

SUMMARY INDIVIDUAL INCOME STATISTICS

This report presents estimates of the income distribution of individuals by sex for Canada and the provinces and Yukon as well as income distribution of individuals by sex, age, and marital status for Canada only. Average income figures for both males and females are shown for each county and census division.

These statistics were obtained from a twenty per cent sample of private non-farm households in the 1961 Census of Canada. The sample excluded farm households, institutions, collective households such as hotels and large lodging houses and all households in the Northwest Territories. In addition, persons away from their usual place of residence as, for example, persons travelling abroad or families of military personnel stationed in Europe, were excluded from the sample.

Information on cash income from all sources was obtained from each person aged 15 and over resident in the sample households. Persons in the sample were asked to report total income received in the 12 months preceding June 1, 1961, or, if this figure could not be provided, the income for the calendar year 1960.

The total population 15 years and over, on June 1, 1961, was 12,046,325. The estimated number of individuals for whom figures in this report are published is 10,101,772. The difference is due to 1,298,784 persons living in rural farm households and 645,769 in collective households, institutions, and a few farms in urban centres which are excluded from the sample.

Average income figures are calculated only for persons with income; all averages in this report exclude persons not reporting income. The income distribution tables show the number of persons reporting no income separately.

More detailed statistics for counties and divisions and urban size groups will be released in report No. 98-501 to be part of the reports which will constitute Volume IV of the 1961 Census of Canada.

STATISTIQUE SOMMAIRE DU REVENU DES PARTICULIERS

Le présent rapport donne des estimations quant à la répartition du revenu des particuliers, par sexe, au Canada et dans les provinces ainsi qu'au Yukon, de même que, pour le Canada seulement, une répartition du revenu des particuliers par sexe, âge et état matrimonial. Le revenu moyen, tant des hommes que des femmes, est indiqué pour chaque comté et division de recensement.

Les chiffres ont été tirés d'un échantillon de vingt pour cent des ménages non agricoles privés lors du recensement du Canada de 1961. Sont exclus de l'échantillon les ménages agricoles, les institutions; les ménages collectifs tels que les hôtels et les grandes "maisons de chambres" et tous les ménages des Territoires du Nord-Ouest. En outre, sont exclues de l'échantillon les personnes éloignées de leur domicile habituel telles que les personnes en voyage à l'étranger ou les familles de militaires postés en Europe.

Les renseignements sur le revenu en espèces ont été obtenus de chaque personne âgée de 15 ans et plus et membre des ménages de l'échantillon. Les personnes comprises dans l'échantillon ont été priées de déclarer leur revenu total des douze mois antérieurs au 1^{er} juin 1961, à défaut de quoi, leur revenu de l'année civile 1960.

La population totale âgée de 15 ans et plus, le 1^{er} juin 1961, était de 12,046,325. Le nombre de personnes à l'égard desquelles le présent rapport donne des chiffres est de 10,101,772. La différence tient à ce que 1,298,784 personnes demeurent dans des ménages ruraux agricoles et 645,769 dans des ménages collectifs, des institutions et quelques fermes situées dans des collectivités urbaines, exclus de l'échantillon.

Les chiffres du revenu moyen ne sont calculés qu'à l'égard des personnes qui ont un revenu; les personnes qui ne déclarent aucun revenu sont exclues de toutes les moyennes données dans le présent rapport. Les tableaux relatifs à la répartition du revenu donnent, à part, le nombre de ces personnes.

Des statistiques plus détaillées pour les comtés et les divisions de même que pour les régions urbaines par tranche de taille paraîtront dans le rapport n° 98-501 qui fera partie du volume IV du recensement de 1961.

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DEFINITIONS

Age

Age reported in the 1961 Census was the completed years of age at last birthday prior to the census date, June 1, 1961.

Total Income

All persons 15 years of age and over residing in sample households were asked to report total income received from each of the sources listed below for the twelve-month period ending May 31, 1961, or, if this figure could not be provided, for the calendar year 1960.

The sources were:

- (a) Gross cash wages, salaries, commissions and tips (before deductions for income tax, pensions, unemployment insurance, etc.).
- (b) Net income (gross income less operating expenses) received from own business or from a professional practice.
- (c) Family allowances.
- (d) Old-age assistance and old-age security payments.
- (e) Other government transfer payments, e.g., unemployment insurance, workmen's compensation, veterans' pensions and allowances, disability pensions, mothers' allowances, etc.
- (f) Retirement pensions.
- (g) Bond and bank interest and dividends.
- (h) Other investment income, e.g., net rents, mortgage interest, estate income, etc.
- (i) All other money income, e.g., annuities, income from roomers and boarders, alimony, etc.

Individual income is the total of the above sources of income reported by each person 15 years of age and over.

Farm

In the 1961 Census a farm is defined as an agricultural holding of one acre or more with sales of agricultural products during the past 12 months of \$50 or more. Only persons with residence on a farm as defined above are considered as farm population, and hence excluded from the sample; all others are non-farm population. Although a few farm households may be found in urban centres, the majority are in rural areas.

Totals of less than 250 are not shown but are indicated by the symbol (-).

DÉFINITIONS

Âge

L'âge d'une personne, au recensement de 1961, était arrêté au dernier anniversaire de naissance qui précédait le 1^{er} juin 1961.

Revenu total

Toutes les personnes âgées de 15 ans et plus demeurant dans les ménages de l'échantillon ont été priées de déclarer leur revenu découlant de chacune des sources énumérées ci-dessous au cours des douze mois terminés le 31 mai 1961, ou, si le renseignement ne pouvait être donné, de l'année civile 1960.

Les sources sont:

- a) Salaires, traitements, commissions et pourboires bruts (avant déductions d'impôt sur le revenu, pensions, assurance-chômage, etc.).
- b) Revenu net (revenu brut moins frais d'exploitation) d'une entreprise individuelle ou de l'exercice d'une profession.
- c) Allocations familiales.
- d) Pensions d'assistance-vieillesse et de sécurité de la vieillesse.
- e) Autres paiements de transfert des gouvernements tels que assurance-chômage, accidents du travail, pensions et allocations aux anciens combattants, allocations aux invalides, allocations maternelles, etc.
- f) Pensions de retraite.
- g) Intérêt et dividendes (obligations, banques).
- h) Autre revenu de placements (loyers nets, intérêt hypothécaire, revenu de succession, etc.).
- i) Tout autre revenu monétaire (rentes, revenu provenant de locataires de chambres et pensionnaires, pension alimentaire, etc.).

Le revenu individuel est le total des sources de revenu mentionnées ci-dessus par toutes les personnes âgées de 15 ans et plus.

Ferme

Au recensement de 1961, une ferme était une exploitation agricole d'une acre ou plus dont les ventes de produits agricoles, au cours des 12 mois précédents, avaient été de \$50 ou plus. Seules les personnes demeurant dans des fermes, suivant la définition ci-dessus, constituaient la population agricole et, partant, étaient exclues de l'échantillon; toutes les autres constituaient la population non agricole. Bien que quelques ménages agricoles puissent se trouver dans des centres urbains, la majorité sont dans les régions rurales.

Les totaux de moins de 250 ne sont pas donnés mais indiqués plutôt par le signe conventionnel (-).
