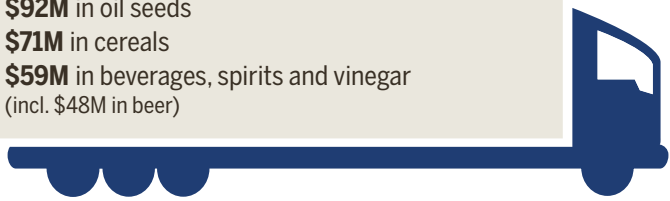

### BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$1.8 BILLION IN 2017

#### MICHIGAN EXPORTED \$854 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$175M in prepared cereal products
- \$157M in vegetables
- \$92M in oil seeds
- \$71M in cereals
- \$59M in beverages, spirits and vinegar (incl. \$48M in beer)

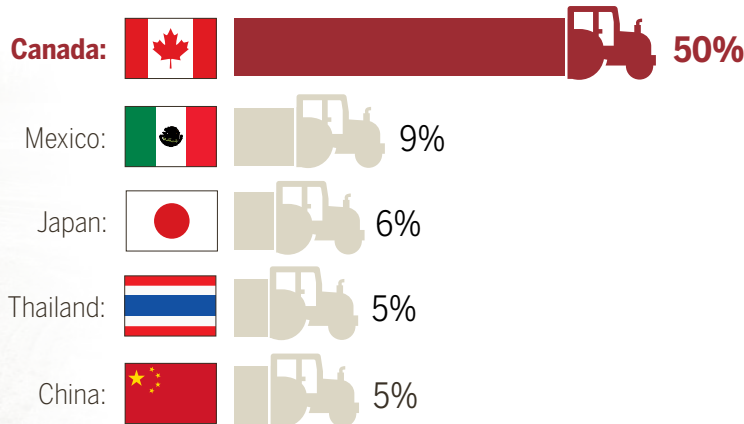


#### MICHIGAN IMPORTED \$959 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$232M in vegetables
- \$162M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$61M in pork)
- \$79M in prepared cereal products
- \$66M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$53M in oil cakes
