


HOUSEHOLD AND FAMILY PROJECTIONS OF REGISTERED INDIANS, 1991-2015

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HIGHLIGHTS

- By 2015, the number of registered Indian households in Canada is projected to increase between 355,500 and 364,000, up from 161,800 in 1990. This corresponds to average annual growth rates between 3.2% and 3.3%.
- Of the 364,000 households projected in 2015 (Scenario B), some 151,100 (41%) could be on reserve, and the remaining 213,000 (59%) off reserve.
- Of the three projection scenarios presented, only Scenario A shows an increase in the proportion of households on reserve, from 45.1% in 1990 to 46.2% in 2015. The other two projections show a decrease to 41.5% (Scenario B) or to 36.8% (Scenario C), by 2015.
- Of the total projected households in 2015, 285,600 (Scenario B) could be single-family households, 10,300 multiple-family households, and 68,200 non-family households.
- The regional distribution of registered Indian households would change very slightly over the projection period. The prairies would increase their share a little while Ontario, Quebec and British Columbia would experience a corresponding slight decline. Ontario and British Columbia, however, would continue to rank first and second, respectively.
- The registered Indian families would increase from 136,800 in 1990 to reach between 289,600 and 296,900 by 2015.
- Between 38.5% and 48.0% of registered Indian families would be living on reserve in 2015, compared to 46.9% in 1990.
- The trend in the regional distribution of registered Indian families would be similar to the trend in households with Ontario and British Columbia retaining the first and second rank respectively in the number of families.

INTRODUCTION

Population projections by age provide the basic demographic input for most socio-economic planning. For many activities and programmes, however, households and families are more relevant than population. An obvious example is housing, where requirements vary according to the number of households and families. Changes in the number of households and families also affect the need for public services and for consumer durables such as household appliances and furniture.

This report presents revised projections of registered Indian private households and census families, by place of residence (on/off reserve), and, in the case of households, by type (single-family, multiple-family, and non-family household), for Canada and INAC regions⁽¹⁾, 1991 to 2015. The previous projections were for the period 1986-2011 (Loh, 1990).

The projections presented herein are based on the relevant data from the 1981, 1986 and 1991 Censuses, as well as the latest population projections of registered Indians (Nault et al., 1993). Three projection scenarios (A, B and C) are presented. These provide a range of plausible alternatives in the number and characteristics of households and families.

Section 1 describes the methodology, data sources and assumptions. Section 2 presents the projections results along with some analysis. Section 3 compares the current and the previous projections (Loh, 1990). Section 4 discusses the limitations of the current projections, and Section 5 outlines the availability of unpublished results. Finally, the tables in the Appendix provide detailed projection figures for Canada and the regions.

1. METHODOLOGY, DATA SOURCES AND ASSUMPTIONS

1.1 Basic Method

The method used for developing the projections of households and families in this report is similar to the method used for the previous registered Indian projections (Loh, 1990), and for Statistics Canada's overall household and family projections (Larrivée, 1990). The model essentially involves applying household maintainer and family reference person rates, to the projected adult population 15 years of age and over⁽²⁾. The method has the distinct advantage of making direct use of the most recent population projections as its base, and thus takes into consideration the changes in the population's age structure which has a major effect on the number and composition of households and families (Perreault and George, 1989).

With the change of concept from household and family "head" to household maintainer and family reference person, the choice of the maintainer and of the reference person has become, at times, somewhat arbitrary. As a consequence, when the rates are computed separately by sex, the true trends in changes of household and family formation are confounded by these arbitrary decisions. For the purposes of these projections, this problem has been solved by combining both sexes in the calculation of the rates.

As in the case of population projections, a regional component approach has been adopted here. This involves developing projections at the regional level and then aggregating them to obtain projections at the national level.

1.2 Base Population Projections

As stated earlier, the household and family projections presented in this report are based on the three selected scenarios of the most recent population projections of registered Indians for INAC (Nault et al., 1993). These projections were developed based on data from the Indian Register maintained by INAC. The three registered Indian population projection scenarios combine three fertility, two mortality, and three on-reserve proportion assumptions, with a zero inter-provincial migration assumption, and a single assumption for both Bill C-31 reinstatements and "miscellaneous additions" (Table 1.1). The projected adult population by place of residence at the end of the projection period resulting from the three scenarios is shown in Table 1.1.

1.3 Household Maintainer and Family Reference Person Rates

1.3.1 Data Sources and Definitions

Unlike the data for the population projections, the household maintainer and family reference person rates cannot be obtained from the Indian Register maintained by INAC. Instead, they were computed from the three most recent Censuses: 1981, 1986, and 1991.

Registered Indians were identified in the 1981 and 1986 Censuses using an INAC-defined variable (Klein and Wright, 1985; Larocque and Gauvin, 1989), while for the 1991 Census, Question 16, which asked whether or not an individual is a registered Indian, was used.

In all three Censuses the registered Indian enumeration was incomplete. However, since the Censuses are used to estimate rates only, it can be assumed that the enumerated registered Indians are a representative sample of all registered Indians.

INAC-defined Indian reserves and settlements were used to distribute the population by region and place of residence.

The projections are for private households only, that is, they exclude collective households⁽³⁾. A registered Indian household is defined as a household in which a registered Indian family lives or where at least 50% of the members are registered Indians. A registered Indian family is defined as a family in which the lone parent or at least one of the spouses is a registered Indian⁽⁴⁾.

The household maintainer and family reference person rates are calculated by dividing the number of household maintainers and family reference persons by the total number

of individuals in a given population. This was done by age group (15-29, 30-44, 45-64, and 65+), by place of residence (on/off reserve), and by INAC region for 1981, 1986 and 1991. Because of the definitions of registered Indian household and family, the numerators of the rates consist of both registered and non-registered maintainers and reference persons, while the denominators consist of registered Indians only. The addition of non-registered individuals in the numerators produces household maintainer and family reference person rates higher than usually observed, especially off reserves⁽⁵⁾.

1.3.2 Assumptions

1.3.2.1 Household Maintainer and Family Reference Person Rates

Table 1.2 and Figure 1.1 show the household maintainer and family reference person rates by age group, and place of residence for Canada in 1981, 1986, and 1991.

The first striking observation is that the off-reserve rates are much higher than the on-reserve rates. This is mainly explained by the higher proportions of households with non-registered maintainers, and of families with non-registered reference persons, living off reserve than on reserve, as shown in Table 1.3. It could also be due to differences in living arrangements and housing availability between on and off reserve. The off-reserve households are likely to be smaller and more numerous, therefore having higher household maintainer rates.


For instance, the 1986 household maintainer rate is 45.7% for the overall Canadian population (Larrivée, 1990) compared to 60.2% for the off-reserve registered Indian population.

Second, both the table and the figure show no clear changes in the household maintainer and family reference person rates from 1981 to 1991. The figure displays curves that are closely aligned. Given this, the best assumption is to maintain household maintainer and family reference person rates by age group, place of residence, and region, constant throughout the projection period. To reflect the most recent trends, an average of the 1986 and 1991 rates was used.

1.3.2.2 Distribution of Households by Type

Table 1.4 shows the distribution of households by type, and place of residence in 1986 and 1991 for registered Indian and Canadian households.

As with the maintainer rates, the main differences are between the on-reserve and off-reserve distributions. The on-reserve proportion of multiple-family households is higher than the off-reserve, while the non-family household proportion is slightly lower. The household structure of the off-reserve population is generally closer to that of the Canadian population as a whole than it is to the on-reserve. Between 1986 and 1991, a convergence towards having the same household structure as the overall Canadian population can be observed. All this is consistent with other demographic aspects of registered Indians, such as fertility and mortality.

Given the above, a possible assumption could incorporate a certain degree of convergency in the registered Indian household distribution by type towards that of all Canadians. Due to small numbers however, gains from such an assumption are marginal, and therefore, a constant approach has been preferred. The average of the 1986 and 1991 distributions of households by type, by age group, by place of residence, and by region is kept constant throughout the projection period to disaggregate the projected households by type.

1.4 Combination of the Population Projections and Assumptions on Household Maintainer and Family Reference Person Rates

Three scenarios for household and family projections, labelled "A", "B", and "C", are offered. The three scenarios use the same assumptions on the household maintainer and family reference person rates, and on the distribution of households by type as described above.

The difference between the scenarios depends on the population projection scenario used as the base. Scenario A uses the rapid-growth scenario of population projections, Scenario B, the medium-growth, and Scenario C, the slow-growth (Table 1.5). The differences between the population projection scenarios mainly depend on the fertility and the on-reserve proportion assumptions. As the household and family projections are based on the projected adult population, the fertility assumptions have a lesser role. The differences in the projected scenarios of households and families will mainly depend on the on-reserve proportion assumptions.

2. PROJECTIONS RESULTS

2.1 Households

2.1.1 Trends in the Number of Households

The estimated number of registered Indian households in Canada in 1990 was 161,800. This number is projected to more than double over the next 25 years to reach between 355,500 and 364,000, depending on the scenario selected (Table 2.1).

This corresponds to 5-year average annual growth rates that range between 1.8% and 5.1% (Table 2.1). The Indian household growth rate is expected to be higher at the beginning than at the end of the projection period, primarily because Bill C-31 reinstatements are projected to be higher at the beginning of the projection period.

The combination of population projection scenarios which include different on-reserve proportions and household maintainer rates that are higher off reserve than on reserve, results in small differences in the projected total number of households among the three scenarios.

2.1.2 Distribution of Households by Place of Residence

The number of on-reserve households is projected to increase from an estimated 72,900 in 1990 to between 130,900 and 166,300 in 2015, depending on the scenario (Table 2.2). The number of off-reserve households is projected to increase from an estimated 88,900 in 1990 to between 193,400 and 224,600 in the same period.

The fact that the estimated number of households off reserve is higher than on reserve may come as a surprise as the population living on reserve is larger than off reserve⁽⁶⁾. Referring back to the definition of a registered Indian household, many off-reserve Indian households are composed of registered and non-registered individuals, while on reserve they are primarily composed of registered individuals. Given this observation, the propensity of household formation is greater for the smaller off-reserve Indian population than the larger on-reserve Indian population. As a result, higher household maintainer rates off reserve applied to a corresponding projected adult population will generate higher number of households off reserve than on reserve.

The population living on and off reserves in 1990 is estimated at 305,890 and 205,492, respectively (Nault et al., 1993).

It is noticeable that the range between scenarios is much wider when place of residence is taken into account. This is because the differences between the projected scenarios are mainly dependent on the on-reserve proportion assumptions as explained in Section 1.4 above.

Only Scenario A results in an increase in the proportion of households established on reserve, from 45.1% in 1990 to 46.2% in 2015 (Table 2.3). The two other scenarios project decreases: Scenario B to 41.5% in 2015, and Scenario C to 36.8%. This is linked to the fact that scenarios B and C assume slowly and rapidly declining on-reserve proportions, respectively.

2.1.3 Distribution of Households by Type

Three types of household are projected: single-family households, multiple-family households, and non-family households⁽⁷⁾. The single-family households are by far the most numerous (Table 2.4). The on-reserve single-family households would increase from 56,500 in 1990 to 117,100 plus 11,800 or minus 15,700 in 2015, and the number of off reserve from

70,300 to 168,500 plus 9,200 or minus 15,500. Multiple-family households would increase from 3,500 to 7,300 plus 800 or minus 900 on reserve, and from 1,200 to 3,000 plus 100 or minus 300 off reserve. Finally, the number of non-family households would increase from 12,900 to 26,700 plus 2,600 or minus 3,600 on reserve and, from 17,300 to 41,500 plus 2,200 or minus 3,900 off reserve.



2.1.4 Regional Distribution of Households

The regional distribution of households would not change very much over the projection period (Figure 2.1). The proportion of households in the prairies (Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta) would increase slightly while Ontario, Quebec, and Quebec would experience a corresponding slight decline. The proportion of households in the Atlantic region, Yukon, and Northwest Territories would remain relatively constant.

The projected regional distribution of households differs from the population distribution (Nault et al., 1993). The most striking difference is that British Columbia would have more households than Manitoba and Saskatchewan but less population. This is explained by a combination of factors: (i) although the total registered Indian population in British Columbia

would be smaller than that of Manitoba or Saskatchewan, the adult population that is responsible for household formation, would be about equal in the three provinces; (ii) the proportion of population living off reserve is larger in British Columbia than in the two other provinces, and this results in a larger number of registered Indian households and, (iii) maintainer rates are slightly higher in British Columbia than in Manitoba or Saskatchewan.

2.2 Families

The trends in the number of families, either total, by place of residence or by region are discussed only briefly as they closely follow the household trends.

2.2.1 Trends in the Number of Families

The estimated number of registered Indian families in Canada in 1990 was 136,800 and is projected to more than double over the next 25 years to reach between 289,600 and 296,900 depending on the scenario selected (Table 2.5). This corresponds to 5-year average annual growth rates that range between 1.7% and 5.0%. As in the case of households, the average annual growth rates of registered Indian families are expected to be higher at the beginning of the projection period than at the end.

2.2.2 Distribution of Families by Place of Residence

The number of families living on reserve is projected to increase from an estimated 64,200 in 1990, to between 111,600 and 141,300 in 2015, depending on the projection scenario (Table 2.6). Similarly, the number of families living off reserve is projected to increase from an estimated 72,600 in 1990, to between 153,300 and 178,000 in 2015.

In the case of the proportion of families living on reserve, only Scenario A results in an increase in the proportion of families, from 46.9% in 1990 to 48.0% in 2015 (Table 2.7). The other two scenarios show decreases, from 46.9% in 1990 to 43.2% and to 38.5% in 2015 for Scenarios B and C, respectively.



2.2.3 Regional Distribution of Families

As in the case of households, the proportion of registered Indian families in the prairies (Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta) would increase slightly while Ontario, British Columbia and Quebec would experience a corresponding slight decline (Figure 2.2). The proportion of families living in the Atlantic region, Yukon, and Northwest Territories is projected to remain fairly constant.

The same factors that were discussed in Section 2.1.4 explain why British Columbia would have more families but a smaller registered Indian population than either Manitoba or Saskatchewan.

3. COMPARISONS WITH PREVIOUS PROJECTIONS

This is the second time that the Demography Division of Statistics Canada has produced household and family projections of registered Indians for INAC. A comparison between the previous projections (Loh, 1990) and the current household and family projections shows small differences in the on-reserve results, but large variations for the off-reserve results (Table 3.1). The differences in the off-reserve results can be explained by the fact that, the underlying adult population, and the household maintainer and family reference person rates are higher in the present series than in the previous series. The adult off-reserve population is higher, mainly because of the assumption made regarding Bill C-31 reinstatements (Nault et al., 1993). In contrast, the household maintainer and family reference person rates applied to the off-reserve population were lower in the previous projections, because of the use of on-reserve instead of the off-reserve rates. The choice of using the on-reserve rates in the previous projection series was made because of a lack of confidence in the off-reserve data (Loh, 1989). In the present projection series, given the consistency observed in the data for the last three Censuses, the use of off-reserve household maintainer and family reference person rates was preferred over the on-reserve rates. The off-reserve rates are much higher than the on-reserve rates, as explained earlier (Section 1.3.1).

4. LIMITATIONS OF PROJECTIONS

The household and family projections cumulate the limitations of the underlying population projections and the limitations of the assumptions on the household maintainer and family reference person rates. The reader is referred to Section 6 of the population projections report (Nault et al., 1993) for a thorough discussion of the limitations of the registered Indian population projections. Concerning the assumptions on the household maintainer and family reference person rates, the following can be stated. First, only one assumption each for the household maintainer and family reference person rates based on census data has been developed and combined with the three series of population projections. Variations between the three series of household and family projections provided, are, thus, only attributable to variations in the population projections, and not to the variations in the propensity to form households and/or families. Second, the definitions of what constitutes a registered Indian family and a registered Indian household must be kept in mind, as they help to explain the high number of households and families living off reserve relative to the Indian population.

The three series provided should not be taken as predictions. They present the resulting projected households and families if the underlying assumptions prove to be correct. These assumptions were developed based on historical trends, but it is difficult to anticipate factors that may affect their course in the future, and consequently, the projection results. Nevertheless, the future number of Indian households and families are expected to fall within the range provided by the three series.

All of these limitations should be kept in mind when using and interpreting these projections.

5. AVAILABILITY OF UNPUBLISHED RESULTS

In this report, the projections of Indian households and families are presented for each year from 1990 to 2000, and for every five years up to 2015. Annual projections for the 2000-2015 period are available on request. Also available are the distributions of households and families by age group of household maintainer and family reference person.

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GLOSSARY

Census Family refers to a husband and a wife (with or without children who have never married, regardless of age), or a lone parent of any marital status, with one or more children who have never married, regardless of age, living in the same dwelling. For census purposes, persons living in a common-law type of arrangement are considered as currently married, regardless of their legal marital status.

Collective Household refers to a person or group of persons who occupy a collective dwelling and do not have a usual place of residence elsewhere in Canada. **Collective Dwelling** refers to a dwelling of a commercial, institutional or communal nature.

Family Reference Person (formerly head of family) refers to a person in the family (who is either the husband or the wife of a married couple, either partner in a common-law relationship or the parent in a lone-parent family) to whom the relationship of all other family members is recorded. Note that the family reference person is not necessarily the household maintainer.

Family Reference Person Rate refers to the proportion of family reference persons in a given population.

Household Maintainer refers to the person or one of the persons in the household who pays the rent, or the mortgage, or the taxes, or the electricity, etc. for the dwelling.

Household Maintainer Rate refers to the proportion of household maintainers in a given population.

Household Type refers to the basic division of private households into family and non-family households. **Family household** refers to a household that contains at least one census family. **Single-family household** refers to a single census family that occupies a private dwelling. **Multiple-family household** refers to one in which two or more census families (with or without additional non-family persons) occupy the same private dwelling. **Non-family household** refers to either one person living alone in a private dwelling or to a group of two or more people who share a private dwelling, but who do not constitute a census family.

INAC regions coincide with the provinces and territories in all but two cases: (i) the Ontario region includes some 2,900 registered Indians living in the Quebec portion of the Akwesasne reserve near Cornwall; (ii) the Yukon region includes about 400 registered Indians from the Takuriver Tlingit and Liard River bands located in British Columbia. The Atlantic region comprises the registered Indian population of New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland.

Private Household refers to a person or group of persons (one person living alone, one family, two or more families or a group of unrelated persons) who occupy a private dwelling and do not have a usual place of residence elsewhere in Canada. The number of private households equals the number of occupied dwellings.

Registered Indian Census Family (based on census data) refers to a family in which the lone parent or at least one of the spouses are registered Indian.

Registered Indian Household (based on census data) refers to a household where a registered Indian family lives or where 50% or more of the members of the household are registered Indians.
