

OHIO EXPORTED \$1.5 BILLION

TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$590M in tobacco products
- → \$147M in prepared cereal products (incl. \$95M in baked goods)
- → \$128M in food preparations*
- → \$118M in prepared meat
- → \$83M in animal feed



FROM CANADA. INCLUDING:

- → \$169M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$115M in pork)
- → \$148M in canola and mustard oils
- → \$137M in prepared cereal products
- → \$100M in food preparations*
- → \$92M in cereals

*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
