers.
47. Wood Turning.
- 470 Wood Turning -
Includes handles of all kinds, dowels, spools, bobbins and shuttles, insulator pins and brackets, etc.
49. Miscellaneous.
- 491 Woodenware -
Includes articles made almost entirely of wood and used in kitchens, bakeries, dairies, laundries, etc., such as clothes pins, washboards, pails and tubs and step, extension and other ladders.
- 492 Boatbuilding -
Includes canoes, rowboats, sailboats, motor boats and other small wooden vessels and pleasure craft.
- 493 Wood Preservation.
- 494 Lasts, Trees and other Wooden Shoe Findings -
Includes lasts, trees, pegs, shanks, heels, etc.
- 495 Coffins and Caskets -
Includes coffins, caskets, shells or rough boxes and other undertakers' supplies.
- 496 Beekeepers' and Poultrymen's Supplies.
- 497 Excelsior -
Includes excelsior and excelsior pads, mats and wrappers.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

- 498 **Miscellaneous Wooden Products -**
 Includes wooden pipes and conduits, sanitary woodwork, patterns and models, wood pulleys, children's, toy vehicles, baby carriages and sleighs, wooden rules, spinning wheels, etc.
- 499 **Charcoal -**
 Includes production of charcoal by burning. (See also "Hard Wood Distillation" - Industry 880)

5. IRON AND ITS PRODUCTS.

50. Primary Iron and Steel.

- 500-503 **Primary Iron and Steel, includes -**
- 500 - Pig Iron
 501 - Steel Ingots and Castings
 502 - Rolled Iron and Steel Products, including the hot and cold rolling of steel into blooms, billets, rails, bars, rods, etc.
 503 - Ferro-Alloys

51. Castings and Forgings.

- 510 **Iron Castings and Forgings -**
 Includes commerical iron castings, iron pipes and fittings, steel tubing, etc.
- 511 **Heating and Cooking Apparatus -**
 Includes stoves, furnaces, oil burners, etc.
- 512 **Machine Shops**
 Includes custom machine shops with a production in excess of \$5,000. per year. (New industry in 1941)

52. Machinery, Farm Implements, Boilers and Plate Work.

- 520 **Boilers, Tanks and Plate Work -**
 Includes heating and power boilers, heating radiators, storage tanks, pressure tanks, smokestacks, miscellantous plate work, etc.
- 521 **Agricultural Implements -**
 Includes only plants making as main products such articles as ploughs, threshers, binders, cream separators, etc.
- 522-523 **Machinery - includes:**
- 522 - Industrial Machinery, including pulp and paper machinery, wood-working machinery, elevators, waterwheels and turbines, mining and metallurgical machinery, etc.
- 523 - Office and Household Machinery, including washing machines, adding machines, typewriters, etc.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

53. Vehicles, principally of Iron and Steel.

- 530 Automobiles -
Includes passenger cars and commercial automobiles and parts made by automobile manufacturers.
- 531 Automobile Supplies -
Includes industries manufacturing automobile parts and accessories as main products, such as auto wheels, rims, axles, trailers, springs, bodies, etc.
- 532 Bicycles -
Includes bicycles for men, women and children, tricycles and miscellaneous bicycle parts.
- 533 Shipbuilding & Repairs.-
Includes all yards which build ships of 5 tons and over.
- 534 Aircraft and aircraft parts.

54. Railway Rolling Stock.

- 540 Railway Rolling Stock and equipment
Includes standard railway and electric cars, locomotives, and parts such as car wheels, brakes, tires and larger repair shops of Canadian National and Canadian Pacific Railways.

56. Wire & Wire Goods.

- 560 Wire and Wire Goods -
Includes the drawing of wire from rods, the production of nails and spikes, brads and tacks, staples, etc; the fabrication of woven wire products such as fencing, gates, wire cloth, screens, etc; and the manufacture of springs, chains, rope and cable, hoops and similar articles.

57. Sheet Metal Products.

- 570 Sheet Metal Products -
Includes tin cans, sheet metal building material, enamelled kitchenware, galvanized sheets, auto stampings, tinware, metal bottle caps, stove pipes, eavestroughing, steel office furniture, etc.

58. Hardware, Tools & Cultery.

- 580 Hardware Tools and Cultery -
Includes bolts, nuts and rivets, safety razors and blades, saws and parts, spades, shovels, forks, hoes, rakes, etc., builders' hardware, axes, files and rasps, small tools, etc.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

59. Miscellaneous.

- 590 Iron & Steel Products, Miscellaneous -
Includes ornamental iron work, steel forgings, safes and steel vaults, shoe shanks, etc.
- 599 Bridge building & Structural Steel Shapes -
Includes the fabrication and erection of buildings, bridges and other done in structural shape.

C. MANUFACTURES OF NON-FERROUS METALS.

61. Aluminum Products.

- 610 Aluminum Products -
Includes sheets, wire, shapes of aluminum, kitchen utensils and other fabricated products.

62. Brass & Copper Products.

- 620 Brass & Copper Products -
Includes the rolling and casting of copper, brass and bronze and the fabrication of brass and copper products such as castings and machinery fittings, brass, bronze and copper rods, plates, sheets and wire, taps, valves, plumbers' goods, etc.

63. White Metal Alloys.

- 630 White Metal Alloys -
Includes the manufacture of babbitt metal, reclaimed metals, lead bar and pipe, solders, collapsible tubes, phosphor-tin and similar products.

64. Jewellery & Silverware.

- 640 Jewellery & Silverware, and Other Precious Metal Products -
Includes the manufacture of sterling silverware, silverplated ware, jewellery, clocks and watches, gold, silver and platinum refined from scrap.

66. Electrical Apparatus.

- 650 Electrical Apparatus & Supplies -
Includes apparatus and supplies used in the transmission, generation and utilization of electrical energy such as radio apparatus, telephone material, generators and motors, incandescent lamps, vacuum cleaners, refrigerators, etc.

69. Miscellaneous Non-Ferrous Metal Products.

- 690 Miscellaneous Non-Ferrous Metal Products -
Includes lamps, lanterns, lamp and lantern burners, weatherstripping and similar products. Also in any compilation of manufactures, the Non-Ferrous Smelting and Refining Industry, classified under "Mining," is included in the main group of "Manufactures of Non-Ferrous Metals".

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

- M 20 Non-Ferrous Metal Smelting & Refining Industry -
Includes metallurgical industries operating mainly on Canadian ores, such as the smelting and refining of copper ores, silver-lead-zinc ores, nickel-copper ores, silver-cobalt ores and the smelting of imported bauxite ores for aluminum ingots and bars; but excludes milling cyaniding of gold and silver ores which is included with mining operations owing to the difficulty of drawing the line of demarcation.

7. NON-METALLIC MINERAL PRODUCTS.

70. Asbestos Products.

- 700 Asbestos Products -
Includes asbestos packing, brake linings, pipe covering, paper gaskets, shingles, lumber, etc.

71. Coke & Gas Products.

- 710-711 Coke & Gas Products - includes:
710 - Coke and its By-Products, including coke produced in bee-hive and by-product ovens; but excludes coke produced as a by-product in the manufacture of illuminating and fuel gas and in the refining of petroleum.
711 - Illuminating and Fuel Gas, including coal gas, water gas, and producer gas; but excludes gas recovered as a by-product in the manufacture of coke and in the refining of petroleum.

72. Products from Imported Clays.

- 720 Clay Products from Imported Clays -
Includes porcelain insulators, firebrick, pottery and earthenware from special clays imported for the purpose.

73. Glass and Its Products.

- 730-731 Glass Products - includes:
730 - Pressed and Blown Glass, including bottles, jars, etc.
731 - Plate, Cut and Ornamental Glass, including the bevelling, cutting and bending of glass to make leaded glass, ornamental glass, memorial windows, mirror plate, etc.

74. Artificial Abrasives & Abrasive Products.

- 740-741 Abrasive Products - includes:
740 - Artificial Abrasives, including fused alumina, silicon carbide, etc.
741 - Abrasive Products, including abrasive wheels, abrasive paper, sharpening stones, etc.

CLASSIFICATION OF MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

75. Petroleum Products.

- 750 Lubrication Oils and Greases -
Includes blending of oils and manufacture of greases in other than refineries.
- 751 Petroleum Refining -
Includes all refiners' products.

76. Stone Products.

- 760 Stone Products -
Includes the cutting and finishing of stone for building or monumental purposes; but excludes the primary production or quarrying of stone and stone finished for market by quarrying concerns; rock wool.

77. Cement Products & Sand-lime Brick.

- 770 Cement Products -
Includes cement blocks, sewer pipe, drain pipe, etc.
- 771 Sand-lime Brick.

79. Miscellaneous Non-Metallic Mineral Products.

- 790 and 799 Miscellaneous Non-Metallic Mineral Products -
Includes;
790 - Gypsum Products, including gypsum wallboard, tile and hard wall plaster.
799 - Miscellaneous Non-Metallic Mineral Products, including foundry supplies, asphalt emulsions, mica products, carbon, and graphite electrodes, etc.
Also, in any compilation of manufactures, the following industries, classified under "Mining" are included in the main group "The Manufactures of Non-Metallic Minerals."

8. CHEMICALS and ALLIED PRODUCTS.

80. Coal Tar Distillation.

- 800 Coal Tar Distillation -
Includes creosote and special oils, pitch, tar, etc.

81. Acids, Alkalies, Salts & Compressed Gases.

- 810 Acids, Alkalies & Salts -
Includes industrial chemicals, such as sulphuric, hydrochloric and nitric acids, caustic soda, salt cake, calcium carbide, cyanamide and phosphorus.

- 811 Gases, Compressed -
Includes oxygen, hydrogen, carbon dioxide and acetylene.

82. Explosives, Ammunition & Fireworks.

- 820-822 Explosives, Ammunition & Fireworks -
Includes:
820 - Explosives, including gun powder, nitrate mixtures, dynamites, propellant powders, and intermediate products such as nitric acid, nitroglycerine and recovered acids used again in the manufacture of commodities for sale.
821 - Ammunition - including small arms, cartridges, artillery shells, smoke bombs, safety fuse for blasting, safety cartridges, fog signals, shot shells, fuses, etc.
822 - Fireworks including civilian and military pyrotechnics.

83. Fertilizers.

- 830 Fertilizers -
Includes superphosphate, bone flour and meal, mixed fertilizers, ammonium phosphate, ammonium sulphate, etc.

84. Medicinal & Pharmaceutical Preparations.

- 840 Medicinal & Pharmaceutical Preparations -
Includes patent and proprietary medicines, standard pharmaceutical preparations, veterinary medicines, etc.

85. Paints, Pigments & Varnishes.

- 850 Paints, Pigments & Varnishes -
Includes mixed paints ready for use, varnishes, white lead, enamels, colors in oil, dry colors.

86. Soaps and Washing Compounds, Cleaning Compounds and Toilet Preparations.

- 860-862 Soaps, Washing Compounds and Cleaning Preparations - includes:
860 - Soaps.
861 - Washing Compounds, including javelle water, ammonia powder, etc.
862 - Cleaning Preparations, including scouring powders, hand cleaner, etc.

Includes perfumes, cosmetics, tooth paste, etc.

9. MISCELLANEOUS INDUSTRIES

91. Household Equipment.
- 910 Brooms, brushes and mops -
Includes brooms and whisks; toilet, paint and household brushes; floor, dust and dish mops.
- 911 Mattresses and Springs -
