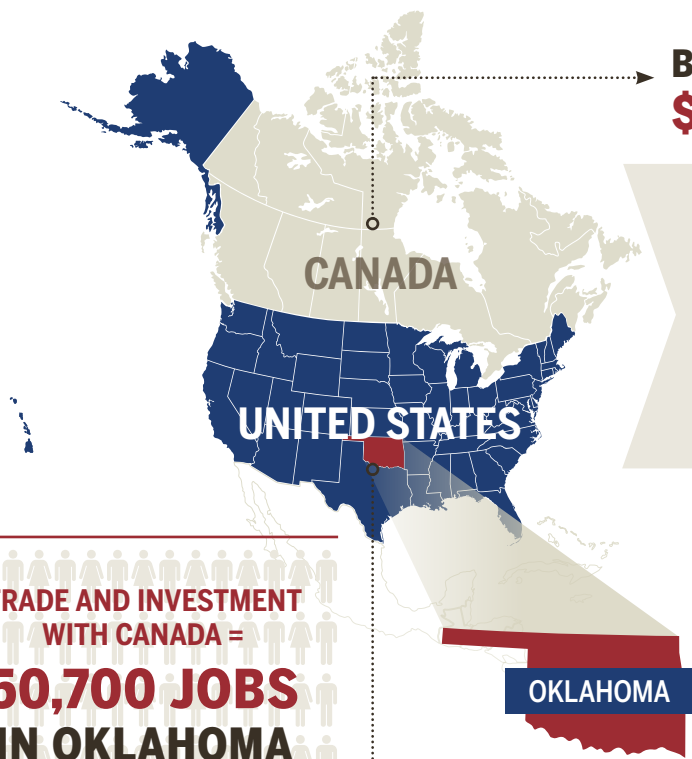

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$79 MILLION IN 2017

OKLAHOMA EXPORTED \$26 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$10M in live animals
- \$6M in proteins and starches
- \$3M in ground nuts
- \$2M in fresh, chilled or frozen pork
- \$2M in prepared cereal products

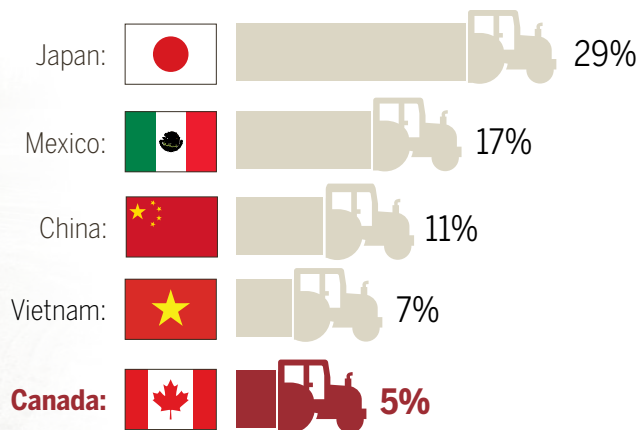


OKLAHOMA IMPORTED \$53 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$19M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. 7M in beef)
- \$15M in baked goods
- \$3M in vegetables
- \$3M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$2M in live animals
