**POPULATION OF MUNICIPAL WARDS  
BY SEX, AGE, RACIAL ORIGIN, RELIGION, ETC.**

This bulletin presents final population figures of the 1941 Census for the municipal wards of cities of 100,000 population and over, classified according to each of the following subjects: sex, conjugal condition, age, racial origin, religion, birthplace, immigration and citizenship, school attendance, official language and mother tongue.

The municipal wards of the following cities are shown in this bulletin: Montreal, Toronto, Winnipeg, Hamilton, Ottawa, Quebec and Windsor. The wards of the City of Vancouver are not included, however, as these were discarded as administrative districts previous to the 1941 Census.

Ce bulletin présente les données finales de la population d'après le recensement de 1941 pour les quartiers municipaux des villes de 100,000 âmes et plus, classifiée selon chacun des sujets suivants: le sexe, l'état conjugal, l'âge, l'origine raciale, la religion, le lieu de naissance, l'immigration et la citoyenneté, la fréquentation scolaire, la langue officielle et la langue maternelle.

Sont donnés dans ce bulletin les quartiers municipaux des villes suivantes: Montréal, Toronto, Winnipeg, Hamilton, Ottawa, Québec et Windsor. Les quartiers de la ville de Vancouver ne paraissent pas vu que ceux-ci ont été abolis comme districts administratifs antérieurement au recensement de 1941.
