TRADE OF CANADA WITH SOUTH AMERICA, CENTRAL AMERICA AND MEXICO
CALENDAR YEARS 1935-1939

EXPORTS

The value of Canadian produce exported to the group of countries comprising South America, Central America and Mexico averaged \$15,735,000 during the five pre-war calendar years 1935-1939, the highest value, \$24,024,000, being recorded in 1937. Exports to Argentina during this period averaged \$4,696,000 in value, the largest to any single country in the group. Exports to Brazil averaged \$4,015,000 and to Mexico \$2,631,000. Other countries with yearly purchases averaging over \$1,000,000 were British Guiana, Colombia, Venezuela and Peru.

IMPORTS

During the period under review the value of Imports into Canada from these countries as a group showed an annual average of \$23,928,000. The peak was reached during 1936 when commodities to the value of \$29,603,000 were imported, more than \$10,000,000 higher than 1935, the lowest of the five years. British Guiana ranked first among the countries as a source of supply with an annual average valued at \$5,845,000. Argentina was second, supplying goods to the average value of \$5,374,000, closely followed by Colombia \$5,139,000, Peru \$3,554,000 and Venezuela \$1,662,000. Yearly Imports from Brazil amounted to \$920,000 while those from Mexico averaged \$667,000.

BALANCE OF TRADE

Imports into Canada from South America, Central America and Mexico as a group, exceeded Canadian Exports to those countries in each of the five years under review. In 1939 the excess of Imports over Exports was \$1,695,000, whereas in 1936 it had reached \$13,127,000 compared with a yearly average of \$5,190,000. The remarkably high adverse balance of trade in 1936 was mainly accounted for by an abnormally large import of corn from Argentina amounting to \$7,505,000 as against an average of \$630,000 during the other four years. This resulted in a substantial excess of Imports from that country in 1936 in contrast to a usual excess of Exports. Imports from Colombia, British Guiana, Paraguay and Venezuela exceeded Exports to those countries during each of the five years. British Guiana, with shipments consisting principally of raw sugar and bauxite ore, had the greatest excess of Imports, averaging \$4,502,000. The excess of Imports from Colombia averaged \$3,843,000 due mainly to large shipments of crude petroleum. Imports from Peru were greater than Exports in each year except 1939 which showed an Export balance of \$664,000 as against an Import balance averaging \$3,264,000 in the other four years. This is accounted for by the fact that in 1939, imports of crude petroleum and gasoline dropped to a value of \$587,000 from an average of \$4,282,000 in the four preceding years. Trade with Argentina showed considerable fluctuation, varying from an Import balance of \$7,361,000 in 1936 to an Export excess of \$2,526,000 in 1938. Exports to Uruguay exceeded Imports in each year except 1939. With few minor exceptions, all other countries in the group purchased more from Canada than they supplied. Outstanding in this regard were Brazil and Mexico. The favourable balance of trade with Brazil was \$3,092,000 per annum and with Mexico \$1,963,000.

EXPORTS

AGRICULTURAL AND VEGETABLE PRODUCTS Commodities classified under this group comprised about one-quarter of all Exports to these countries. The principal export was that of rubber products chiefly automobile tires and tubes but there was also a considerable trade in rubber boots and shoes, belting, hose and other rubber manufactures. The exports of flour to British Guiana and British Honduras formed a large part of the trade with those two countries under this commodity group. Each year Colombia purchased wheat from Canada, the largest amount being 466,660 bushels in 1939. Malt was shipped to Mexico and Brazil. Argentina has been an important market for certified seed potatoes and took 1,190,000 bushels in 1937, over one-half the total exports of seed potatoes from Canada in that year. British Guiana purchased over ten per cent of all exports of table potatoes.

ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS Although exports under this group were comparatively small, representing five per cent of the total, there was a steady increase in value each year from 1935 to 1939. Exports of fish, mainly dried cod and hake, were made to British Guiana, Brazil and Panama. Butter and cheese were shipped principally to British Guiana, British Honduras and Peru. Shipments of powdered milk to Venezuela increased steadily from a value of \$1,353 in 1935 to over \$491,000 in 1939. During 1938 and 1939, the value of powdered milk purchased by Venezuela was about forty per cent of all Canadian exports of this product. Smaller amounts were taken by Colombia and Peru.

FIBRES, TEXTILES AND TEXTILE PRODUCTS Exports under the Textile group were comparatively small, amounting to less than two per cent of the total. Principal commodities were cotton fabrics, silk stockings, cordage, oilcloths and wool fabrics.

EXPORTS (Continued)

WOOD, WOOD PRODUCTS AND PAPER Newsprint paper was the leading commodity exported in the Wood and Paper group. Shipments were made to almost every country with Argentina the principal customer. In fact, Argentina ranked fourth as a purchaser of Canadian newsprint, exceeded only by the United States, United Kingdom and Australia in 1937, 1938 and 1939. Japan took fourth place in 1935 and 1936 but Exports to that country declined rapidly and disappeared entirely in 1939. Other countries in the group ranking high as purchasers of newsprint were Mexico, Brazil, Chile, Peru, Uruguay and Venezuela. Wood pulp found a small market in Mexico and Brazil. Peru was an important purchaser of box shooks, ranking first among all countries in 1936 and 1939. Kraft wrapping paper found a steady market in Colombia.

IRON AND ITS PRODUCTS Almost twenty-five per cent of Exports to these countries during 1935-1939 consisted of products within the Iron group. Argentina, Colombia, Brazil and Peru purchased considerable quantities of pipe and fittings. Agricultural implements were shipped to nearly every country with Argentina the principal destination. The value of implements purchased by Argentina during the five-year period averaged \$1,551,000 compared with average purchases by the United States of \$2,307,000. As a buyer of reaper-threshers (combines) Argentina far outranked any other country and was among the leading purchasers of mowing machines, cultivators, drills, harrows, plows, planters and other implements. Mexico, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Uruguay and other South American countries imported implements in varying amounts. About eighty per cent of Canadian exports of sewing machines went to Brazil with an average yearly value of \$1,500,000, while Mexico was the second largest market for these machines.

NON-FERROUS METALS AND THEIR PRODUCTS Among the countries under review Brazil was the only large purchaser of Canadian copper in primary forms. Mexico was the largest single market in the world for insulated copper wire, with Colombia, Chile and Argentina important outlets as well. Shipments of pig lead to Brazil were exceeded only by those to United Kingdom and Japan. Under the heading of telegraph and telephone apparatus, Brazil was the largest importer among all countries, closely followed by Argentina, Chile and Mexico. Many other items of electrical apparatus were exported to nearly all countries in this group.

NON-METALLIC MINERALS AND THEIR PRODUCTS Exports under this heading comprised less than two per cent of the total. The principal commodities were asbestos to Argentina, Brazil, Chile and Peru; porcelain insulators to Brazil; artificial abrasives to Mexico and Portland cement to British Guiana, Colombia and Peru.

CHEMICALS AND PRODUCTS Exports to Mexico of sodium compounds, mainly cyanide for the mining industry, averaged over \$1,000,000 per year. Lesser amounts were shipped to Honduras and Chile. Mexico was also a large purchaser of acids. Guatemala and Honduras imported considerable amounts of manufactured fertilizers while Peru, Colombia and British Guiana were important markets for paints and varnishes.

MISCELLANEOUS COMMODITIES Shipments under this grouping consisted mainly of irregular sales of aircraft and ships to various countries. There was a steady trade in brushes and office stationery with many of the countries under review.

IMPORTS

AGRICULTURAL AND VEGETABLE PRODUCTS Over forty per cent of all Imports from South America, Central America and Mexico during the years 1935-1939 consisted of Agricultural and Vegetable Products. Bananas were imported from Ecuador and Panama; grapefruit from British Honduras, Brazil and Honduras; oranges from Brazil and Honduras; and grapes from Argentina. Imports of fresh tomatoes from Mexico averaged close to 16,000,000 pounds per annum, second only to imports from United States. In 1936 the imports of corn from Argentina reached a peak of 14,000,000 bushels valued at \$7,500,000 but this trade dwindled to less than 20,000 bushels in 1939. Argentina was the only important source of flax seed and imports were fairly constant, averaging almost 1,000,000 bushels per year. Nuts came from Brazil and Mexico. British Guiana ranked first among all countries as a source of raw sugar, the value of imports averaging over \$4,500,000. Coffee in large amounts was supplied by Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica and Guatemala, with smaller amounts from Mexico, Salvador and Venezuela. Over one-third of all rum imported into Canada came from British Guiana, averaging nearly 100,000 proof gallons during the five-year period.

ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS Imports under this group of commodities averaged over \$2,000,000 in value during 1935-1939, about nine per cent of all imports. The articles of chief value were cattle hides and canned beef. Argentina supplied more cattle hides to Canada than any other country, imports averaging \$1,330,000 per year compared with \$1,000,000 from the United States. Small amounts were also obtained from Uruguay and Brazil. Canada imported yearly over 12,000,000 pounds of canned beef and of this amount 8,300,000 pounds were supplied by Argentina and 2,600,000 pounds by Uruguay. In 1938 and 1939 large amounts were imported from Brazil for the first time. Paraguay was also a source of supply of this product.

FIBRES, TEXTILES AND TEXTILE PRODUCTS Less than one per cent of total imports were classed under this heading. Main items were raw cotton from Brazil and vegetable fibres for cordage from Mexico.

WOOD, WOOD PRODUCTS AND PAPER Imports under this group were negligible, averaging only \$6,000 per year.

IRON AND ITS PRODUCTS In this commodity group the only trade of importance was iron ore from Brazil. The yearly average value was \$83,000.

NON-FERROUS METALS AND THEIR PRODUCTS The value of Imports under the Non-ferrous Metal grouping showed a steady increase from \$118,000 in 1935 to \$2,294,000 in 1939. This is accounted for entirely by increased shipments of bauxite ore for aluminium from British Guiana.

NON-METALLIC MINERALS AND THEIR PRODUCTS Over forty per cent of the value of all Imports falls within this category. With the exception of the United States the main sources of supply of crude petroleum for refining were the southern countries of Colombia, Peru and Venezuela. During the 1935-1939 period, total imports into Canada of crude petroleum from all countries averaged 1,250,000,000 gallons. Of this amount, the three countries named above supplied 325,000,000 gallons. In addition to crude petroleum, Peru sold to Canada large quantities of natural casinghead gasoline for blending.

IMPORTS (Continued)

CHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS The most important import commodity listed under this group was tanning material, principally quebracho extract, from Argentina and Paraguay. Large supplies of nitrate of soda for fertilizer were obtained from Chile.

MISCELLANEOUS COMMODITIES Only small imports were recorded in this grouping, the total value amounting to less than one per cent of all imports.

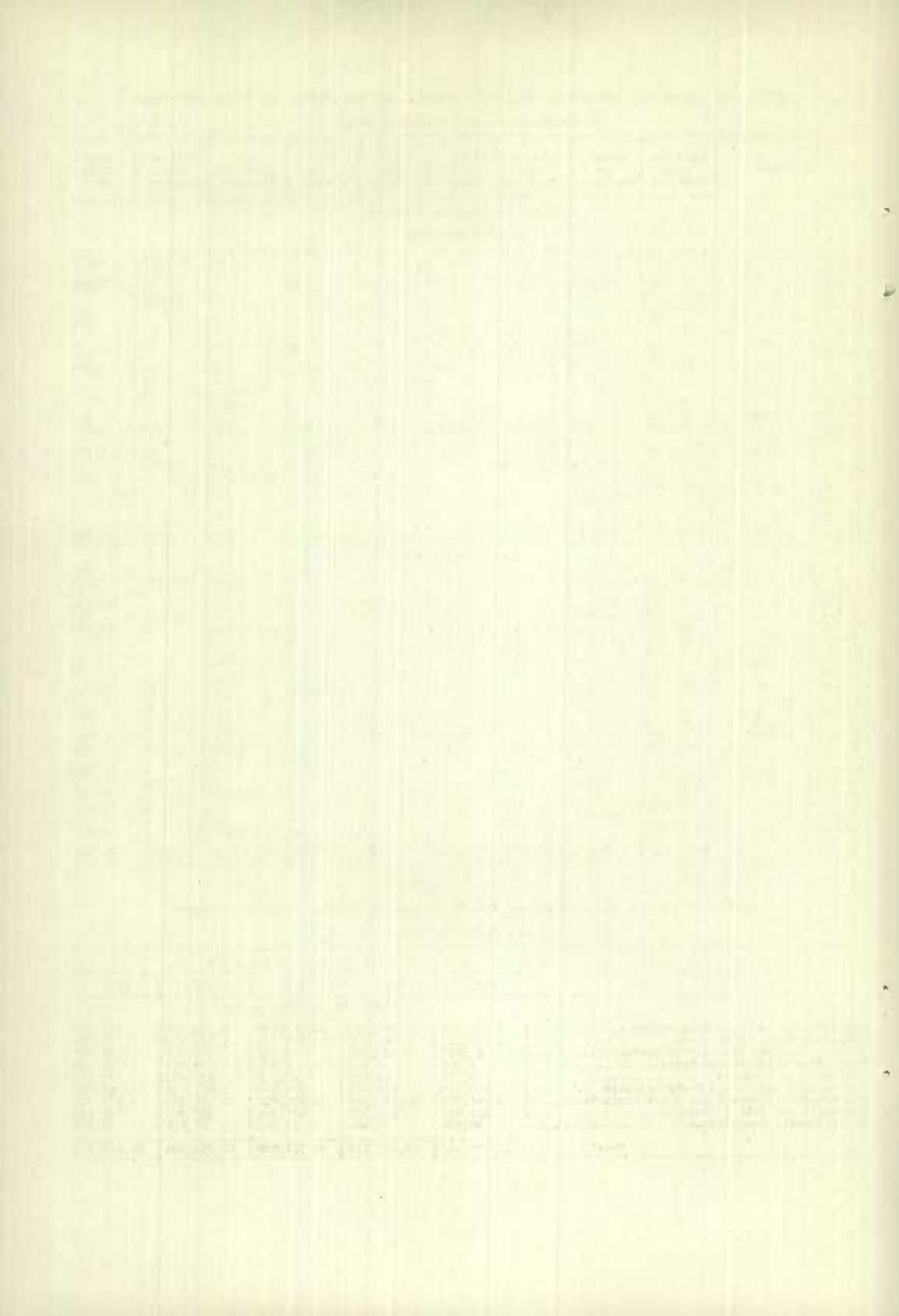

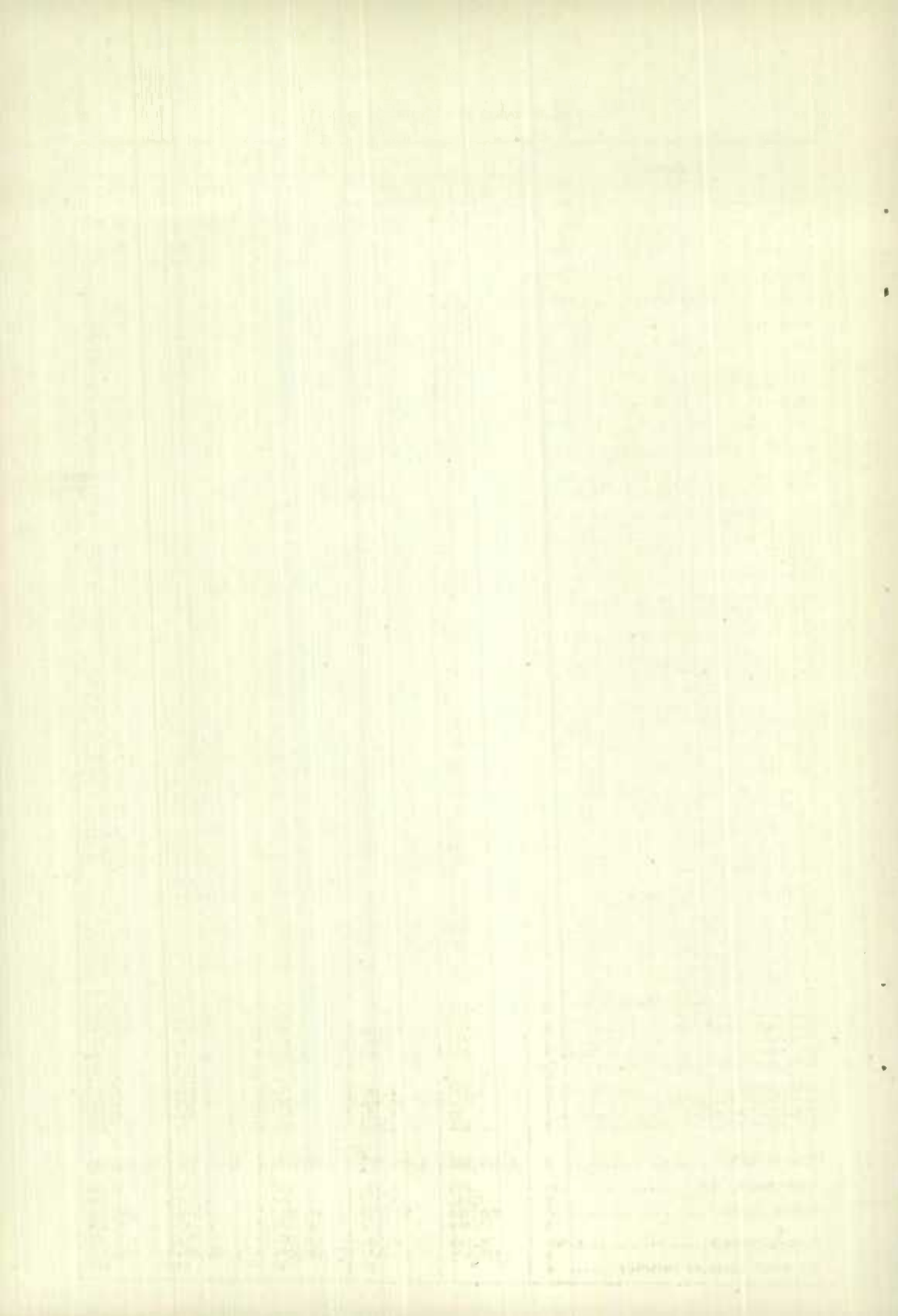
