




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## INTRODUCTION

This bulletin provides final population counts of the 1981 Census for census divisions (CDs), census divisions according to the urban and rural distribution of the population, census subdivisions (CSDs), and for census metropolitan areas (CMAs) and/or census agglomerations (CAs) with CMA/CA parts and their component municipalities. Data for land area, population density and percentage population change 1976 to 1981 are also reported. This is one of 12 provincial and territorial bulletins (Catalogue Nos. 93-901 to 93-912) that together provide coverage for the entire country.

Population counts from the 1976 Census, included for comparison purposes, are reported in some tables of this bulletin. These 1976 counts have been adjusted to reflect the January 1, 1981 limits, upon which the 1981 Census is based, in cases where population has been affected by the annexation or loss of land through the alteration of municipal limits. Detailed descriptions of such alterations may be found in the two bulletins Changes to Municipal Boundaries, Status and Names (Catalogue No. 12-201, Annual), and Standard Geographical Classification, 1981, Vol. I (Catalogue No. 12-567, Occasional).

It should be noted that in 1981, for the first time, each Indian Reserve, Indian Settlement and unorganized territory is reported separately in those tables reporting data by census subdivisions.

All land area measurements apply to the limits in effect on January 1, 1981, the geographic reference date for the 1981 Census of Canada, and are reported in square kilometres. The map scales used to measure land area generally vary between 1:50,000 and 1:250,000. In densely populated urban areas and in sparsely populated areas, larger or smaller scales are sometimes used.

Land areas are measured using a planimeter and exclude, wherever feasible, large bodies of water. The Census of Canada provides unofficial land area measurements only, as these are required in order to calculate population density.

## INTRODUCTION

Ce bulletin présente les chiffres définitifs de population du recensement de 1981 pour les divisions de recensement (DR), les divisions de recensement selon la répartition urbaine et rurale de la population, les subdivisions de recensement (SDR), ainsi que pour les régions métropolitaines de recensement (RMR) et (ou) les agglomérations de recensement (AR) renfermant des parties de RMR/AR et leurs municipalités composantes. On y donne aussi des statistiques sur la superficie des terres, la densité de population et le taux de variation de la population entre 1976 et 1981. Ce bulletin fait partie d'une série de 12 publications sur les provinces et les territoires (nos 93-901 à 93-912 au catalogue), couvrant tout le Canada.

Les chiffres de population du recensement de 1976 figurent dans quelques tableaux de ce bulletin pour fins de comparaison. Ces chiffres ont été rectifiés pour tenir compte des limites des municipalités établies au 1er janvier 1981, lesquelles ont servi de base au recensement de 1981, dans tous les cas où le chiffre de population a changé par suite de modifications aux limites des municipalités. On pourra trouver une description détaillée de ces changements dans les bulletins intitulés Changements de limites, de statut et de nom des municipalités (n° 12-201 au catalogue, publication annuelle) et Classification géographique type, 1981. Vol. I (n° 12-567 au catalogue, publication hors série).

Il convient de noter que pour la première fois en 1981, chaque réserve indienne, chaque établissement indien et chaque territoire non organisé fait l'objet d'une entrée distincte dans les tableaux présentant des données par subdivisions de recensement.

Toutes les superficies de régions sont basées sur les limites en vigueur au 1er janvier 1981, c'est-à-dire la date de référence géographique du recensement du Canada de 1981, et sont données en kilomètres carrés. L'échelle des cartes ayant servi à mesurer ces superficies varie habituellement entre 1:50,000 et 1:250,000. Dans les régions urbaines fortement peuplées et dans les régions à faible densité de population, il se peut qu'une échelle plus grande ou plus petite ait été utilisée.

Les superficies sont mesurées à l'aide d'un planimètre et ne tiennent pas compte, dans la mesure du possible, des grandes étendues d'eau. Le recensement du Canada présente uniquement des superficies non officielles puisqu'elles sont nécessaires pour calculer la densité de population.

Table 1 presents population counts of the 1981 Census for census divisions. Table 2 breaks these counts down according to the urban and rural distribution of the population. The 1976 counts provided are based on the 1981 areas and have been recalculated according to the new urban definition. In 1976 the population density criterion for urban areas was 1,000 persons per square mile (386 persons per square kilometre). The 1981 population density criterion is 400 persons per square kilometre.

Table 3 presents population counts of the 1981 Census for census divisions showing the seven urban size groups and rural population. Urban areas are assigned to urban size groups on the basis of their total population. An urban area may fall in more than one census division. In this table the population of the urban area in each census division is reported according to the size group of the urban area as a whole. For example: urban area "x", with a population of 534,800, falls in census divisions "a" and "b". The population of that part of the urban area in census division "a" is 496,700 and in census division "b" is 38,100. These populations are reported in the size groups "500,000 and over" for both census divisions "a" and "b".

Table 4 presents population and total occupied dwelling counts for Canada, province, census divisions and census subdivisions. The total occupied dwelling counts include all private and collective dwellings occupied by usual residents as well as dwellings occupied solely by temporary or foreign residents. Those dwellings occupied solely by temporary or foreign residents are excluded from regular housing data reports.

Table 5 breaks down the population of each census metropolitan area and/or census agglomeration into (a) its CMA/CA part, i.e., urbanized core and fringe (urban part and rural part) and (b) the component municipalities in each CMA/CA part. Not all three CMA/CA parts will necessarily be found in each CMA or CA. A component municipality (or census subdivision) may be found in more than one CMA/CA part.

For the 1981 Census of Canada census agglomerations are delineated according to the same criteria as census metropolitan areas and differ only in the size of their urbanized cores (CMAs having urbanized cores of 100,000 or more population, CAs having urbanized cores of between 10,000 and 99,999 population). Twenty-four CAs have been added to the programme as a result of this change. At the same time 23 CAs have been deleted from the programme as a result of raising the minimum urbanized core population from 2,000 to 10,000. One 1976 CA, Trois-Rivières, Quebec,

Le tableau 1 illustre les chiffres de population du recensement de 1981 pour les divisions de recensement. Le tableau 2 ventile ces chiffres selon la répartition urbaine et rurale de la population. Les chiffres de 1976 s'appliquent aux régions de 1981 et ont été recalculés en fonction de la nouvelle définition de la région urbaine. En 1976, le critère de densité de population d'une région urbaine avait été établi à 1,000 habitants au mille carré (386 personnes au kilomètre carré). Pour 1981, ce critère est passé à 400 personnes au kilomètre carré.

Le tableau 3 présente les chiffres de population du recensement de 1981 pour les divisions de recensement avec indication des sept régions urbaines par groupe de taille et de la population rurale. Les régions urbaines sont attribuées à des groupes de taille selon leur population totale. Il se peut qu'une région urbaine touche à plus d'une division de recensement. Dans ce tableau, la population de la région urbaine dans chaque division de recensement est présentée selon le groupe de taille de la région urbaine prise dans son ensemble. Donnons un exemple: la région urbaine "x", qui compte une population de 534,800 habitants, se trouve dans les divisions de recensement "a" et "b". La population de la région urbaine située dans la division de recensement "a" s'établit à 496,700 habitants tandis que dans la division de recensement "b", elle est de 38,100 habitants. Ces deux chiffres de population figureront dans les groupes de taille "500,000 et plus" pour les deux divisions de recensement "a" et "b".

Le tableau 4 donne les chiffres de population et le nombre total de logements occupés pour le Canada, la province, les divisions de recensement et les subdivisions de recensement. Le nombre total de logements occupés englobe tous les logements privés et collectifs occupés par des résidents habituels ainsi que les logements occupés seulement par des résidents temporaires ou étrangers. Les logements appartenant à cette dernière catégorie sont exclus des bulletins réguliers de données sur le logement.

Le tableau 5 ventile la population de chaque région métropolitaine de recensement et (ou) agglomération de recensement selon a) la partie de RMR/AR, c'est-à-dire le noyau urbanisé et la banlieue (partie urbaine et partie rurale) et b) selon les municipalités composantes qui se trouvent dans chaque partie de RMR/AR. Chaque RMR ou AR ne comprendra pas nécessairement les trois parties de RMR/AR. Une municipalité composante (ou subdivision de recensement) pourrait se trouver dans plus d'une partie de RMR/AR.

Pour les fins du recensement du Canada de 1981, les agglomérations de recensement sont délimitées en fonction des mêmes critères que les régions métropolitaines de recensement, mais elles ne s'en distinguent que par la taille de leur noyau urbanisé (les RMR ont un noyau urbanisé de 100,000 habitants ou plus et celui des AR peut varier entre 10,000 et 99,999 habitants). Vingt-quatre AR ont été ajoutées au programme à la suite de cette modification. Par la même occasion, 23 AR ont été éliminées du programme lorsque nous avons relevé le seuil minimal de population du noyau urbanisé de 2,000 à 10,000 habitants. Une AR

has been transferred to the CMA programme as a result of recent growth in its urbanized core. The net effect of the above changes has been to maintain the total number of CAs at 88.

Table 6 lists all census subdivisions in alphabetical order and gives a guide to the location of each as to census division and census consolidated subdivision. When applicable the census metropolitan area or census agglomeration in which a census subdivision is located is also indicated.

More detailed tables of data covering demographic, social and economic characteristics of individuals as well as characteristics of dwellings, households and families are provided for census divisions (Catalogue Nos. 95-902 and 95-942), census subdivisions with a population of 5,000 or more (Catalogue Nos. 95-904 and 95-945), census metropolitan areas and their components (Catalogue Nos. 95-903 and 95-943) and census agglomerations and their components (Catalogue Nos. 95-903 and 95-944).

Thematic maps of census data are presented for 12 large CMAs in a new series of Metropolitan Atlas bulletins (Catalogue Nos. 99-919 to 99-930).

Reference maps showing census divisions and census subdivisions are available in a separate bulletin (Catalogue No. 99-907). Another bulletin (Catalogue No. 99-906) provides two series of maps showing census metropolitan areas and census agglomerations with their CMA/CA parts and components.

## DEFINITIONS

**Province.** Refers to the major political division of Canada. From a statistical point of view, it is a basic unit for which data are tabulated and cross-classified. In census publications, provincial tables include the Yukon and Northwest Territories.

**Census Division (CD).** Refers to the general term applying to counties, regional districts, regional municipalities and five other types of geographic areas made up of groups of census subdivisions. In Newfoundland, Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, the term describes areas that have been created by Statistics Canada in cooperation with the provinces as an equivalent for counties.

**Urban Area.** Refers to an area having a population concentration of 1,000 or more and a population density of 400 or more per square kilometre.

**Urban Population.** Refers to persons living in an area having a population concentration of 1,000 or more and a population density of 400 or more per square kilometre.

de 1976, Trois-Rivières (Québec), a été ajoutée au programme des RMR puisque son noyau urbanisé a connu une récente croissance de sa population. Tous ces changements ont eu pour effet de maintenir le nombre total d'AR à 88.

Le tableau 6 présente toutes les subdivisions de recensement par ordre alphabétique et précise leur localisation par rapport à chaque division de recensement et subdivision de recensement unifiée. On a également indiqué, lorsqu'il y a lieu, la région métropolitaine de recensement ou l'agglomération de recensement dans laquelle une subdivision de recensement se trouvait.

Des tableaux plus détaillés sur les caractéristiques démographiques, sociales et économiques des particuliers ainsi que sur les caractéristiques des logements, des ménages et des familles peuvent être obtenus pour les divisions de recensement (nos 95-902 et 95-942 au catalogue), les subdivisions de recensement comptant 5,000 habitants ou plus (nos 95-904 et 95-945 au catalogue), les régions métropolitaines de recensement et leurs composantes (nos 95-903 et 95-943 au catalogue) et les agglomérations de recensement et leurs composantes (nos 95-903 et 95-944 au catalogue).

Les cartes thématiques des données du recensement sont présentées pour 12 grandes RMR dans une nouvelle série de bulletins de cartes sur les régions métropolitaines (nos 99-919 à 99-930 au catalogue).

Les cartes de référence indiquant les divisions de recensement et les subdivisions de recensement figurent dans un bulletin distinct (n° 99-907 au catalogue). Une autre publication (n° 99-906 au catalogue) présente deux séries de cartes illustrant les régions métropolitaines de recensement et les agglomérations de recensement avec leurs parties de RMR/AR et leurs composantes.

## DÉFINITIONS

**Province.** Principale division politique du Canada. Du point de vue statistique, c'est une unité de base pour laquelle toutes les données sont totalisées et recoupées. Dans les publications du recensement, les tableaux relatifs aux provinces comprennent le Yukon et les Territoires du Nord-Ouest.

**Division de recensement (DR).** Terme générique qui désigne les comtés, les districts régionaux, les municipalités régionales et cinq autres types de régions géographiques formées de groupes de subdivisions de recensement. À Terre-Neuve, au Manitoba, en Saskatchewan et en Alberta, l'expression désigne les unités créées comme équivalents des comtés et délimitées par Statistique Canada en collaboration avec les provinces.

**Région urbaine.** Région dont la concentration démographique est de 1,000 habitants ou plus et dont la densité de population est de 400 habitants ou plus au kilomètre carré.

**Population urbaine.** Personnes demeurant dans une région qui a une concentration démographique de 1,000 habitants et plus, et une densité de population de 400 habitants ou plus au kilomètre carré.

**Urban Population Size Group.** Refers to the classification used in tabulations where the urban areas are distributed according to the following size groups:

Urban areas are defined using population data from the previous census. It can therefore occur that an area meeting the criteria and defined as urban according to the population data of the 1976 Census will contain fewer than 1,000 people according to the 1981 Census. Where this occurs the population is assigned to the urban population size group 1,000 to 2,499.

**Rural Area.** Refers to all territory lying outside "Urban Areas".

**Rural Population.** Refers to persons living outside "Urban Areas".

**Census Subdivision (CSD).** Refers to the general term applying to municipalities, Indian Reserves, Indian Settlements and unorganized territories.

In Newfoundland, Nova Scotia and British Columbia, the term also describes geostatistical areas that have been created by Statistics Canada in cooperation with the provinces as an equivalent for municipalities.

**Census Subdivision Type.** Census subdivisions are classified into various types, according to official designations adopted by provincial or federal authorities. With the exception of unorganized territories and Indian Reserves, the type indicates the municipal status of a CSD. The following list indicates the abbreviations used for the most common CSD types:

Les régions urbaines sont définies à partir des données démographiques du recensement précédent. Il peut arriver qu'un territoire répondant aux critères et défini comme urbain selon les données démographiques du recensement de 1976 contienne moins de 1,000 personnes selon les résultats du recensement de 1981. Dans ce cas la population de ce territoire fera partie du groupe de taille de la population urbaine 1,000 à 2,499.

**Région rurale.** Tout territoire situé en dehors des "régions urbaines".

**Population rurale.** Toutes les personnes vivant à l'extérieur des régions urbaines.

**Subdivision de recensement (SDR).** Terme générique qui désigne les municipalités, les réserves indiennes, les établissements indiens et les territoires non organisés.

A Terre-Neuve, en Nouvelle-Écosse et en Colombie-Britannique, l'expression désigne également des unités géostatistiques créées comme équivalents des municipalités et délimitées par Statistique Canada en collaboration avec les provinces.

**Catégorie de subdivision de recensement.** Les subdivisions de recensement sont classées en diverses catégories selon les appellations adoptées par les autorités provinciales ou fédérales. A l'exception des territoires non organisés et des réserves indiennes, la catégorie indique le statut d'une subdivision de recensement. Voici la liste des abréviations des catégories de subdivision de recensement les plus courantes:

**Census Consolidated Subdivision (CCS).** A census consolidated subdivision is a geographically contiguous group of census subdivisions.

Two rules are applied in delineating census consolidated subdivisions:

- (1) all census subdivisions smaller than 25 square kilometres are grouped with a larger subdivision; and
- (2) if a census subdivision greater than 25 square kilometres is surrounded on more than half its perimeter by another subdivision, it is included as part of the CCS formed by the other subdivision; if not, the census subdivision forms a CCS on its own.

**Municipality.** Refers to an area with corporate status governed by Provincial and Territorial Acts. These acts differ from province to province. Moreover, municipalities within each province vary in name, status, and administrative powers.

**Indian Reserve.** Refers to territory, mostly rural and varying in size, that belongs to an Indian tribe according to treaties between the Federal Government and the Indians. It is excluded from local jurisdiction and administered by the Federal Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development.

**Unorganized Territory.** Refers to an area without municipal organization, directly administered by the province or, when applicable, by the county. Such areas are generally characterized by low population density.

**Occupied Private Dwelling.** Refers to a private dwelling in which a person or group of persons is permanently residing. Also included are private dwellings whose usual residents are temporarily absent on Census Day.

**Subdivision de recensement unifiée (SRU).** Une subdivision de recensement unifiée est une unité géostatistique qui regroupe plusieurs subdivisions de recensement adjacentes.

Pour délimiter les subdivisions de recensement unifiées, il faut appliquer les deux règles suivantes:

- (1) toutes les subdivisions de recensement de moins de 25 kilomètres carrés sont incluses dans une plus grande subdivision de recensement;
- (2) si une subdivision de recensement dont la superficie est supérieure à 25 kilomètres carrés est entourée d'une autre subdivision de recensement sur plus de la moitié de son périmètre, elle fait alors partie de la SRU formée par la subdivision de recensement environnante; sinon, elle constitue à elle seule une SRU.

**Municipalité.** Territoire constitué en corporation, régi par des lois provinciales et territoriales. Les lois diffèrent d'une province à une autre. De plus, dans chaque province, les municipalités ont des appellations, des statuts et des pouvoirs administratifs différents.

**Réserve indienne.** Territoire, le plus souvent rural et de taille variable, qui appartient à une tribu indienne en vertu de traités conclus entre le gouvernement fédéral et les Indiens. Elle échappe à la compétence des autorités locales et est administrée par le ministère des Affaires indiennes et du Nord.

**Territoire non organisé.** Région sans organisation municipale, administrée directement par la province ou, selon le cas, par le comté. Ces régions sont généralement caractérisées par la faible densité de leur population.

**Logement privé occupé.** Logement privé occupé de façon permanente par une personne ou un groupe de personnes. Sont également inclus dans cette catégorie les logements privés dont les résidents habituels sont temporairement absents le jour du recensement.

## DEFINITIONS - Continued

**Private Dwelling Occupied by Foreign and/or Temporary Residents.** Refers to a private dwelling solely occupied by foreign and/or temporary residents on Census Day. A TEMPORARY RESIDENT of a dwelling is a person who resides there on Census Day, but has a usual place of residence elsewhere in Canada. A FOREIGN RESIDENT is a person whose usual place of residence is outside Canada.

**Collective Dwelling.** Refers to a dwelling of a commercial, institutional or communal nature. It may be identified by a sign on the premises or by a Census Representative speaking with the person in charge or with a resident or a neighbour, etc. Included are hotels, motels, tourist homes, nursing homes, hospitals, staff residences, communal quarters of military camps, work camps, jails, missions, rooming- or lodging-houses, and so on. Collective dwellings may be occupied by usual residents or solely by foreign and/or temporary residents.

**Census Metropolitan Area (CMA).** Refers to the main labour market area of an urbanized core (or continuously built-up area) having 100,000 or more population. CMAs are created by Statistics Canada and are usually known by the name of the urban area forming their urbanized core. They contain whole municipalities (or census subdivisions). CMAs are comprised of (1) municipalities completely or partly inside the urbanized core; and (2) other municipalities if (a) at least 40% of the employed labour force living in the municipality works in the urbanized core, or (b) at least 25% of the employed labour force working in the municipality lives in the urbanized core.

Since a CMA must contain whole census subdivisions, its limits may fall within, or extend beyond, the actual labour market area. The differences may be significant in those parts of Canada where census subdivisions cover particularly large areas of land. Census metropolitan areas may also differ from Metropolitan Areas designated by local authorities for planning or other purposes.

**Census Agglomeration (CA).** Refers to the main labour market area of an urbanized core (or continuously built-up area) having between 10,000 and 99,999 population. CAs are created by Statistics Canada and are usually known by the name of the urban area forming their urbanized core. They contain whole municipalities (or census subdivisions). CAs are comprised of (1) municipalities completely or partly inside the urbanized core; and (2) other municipalities if (a) at least 40% of the employed labour force living in the municipality works in the urbanized core, or (b) at least 25% of the employed labour force working in the municipality lives in the urbanized core.

## DÉFINITIONS - suite

**Logement privé occupé par des résidents étrangers et (ou) temporaires.** Logement privé occupé uniquement par des résidents étrangers et (ou) temporaires le jour du recensement. Le RÉSIDENT TEMPORAIRE d'un logement est une personne qui habitait ce logement le jour du recensement, mais dont le domicile habituel se trouve ailleurs au Canada. Un RÉSIDENT ÉTRANGER est une personne dont le domicile habituel est à l'extérieur du Canada.

**Logement collectif.** Institution ou établissement commercial ou communautaire qui s'affiche comme tel ou que le recenseur peut identifier comme tel en s'adressant à la personne qui en a la charge, à un résident, à un voisin, etc. Sont inclus dans cette catégorie les hôtels, les motels, les maisons de chambres pour touristes, les maisons de repos, les hôpitaux, les résidences de personnel, les casernes de camps militaires, les camps de chantier, les prisons, les centres d'accueil, les pensions et maisons de chambres, etc. Il peut s'agir d'un logement occupé par des résidents habituels ou uniquement par des résidents étrangers et (ou) temporaires.

**Région métropolitaine de recensement (RMR).** Principal marché du travail d'un noyau urbanisé (ou d'une zone bâtie en continu) comptant 100,000 habitants ou plus. Les RMR sont créées par Statistique Canada et sont ordinairement désignées par le nom de la région urbaine qui forme leur noyau urbanisé. Elles renferment des municipalités (ou subdivisions de recensement) entières. Il est également possible que des régions métropolitaines de recensement ne concordent pas avec les régions métropolitaines désignées par les autorités locales à des fins de planification ou autres.

**Agglomération de recensement (AR).** Principal marché du travail d'un noyau urbanisé (ou d'une zone bâtie en continu) comptant entre 10,000 et 99,999 habitants. Les AR sont créées par Statistique Canada et sont ordinairement désignées par le nom de la région urbaine qui forme leur noyau urbanisé. Elles renferment des municipalités (ou subdivisions de recensement) entières. Une AR comprend (1) les municipalités qui se trouvent en totalité ou en partie à l'intérieur du noyau urbanisé et (2) d'autres municipalités si a) au moins 40 % de la population active occupée demeurant dans la municipalité travaille dans le noyau urbanisé ou si b) au moins 25 % de la population active occupée travaillant dans la municipalité demeure dans le noyau urbanisé.

## DEFINITIONS - Concluded

Since a CA must contain whole census subdivisions, its limits may fall within, or extend beyond, the actual labour market area. The differences may be significant in those parts of Canada where census subdivisions cover particularly large areas of land.

**CMA/CA Part.** Census metropolitan areas (CMAs) and census agglomerations (CAs) are divided into three parts: urbanized core, urban fringe and rural fringe. The parts are always made up of complete enumeration areas, but often comprise only parts of municipalities (or census subdivisions). Not all three parts will necessarily be found in each CMA or CA.

**Urbanized core:** Continuous built-up area around which a CMA or a CA is delineated. To be considered as continuous, the built-up area must not have a discontinuity exceeding two kilometres. Usually its name is used as the name of the CMA or CA.

**Fringe:** Parts of a CMA or a CA outside the urbanized core. The fringe consists of urban parts and rural parts.

**Component.** Refers to the municipality or census subdivision building block of a census metropolitan area or a census agglomeration.

**Enumeration Area (EA).** Refers to the spatial unit usually canvassed by one Census Representative. It is defined according to the following criteria: (1) Population - the number of households in an enumeration area varies between a maximum of 375 households in large urban areas to a minimum of 125 in rural areas; (2) Limits - an enumeration area, being the building block of all geostatistical areas, never cuts across any geographic area recognized by the census. Moreover, enumeration area boundaries are such that the Census Representative will be able to locate them without difficulty as, for example, streets, roads, railways, rivers and lakes. Enumeration areas are normally the smallest geographic unit for which census data are available.

**Land Area.** Refers to area measurement in square kilometres and excludes, wherever feasible, large bodies of water.

**Population Density.** Refers to the number of persons per square kilometre.

**Reference Map.** Refers to a map that identifies and locates the boundaries of census geostatistical areas.

## DÉFINITIONS - fin

Puisqu'une AR doit renfermer des subdivisions de recensement entières, ses limites peuvent se trouver dans le secteur réel du marché du travail, ou s'étendre en dehors de celui-ci. Les différences peuvent être importantes dans les régions du Canada où les subdivisions de recensement ont une très grande superficie.

**Partie de RMR/AR.** Les régions métropolitaines de recensement (RMR) et les agglomérations de recensement (AR) se divisent en trois parties: noyau urbanisé, banlieue urbaine et banlieue rurale. Les parties sont toujours formées de secteurs de dénombrement entiers, mais ne comprennent souvent que des parties de municipalités (ou subdivisions de recensement). Les trois parties ne se retrouvent pas toutes nécessairement dans chaque RMR ou AR.

**Noyau urbanisé:** zone bâtie en continu autour de laquelle une RMR ou une AR est délimitée. Pour être considérée comme continue, une zone bâtie ne doit pas comporter d'espaces libres de plus de deux kilomètres. Son nom sert habituellement de nom à la RMR ou à l'AR.

**Banlieue:** partie d'une RMR ou d'une AR située en dehors du noyau urbanisé. La banlieue est formée de parties urbaines et de parties rurales.

**Composante.** Municipalité ou subdivision de recensement qui constitue l'unité de base d'une région métropolitaine de recensement ou d'une agglomération de recensement.

**Secteur de dénombrement (SD).** Unité géographique dénombrée par un recenseur. Elle est définie selon les critères suivants: (1) Population - le nombre de ménages dans un secteur de dénombrement peut varier de 375 (maximum) dans les grandes régions urbaines à 125 (minimum) dans les régions rurales; (2) Limites - un secteur de dénombrement étant l'unité de base de toutes les unités géostatistiques ne déborde jamais une unité reconnue par le recensement. Par ailleurs, les limites des secteurs de dénombrement sont telles que le recenseur peut les repérer sans difficulté, par exemple, rues, chemins, voies ferrées, rivières et lacs. Les secteurs de dénombrement constituent normalement les plus petites unités géographiques pour lesquelles on peut obtenir des données de recensement.

**Superficie.** Surface en kilomètres carrés excluant les grandes nappes d'eau, lorsque cela est possible.

**Densité de population.** Nombre de personnes au kilomètre carré.

**Carte de référence.** Carte qui délimite et situe les unités géostatistiques de recensement.

## SAMPLING

The 1981 Census data were collected either on a 100% basis (i.e. from all households) or on a sample basis (i.e. from only a random sample of households) with data weighted to provide estimates of the entire population. The information in this report was collected on a 100% basis. All table headings are noted accordingly.

## COVERAGE ERROR

A coverage error occurs in the census whenever a person or a household is missed completely or counted more than once. Since overcoverage is fairly rare in relation to undercoverage, the net effect of such errors is to introduce a downward bias in census figures, so that the published census estimates tend to underestimate the actual population.

A special study was undertaken in relation to the 1976 Census to measure the extent of the bias due to undercoverage. This study estimated the overall undercoverage rate to be of the order of 2% of the total population for persons and 2% for households. It also indicated that undercoverage is higher in certain segments of the population, e.g., young male adults and recent immigrants. Similar trends were obtained in connection with the 1971 Census.

A comparable study was undertaken for the 1981 Census but the results were not available at the time this report was published. The results are included in Data Quality - Total Population (Catalogue No. 99-904) as part of a comprehensive assessment of the quality of the census data.

## REFERENCE PRODUCTS

The 1981 Census Dictionary (Catalogue No. 99-901) contains the complete range of definitions for all variables and terms used in the 1981 Census data products. Of general interest would be information contained in Summary Guide - Total Population (Catalogue No. 99-902) and Summary Guide - Sample Population (Catalogue No. 99-903) which include lists and indexes of tables appearing in the data publications, as well as reproductions of the census questionnaire forms and basic indicators of data quality. Further details on the data quality may be obtained from Data Quality - Total Population (Catalogue No. 99-904) and Data Quality - Sample Population (Catalogue No. 99-905).

A wide range of other analytical and reference products are available and described, along with information on data products and available services, in Products and Services of the 1981 Census of Canada.

## ÉCHANTILLONNAGE

Les données du recensement de 1981 ont été recueillies sur une base de 100 % (c'est-à-dire auprès de tous les ménages) ou par un échantillonnage aléatoire des ménages; ces données sont pondérées afin de fournir des estimations sur l'ensemble de la population. Les renseignements figurant dans le présent bulletin ont été recueillis selon la première méthode. Tous les titres des tableaux ont été annotés en conséquence.

## ERREUR D'OBSERVATION

Il y a erreur d'observation au recensement lorsqu'on oublie complètement une personne ou un ménage ou qu'on le compte plus d'une fois. Étant donné que le sous-dénombrement est assez rare par rapport au sous-dénombrement, de telles erreurs produisent un biais vers le bas dans les statistiques du recensement, de sorte que les estimations publiées du recensement tendent à sous-estimer le chiffre réel de population.

On a entrepris une étude spéciale sur le recensement de 1976 afin d'évaluer le biais entraîné par le sous-dénombrement. Selon les résultats, le taux global du sous-dénombrement serait de 2 % de l'ensemble de la population dans le cas des particuliers et de 2 % pour les ménages. L'étude a révélé que le sous-dénombrement est plus élevé dans certains groupes de la population, par exemple chez les jeunes adultes de sexe masculin et les nouveaux immigrants. On avait décelé les mêmes tendances lors du recensement de 1971.

Une étude similaire a été entreprise pour le recensement de 1981, mais les résultats n'étaient pas accessibles au moment de la parution du présent bulletin. Ils figurent toutefois dans la publication Qualité des données - Population totale (nº 99-904 au catalogue), laquelle constitue une évaluation globale de la qualité des données obtenues au recensement.

## PRODUITS DE RÉFÉRENCE

Le Dictionnaire du recensement de 1981 (nº 99-901 au catalogue) donne les définitions de toutes les variables et de tous les termes utilisés dans les produits du recensement de 1981. Les renseignements que renferment le Guide sommaire - Population totale (nº 99-902 au catalogue) et le Guide sommaire - Population-échantillon (nº 99-903 au catalogue), présentent un intérêt général puisqu'ils donnent la liste et l'index de tous les tableaux des publications ainsi qu'une reproduction des questionnaires du recensement et les indicateurs de base de la qualité des données. On peut obtenir plus de détails sur la qualité des données dans Qualité des données - Population totale (nº 99-904 au catalogue) et Qualité des données - Population-échantillon (nº 99-905 au catalogue).

La publication Produits et services du recensement du Canada de 1981 décrit une foule d'autres analyses et de produits de référence, et fournit des renseignements sur les produits et services disponibles.
