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FLUID MILK TRADE
in the
PRINCIPAL MARKETS OF CANADA
1945, 1946 and 1947

The data for the forty markets covered in this report are a fair index of the situation in Canada as a whole. It should be remembered, however, that conditions in the larger cities of the Dominion may not always apply to the smaller urban markets where somewhat lower prices and nearness to the source of supply frequently establish a slightly higher level of consumption. The distribution of milk and cream in these forty markets represents about one-half of the total distribution, the remainder being distributed in hundreds of small towns, villages and hamlets for which accurate records are not obtainable. During the last few years the number of milk distributors in Canada suffered a considerable reduction. In 1946, approximately 992 were operating in the forty markets covered by this report. In 1947, this number had fallen to 879. On the basis of claims made to the Commodity Prices Stabilization Corporation in 1944 for the consumer subsidy it was estimated that there were approximately 15,000 distributors of milk in Canada. It is possible that this number has now been reduced to about 12,000.

Volume of fluid milk sales during the period under review was affected by high purchasing power, government subsidies and demobilization of service personnel. Increases in sales were most significant during the latter part of 1945 and early 1946 when demobilization of armed forces and return of personnel to Canada was taking place. A temporary decline occurred after June 1, 1946 when the consumer government subsidy of 2 cents per quart was discontinued and milk prices to consumers were increased by this amount. A more pronounced decline in sales occurred in September 1946 when the government removed the subsidy paid to producers of fluid milk. Price increases to compensate producers were permitted by provincial milk control boards and increases to consumers ranging from 1-1/2 to 3 cents per quart resulted. The general cost of living rose rapidly during this period and this no doubt had an adverse effect on the volume of milk purchased by consumers.

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Milk Sales: The data which appear in Table 1, pages 6 to 11, reveal the variations in the sales and distribution of milk during the three-year period under review. Between 1945 and 1946, milk sales advanced in 28 out of the 36 markets for which statistics are available. In the subsequent period the opposite situation was revealed, showing a reduction in milk sales in all but three markets. A summary statement of milk sales for the two principal population groups appears in the table below with percentage changes from 1945 to 1946, and from 1946 to 1947.

Note: The grouping of these markets is based on the 1941 Census of Population, except in the Prairie Provinces where the 1946 census data are employed.

Cream Sales: Sales of cream during 1946 remained comparatively steady, but generally reflected the upward movement in milk sales, 33 out of 36 markets showing sales increases as compared with the previous year. Due to the removal of the war-time restrictions on April 1, 1947, cream sales followed the opposite trend to those of milk. Consequently, 24 markets showed higher sales in 1947 than in 1946. Analysing 1947 by population groups, it will be seen from the table above that quart sales increased 4½ per cent in the larger markets, and 10 per cent in markets of 10,000 to 100,000 population. However, on a butter-fat basis, cream sales in 1947 were up 17 per cent in the larger centres and 27 per cent in the other group.

SALES VALUES OF MILK AND CREAM

Milk: Sales values reported in this statement showed the effect of increased sales in 1946 and price increases in both 1946 and 1947. In reviewing the data shown in Table 2, pages 12 to 17, it will be seen that sales values advanced in all markets during 1946 and 1947. Markets with a population of 100,000 people or more showed a percentage gain of approximately 26 per cent in 1946 over 1945, and a percentage gain of 19 per cent in 1947 over 1946. In the other group respective gains of 22 per cent and 14 per cent were recorded.

Cream: Out of 36 markets for which statistics are available, sales values increased in all but one market between 1945 and 1946, while all markets reported increases between 1946 and 1947. In the population range of 100,000 or more percentage gains of 17 per cent and 27 per cent were recorded between 1945 and 1946, and between 1946 and 1947, respectively.

CONSUMPTION OF FLUID MILK

Figures showing the consumption of fluid milk for the two principal population groups appear in the statement below showing the sales in quarts, population and daily per capita consumption for the years 1945, 1946 and 1947.

MILK PRICES PER QUART

Average prices of milk in cents per quart (Table 3, pages 18 to 23), and average prices of cream (Table 9, pages 54 to 59), cover all grades and classes of these products, including high test and low test milk and cream sold at wholesale and retail prices. If reference is made to the Board Orders and basic prices shown in Table 13, pages 78 to 87, it will be observed that the prices set by provincial agencies do not correspond with the averages per unit shown in the aforesaid tables. Variations are due to differences in the butter-fat content of cream, and the proportion of special milk, jersey and guernsey milk included in the milk sales.

MILK BOARDS AND PRICE CONTROL

In collecting the statistics shown in this report, the Milk Control Boards of the Provinces have co-operated very closely with the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. In Ontario and Quebec the Milk Boards have province-wide authority. Elsewhere, the Milk Control Boards exercise jurisdiction only in those markets where conditions make it necessary for price regulations to be established. Wide differences also exist in the authority vested in these Boards by provincial legislation. The names of the various Boards and the authority under which they operate follow:

Prince Edward Island Milk Control Board was authorized by special act of 1938; revised in 1941 under new name with province-wide powers.

Nova Scotia Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities: Responsible for milk control from 1944. (Arbitration Commission functioned from 1938 to 1944).

New Brunswick Dairy Products Commission: (Dairy Products Act, 1935)

Quebec Dairy Industry Commission: (Appointed in 1934 under Milk and Dairy Products Act of 1925 as amended in 1933).

The Milk Control Board of Ontario: (Special Act of 1934 superseded by Milk Control Act of 1948).

The Manitoba Milk Control Board: (Functioned under Municipal and Public Utility Act from 1932 to 1937; changed to present name under special Act of 1937).


Saskatchewan Milk Control Board: (Special legislation - 1935)

Alberta Board of Public Utility Commissioners has functioned as a control agency since 1933.

The Milk Board (British Columbia): (Organized in 1946 under authority of the Public Utility Act).




AVERAGE PRICES PAID TO FARMERS FOR FLUID MILK

IN DOLLARS PER ONE HUNDRED POUNDS - F.O.B. PLANT




AVERAGE PRICES PAID TO FARMERS FOR FLUID CREAM

IN CENTS PER POUND BUTTER-FAT — F.O.B. PLANT





Vancouver and Victoria: Buying prices for standard milk have been established on a basic butter-fat test of 3.5 per cent. There is now a $6\frac{1}{2}$ cent differential on each one-tenth of one per cent variation from the basic test, but prior to November 1, 1947, the differential was 5 cents. Standard butter-fat tests for sales have been established by the Milk Board as follows: standard milk, 3.5 per cent, cereal cream, 9 per cent, table cream, 18 per cent and whipping cream, 32 per cent.

Prices in the Nanaimo and Duncan markets, under control since August 1, 1947, are the same as those in Victoria.

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
