



INTRODUCTION

I. CONCEPTS, DEFINITIONS AND CLASSIFICATIONS USED IN WHOLESALE TRADE STATISTICS

The Statistical Concept of Wholesale Trade

Wholesalers are primarily engaged in buying merchandise for resale to retailers; to industrial, commercial, institutional and professional users; to other wholesalers; or in acting as agents in connection with such transactions.

Mixed-activity businesses (such as firms engaged both in wholesaling and retailing, contracting, service trades, manufacturing, etc.) are considered to be primarily in wholesale trade whenever they derive a larger gross margin from wholesale than from any other activity. (The gross margin is the difference between the total sales and the cost of goods sold. As the 1966 questionnaire did not seek information on the cost of goods sold, the 1961 gross margins were used for the classification of establishments.)

The delineation between wholesale and retail activity is based on the "class of buyer" criterion. If a larger share of the gross margin is obtained from sales to retailers, industrial, commercial, institutional or professional users than from sales to households or private individuals for personal use (including sales to farmers for non-farm use), the business is classified to wholesale trade. Certain businesses are considered to be in wholesale trade disregarding the class of customer breakdown of their sales. These businesses deal in the following commodities: office furniture, lumber and building materials, farm supplies and all kinds of machinery and equipment.

Wholesale statistics measure the total volume of Canadian wholesale trade; this is the aggregate business conducted by all wholesalers operating in Canada, whether Canadian or foreign and whether sales are domestic or abroad. The total volume of trade measured by statistics is not identical with the value of goods passing through the wholesale sector of the economy: at times wholesale firms sell to each other and thus the value of the same merchandise may be recorded twice or more in the total volume of wholesale trade. No attempt is made to eliminate such duplications.

Establishment and Location Series

Wholesale statistics are collected in two ways; at the establishment and at the location level.

The establishment concept is based primarily on the system of accounting used in business. The establishment is defined as the smallest unit which is a separate operating entity capable of reporting those elements of input and output necessary to the calculation of gross margin, as well as employment, wages and salaries.

The location is defined as the physical outlet in which business activity takes place. The location is not necessarily dependent upon the availability of accounting-based data but must be capable of providing a limited range of statistics even though these may have to be estimated. Where the accounting records are designed to measure the detailed business activity of a single location, the establishment and location coincide; otherwise two or more locations belong to a certain establishment.

I. CONCEPTS, DEFINITIONS ET CLASSIFICATIONS UTILISÉS DANS LA STATISTIQUE DU COMMERCE DE GROS

Concept statistique du commerce de gros

Les grossistes ont pour activité principale l'achat de marchandises en vue de leur revente à des détaillants, des industries, des commerçants, des institutions, des professionnels, d'autres grossistes; ils peuvent également servir d'agents à l'occasion de ces opérations.

Les entreprises à activité mixte (telles que les entreprises de vente de gros exerçant en même temps comme détaillants ou comme entrepreneurs, prestataires de service, fabricants, etc.) ont pour activité principale le commerce de gros lorsque la plus grande partie de leur marge brute de profit provient du commerce de gros plutôt que d'une autre activité. (La marge brute de profit est la différence entre le total des ventes et le prix de revient. Comme le questionnaire de 1966 ne posait pas de question sur le prix de revient, les marges brutes pour 1961 ont servi à classer les établissements.)

La distinction entre le commerce de gros et le commerce de détail se base sur la "catégorie d'acheteur". Si la plus grande partie de la marge brute provient de ventes à des détaillants, des industries, des commerçants, des institutions, des professionnels, plutôt que de ventes à des ménages ou à des particuliers pour leur usage personnel (y compris les ventes à des exploitants agricoles en vue d'un usage autre qu'agricole), le commerce est classé dans la catégorie "vente de gros". Certaines entreprises sont classées dans le commerce de gros malgré la répartition de leurs ventes par catégorie de client. L'activité de ces entreprises porte sur les marchandises suivantes: matériel de bureau, bois d'œuvre et matériaux de construction, fournitures agricoles et toutes sortes de types de machines et de matériel.

Les statistiques du commerce de gros mesurent le volume total des ventes de gros au Canada. Il s'agit là de l'activité totale de tous les grossistes commerciant au Canada, qu'ils soient canadiens ou étrangers et que les ventes soient destinées au Canada ou à l'étranger. Le chiffre d'affaires obtenu par les statistiques n'est pas identique à la valeur des biens passant par le secteur du commerce de gros de l'économie, car parfois il y a des échanges commerciaux entre diverses entreprises de gros, ce qui fait que la valeur de la même marchandise peut être comptée deux fois ou même davantage dans le chiffre d'affaires du commerce de gros. On n'a pris aucune mesure pour supprimer ces chevauchements.

Établissements et locaux d'affaires

Les statistiques sur le commerce de gros sont recueillies de deux manières: au niveau de l'établissement et au niveau du local d'affaires.

Le concept de l'établissement s'appuie essentiellement sur le système comptable utilisé dans le commerce. L'établissement est la plus petite unité constituant un ensemble d'exploitations séparé en mesure de déclarer tous les éléments qui y sont mis en oeuvre ou produits et qui sont nécessaires au calcul de la marge brute, ainsi que les effectifs occupés et la rémunération des salariés.

Le local d'affaires est le point de vente réel où a lieu l'activité commerciale. Le local d'affaires ne dépend pas obligatoirement de la disponibilité de données comptables, mais il doit pouvoir fournir un nombre limité de données statistiques même s'il y a lieu de procéder par estimation. Lorsque les dossiers comptables servent à mesurer l'activité commerciale détaillée d'un seul local d'affaires, l'établissement et le local d'affaires se confondent; dans le cas contraire, deux ou plusieurs locaux d'affaires appartiennent à un même établissement donné.

Statistics on wholesale trade establishments and locations do not completely overlap as wholesale trade establishments also operate non-wholesale locations and, conversely, there are wholesale trade locations which do not belong to wholesale trade establishments. For example: a wholesale establishment may operate two wholesale and one retail locations and a service establishment may operate a service and a wholesale trade location.

Types of Operations

According to certain common characteristics, each wholesale establishment and location is assigned to one of the following types of operations:

1. Primary Product Dealers

Establishments mainly engaged in purchasing primary products, such as grain, livestock, raw furs, fish, leaf tobacco, pulpwood, etc., directly from Canadian farmers, loggers, fisherman and trappers or acting as agents in such transactions. Co-operative marketing associations marketing products of their members are considered as primary product dealers.

2. Wholesale Merchants

Establishments primarily engaged in buying and selling goods on own account. Such a business may be described as export and/or import merchant, cash and carry wholesaler, drop shipper or desk jobber, mail order wholesaler, truck distributor, rack jobber, voluntary group wholesaler, etc.

3. Agents and Brokers

Establishments primarily engaged in buying and/or selling products for others on a commission basis. They may be known as auction company, commission merchant, export and/or import agent or broker, manufacturer's agent, purchasing agent or resident buyer, selling agent, etc. Not every agent or broker is classified to this type of operation. An agent dealing in primary products by buying directly from Canadian farmers is classified as a Primary Product Dealer (type 1); agency-type wholesale operations by manufacturers as a Manufacturer's Sales Branch (type 4) and agents dealing primarily in petroleum products as a Petroleum Bulk Tank Plant and Truck Distributors (type 5).

4. Manufacturers' Sales Branches

Wholesale businesses owned by manufacturing firms for marketing their own products. Those manufacturers' sales branches which are not separate accounting entities but mere extensions of the manufacturing plant(s) (and thus do not mark up their goods received from the parent plant nor are they remunerated on a commission basis by the parent company) are part of the manufacturing establishments and as such were considered to be out of scope for Wholesale Trade Statistics.

5. Petroleum Bulk Tank Plants and Truck Distributors

Businesses primarily engaged in the wholesale distribution of petroleum products, such as salaried, independent or agency operated bulk tank plants and independent or agency type truck distributors.

Les statistiques sur les établissements de commerce de gros et sur les locaux d'affaires ne se recouvrent pas entièrement car les établissements de commerce de gros exploitent aussi des locaux d'affaires qui ne vendent pas en gros et, vice versa, il y a des locaux d'affaires de commerce de gros qui n'appartiennent pas aux établissements de commerce de gros. Par exemple: un établissement de vente de gros peut exploiter deux locaux d'affaires de commerce de gros et un de commerce de détail, et un établissement de service peut exploiter un local d'affaires de service et un de commerce de gros.

Genres d'exploitations

À partir de certaines caractéristiques communes, chaque établissement de vente de gros est classé dans l'un des genres d'exploitations suivants:

1. Commerçants en produits primaires

Établissements dont l'activité principale consiste à acheter des produits primaires tels que les céréales, le bétail, les fourrures non traitées, le poisson, le tabac en feuilles, la pulpe de bois, etc., directement aux exploitants agricoles et forestiers, aux pêcheurs et aux trappeurs canadiens ou à servir d'agents à l'occasion de telles opérations. On considère les coopératives de vente qui mettent sur le marché les produits primaires de leurs membres comme des commerçants en produits primaires.

2. Grossistes

Établissements dont l'activité principale consiste à acheter et à vendre pour leur propre compte. Cette catégorie comprend les grossistes en exportation ou en importation, en vente au comptant sans livraison, les grossistes spécialisés en expédition directe, en vente par correspondance, en répartition par empiècement, en vente en moyen d'étalages placés chez les clients, en vente aux chaînes volontaires de commerçants, etc.

3. Agents et courtiers

Établissements dont l'activité principale est l'achat ou la vente à la commission de marchandises appartenant à d'autres. Ces établissements peuvent porter la désignation de sociétés de vente aux enchères, de commissionnaires en marchandises, d'agents ou courtiers en importation ou en exportation, de représentants de fabricants, d'agents d'achat et acheteurs, d'agents de vente, etc. On ne classe pas tous les agents ou courtiers dans cette catégorie; un agent dont l'activité porte sur les produits primaires qu'il achète directement aux fermiers canadiens est considéré comme un commerçant en produits primaires (1^{er} type); les activités de gros du type agence assurées par des fabricants feront partie des succursales de vente des fabricants (4^e type), tandis que les agents dont le commerce porte principalement sur les produits du pétrole feront partie des dépôts et distributeurs par camion-citerne de produits pétroliers (5^e type).

4. Succursales de vente des fabricants

Établissements de vente de gros que les entreprises manufacturières possèdent pour la commercialisation de leurs propres produits. Les succursales de vente des fabricants qui n'ont pas de comptabilité distincte mais constituent de simples prolongations des usines (qui n'ajoutent donc aucune marge de profit aux biens qu'elles reçoivent de la fabrique mère, et qui ne sont pas payées à la commission par la compagnie mère) font partie des établissements manufacturiers, ce qui les fait exclure du champ de la statistique du commerce de gros.

5. Dépôts et distributeurs par camion-citerne de produits pétroliers

Entreprises dont l'activité principale consiste en la distribution en gros des produits du pétrole. Par exemple: dépôts de pétrole en vrac exploités par un personnel salarié ou indépendant ou par une agence; distributeurs par camion-citerne fonctionnant à titre indépendant ou sous forme d'agence.

Where a wholesale establishment or location is engaged in more than one type of operation, it is classified to the primary type accounting for the largest part of its gross margin. In case of an agency or brokerage operation, the total amount of commission received represents the gross margin. For example, a certain establishment is partly a wholesale merchant and partly an agent and earns \$20,000 gross margin on own account business and receives a revenue of \$30,000 from commissions. As the commission income exceeds the margin earned on own account transactions, the establishment or location is classified to the Agents and Brokers type.

Kind of Business Classification

In addition to being assigned to a certain type of operation, each wholesale establishment and location is also classified to one of 158 Kinds of businesses, according to the major commodity handled (such as Raw Furs, Office Furniture, Flour, etc.)

When classifying an establishment or a location to a certain Kind of business, the "value added" method (comparison of gross margins earned on various commodities) is not applied, the decision is based on the percentage shares of various commodities in total sales.

II. STATISTICAL MEASUREMENT OF WHOLESALE TRADE

Business activities of wholesalers are measured in two ways:

- (a) By full coverage censuses every five years. These surveys collect a wide range of statistics on establishments and a limited range of information on locations for all the 158 Kinds of businesses and for all 5 types of operations. The establishment series are broken down into 5 regions within Canada, while the location series are published for provinces, counties and for incorporated places of over 5,000 population. The last census was taken for 1966 and the next census will take place in 1972 for 1971. Because of lack of resources, only the establishment series were completed and published for 1966 (see: "Wholesale Trade, 1966, Establishments", Cat. No. 96-627 \$1.50), the location series were cancelled.
- (b) Monthly, by estimated figures calculated from information supplied by a panel of reporting establishments. In comparison with the census, the following points should be noted on the monthly survey:
 - (1) It covers only Wholesale Merchants, the most important type of operation and does not attempt to measure the business activities of primary product dealers, agents and brokers, manufacturers' sales branches and the petroleum trade. Wholesale merchants accounted for over 60 % of total wholesale sales of \$31,172 million as measured by the 1966 Census.
 - (2) It is establishment-based.
 - (3) Because of the limitations imposed by sample size, the monthly estimates are not available for the 5 regions, only for Canada.
 - (4) For the same reason, it is not possible to provide separate estimates for each of the 158 Kinds of businesses; they are aggregated into 26 trade groups in the monthly reports.

Lorsqu'un établissement de commerce de gros a plusieurs genres d'exploitations, il est classé selon l'activité d'où provient la plus grande partie de sa marge brute. Lorsque cet établissement est exploité par des agents ou par des courtiers, le montant total des commissions reçues représente la marge brute. On peut citer comme exemple un établissement qui est à la fois grossiste et en partie agent, qui gagne \$20,000 sous forme de marge brute pour compte propre et touche \$30,000 sous forme de commissions. Du fait que les recettes provenant des commissions dépassent la marge sur les opérations pour compte propre, l'établissement est classé dans la catégorie des agents et courtiers.

Genre de commerce

Chaque établissement de vente de gros et chaque local d'affaires, autre leur classification dans un "genre d'exploitation", sont également classés dans l'un des 158 genres de commerce, suivant les principales marchandises qu'ils traitent (par exemple, fourrures non traitées, articles de bureau, farine, etc.).

Pour classer un établissement ou un local d'affaires dans un genre de commerce donné, la méthode de la "valeur ajoutée" (comparaison des marges brutes gagnées pour diverses marchandises) n'est pas utilisée: on se base sur la part proportionnelle des différentes marchandises par rapport au total des ventes.

II. MESURE STATISTIQUE DU COMMERCE DE GROS

Les activités des commerçants de gros se mesurent de deux manières:

- (a) À l'aide de recensements quinquennaux complets: ces enquêtes collectent une grande variété de statistiques sur les établissements et un petit nombre de renseignements représentatifs sur les locaux d'affaires pour les 158 genres de commerce et pour les 5 types d'exploitations. Les données sur les établissements sont ventilées en 5 régions au Canada alors que les renseignements sur les locaux d'affaires sont publiés pour les provinces, les comtés et les endroits constitués en municipalités de plus de 5,000 habitants. Le dernier recensement a été effectué en 1966 et le prochain aura lieu en 1972 pour 1971. En raison du manque de ressources, seuls les renseignements sur les établissements ont été dépouillés et publiés pour 1966 (voir: "Commerce de détail, 1966, Établissements," no 96-627 au catalogue, \$1.50) et les renseignements sur les locaux d'affaires ont été laissés de côté.
- (b) Chaque mois, à l'aide de chiffres estimatifs calculés à partir de renseignements fournis par un groupe d'établissements enquêtés. Lors de la comparaison avec le recensement, il faut tenir compte des points suivants pour l'enquête mensuelle:
 - (1) Elle ne concerne que les grossistes, l'aspect le plus important du commerce, ne cherche pas à mesurer les activités commerciales des commerçants en produits primaires, des agents et courtiers, des succursales de vente des fabricants ni le commerce du pétrole. Les ventes des grossistes représentaient plus de 60 % du total des ventes de gros (soit 31,172 millions de dollars), dans le recensement de 1966.
 - (2) Elle est fondée sur l'établissement.
 - (3) À cause des limites imposées par la taille de l'échantillon, les estimations mensuelles ne sont pas disponibles pour les 5 régions mais seulement pour le Canada.
 - (4) Pour la même raison, il est impossible de fournir des estimations séparées pour chacun des 158 genres de commerce; ils sont rassemblés en 26 groupes de commerce dans les bulletins mensuels.

(5) The monthly panel measures only two characteristics of wholesale trade: total volume of trade (total sales, all other revenues plus the value of goods handled on commission), and the actual or calculated values of inventories.

(6) The estimates are not adjusted for price changes, seasonal variations or number of business days in the respective months.

III. INTERCENSAL AND POSTCENSAL REVISIONS OF MONTHLY WHOLESALE TRADE ESTIMATES

Data derived from censuses are considered as final actual measurement of business activities. Samples, on the other hand, result only in approximation of actual facts. Therefore, previous estimates produced by sampling the universe are revised in the light of census information. Revisions after a census are necessary for three reasons:

(a) Due to sampling errors

(b) The current sample does not reflect changes resulting from the reclassification of businesses for the interval between the base years; and

(c) Sample estimates do not take into account increases due to new businesses entering the field and decreases due to closing down of existing businesses.

The previous revision of the wholesale trade estimates were published in "Wholesale Trade, 1951-1968" Cat. No. 63-515, occasional, in April 1969. This revision was based on the results of the 1961 census and on an unpublished 1964 full coverage survey.

The revised estimates, incorporated in this publication, have been calculated by using the 1961 and 1966 census results as benchmarks. These estimates fall into two categories:

(a) Intercensal revisions for the period 1961 to 1966. These are final data subject to no further revisions. The figures for the intervening years and the monthly data reflect the trends as measured by the sample.

(b) Postcensal revisions for the period 1967 to 1971. These data use 1966 Census results as the new base, and for the period of 1967 to 1970 they are also adjusted for birth of new businesses and death of existing establishments. They cannot be considered as final data because they will be subject to a final revision after the completion of the 1971 census of wholesale trade.

IV. ANNUAL AND MONTHLY INVENTORY STATISTICS

The present publication contains information on end-of-year inventories for the years of 1961 to 1966 and monthly inventories from January 1967 to December 1971.

It should be noted that monthly inventories reported by members of the panel are often not based on actual stock-taking but only on a calculated value derived by comparing the value of the last actual stock-taking with sales and purchases.

In certain trades the reporting of inventory data was considered unsatisfactory and, therefore, the results are not disclosed in this publication.

(5) Le groupe mensuel permet de mesurer seulement deux caractéristiques du commerce de gros: le volume total du commerce (ventes totales, plus toutes les autres recettes, plus la valeur des marchandises vendues à commission), et la valeur réelle ou calculée des stocks.

(6) Les estimations ne sont pas corrigées en fonction des variations de prix, des variations saisonnières ou du nombre de jours ouvrables dans chaque mois.

III. RÉVISIONS INTERCENSITAIRES ET POSTCENSITAIRES DES ESTIMATIONS MENSUELLES DU COMMERCE DE GROS

Les données provenant du recensement sont considérées comme des mesures définitives réelles des activités commerciales. Par contre, les échantillons ne permettent d'obtenir qu'une approximation des faits réels. Les estimations antérieures produites par l'échantillonnage de l'univers sont donc révisées à la lumière des données du recensement. Les révisions qui suivent un recensement sont nécessaires pour trois raisons:

(a) Il a pu se produire des erreurs d'échantillonnage.

(b) L'échantillon actuel ne reflète pas les changements occasionnés par les reclassements commerciaux au cours de l'intervalle entre les années de base; et

(c) Les estimations de l'échantillon ne tiennent pas compte des augmentations dues aux nouveaux établissements qui ont ouvert leurs portes et des diminutions dues à la fermeture d'entreprises déjà existantes.

Le bulletin Commerce de gros, 1951-1968 (n° 63-515 au catalogue), hors série, publié en avril 1969 contient la révision antérieure des estimations du commerce de gros. Cette révision est basée sur les résultats du recensement de 1961 et sur une enquête générale menée en 1964 et non publiée.

Les résultats des recensements de 1961 et de 1966 ont servi de base au calcul des estimations révisées qui sont contenues dans le présent bulletin. Ces estimations se divisent en deux catégories:

(a) révisions intercensitaires pour la période 1961 à 1966. Ce sont des données définitives, non sujettes à rectification. Les chiffres pour les années intervenantes et les données mensuelles reflètent les tendances mesurées par l'échantillon.

(b) révisions postcensitaires pour la période 1967 à 1971. La nouvelle base de ces données est constituée par les résultats du recensement de 1966; de plus, pour la période 1967 à 1970, ces données sont ajustées pour tenir compte de l'apparition de nouveaux établissements et de la disparition de certains établissements qui existaient. Il ne s'agit pas de données définitives car elles sont sujettes à une dernière rectification, quand le recensement du commerce de gros de 1971 sera terminé.

IV. STATISTIQUES SUR LES STOCKS ANNUELS ET MENSUELS

Le présent bulletin contient des renseignements sur les stocks de fin d'année pour les années de 1961 à 1966 et sur les stocks mensuels de janvier 1967 à décembre 1971.

Il convient de remarquer que les stocks mensuels déclarés par les participants du groupe ne sont pas toujours basés sur le compte réel des stocks mais qu'ils proviennent de la comparaison entre le dernier compte réel et les ventes et achats.

Le bulletin ne contient pas les résultats relatifs à certains établissements car les données relatives à leurs stocks n'ont pas été jugées satisfaisantes.




