

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$2.8 BILLION IN 2017

PENNSYLVANIA EXPORTED \$1.1 BILLION

TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$300M in cocoa and cocoa preparations
- → \$166M in prepared cereal products (incl. \$93M in baked goods)
- → \$142M in food preparations*
- → \$84M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- → \$81M in coffee



PENNSYLVANIA IMPORTED \$1.7 BILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$348M in prepared cereal products
- → \$242M in cocoa and cocoa preparations
- → \$141M in sugars and sweets
- → \$123M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- → \$119M in live animals (incl. \$105M in live cattle)

*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
