AGRICULTURE OF QUEBEC FOR THE YEAR 1910 AS ENUMERATED UNDER DATE OF 1ST JUNE, 1911.

PUBLISHED BY AUTHORITY OF THE HONOURABLE GEORGE E. FOSTER, MINISTER OF TRADE AND COMMERCE.
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QUEBEC.

The province of Quebec was known under the name of New France or Canada from 1608 to 1765, as the Province of Quebec from 1765 to 1790, as Lower Canada from 1791 to 1840, as Canada East from 1841 to 1867, and when by the union of the four original provinces the Confederation of the Dominion of Canada was formed, it again became known as the Province of Quebec.

It is interesting to note that the first nominal census, that is to say a record for each individual by name and his belongings, of which the results are now known, was taken in Quebec in 1665. This census was followed at irregular intervals up to 1763 by fourteen more or less complete enumerations, and by eight census enumerations between 1763 and 1867. Previous to 1665 various estimates of population had been published; the first of these was for the year 1608 when Champlain and 27 settlers wintered at Quebec. In 1665 the total population of New France (Quebec) was 3,215, of whom 2,034 were males and 1,181 were females.

According to the census of 1667 there were 3,918 persons in New France. It is stated there were 11,448 arpents under cultivation, the number of cattle 3,107 and of sheep 85. In 1668 an estimate placed the population at 6,282, the arpents under cultivation at 15,642, the number of horned cattle at 3,400, and the production of grain at 130,978 minots.

Following 1667 no census was taken until 1679. In this census the population was 9,400, the land under cultivation 21,900 arpents, the number of horses 145, of asses 12, of horned cattle 6,983, of sheep 719 and of goats 33. In 1681 another census was taken, but the records do not indicate any marked progress in agriculture. In the census of 1685 the population is given as being 12,263, of which 10,725 were whites and 1,538 Indians settled near the French, the number of houses 1,990, of mills 41, of horses 156, of horned cattle 7,474, of sheep 787 and of goats 14. The area of cultivated land was given as 24,390 arpents.

The census of 1688 shows a decrease in population and in the number of houses. The area of cultivated land increased to 28,663 arpents. The production of wheat was placed at 100,971 minots and of other grains at 28,554 minots. Horses numbered 218, cattle 7,719, sheep 1,061 and swine 3,701.

Beginning with the enumeration of 1692 the scope of the census was greatly extended, as the statistics of agriculture show. The population at this census was given as 12,431, of which 11,075 were whites and 1,356 Indians settled near the French. The slow but steadily forward trend of agriculture is shown by the various nominal censuses and statements made between 1692 and the date of the Treaty of Paris, 1763, in the following table.

NOTE.—The statistics for those years marked with a star (*) were considered by Dr. Taché and others as being the only nominal censuses taken between 1692 and 1763. The census records in the Archives at Ottawa, which are transcriptions of the original copies in the "Archives de Paris," classify the enumerations for all years given in this table as "General Census of Canada." For the year 1754 the records show only a census of population.

Although what is now known as the Province of Ontario was included under the term "Canada," yet Mr. W. H. P. Clement, in his history, states that "from Montreal until Detroit was reached, not a genuine settler could be found." It is therefore assumed that the statistics of the foregoing table relate solely to territory within the Province of Quebec as now constituted.

Between 1763 and the date of Confederation eight censuses were taken. Beginning with 1851 the enumeration has been made in the first year of each decade.

The rural population of Quebec increased from 992,667 in 1901 to 1,032,618 in 1911. The area of land occupied in 1911 was 15,576,809 acres as against 14,444,175 acres in 1901. Taking the land area of the province at the date of the last census there was only 7.12 per cent occupied as farm land.

The number of farm holdings in 1911 was 159,554 as against 150,599 in 1901. The average size per holding in 1911 was 97.63 as against 95.90 acres in 1901.

Improved land for the census of 1911 according to the Manual of Instruction to enumerators was defined as "land which has been brought under cultivation, and has been cropped and is fitted for producing crops." In previous censuses no clear definition was given of the term "improved land." The result was that under this heading was included non-tillable areas used as pasture. In this census the areas of arable lands only were enumerated under this heading. Therefore the areas of improved land in this census are not strictly comparable with those of the previous ones.

The area of improved lands increased by about 9½ per cent in the decade, being 8,147,633 in 1911 as against 7,439,941 acres in 1901. At the last census

52.30 per cent of the land occupied was improved as against 51.51 per cent in 1901.

Land in field crops was 5,399,223 acres in 1911, being an average of 33.8 acres per holding as against 4,704,396 acres in 1901 or an average of 31.2 acres per holding; the land in orchard and nursery shows a slight decrease in area between 1901 and 1911; the land in vegetables increased from 28,809 to 63,216 acres in the decade; land in vineyards increased from 119 acres in 1901 to 709 acres in 1911. The record of land in small fruits was not taken in 1901, but in 1911 it is given as 1,961 acres.

Tables III and IV give the area and production of field crops by census or electoral districts for 1910 and by totals for the province for 1910 and 1900 and Table IX gives the areas in field crops for the province in the years 1911, 1910 and 1900. The area of land under spring wheat for 1911 shows an increase over 1910, but is only one-half of that reported in 1900. There are increases in the land under oats, hay, buckwheat and forage crops. There is an increase for 1910 of 3,433 acres in tobacco over that of 1900. The statistics of horticulture as shown in Table V indicate that the number of fruit trees and the production of fruit is less in 1910 than it was in 1900. The production of small fruits shows a good increase.

Horses increased from 320,673 to 369,237, swine from 404,163 to 793,348. There are also large increases in all kinds of poultry. The number of milch cows decreased from 767,825 in 1901 to 753,134 in 1911; for the same period the number of other horned cattle increased from 598,004 to 697,860. Notwithstanding the increased price of mutton and lamb, the number of sheep shows a decrease from 1901 to 1911. There are increases in the numbers of all pure bred stock, the greatest improvement being made in cattle and the smallest in sheep. The production of wool has fallen off by 31.42 per cent in the ten years.

Tables X and XI give comparative statistics of total area and production, together with the average yields per acre of the different field crops in 1910 and 1900, and the average value per acre of the various crops for the year 1910.

The average value of horses in 1911 was \$127.98; of milch cows \$37.51; of other horned cattle \$12.48; of sheep \$4.26; of swine \$7.61; in 1901 the average value of horses was \$75.35; of milch cows \$27.03; of other horned cattle \$11.08; of sheep \$3.63; of swine \$7.78. The average value of all live stock per farm holding was \$600 in 1911 as against \$387 in 1901, and of field crops, vegetables and fruits was \$448 in 1910 as against \$315 in 1900.

The value of live stock sold in 1910 is given as \$20,406,385, as against \$6,650,486 in 1900. The value of animals slaughtered on the farm increased by \$621,650; the value of wool, eggs, honey and wax increased by \$2,342,746; eggs alone made up for \$2,085,375 of this increase. The value of maple sugar and syrup increased from \$1,356,481 in 1901 to \$1,680,393 in 1911.

The number of weeks of hired labour on farms in 1910 was 686,114 and the value \$5,077,987, being an average wage of \$7.40 per week as against 894,534 weeks in 1900 with a value of \$4,512,674 and an average of \$5.04. This is an increase over 47 per cent in farm wages per week in ten years.
