INTRODUCTION

This report provides final 1966 Census population totals for the 175 cities, 722 towns and 1,121 incorporated villages in Canada on June 1, 1966. Table 10 lists these centres alphabetically and shows the township or municipality, etc., as well as the county or census division and province in which each is located. Population totals from the 1961 Census (according to the boundaries in effect at that date) are included for comparative purposes. Figures for 1956 may be found in Report 1-6 of the 1956 Census and for 1901 to 1951 in Table 9, Volume I of the 1951 Census. A special 1966 Census report (S-3) will provide 1966 and 1961 totals for unincorporated settlements of 50 or more persons.

Included in the present report are tables showing 1966 Census population totals, with comparative 1961 figures for: (a) census metropolitan areas and their component parts (Table 11), and (b) other major urban areas and their component parts (Table 12). A metropolitan area, as defined in the census, relates to a group of predominantly urban communities which are in close economic, geographic and social relationship although in a few cases (Regina, Saskatoon and Calgary) annexations of their fringe municipalities have occurred in recent years. Those communities classed as "other major urban areas" possess characteristics of census metropolitan areas but in most cases the cities proper are smaller in size.

Le présent rapport donne les chiffres définitifs de la population au recensement de 1966 des 175 cités, 722 villes et 1,121 villages constitués au Canada le 1er juin 1966. Le tableau 10 énumère ces agglomérations par ordre alphabétique et indique le canton ou township, municipalité, etc., ainsi que le comté ou la division de recensement et la province où elles sont situées. Pour fins de comparaison, on a ajouté la population du recensement de 1961 (suivant les limites en vigueur à ce temps-là). Les chiffres de 1956 se trouvent dans le rapport 1-6 du recensement de 1956 et ceux de 1901-1951 au tableau 9 du volume I du recensement de 1951. Un rapport spécial du recensement de 1966 (S-3) fournira les chiffres de 1966 et de 1961 pour les établissements non constitués ayant une population de 50 personnes ou plus.

Les tableaux du présent rapport donnent la population au recensement de 1966 et les chiffres comparatifs du recensement de 1961: a) des zones métropolitaines de recensement et de leurs parties constitutantes (tableau 11), et b) des autres grandes agglomérations urbaines et de leurs parties constitutantes (tableau 12). Suivant la définition, pour les besoins du recensement, une zone métropolitaine est un groupe d'agglomérations de prédominance urbaine qui sont étroitement liées au point de vue économique, géographique et social, quoique dans quelques cas (Regina, Saskatoon et Calgary) leurs municipalités de banlieue aient été annexées durant les récentes années. Les centres urbains classés comme "autres grandes agglomérations urbaines" possèdent les caractéristiques propres aux zones métropolitaines mais, dans la plupart des cas, la cité proprement dite est moins populeuse.
