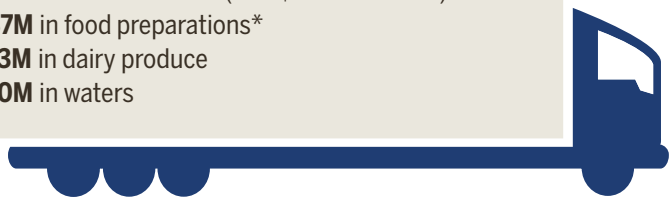

**BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$541 MILLION IN 2017**

**ARIZONA EXPORTED \$416 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$252M in vegetables (incl. \$53M in tomatoes)
- \$92M in fruits and nuts (incl. \$38M in melons)
- \$37M in food preparations\*
- \$13M in dairy produce
- \$10M in waters



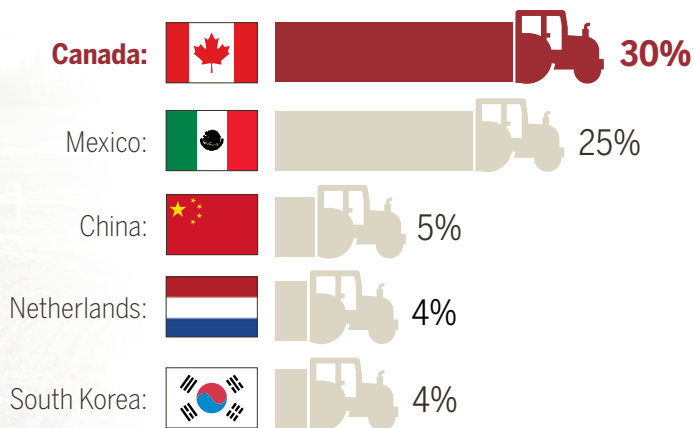
**ARIZONA IMPORTED \$125 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$26M in baked goods
- \$15M in chocolate products
- \$12M in oil cakes
- \$9M in vegetables
- \$9M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts

\* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
