

TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$248M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- → \$230M in fruits and nuts
- → \$86M in food preparations\*
- → \$80M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- → \$72M in fats and oils



FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$178M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$83M in beef)
- → \$175M in prepared cereal products
- → \$167M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- → \$160M in coffee
- → \$158M in fats and oils

\*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
