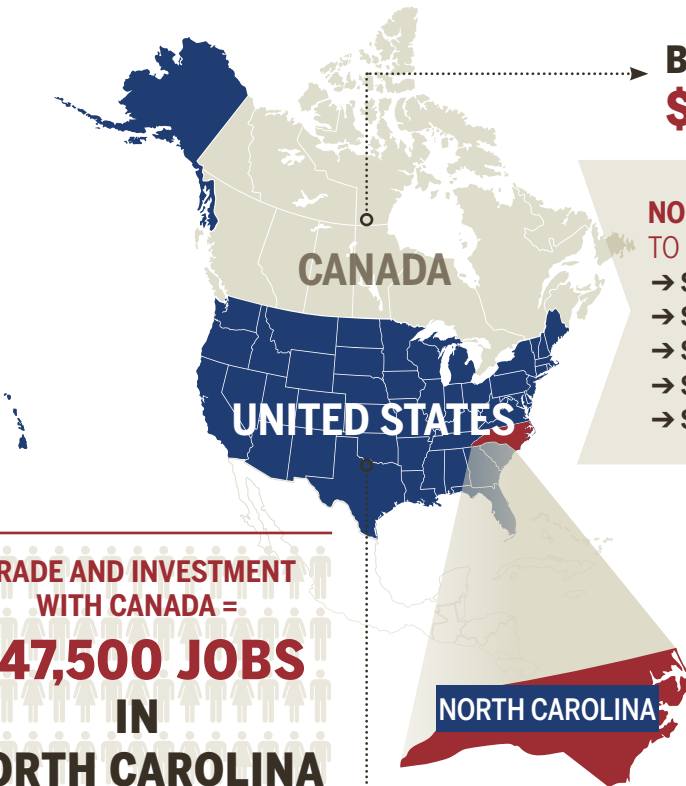

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$594 MILLION IN 2017

NORTH CAROLINA EXPORTED \$290 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$79M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$50M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$31M in chicken)
- \$41M in prepared cereal products
- \$30M in vegetables
- \$22M in tobacco products



NORTH CAROLINA IMPORTED \$304 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$56M in tobacco products
- \$46M in prepared cereal products
- \$34M in vegetables
- \$29M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$25M in beef)
- \$20M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts

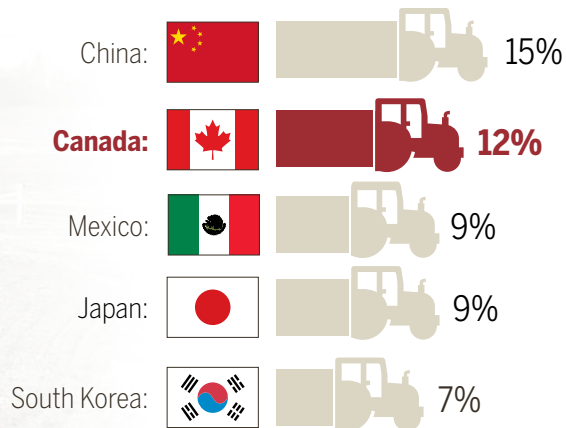
