

## RHODE ISLAND EXPORTED \$7 MILLION

TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$4M in sausages
- → \$2M in coffee
- → \$1M in food preparations\*
- → \$299K in prepared cereal products
- → \$171K in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$120K in pork)



## RHODE ISLAND IMPORTED \$28 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$13M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$11M in pork)
- → \$4M in vegetables
- → \$3M in baked goods
- → \$2M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- → \$2M in live plants

\*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
