



SUMMARY OF HOUSEHOLD AND FAMILY CHARACTERISTICS

This advance report presents a summary of data on household and family characteristics from the 1971 Census for provinces, census divisions, urban centres of 10,000 population and over and census metropolitan areas.

More detailed information on these subjects will be issued at later dates as part of the regular volume series of final reports of the 1971 Census. The purpose of this advance report is to make summary totals available at the earliest possible date for the larger geographic areas and urban centres.

Definitions on which these statistics are based appear on page 16. The following statement shows a comparison of some of the main items with the 1961 and 1966 Censuses.

All figures in this report have been subjected to the confidentiality procedure introduced in the 1971 Census to prevent the possibility of associating small figures with any identifiable individual. Briefly, it involves the random rounding of all last or unit digits. Since totals are independently rounded, they do not necessarily equal the sum of rounded figures in distributions. Also there may be slight differences between comparable figures in this report and those in other census bulletins. This technique will be described in the reports of the 1971 Census volume series.

Each bulletin of the 1971 Census volume series will include measures of reliability in the form of estimates of the mean square error for sets of characteristics covered in that bulletin. The user interested in obtaining an indication of the reliability of these advance data should refer to the appropriate bulletin in the volume series.

CARACTÉRISTIQUES SOMMAIRES DES MÉNAGES ET DES FAMILLES

Ce bulletin préliminaire présente des données sommaires sur les caractéristiques des ménages et des familles, d'après le recensement de 1971, pour les provinces, les divisions de recensement, les centres urbains de 10,000 habitants et plus et les régions métropolitaines de recensement.

De plus amples détails sur ces sujets paraîtront à une date ultérieure dans la série des volumes du recensement de 1971. L'objet de ce bulletin préliminaire est de communiquer le plus tôt possible les résultats sommaires pour les grands secteurs géographiques et les centres urbains.

Les définitions sur lesquelles ces statistiques sont fondées figurent à la page 16. On trouvera ci-après une comparaison de certains des principaux points avec ceux des recensements de 1961 et de 1966.

La confidentialité de toutes les données présentées ici est assurée par la méthode utilisée au recensement de 1971 pour interdire la possibilité d'associer des chiffres de faible importance à une personne en particulier. En un mot, cette méthode consiste à arrondir au hasard tous les derniers chiffres, c'est-à-dire les chiffres représentant les unités. Ainsi, tous les chiffres ayant été arrondis individuellement, leur somme ne donne pas nécessairement les totaux indiqués. Il peut également y avoir de légères différences entre des chiffres comparables de ce bulletin et ceux d'autres bulletins du recensement. Une description de cette technique figurera dans les bulletins de la série des volumes du recensement de 1971.

Chaque bulletin de la série des volumes du recensement de 1971 renfermera des mesures de fiabilité sous forme d'estimations de l'erreur quadratique moyenne relativement aux groupes de caractéristiques observées. L'utilisateur désireux de connaître le degré de fiabilité de ces données préliminaires devra consulter le bulletin approprié de la série des volumes.

DEFINITIONS

DÉFINITIONS

Household

For census purposes, a household consists of a person or group of persons occupying one dwelling. It usually consists of a family group with or without lodgers, employees, etc. However, it may consist of two or more families sharing a dwelling, of a group of unrelated persons or of one person living alone. Every person is a member of some household and there is a one-to-one relationship between households and occupied dwellings except in the case of certain special households, such as those of military and diplomatic personnel stationed overseas, from which no housing information was collected.

The census classifies households into two main groups: (1) the household which consists of one person or a small group of persons occupying an ordinary dwelling, usually spoken of as a private household, and (2) the "collective" type household which includes hotels, large lodging-houses of 10 or more lodgers, institutions, hospitals, or military camps, lumber camps and other establishments of a similar nature. Unless otherwise specified, these "collective" type households are excluded from household reports.

Family

A census family consists of a husband and wife (with or without children who have never been married, regardless of age) or a parent with one or more children never married, living in the same dwelling. A family may consist, also, of a man or woman living with a guardianship child or ward under 21 years for whom no pay was received.

Children in family

Refers to sons and daughters, under 25 years, who have never married and are living at home. Children who have ever been married, regardless of age, are not considered as members of their parents' family even though they are living in the same dwelling. Unmarried sons and daughters 25 years and over living at home on the census date are also family members, but considered as children only in a broad sense in a few tabulations.

The following were to be included as children: adopted children, stepchildren, foster children and wards for whom no pay was received.

Ménage

Aux fins du recensement, un ménage est formé d'une personne ou d'un groupe de personnes occupant un logement. Il se compose ordinairement d'un groupe familial, avec ou sans chambreurs, employés, etc. Il peut aussi se composer d'un groupe de personnes non apparentées, de deux familles ou plus partageant le même logement ou d'une personne seule. Toute personne est membre d'un ménage quelconque et le nombre de ménages est égal au nombre des logements occupés, sauf dans le cas de certains ménages spéciaux, les ménages des militaires et des membres du corps diplomatique en poste outre-mer, par exemple pour lesquels on n'a pas recueilli de données.

Les ménages sont divisés en deux groupes principaux: 1) les ménages privés, composés d'une personne ou d'un petit groupe de personnes, occupant un logement ordinaire, et 2) les ménages collectifs (hôtels, grandes maisons de chambres de 10 chambreurs ou plus, institutions, hôpitaux, camps militaires, camps de bûcherons et autres établissements semblables). Sauf indication contraire, ces ménages collectifs ne sont pas pris en compte dans les bulletins sur les ménages.

Famille

Une famille de recensement se compose de l'époux et de l'épouse avec ou sans enfants célibataires (peu importe leur âge) ou de l'un ou l'autre des parents avec un ou plusieurs enfants célibataires vivant dans le même logement. Une famille peut être formée également d'un homme et d'une femme vivant avec un enfant en tutelle ou un pupille de moins de 21 ans pour lequel ils ne reçoivent pas de rétribution.

Enfants faisant partie de la famille

Fils et filles célibataires de moins de 25 ans qui vivent à la maison. Les enfants qui ont déjà été mariés, peu importe leur âge, ne sont pas considérés comme membres de la famille de leurs parents même s'ils vivent dans le même logement. Les fils et filles célibataires de 25 ans et plus vivant à la maison le jour du recensement sont aussi membres de la famille, mais ils sont considérés comme "enfants" au sens large seulement dans quelques tableaux.

Les personnes suivantes sont aussi considérées comme enfants: les enfants adoptés, les enfants d'un autre lit, les enfants en tutelle et les pupilles pour lesquels on ne reçoit pas de rétribution.

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
