STUDENTS! COST OF A YEAR AT CANADIAN UNIVERSITIES

1.

The tables on the following pages are based on a survey made by a committee of the National Federation of Canadian University Students assisted by the Education Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

A questionnaire was sent out in sufficient quantity to have given a 10 p.c. sample of the students in several faculties of ten of the larger universities. While the response fell short of 10 p.c., the tables represent the experience of 1,291 single students during the academic year 1947-48. Of these 213 were women in arts and Science.

In order to extend the information to include at least one representative institution in each province, estimates based on the results of the survey were made for five additional centres.

The expenses are classified under nine headings: (1) "Tuition and other fees" is intended to include all the extra fees varying with the course such as caution fees, athletic fees, laboratory fees, health insurance, student federation, etc.; (2) "Textbooks and equipment" covers the cost of all equipment, as well as textbooks, which the individual student is required to purchase; (3) "Living expense" is the cost of food and lodging, which may be combined for those living in a university residence or fraternity and those boarding in private homes, or may be separate items for those rooming and buying their meals out; (4) "Clothing"; (5) "Laundry"; (6) "Transportation" is limited to the amount spent on transportation to and from the university within the local centre. Transportation from the student's home, when he is living away from home, is not included; (7) "Health" includes all medical and dental expenses; (8) Sports, shows, dances, candy, cigarettes are all combined under "Recreation"; (9) "Other expenses" comprise club fees; church and charitable contributions; books, magazines, papers for general reading; and other items such as toilet articles, haircuts, etc., which cannot be classified elsewhere.

Tables 1 to 6 show the average total cost by faculties, with separate tables for men and women in Arts and Science. The results show that, in general, a year at university is more costly for men than women. This is particularly true of living expenses, laundry and recreation. Women spend more on health services than men.

There is a noticeable variation in cost between centres. The average of total expenses for men in Arts and Science varies from \$892 to \$1,247, and for women from \$816 to \$1,103.

Usually Arts and Science courses involve the least expense. Engineering may cost up to \$165 more. Fees are \$5 to \$117 higher with two out of eight centres charging around \$100 more than for Arts courses. Usually a little more is spent on textbooks and equipment.

A year in Forestry, given at three universities, costs \$67 to \$211 more than a year in Arts. Fees are higher, as well as expenditure on clothing and laundry.

Fees for dentistry are \$10 to \$180 above those for Arts. While the expenditure on textbooks alone varies little from that in an Arts course, the cost of equipment raises the expense for textbooks and equipment for the four years of the course to a total of \$600 to \$1,000 depending on the institution. In most cases the greater proportion is spent in the first two years and in all cases this expense is much lower in the fourth year.

Medicine appears to be the most expensive course. Fees vary with institutions from \$252 to \$450. While the amount required for textbooks and equipment is less than that required for dentistry in the same institution, it is anywhere from \$25 to \$117 more than that required for Arts. In six of the universities the cost of clothing was greater, and laundry in all cases.

Table 7 omits tuition and other fees which vary with the course, and shows the minimum required to meet all other expenses, together with the amount most frequently reported which presumably is the cost to the student in normal circumstances. The highest reported cost is also shown. Figures are given for single men under the three possible conditions for students not living at home.

Table 8 analyzes the largest single controllable item, living expenses, to show the least amount required, the most common cost, and the highest, separately for those living in university residence and those boarding and rooming.

Fees for residence fluctuate less than the cost of living outside so that in a period of high prices it is cheaper on the average to live in a residence, while in a period of low prices it may be more expensive.
