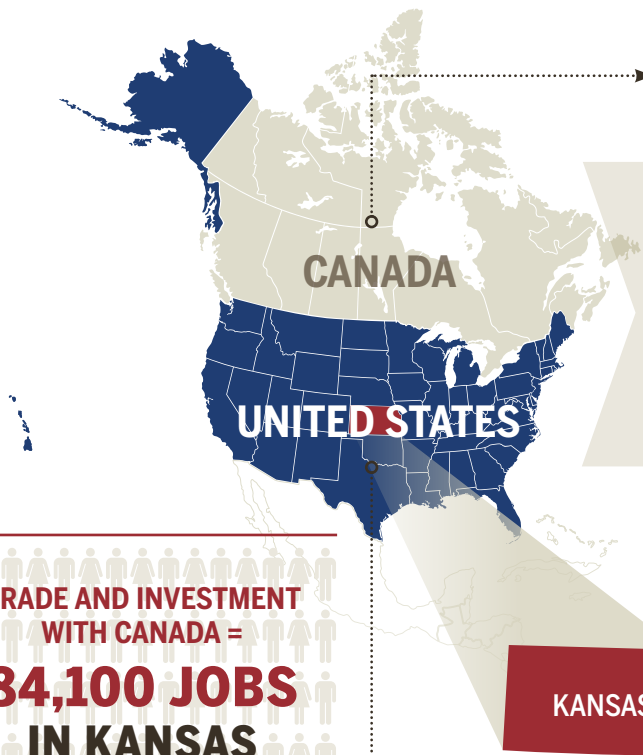

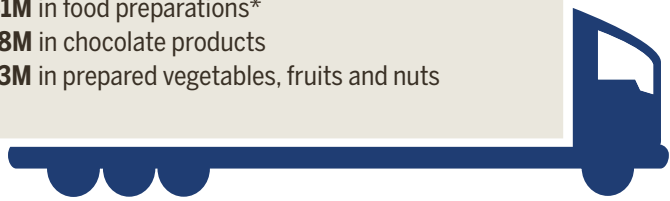

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$464 MILLION IN 2017

KANSAS EXPORTED \$329 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$116M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$107M in beef)
- \$99M in animal feed
- \$31M in food preparations*
- \$18M in chocolate products
- \$13M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts



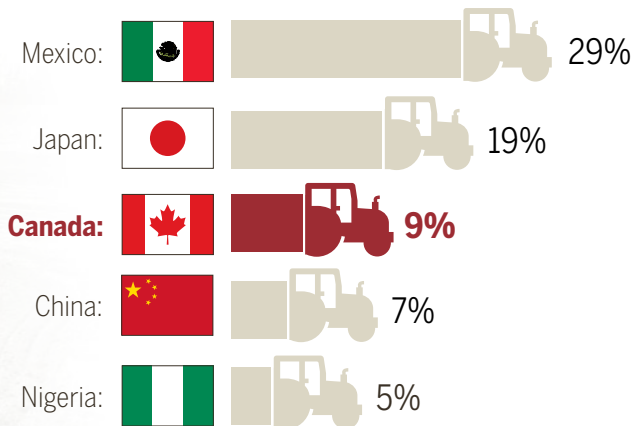
KANSAS IMPORTED \$135 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$18M in fats and oils (incl. \$14M in canola oil)
- \$17M in vegetables
- \$15M in live animals
- \$11M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$8M in pork)
- \$9M in chocolate products

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
