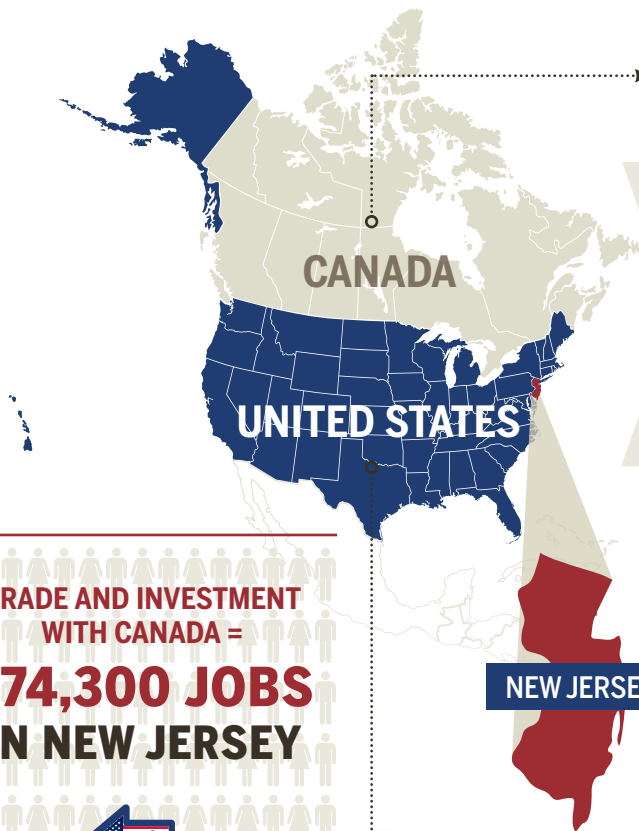

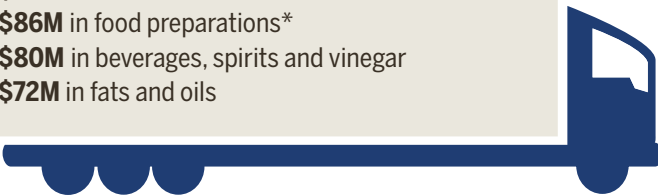

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$2.3 BILLION IN 2017

NEW JERSEY EXPORTED \$1 BILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$248M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$230M in fruits and nuts
- \$86M in food preparations*
- \$80M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$72M in fats and oils



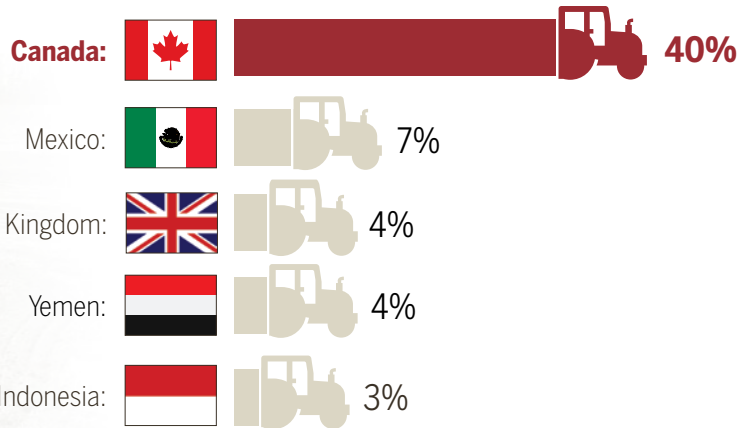
NEW JERSEY IMPORTED \$1.3 BILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$178M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$83M in beef)
- \$175M in prepared cereal products
- \$167M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$160M in coffee
- \$158M in fats and oils

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
