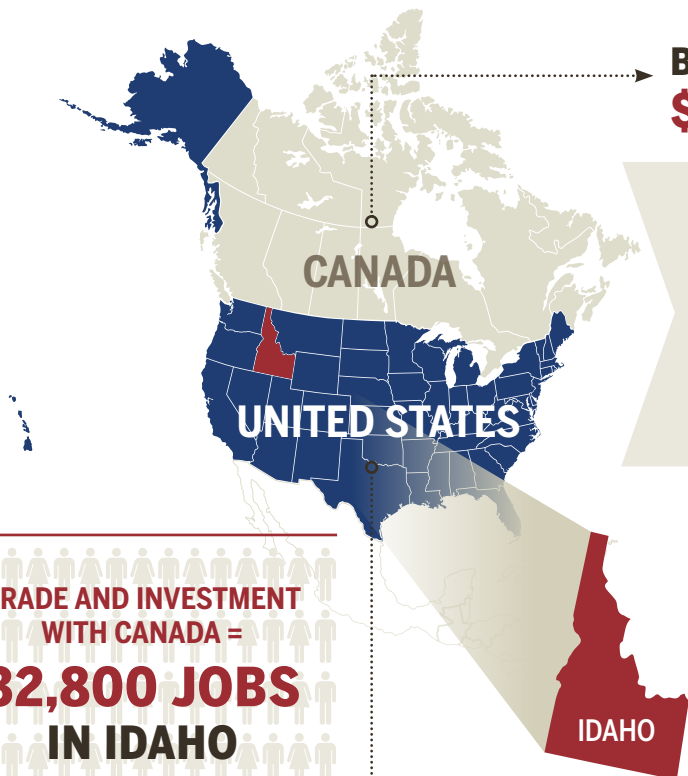

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$447 MILLION IN 2017

IDAHO EXPORTED \$213 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$39M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$33M in vegetables
- \$30M in oil seeds (incl. \$23M in canola seeds)
- \$22M in food preparations*
- \$13M in live cattle

IDAHO IMPORTED \$234 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

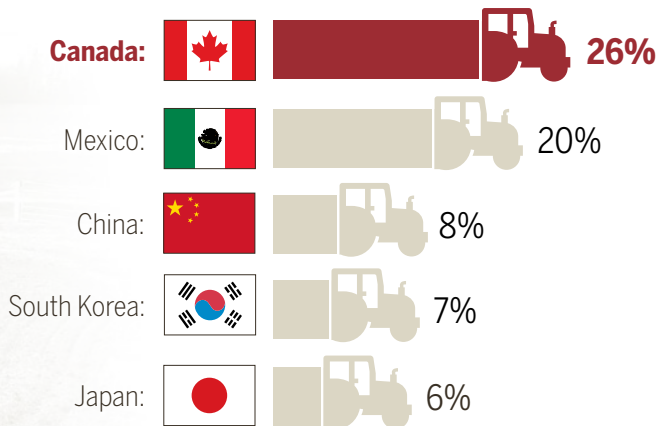
- \$55M in oil cakes
- \$33M in oil seeds (incl. 31M in alfalfa seeds)
- \$22M in fresh, chilled or frozen beef
- \$20M in canola oil
- \$14M in live animals



* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
