AGES OF THE PEOPLE.

This bulletin contains the statistics of ages of the people by single years as reported at the date of the Fifth Census of Canada, taken as of June 1, 1911, by totals for Canada and for each of the provinces, also comparative statistics of the distribution of the people by age periods in 1911 and 1901.

It is impossible to claim absolute accuracy for census statistics of ages because (1) some people do not know their true age, (2) some people appear to deliberately mis-state their age and (3) in many instances the report of ages is not made by the persons themselves but by persons who have not an exact knowledge of the person or persons concerning whom the enumerator is prosecuting the enquiry as to age. This is especially true in the case of boarders and lodgers. There is also the tendency of people to state their age in round numbers. For example the number of persons at the age of 30 is much greater than the number at either 29 or 31. This reporting of ages as being at 25, 30, 35, 40, 50, etc., is apparently not always, if ever, done for the purpose of pushing back the hand of time.

The groupings of ages in the following table would seem to indicate that there is nearly as great a tendency on the part of the people to overstate their true age as there is to underestimate it. For example in Group 1 the number of persons in class 2 (age 29) is smaller than the number in either classes 1 or 3 (ages 28 or 30), and the number in class 4 (age 31) is smaller than the number in either classes 3 or 5 (ages 30 or 32) and similarly in the other groups.

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The tendency of clustering is as noticeable in the groups of which 70, 75 and 80 are the medials as it is in the younger ages. The proportion of discrepancy is fairly level for both sexes.

In Table 2 the population is classified according to certain more or less recognized age periods of life. For example, generally speaking, the years under 5 may be considered as those of childhood, the years from 5 to 14 as those of school-life, the years from 15 to 24 as those of apprenticeship, trade-learning or of other means of preparation for life's battle, the years from 25 to 44 as those of the prime of life, the years from 45 to 64 as those of middle life, and those of 65 years and over as old age.

Table 3 affords comparisons of the proportion per 1,000 at certain age periods with the previous census. The statistics for the Yukon and the Northwest territories are not given in the table but are included in the total population of Canada. The names of the provinces are arranged from west to east.

The largest proportion per 1,000 of persons under ten years is found in the province of Quebec with 273·508 as compared with 271·456 in 1901 when it also held the premier position. The lowest proportion is found in British Columbia with 166·345 followed by Ontario with 200·316 per 1,000; these two provinces occupied the same relative positions in 1901, the former having 169·374 and the latter 208·393 per 1,000. The provinces which show a betterment at this age are Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Quebec. The greatest falling off is shown by Manitoba, which has dropped from 270·094 to 248·677 and by Prince Edward Island, which has fallen from 232·086 to 214·450 per 1,000. The Western provinces are the regions of young men and women as is shown by the large percentage of the population between the ages of 20 and 45. It is an interesting fact that the highest proportion for this age period is to be found in British Columbia and that as we come eastward the proportion assumes a constantly decreasing figure.

The provinces showing the largest proportion over 70 years of age are Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Ontario with 52·9, 46·6, 38·1 and 34·7 respectively per 1,000, while those showing the lowest are Alberta, Saskatchewan, British Columbia and Manitoba with 8·2, 8·8, 12·3 and 13·3 per 1,000 respectively. That Canada is pre-eminently



Table 5 deals with the conjugal or civil condition of the people 15 years of age and over by numbers and percentages for males and females. As the proportion of divorces for both sexes is only about six in every 10,000 the percentages for them are not worked out. Of the total male population 62 per cent are single, 34.85 per cent married and 2.33 per cent widowed; of the total female population 57.37 per cent are single, 36.97 per cent married and 5.31 per cent widowed.

The records of the last census show that one male and 30 females under the age of 15 had assumed the cares of married life. The one adventurous male was a foreigner in Alberta, while the females comprised 17 Canadian-born, 5 British-born and 8 foreign-born; of the native-born 4 resided in New Brunswick, 4 in Ontario and 9 in Quebec, of the British-born 2 lived in Alberta, one each in British Columbia, Manitoba and Saskatchewan, while of the foreign-born married females under 15 years of age 3 were in Alberta, 1 in British Columbia, 2 in Ontario and 2 in Saskatchewan.

It will be observed that only 1.20 per cent of males and 6.9 per cent of females between the ages of 15 and 19 were married. Of the total male and female population between the ages of 20 and 40 years of age 45.8 per cent of the former and 63.6 per cent of the latter were married. The percentage of the widowed is greater for females at every age period, starting with those in the 15-19 group and the disproportion becomes more marked as the years advance. This apparently shows that the rate of mortality is greater among married males than among married females, or it may be that the latter remain widowed to a greater extent than the former.



a country of young people is evidenced by the fact that 812·9 persons in every 1,000 of the population of known age are under 45 years. As there are only 5 persons in every 1,000, or  $\frac{1}{2}$  of one per cent of the total population for whom an age is not given, computations on the basis of known ages are not presented.

Table 4 shows for 1911 and 1901 the per cent distribution of the population by five year age periods and the number of males to every 100 females at every age period. Of the total population 12·31 per cent were under five years of age in 1911 as against 11·97 per cent in 1901, whilst those who had reached the allotted span of life represented only 2·31 per cent in the last census as compared with 3·04 per cent in the preceding one.

There were 30·03 per cent of the population between the ages of 5 and 19 as compared with 32·57 per cent in 1901. It is also worthy of note that only 14·02 per cent of the total population were fifty years of age and over in 1911 as compared with 14·42 in 1901.

The influence of immigration on the relative standing of the sexes is shown by the fact that in 1911 there were nearly 113 men to every 100 women as compared with 105 to 100 in 1901. For the population under 15 years of age the proportion of males to females is fairly level, with the former having but a slight advantage. In the population between the ages of 20 and 45 this influence is strikingly shown—the aggregates for this period giving 124 males to 100 females. At the age of 70 the ratio of males to females assumes again its normal proportions. From 80 years of age and upwards the female population exhibits a greater tenacity of life than do the males.







Table 7 affords an opportunity to compare the per cent distribution of the population in the principal cities and towns of Canada by sex and age periods. The percentages for each age period are calculated for males on the total male population and for females on the total female population of each city and town in the class. In the city of Vancouver, for example, the table shows that 6.98 per cent of the total male population of 60,227 are under 5 years of age, 10.77 per cent from 5 to 14 years of age and 47.13 per cent between the ages of 25 and 44; and that 10.31 per cent of the total female population of 40,174 are under 5 years of age, 15.97 per cent between the ages of 5 and 14 and 37.64 per cent between the ages of 25 and 44. That the smallness of the percentage of males in western cities in the earlier years is due to migration and immigration is indicated not only by the excess of males over females in the totals but more particularly in the ages between 15 and 45.

In all eastern cities the female population outnumbers the male in very nearly a corresponding ratio to the extent that males preponderate over females in the west. Montreal is the only Canadian city where the numbers of males and females are in fairly true proportions.

In Table 8 the percentages for each age period are computed for both males and females on the total population of each city and town in the class, whereas in Table 7 the percentages are computed on the totals of males and females respectively. In other words the percentages in Table 7 are in relation to the totals of each sex while in Table 8 they are in relation to the total population. In the city of Vancouver the table shows that 4·19 per cent of the total population of 100,041 are males and 4·12 per cent females under 5 years of age, and so on through the other age periods.




