CANADA-KOREA FREE TRADE AGREEMENT (CKFTA)

A gateway to increased Canadian agri-food trade in Asia

What is CKFTA?

The Canada-Korea Free Trade Agreement, or CKFTA, is a free trade agreement that provides preferential tariff treatment for Canadian exports to Korea, including agri-food and seafood products

CKFTA has been in force since January 1st, 2015, creating significant advantages for our businesses in Korea's fast growing and highly connected economy. Upon its full implementation in 2032, it is projected to boost Canada's Gross Domestic Product by \$1.7 billion and increase Canadian exports to Korea by over 30%.

As our first free trade agreement in the region, it levels the playing field in the Korean market, opens the doors to regional value chains and expands Canadian trade opportunities.

How does CKFTA support Canadian agri-food and seafood businesses?

Agriculture and food

Since 2017, **54%** of Canadian agriculture and food exports have been eligible to enter Korea duty-free.

That will grow to **70%** by 2019 and to **99%** by 2029.

Before implementation in 2015, Korea's average tariff rate was **52.7%**.

Fish and seafood

Since 2017, **82%** of Canadian fish and seafood exports have been eligible to enter Korea duty-free.

That will grow to **87%** by 2019 and to **100%** by 2026.

Before implementation in 2015, Korea's average tariff rate was 16.5%.


Some of the tariffs on Canadian agri-food and seafood exports already eliminated by CKFTA include:

- 18% for French fries
- **15%** for wine
- **5%** for refined canola oil
- 20% for Pacific and Atlantic salmon
- 20% for lobster
- 20% for rye whisky


Note: To benefit from CKFTA, your products exported to Korea must meet all applicable regulatory and rules of origin requirements.
