

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INTRODUCTION

Final counts of the 1976 Census are presented in this report according to the urban and rural distribution of the Canadian population.

Table 7 provides population counts, by sex, for the provinces and territories. Urban population is broken down into seven size groups and rural population into farm and non-farm. Comparative data from the 1971 Census are provided. Table 8 presents urban and rural population counts, by sex, for census divisions. Comparative data from the 1971 Census are again provided. Table 9 presents population counts of the 1976 Census only, by sex, for census divisions, showing the seven urban size groups and the rural farm and non-farm population.

Size groups are assigned to urban areas. An urban area may cover more than one Census Division. In this case, the population of each part of a census division making up the urban area is classified according to the size group of the urban area as a whole.

The definition of urban areas (see below) is more restrictive in 1976 than in previous censuses. All areas must now show a density of 1,000 or more persons per square mile (386 per square kilometre), as well as the minimum population of 1,000, to be classified as urban. In previous censuses, this criterion applied only to areas outside the incorporated cities, towns and villages. While there was a significant reduction in area classified as urban because of the new definition, the reduction in population so classified was minimal.

Similarly, the definition of a census-farm (see "rural farm population" below) is more restrictive in 1976 than in previous censuses. Holdings of one acre (0.405 hectares) or more must now report sales of agricultural products during the past 12 months of \$1,200 or more to be considered census-farms, whereas in previous censuses the requirement was only \$50 in sales. Farm populations in 1971 have been reduced by the following amounts because of this change in definition:

The population counts from the 1971 Census, presented in Tables 7 and 8, have been adjusted to reflect the 1976 definitions and areas. The farm/non-farm breakdown of rural population counts (in Table 7) and the male/female breakdown of both urban and rural population counts (in Tables 7 and 8) are based on estimates of their 1971 values.

DEFINITIONS

Province: Major political division of Canada. From a statistical point of view, it is a basic unit for which data are tabulated and cross-classified. There are ten provinces which are divided into federal electoral districts, census divisions, census subdivisions, etc. In census publications, provincial tables include the Yukon and Northwest Territories.

Ce bulletin présente la répartition rurale et urbaine de la population canadienne fondée sur les chiffres définitifs du recensement de 1976.

Le tableau 7 donne les chiffres de population selon le sexe pour les provinces et les territoires. La population urbaine est répartie en sept groupes de taille et la population rurale est classée selon les catégories agricoles et non agricoles. Les chiffres comparatifs du recensement de 1971 sont indiqués. Le tableau 8 présente les chiffres de la population urbaine et rurale, selon le sexe, pour les divisions de recensement. Ce tableau renferme également les chiffres comparatifs du recensement de 1971. Le tableau 9 présente les chiffres de population du recensement de 1976 seulement, selon le sexe, pour les divisions de recensement, avec indication de la population rurale agricole et non agricole et des sept groupes de taille des régions urbaines.

Le groupe de taille est assigné à chaque région urbaine. Il peut arriver qu'une région urbaine déborde les limites d'une division de recensement. Dans ce cas, chaque partie de division de recensement composant la région urbaine voit sa population classifiée selon le groupe de taille de la région urbaine totale.

Le terme "région urbaine" (voir la définition ci-dessous) est plus restrictif en 1976 qu'il ne l'était lors des recensements précédents. En 1976, on a classé comme urbaines les régions dont la densité de la population était de 1,000 habitants ou plus au mille carré (386 habitants au kilomètre carré), et qui comptaient au moins 1,000 habitants. Lors des recensements précédents, ce critère ne s'appliquait qu'aux régions situées à l'extérieur des cités, villes et villages constitués. Bien que le nombre de régions classées comme urbaines ait beaucoup diminué en raison de la nouvelle définition, la population classée comme urbaine est demeurée presque inchangée.

De même, la définition de "ferme de recensement" (voir "population rurale agricole" ci-dessous) est plus restrictive en 1976 qu'elle ne l'était lors des recensements précédents. Les exploitations d'une acre (0.405 hectare) ou plus doivent maintenant déclarer des ventes de produits agricoles d'une valeur de \$1,200 ou plus au cours des 12 derniers mois pour être considérées comme fermes de recensement, tandis que dans les recensements antérieurs, l'exigence n'était que de \$50. En raison de cette modification, on observe les réductions suivantes relativement à la population agricole de 1971:

Les chiffres de population tirés du recensement de 1971 figurant aux tableaux 7 et 8 ont été recueillis afin de tenir compte des définitions et des régions en vigueur en 1976. La répartition de la population rurale selon les catégories agricole et non agricole (tableau 7) et la répartition de la population rurale et urbaine selon le sexe (tableaux 7 et 8) sont fondées sur des estimations des valeurs de 1971.

DÉFINITIONS

Province: Principale division politique du Canada. Du point de vue statistique, c'est une unité de base pour laquelle toutes les données sont totalisées et recoupées. Il y a dix provinces, divisées en circonscriptions électorales fédérales, en divisions de recensement, en subdivisions de recensement, etc. Dans les publications du recensement, les tableaux relatifs aux provinces comprennent le Yukon et les Territoires du Nord-Ouest.

DEFINITIONS – Concluded

Census Division (CD): General term applying to counties, regional districts, regional municipalities, etc. In Newfoundland, Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, the term describes geostatistical areas that have been created by Statistics Canada in co-operation with the province as an equivalent for counties.

Urban Area: Area having a population concentration of 1,000 or more and a population density of 1,000 or more per square mile (386 per square kilometre).

Urban Population: Persons living in an area having a population concentration of 1,000 or more and a population density of at least 1,000 per square mile (386 per square kilometre).

Urban Population Size Group: Classification used in tabulations where the urban areas are distributed according to the following size groups:

Rural Area: All territory lying outside "Urban Areas".

Rural Population: Persons living outside "Urban Areas".

Rural Farm Population: All persons living in dwellings situated on census-farms in rural areas. The rural farm population includes persons living on census-farms who are not connected with the farming operations and who derive their income from non-agricultural pursuits. Conversely, farm operators and their families who live elsewhere than on a census-farm are not included. A census-farm is any holding of one acre (0.405 hectare) or more with sales of agricultural products during the past 12 months of \$1,200 or more.

Rural Non-farm Population: All persons living in rural areas in dwellings not situated on census-farms.

SAMPLING AND WEIGHTING

The information in this report was collected on a 100% basis and as such represents the official census counts. All table headings are noted accordingly.

CONFIDENTIALITY AND RANDOM ROUNDING

The figures shown in this report have been subjected to a confidentiality procedure known as "random rounding" to prevent the possibility of associating small figures with any identifiable individual. Under this method, all figures including totals are randomly rounded (either up or down) to a multiple of "5". This technique provides strong protection against direct, residual or negative disclosures without adding significant error to the census

DÉFINITIONS – fin

Division de recensement (DR): Terme générique qui désigne les comtés, les districts régionaux, les municipalités régionales, etc. À Terre-Neuve, au Manitoba, en Saskatchewan et en Alberta, l'expression désigne les unités géostatistiques créées comme équivalent des comtés et délimitées par Statistique Canada en collaboration avec les provinces.

Région urbaine: Région dont la concentration démographique est de 1,000 habitants ou plus et dont la densité de population est de 1,000 habitants ou plus au mille carré (386 au kilomètre carré).

Population urbaine: Toutes les personnes demeurant dans une région dont la concentration de population est de 1,000 habitants ou plus et la densité d'au moins 1,000 habitants au mille carré (386 au kilomètre carré).

Groupe de taille de la population des régions urbaines: Classement utilisé dans les tableaux pour indiquer la répartition des régions urbaines selon les groupes de taille suivants:

Région rurale: Tout territoire situé en dehors des "régions urbaines".

Population rurale: Personnes demeurant en dehors des "régions urbaines".

Population rurale agricole: Toutes les personnes habitant des logements situés dans les fermes de recensement des régions rurales. La population rurale agricole comprend les personnes demeurant dans des fermes de recensement qui ne participent pas à l'exploitation agricole et qui tirent leur revenu d'occupations non agricoles. Inversement, les exploitants agricoles et leur famille qui demeurent ailleurs que dans leur exploitation ne sont pas compris. Constitue une ferme de recensement toute propriété d'une acre (0.405 hectare) ou plus dont la vente de produits agricoles s'est chiffrée à \$1,200 ou plus au cours des 12 derniers mois.

Population rurale non agricole: Toutes les personnes demeurant dans une région rurale et habitant un logement situé ailleurs que dans une ferme de recensement.

ÉCHANTILLONNAGE ET PONDÉRATION

Les renseignements de la présente publication ont été recueillis à 100 % et représentent les chiffres officiels de recensement. Les titres des tableaux sont annotés en conséquence.

CONFIDENTIALITÉ ET ARRONDISSEMENT ALÉATOIRE

Par souci de confidentialité, les chiffres présentés ici ont été soumis à une formule appelée "arrondissement aléatoire" qui interdit la possibilité d'associer des chiffres de faible importance à une personne reconnaissable. Grâce à cette méthode, tous les chiffres, y compris les totaux, sont arrondis de façon aléatoire (vers le haut ou vers le bas) à un multiple de "5". Cette technique assure une bonne protection contre la divulgation directe, négative ou par recoupements, sans ajouter

data. However, since totals are independently rounded they do not necessarily equal the sum of individual rounded figures in distributions. Also, minor differences can be expected for corresponding totals and cell values in various census reports. Similarly, percentages, which are calculated or rounded figures, do not necessarily add to the total. Percentage distributions and rates for the most part are based on rounded data, while percentage changes and averages are based on unrounded data. Users are advised that each table is noted accordingly. Additional details on the random rounding technique may be obtained by writing to the Census User Inquiry Service, Statistics Canada, Ottawa K1A 0T7.

BASIC MEASURES OF DATA QUALITY

Coverage Error

A coverage error occurs in the census whenever a person or a household is missed completely or counted more than once. Since overcoverage is fairly rare in relation to undercoverage, the net effect of such errors is to introduce a downward bias in census figures, so that the published census estimates tend to underestimate the actual population.

A special study was undertaken in relation to the 1976 Census to measure the extent of the bias due to undercoverage. This study estimated the over-all undercoverage rate to be of the order of 2% of the total population.

Evidence from studies of coverage errors in earlier censuses indicates that undercoverage is not evenly distributed throughout the population but tends to be higher in certain segments of the population, e.g., young male adults, recent immigrants.

Response Rates

The table below presents the response rates obtained in the 1976 Census for the stated characteristics. A response rate is defined as the number of times the value of the characteristic was obtained divided by the number of times it should have been obtained.

These response rates are published in order to give an indication, for each characteristic, of the proportion of cases which required imputation for non-response.

MESURES DE BASE DE LA QUALITÉ DES DONNÉES

Erreur de couverture

Une erreur de couverture se glisse chaque fois qu'une personne ou un ménage sont omis ou comptés plus d'une fois. Étant donné que le surdénombrement est assez rare par rapport au sous-dénombrement, les erreurs de couverture introduisent un biais vers le bas dans les estimations du recensement de sorte que ces dernières ont tendance à sous-représenter la population réelle.

On a mené une étude spéciale concernant le recensement de 1976 afin de mesurer l'importance des biais attribuables au sous-dénombrement. On a estimé que le taux global du sous-dénombrement représentait 2 % de la population totale.

Des études d'erreurs de couverture effectuées à l'occasion de recensements antérieurs ont révélé que le taux de sous-dénombrement n'était pas également réparti dans toute la population, mais qu'il avait tendance à être plus élevé pour certains segments de la population, par exemple, chez les jeunes adultes de sexe masculin et les nouveaux immigrants.

On peut obtenir de plus amples renseignements sur cette étude en communiquant avec Information recensement (voir la couverture arrière).

Taux de réponse

Le tableau ci-dessous présente les taux de réponse obtenus lors du recensement de 1976 relativement aux caractéristiques citées. Le taux de réponse est égal au quotient du nombre de fois que la valeur de la caractéristique a été obtenue par le nombre de fois qu'on aurait dû l'obtenir.

Ces taux de réponse sont publiés afin d'indiquer, pour chaque caractéristique, le pourcentage de cas qui ont dû être imputés en raison de la non-réponse.

BASIC MEASURES OF DATA QUALITY - Concluded**Total Standard Error**

The measures of reliability given in the table below are estimates of the total standard error (TSE)¹ of the published 1976 Census figures. These include the effects of sampling (where applicable) as well as the random or non-systematic components of response and processing errors. The total standard errors, however, do not include allowances for systematic errors such as coverage errors, biases due to similar misinterpretations of concepts by many respondents, or systematic processing errors. These estimates of reliability are published to give an indication of the level of error only and are not meant for use in hypothesis testing or detailed analysis.

Users wishing to obtain TSE estimates for a given cell of data in any table in the Volume Series should follow these procedures:

1. Determine if the table is based on the complete census or on the one-third sample.
2. Determine the categories defining the cell. In some cases, this may be just a single category (e.g., age 25-29), while for a cell in a cross-classification involving several variables, there may be several categories (e.g., married males aged 25-29).
3. Referring to the TSE table locate the cell-defining category which presents the highest value. Any column can be used for this comparison. For those categories where both 100% and sample TSE values are shown, use only the 100% rows for tables based on the complete census and only the sample rows for tables based on the one-third sample (see step 1).
4. Choose the column in the TSE table whose heading is closest to the value of the given cell in the census table. Approximations for intermediate values may be achieved by linear interpolation.
5. Read off the figure from the row (determined in step 3) and column (determined in step 4) of the TSE table.

When using these figures, the user can be reasonably certain that, for the enumerated population, the true value (discounting systematic and coverage errors) lies within plus or minus twice the total standard error (e.g., for a figure of 100 with a hypothetical TSE of 3, the range would be 100 ± 6) and virtually certain that it lies within plus or minus three times the total standard error (e.g., for the same figure of 100 with a hypothetical TSE of 3, the range would be 100 ± 9).

MESURES DE BASE DE LA QUALITÉ DES DONNÉES - fin**Erreur type totale**

Les mesures de fiabilité du tableau ci-dessous constituent des estimations de l'erreur type totale (ETT)¹ des chiffres publiés du recensement de 1976. L'erreur type totale englobe les effets de l'échantillonnage (s'il y a lieu) ainsi que les composantes aléatoires et non systématiques des erreurs de réponse et de dépouillement. Cependant, l'erreur type totale ne comprend pas les erreurs systématiques telles que les erreurs de couverture, les biais découlant d'une mauvaise compréhension des concepts par plusieurs recensés et les erreurs systématiques de dépouillement. Ces estimations de fiabilité sont présentées uniquement pour donner une indication du niveau d'erreur dans les chiffres du recensement et ne doivent pas être utilisées pour faire des tests d'hypothèses ou effectuer une analyse détaillée.

Les lecteurs qui veulent calculer des estimations de l'ETT pour une case donnée d'un tableau quelconque de cette série devront procéder de la façon suivante:

1. Déterminer si le tableau est fondé sur le recensement exhaustif ou sur l'échantillon partiel (un tiers).
2. Déterminer les catégories qui définissent la case. Dans certains cas, il peut n'y avoir qu'une seule catégorie (par ex., les 25-29 ans), tandis que dans le cas des classements recoupés mettant en jeu plusieurs variables, il peut y en avoir plusieurs (par ex., les hommes mariés âgés de 25 à 29 ans).
3. En consultant le tableau des ETT, situer la catégorie qui a la valeur la plus élevée. N'importe quelle colonne peut servir à cette comparaison. Dans le cas des catégories pour lesquelles sont indiquées les valeurs de l'ETT à la fois pour le recensement exhaustif et pour l'échantillon, utiliser uniquement les lignes du recensement pour les tableaux fondés sur le recensement exhaustif, et uniquement les lignes de l'échantillon pour les tableaux fondés sur l'échantillon d'un tiers des ménages (voir l'étape 1).
4. Dans le tableau des ETT, choisir la colonne dont l'en-tête se rapproche le plus de celle de la case donnée dans le tableau du recensement. Les approximations des valeurs intermédiaires peuvent être effectuées par interpolation linéaire.
5. Lire la valeur correspondant à la ligne (déterminée à l'étape 3) et à la colonne (déterminée à l'étape 4) du tableau des ETT.

L'utilisateur de ces chiffres peut être raisonnablement certain que, pour la population recensée, la vraie valeur (en faisant abstraction des erreurs systématiques et de couverture) se situe dans un intervalle de plus ou moins deux fois l'erreur type totale (par exemple, pour le chiffre 100 et une ETT hypothétique de 3, l'intervalle serait de 100 ± 6). L'utilisateur peut être presque certain que cette valeur se situe dans un intervalle de plus ou moins trois fois l'erreur type totale (par exemple, pour le chiffre 100 et une ETT hypothétique de 3, l'intervalle serait de 100 ± 9).




