PREFACE

In 1920 the Bureau undertook a statistical survey of the urban municipalities throughout Canada having a population of 10,000 and over. The report, though regarded as tentative, proved of much interest, and the edition was quickly exhausted. Subsequently the Bureau published reports dealing respectively with towns of 3,000 to 10,000 population, and with towns and incorporated villages having a population of 1,000 to 3,000.

A second survey of the larger urban centres is herewith presented. It has not been considered necessary to republish the statistics concerning street pavements, lighting systems, water supply systems, purification plants and fire and police department equipment, but in the financial tables, showing receipts, expenditures and assets, a number of additions have been made, and the present report is therefore more complete than its predecessor. The Bureau again tenders its thanks to the municipal officers who so kindly aided in the survey.

The returns as furnished by municipal officials for 1919 and published in previous reports of the Bureau showed that 61 urban municipalities estimated their population to be 10,000 or over. Of this number, Guelph, Glace Bay and Shawinigan Falls failed to report for 1920, while the return for Valleyfield showed it to have less than 10,000 population. This gives a net total of 57 municipalities recorded. Included for comparative purposes in this number are the returns for Amherst, Dartmouth and New Glasgow in Nova Scotia and Oshawa and North Bay in Ontario whose officials claimed a population of over 10,000, though the returns of the Census of 1921 just completed, show that each had somewhat less.

PRÉFACE

En 1920, le Bureau entreprit une investigation statistique des municipalités urbaines du Canada dont la population atteignait ou dépassait 10,000 habitants. Les résultats de cette enquête furent condensés dans un rapport jugé fort intéressant et dont l'édition fut rapidement épousée. Subséquemment, le Bureau publia des statistiques similaires, consacrées respectivement aux villes d'une population de 3,000 à 10,000 habitants et aux villes et villages incorporés de 1,000 à 3,000 habitants.

Nous présentons ici, pour la seconde fois, les données se rapportant aux agglomérations urbaines les plus importantes. On a jugé inutile de répéter ce qui a déjà été dit au sujet des pavages des rues, de l'éclairage, des adductions d'eau et de sa purification, du matériel d'incendie et policier mais, par contre, un certain nombre d'additions ont été faites aux tableaux d'ordre financier relatant les recettes, les dépenses et l'actif, de telle sorte que le présent rapport est plus complet que son prédecesseur. Le Bureau offre ses sincères remerciements aux fonctionnaires municipaux qui ont participé à la préparation de ce travail.

Les informations fournies par les fonctionnaires municipaux pour l'année 1919, et qui ont fait l'objet de rapports antérieurs, indiquaient que 16 municipalités urbaines estimaienr leur population à 10,000 habitants ou plus. Parmi elles, Guelph, Glace Bay et Shawinigan Falls ont négligé de faire parvenir leurs rapports pour 1920; d'autre part, la population de la ville de Valleyfield est inférieure à 10,000 habitants; il reste donc un total de 57 municipalités comprises dans ce rapport. Dans ce nombre figurent les villes d'Amherst, Dartmouth et New Glasgow, en Nouvelle-Ecosse, d'Oshawa et North Bay dans Ontario, qui se sont placées dans cette catégorie, quoique les résultats du recensement de 1921 démontrent que leur population est quelque peu inférieure à 10,000 habitants.

COMPARATIVE SUMMARY

The total assessed value of taxable property in cities of 10,000 and over in Canada for 1920 was \$2,786,894,948, while in 1919 it was \$2,924,553,003. The figures however are not comparable as in 1919 several municipalities were unable to separate business assessment but included it in the assessed value of taxable property. The total value of taxable property was \$280,294,473, in towns of 3,000 to 10,000, and \$227,073,141 in the towns of 1,000 to 3,000.

The assessed per capita values of taxable property, in cities of 10,000 and over by provinces are as follows: Prince Edward Island, \$466.72, Nova Scotia \$677.10, New Brunswick \$668.04, Quebec \$1,017.68, Ontario \$878.84, Manitoba \$1,284.73, Saskatchewan \$1,106.34. Alberta \$1,240.75, British Columbia \$1,280.17. The cities in the provinces east of Manitoba, had an assessed value of taxable property of \$914.53 per capita as compared with \$1,249.34 per capita for the provinces west of Ontario. In 1919 the per capita assessed value was \$907.10 for the Eastern group, compared with \$1,238.58 for the Western. Towns of 3,000 to 10,000 showed a per capita value of \$455.12 for Eastern provinces as against \$784.84 for the Western group in 1919 while the towns of 1,000 to 3,000 showed \$503.12 per capita for the Eastern provinces as compared with \$666.40 for the western in 1920.

In connection with receipts, "compulsory taxation" consisting of taxation for general purposes, arrears, school taxes, poll tax, income tax and other special taxation, showed a total for all cities in 1920 of \$94,407,641.31 and a per capita revenue of \$33.39, while in 1919 taxation receipts amounted to \$81,436, 969.93 or \$27.34 per capita. Receipts were \$16.97 per capita for towns of 3,000 to 10,000 in 1919 and \$17.60 per capita for the towns of 1,000 to 3,000 in 1920.

Taking the provinces separately, taxation receipts for the cities amounted to \$118,858.19 in Prince Edward Island, \$1,677,441.16 in Nova Scotia, \$2,007, 127.41 in New Brunswick, \$22,345,510.74 in Quebec, \$40,742,820.99 in Ontario, \$7,117,370.60 in Manitoba, \$3,941,951.44 in Saskatchewan, \$8,611,210.45 in Alberta and \$7,845,350.33 in British Columbia, with per capita revenues respectively of \$9.63 in Prince Edward Island, \$15.56 in Nova Scotia, \$27.58 in New Brunswick, \$25.50 in Quebec; \$35.17 in Ontario, \$34.33 in Manitoba, \$49.61 in Saskatchewan, \$60.28 in Alberta and \$46.03 in British Columbia.

The total ordinary receipts for cities in 1920 amounted to \$168,840,791.90, while the extraordinary revenue was \$41,679,648.02, showing a per capita revenue of \$59.71 for ordinary receipts and \$14.74 for extraordinary. In 1919 the total ordinary receipts for cities were \$135,476,954.94, with extraordinary receipts of \$52,288,251.29, ordinary per capita revenue being \$45.48, and extraordinary \$17.55. Corresponding figures for the towns of 3,000 to 10,000 showed total ordinary receipts of \$15,309,561.63, being \$27.70 per capita, while extraordinary receipts were \$4,476,454.13 or \$8.10 per capita. The ordinary receipts for towns of 1,000 to 3,000 amounted to \$10,684,794.60, while the extraordinary revenue was \$5,448,828.55, showing a per capita revenue of \$25.49 for ordinary receipts and \$13.00 for extraordinary.

A study of the expenditure statements shows that the total ordinary expenditure for the cities in 1920 amounted to \$170,883,853.71 while the extraordinary expenditure was \$39,808,405.44 a per capita expenditure of \$60.43 for ordinary and \$14.08 for extraordinary. In 1919 the total ordinary expenditure for cities was \$128,273,644.36, while the extraordinary expenditure was

\$53,653,888.55, being \$43.06 per capita ordinary, and \$18.01 extraordinary. Similar statistics for the towns of 3,000 to 10,000 show total ordinary expenditure of \$15,185,024.08, total extraordinary \$5,209,136.78, with per capita expenditure of \$27.48 and \$9.43 respectively. The total ordinary expenditure for the towns of 1,000 to 3,000 was \$11,318,445.73, while the extraordinary expenditure was \$4,848,881.53, being \$27.00 per capita ordinary and \$11.57 extraordinary.

In the previous reports only available assets were shown, whereas in this report a full statement of all assets is given. The total assets of the cities for 1920 amounted to \$809,861,298.54, showing a per capita value of \$286.40.

The liabilities of the cities in 1920 amounted to \$675,610,500.63 showing a per capita indebtedness of \$238.93, while in 1919 the total liabilities were \$603,039,036.92 or \$202.44 per capita. The towns of 3,000 to 10,000 showed total liabilities of \$55,719,411.43, or a per capita indebtedness of \$100.82, while the towns of 1,000 to 3,000 had total liabilities of \$33,407,404.64, or a per capita debt of \$79.69.

RÉSUMÉ

La valeur estimative des propriétés taxables, dans les cités canadiennes de 10,000 habitants et plus, s'élevait, en 1920, à \$2,786,894,948, tandis qu'en 1919 elle atteignait \$2,924,553,003. Toutefois, ces chiffres ne sont pas strictement comparables car, en 1919, plusieurs municipalités au lieu d'indiquer séparément les évaluations relatives à la taxe d'affaires, les avaient englobées dans la valeur des propriétés taxables. Dans les villes de 3,000 à 10,000 habitants les propriétés de cette nature sont évaluées à \$280,294,473 et, dans les villes de 1,000 à 3,000 habitants, à \$227,073,141.

Cette même valeur per capita, dans les cités d'une population de 10,000 habitants au moins, fut établie ainsi qu'il suit dans les provinces: Ile du Prince-Edouard \$466.72, Nouvelle-Ecosse \$677.10, Nouveau-Brunswick \$668.04, Québec \$1,017.68, Ontario \$878.84, Manitoba \$1,284.73, Saskatchewan \$1,106.34; Alberta \$1,240.75, Colombie Britannique \$1,280.17. Les cités du groupe des provinces sises à l'est du Manitoba possèdent des immeubles sujets à la taxe d'une valeur per capita de \$914.53, au lieu de \$1,249.34 per capita pour les provinces situées à l'ouest d'Ontario. En 1909, cette valeur était de \$907.10 pour le groupe oriental, comparativement à \$1,238.58 pour le groupe occidental. Les villes de 3,000 à 10,000 habitants donnèrent, en 1919, une valeur per capita de \$455.12 pour les provinces de l'est, contre \$784.84 pour les provinces de l'ouest; enfin, en 1920, dans les villes et villages de 1,000 à 3,000 habitants, on trouvait une valeur per capita de \$503.12 dans les provinces de l'est, comparativement à \$666.40 pour les provinces de l'ouest.

Abordant le chapitre des recettes nous trouvons que la "taxe obligatoire", qui embrasse la taxe foncière et ses arrérages, la taxe scolaire, la taxe de capitation, la taxe sur le revenu et d'autres taxes spéciales, a produit en 1920, dans toutes les cités, une somme de \$94,407,641.31, soit un revenu per capita de \$33.39, tandis qu'en 1919, les recettes provenant des mêmes sources s'étaient limitées à \$81,436,969.93 ou \$27.34 per capita. Dans les villes de 3,000 à 10,000 habitants, les mêmes recettes ont donné en 1919 une moyenne de \$16.97 per capita et en 1920, dans les villes et villages de 1,000 à 3,000 habitants, de \$17.60 per capita.

Si l'on considère les provinces séparément, on voit que les taxes encaissées par les cités de l'île du Prince-Edouard représentaient \$118,858.19; de la Nouvelle-Ecosse \$1,677,441; du Nouveau-Brunswick \$2,007,127.41; de Québec \$22,345,510.70; d'Ontario \$40,742,820.99; du Manitoba \$7,117,370.60; de la Saskatchewan \$3,941,951.44; de l'Alberta \$8,611,210.45 et de la Colombie Britannique \$7,845,350.33, ce qui porte les revenus per capita à: \$9.63 dans l'île du Prince-Edouard, \$15.56 dans la Nouvelle-Ecosse, \$27.58 dans le Nouveau-Brunswick, \$25.50 dans Québec; \$35.17 dans Ontario; \$34.33 au Manitoba; \$49.61 dans la Saskatchewan; \$60.28 dans l'Alberta et \$46.03 dans la Colombie Britannique.

En 1920, les recettes ordinaires des cités formaient un total de \$168,840,791 50, tandis que leurs revenus extraordinaires représentaient \$41,679,648.02, soit un revenu per capita de \$59.71 pour les recettes ordinaires et \$14.74 pour les recettes extraordinaires. En 1919, les recettes ordinaires des cités n'avaient pas dépassé \$135,476,954.94, mais les recettes extraordinaires avaient atteint \$52,288,251.29, le revenu ordinaire per capita étant de \$15.48 et le revenu extraordinaire de \$17.55. Les chiffres correspondants, quant aux villes de 3,000 à 10,000 habitants, étaient les suivants: recettes ordinaires \$15,309,561.63 ou \$27.70 per capita, recettes extraordinaires \$4,476,454.13 ou \$8.10 per capita.

Enfin, les recettes ordinaires des villes et villages de 1,000 à 3,000 habitants donnaient \$10,684,794.60 et leurs recettes extraordinaires \$5,448,828.55, soit, per capita, \$25.49 pour les recettes ordinaires et \$13.00 pour les recettes extraordinaires.

Une analyse des colonnes réservées aux dépenses montre qu'en 1920, les dépenses ordinaires des cités s'élevaient à \$170,883,853.71 et les dépenses extraordinaires à \$39,808,405.44, soit \$60.43 per capita pour les dépenses ordinaires et \$14.08 pour les dépenses extraordinaires. En 1919, les dépenses ordinaires des cités n'avaient pas dépassé \$128,273,644.36, mais leurs dépenses extraordinaires avaient atteint \$53,653,888.55, soit \$43.06 per capita pour les dépenses ordinaires et \$18.01 pour les dépenses extraordinaires. Les statistiques similaires des villes de 3,000 à 10,000 habitants portent leurs dépenses ordinaires à \$15,185,024.08 et leurs dépenses extraordinaires à \$5,209,136.78, soit une dépense per capita de \$27.48 et \$9.43 respectivement. Quant aux villes de 1,000 à 3,000 habitants, leurs dépenses ordinaires ont été de \$11,318,445.73 et celles extraordinaires de \$4,848,881.53, soit \$27.00 per capita pour les dépenses ordinaires et \$11.57 pour les dépenses extraordinaires.

Les rapports précédents se bornaient à indiquer l'actif disponible, tandis que ce rapport présente un inventaire complet de la totalité de l'actif. En 1920, la totalité de l'actif des cités formait une somme de \$809,861,298.54, soit une valeur per capita de \$286.40.

D'autre part, en la même année 1920, le passif des cités était représenté par \$675,510,500.63, soit une dette per capita de \$238.93; en 1919, ce passif était de \$603,039,036.92 ou \$202.44 per capita. Le passif des villes de 3,000 à 10,000 habitants vient s'y ajouter pour \$55,709,411.43, soit \$100.82 per capita et celui des villes et villages de 1,000 à 3,000 habitants pour \$33,497,404.64, soit une dette per capita de \$79.69.
